## 'OUT' TO MAKE HISTORY

Featuring the race's two-time defending champion, winners of two-thirds of this year's Triple Crown as well as the prestigious GI Woodward S. and GI Whitney Invitational H., today's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Invitational at Belmont Park has it all.

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Cross Traffic** (Unbridled's Song), making his first attempt beyond nine furlongs here, has done very little wrong in five career starts. A heartbreaking second in the GI Metropolitan H. May 27, the GoldMark Farm colorbearer successfully carried his speed, albeit while racing a bit erratically in the stretch, in the Whitney last out Aug. 3. Cross Traffic is the 5-2 morning-line favorite.

really."

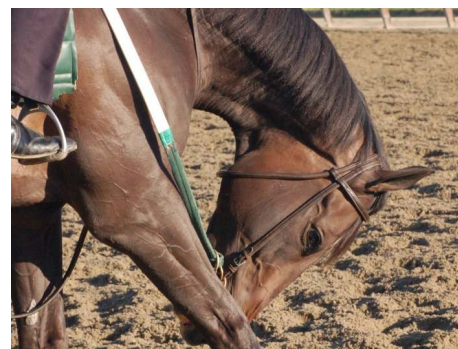

## 'PRINCESS' ATTEMPTS TO DETHRONE QUEEN

Despite having a field of six, today's GI Beldame Invitational S. at Belmont Park looks to be a royal match race between the two leading ladies of racing ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) and **Princess of Sylmar** (Majestic Warrior). This 1 1/8-mile event is a "Win and You're in" for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, known as the Ladies' Classic for the past two years.

Royal Delta won last year's renewal of this test by 9 1/2 lengths on her way to her second straight victory in the Distaff, which she will try to extend to three-in-a-row this year. The Besilu Stables colorbearer has another divisional championship in her sights after a

10-length romp in the GI Delaware H. July 20 followed by a solid score in the GI Personal Ensign H. at Saratoga Aug. 25. Her only losses in 2013 were against the boys in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 30 and an uncharacteristically dull second in Churchill Downs' GI Fleur De Lis H. June 15. Royal Delta led from wire-to-wire in her last two scores, but trainer Bill Mott said she doesn't have to be the front-runner to win. "I'll let [jockey] Mike [Smith] worry about that," Mott said. "She will position herself where she's comfortable. She's been [on the lead] her last few races, but it's not a situation where she has to be on the lead." As far as top 3-year-old filly Princess of Sylmar is concerned, Mott said, "She's a serious filly. You can't take her for granted, but Royal Delta is doing well. I would say it seems she's on the same path she was last year."

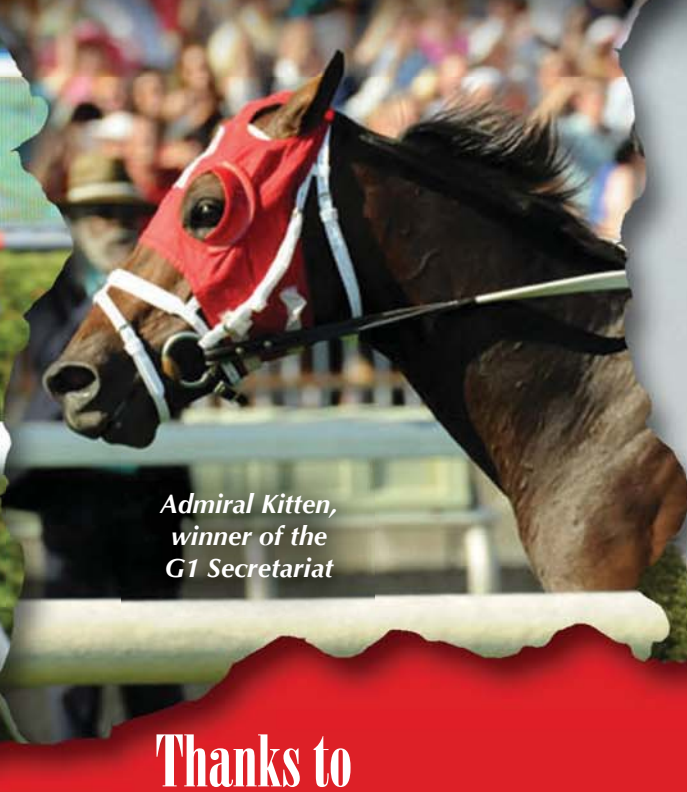

Three-year-olds have fared quite well in the Gold Cup in recent years, including 2006 hero Bernardini (A. P. Indy), 2007 winner Curlin (Smart Strike) and 2009 victor Summer Bird (Birdstone). All three earned Eclipse honors at year's end.

**Orb** (Malibu Moon) capped a five-race winning streak with a tour-de-force in the GI Kentucky Derby May 4, and appears to be rounding back into form as he faces his elders for the first time. A well-beaten fourth in the GI Preakness S. two weeks later, the bay was freshened after finishing third, beaten five lengths, behind **Palace Malice** (Curlin) in the GI Belmont S. June 8. Orb seized command in the stretch and looked like he was going to be a major player in the GI Travers S. Aug. 24, but got a little tired late and had to settle for a close third. The Stuart S. Janney III and Phipps Stable homebred returned to Fair Hill after the 'Midsummer Derby,' most recently working five furlongs in 1:01 Sept. 23.

"I think the Travers helped him," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "I thought he ran a very good race in the Travers and he came out of it very good. His works at Fair Hill have been exactly what we've wanted. I think we've got a fresh horse that's going in the right direction with a good, solid race under his belt."

Dogwood Stable's Palace Malice, meanwhile, continues to improve with every start. He followed his Belmont upset with a one-length tally over Will Take Charge (Unbridled's Song) in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 27 before finishing a well-documented troubled fourth behind that rival in the Travers.

Ed Stanco's homebred Princess of Sylmar faces older females for the first time in her career. The Todd Pletcher trainee is on a hot streak with back-to-back wins in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3, Saratoga's GI Coaching Club

American Oaks July 20, and GI Alabama S. Aug. 17. She has only one blemish to her 2013 record with a second to GI Cotillion S. heroine Close Hatches (First Defence) after a wide trip in the GII Gazelle S. at Laurel Apr. 6. Pletcher does not plan on changing Princess of Sylmar's

stalking style. "We will not alter her style, and I think that's really important that [jockey] Javier [Castellano] understand that and not take her out of her own style. What we've got to hope is the last eighth of a mile, the last sixteenth of a mile that Royal Delta comes back to us a little bit. Obviously we can be helped by someone showing some initiative early, but if they don't do it, we're just going to let our filly run her race and hope for the best."

Darley homebred **Centring** (A.P. Indy) faced Royal Delta in her last two starts, finishing fourth in the Delaware H. and third in the Personal Ensign. "She's been running some big races," trainer Tom Albertrani said. "Pace has a lot to do with the way she'll close on the front-runners. We're going to add some blinkers this time to try and get her a little closer."

**LAUGHING GOING LONGER IN FLOWER BOWL**

Richard Santulli's **Laughing (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) will attempt to carry her speed over more ground as she seeks her fourth straight win in Belmont's GI Flower Bowl Invitational S., which holds "Win and You're In" status for the

GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. A winner of last year's GIII Matchmaker S. at Monmouth, the Irish import has really come into her own at five. "We always thought she had the talent, but she was never really 100% healthy or 100% happy; now

she is," explained trainer Al Goldberg. Laughing upset Grade I winner Dayatthespa (City Zip) in Oceanport's GIII Eatontown H. on her belated seasonal debut June 29, and took advantage of the latter's scratch and controlled Saratoga's July 27 Diana S. from the outset to score by a head. The bay enters off a similar success upstate in the Aug. 24 GII Ballston Spa S., but will be asked to go this 10-furlong trip for the first time since she finished 10th as a 3-year-old facing older in Woodbine's GI E. P. Taylor S. for Charles O'Brien in 2011. The bay is a stakes winner over 1 3/8 miles in her native country, and a lack of early pace pressers could help her get the distance. "I think she'll get the trip," Goldberg said. "She's kind of bred to go that far, anyway." Laughing's half-brother Viva Pataca (GB) (Marju {Ire}) excelled at longer distances, and was named champion older horse and champion stayer in Hong Kong. Coupled in the wagering with Laughing is **Tannery (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}). The bay annexed the GII Sheepshead Bay S. over a very boggy local course May 25, but settled for eighth over course and distance in the GII New York S. June 29. Tasked with taking on the boys in Saratoga's Aug. 17 GI Sword Dancer S., Tannery performed admirably despite a wide trip to check in a fast-closing fourth, beaten narrowly by a trio of contenders in today's GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S. Andrew Stone's **Qushchi (GB)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) is the 3-1 second choice on Eric Donovan's morning line. Never off the board in five previous U.S. attempts, the Graham Motion pupil took the 12-furlong Waya S. Aug. 25 over next-out Kentucky Downs Ladies Marathon winner **Mystical Star** (Ghostzapper) and **Kissable (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). Jake Ballis colobearer **White Rose** (Tapit) gets in light at 115 pounds as the lone 3-year-old in the field. The grey flew home to annex a 1 3/16-mile Saratoga allowance July 25, and finished second against her elders last out in the off-the-turf Glens Falls S. Sept. 2.

On Aug. 17, Ken and Sarah Ramsey had a day most owners could only dream about--they annexed three Grade I races in a matter of two hours with progeny of their stallion Kitten's Joy. Now they return with two of the key players from that banner day in this afternoon's

GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S., an automatic qualifier for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. **Real Solution** (Kitten's Joy) annexed the first three starts of his career in Italy for conditioner Gianluca Bietolini, but was transferred to Chad Brown after a pair of

losses. Fourth in this venue's 8 1/2-panel GIII Fort Marcy S. May 4, the Pennsylvania-bred came with a strong rally to be third over yielding going here in the GI Manhattan H. June 8. Shipped to Chicago for a wide-open renewal of the GI Arlington Million, the bay flew home late, only to come up a head short of foreign invader The Apache (SAf) (Mogok), who was subsequently taken down for coming out on and interfering with Real Solution. "He keeps improving with every race we run him, and it seems like he's sitting on another top effort," Brown said of Real Solution. "This horse has appreciated longer time with me, and he's still a relatively young horse. He hasn't been [1 1/2 miles], but with the way he was closing in the [1 1/4-mile] Million, perhaps the distance won't bother him." Joining Real Solution is fellow Chad Brown pupil **Big Blue Kitten** (Kitten's Joy), who sports a 7-5-1-1 record in his last seven starts and back-to-back Grade I victories. The bay took advantage of a rail-skimming run in the July 6 GI United Nations S. at Monmouth, and bested **Twilight Eclipse** (Purim) and **Nutello** (Lemon Drop Kid) in Saratoga's GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at this distance. "He's finally getting those longer distances, and I think that, in combination with physically maturing, has him in top form, as long as the turf is firm," said Brown of the former claimer, who also annexed the 2011 GII Hall of Fame S. at 1 1/16 miles. "He's won two Grade I races in a row, so he should be a major player." Also donning the Ramsey silks is **Joel Blazing Aaron** (Grame Hall), claimed for \$62,500 by Mike Maker at the Spa Aug. 26. The 5-year-old is entered to ensure a fast pace, and could pose a major problem for defending GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner **Little Mike** (Spanish Steps) and fleet-footed middle-distance type **King Kreesa** (King Kugat).

"I was disappointed in the race," Hushion admitted of The Lumber Guy's most recent start. "I thought he had trained well enough to win it and that he would run better. But, going 6 1/2 [furlongs], and the fact that he hasn't really run hard for well over three-quarters of a year, I guess I'll have to settle for it with a big, strong, muscular horse like him." **Strapping Groom** (Johannesburg), claimed by trainer David Jacobson and Drawing Away Stable for \$35,000 in May, enters off a pair of victories, including a 15-1 upset in a sloppy renewal of Saratoga's GI Forego S. Aug. 31. "He came out of the race great," Jacobson said. "He's been training and doing as good as he can. The Forego didn't take anything out of him. If anything, he's improved a little bit." **Justin Phillip** (First Samurai) followed a breakthrough performance in Saratoga's GI Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. Aug. 4 with a third-place finish in the Forego. Sophomore **Forty Tales** (Tale of the Cat), winner of the GI Woody Stephens S. over this strip June 8, tackles elders after finishing a troubled fourth as the 5-2 favorite in the GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 24.

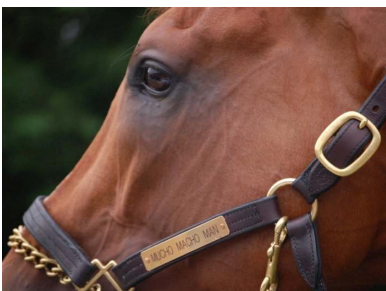

John Sadler takes the blinkers off multiple Grade I winner Lady of Shamrock in an attempt to capture her first victory this season after a series of graded stakes placings. Since rounding out the Gamely trifecta, the Hronis Racing LLC colorbearer took second in her only start outside of California in Belmont's GII New York S. June 29 and was runner-up again in the John C. Mabee. She boasts four wins and a second in her six starts over this course.

Trainer Paul Cole's son and assistant Oliver commented, "He's bred to stay a bit further and in his final bit of work at the weekend he settled and we thought we wouldn't be shy to take the mile on. I don't think there'll be any problems as far as stamina is concerned. He finished well over seven furlongs in the Chesham and is crying out for a mile. We've been pleased with him all along--there's been no hiccups, touch wood. He was just slightly immature at Ascot and we decided to give him time. Seeing how he runs, the [G1] Dewhurst could be the next race--that's what Frankel did, go from a mile to seven furlongs. I'd doubt we'd go for the [G1] Racing Post Trophy, as it's too late on in the season and the ground could be a question mark up there." Since his fourth in the Chesham, Sheikh Majid bin Mohammed al Maktoum's Somewhat has finished runner-up in the G2 Superlative S. at Newmarket July 13 before beating the subsequent listed winner Be Ready (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) in Newbury's Listed Washington Singer S. last time Aug. 17. Ballydoyle test the waters with **Kingfisher (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who will provide a fairer indication as to the ability of his stable companion Australia (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), who he trailed by 9 1/2 lengths when third in the G3 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Trial S. at Leopardstown on the Irish Champion S. undercard Sept. 7.

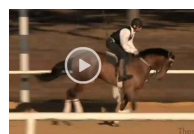

Not instantly in love with the switch to more dramatic hold-up tactics here, she was rank until succumbing to Richard Hughes' tender handling and was able to conserve energy in a pocket behind the similarly patiently ridden Rizeena, with only Godolphin's **Ihtimal (Ire)** (Shamardal) behind. As the early crawl led to the inevitable final surge, the Irish pair of **Avenue Gabriel (GB)** (Champs Elysees {GB}) and **Ballybacka Queen (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}) gained first run, but Rizeena quickly brushed them aside before being overhauled by the surprise winner. "It was a little bit stop-start, but not that much of a sprint as two-

and-a-half down there were a lot of horses off the bridle and we quickened well to the line with Rizeena," Hughes commented. "Willie Carson said the only thing he could come up with from the Deauville run was that she had too much daylight for the whole race, so I was very conscious to get cover and was sitting a long way out of my ground as a result. Luckily, Rizeena was in front of me and she was the one to beat and I felt I was going to win from halfway. I rode Chief Barker when he beat her last time and with the turn of foot she showed that day I thought I was in with a sneaky chance. She is an ideal Guineas candidate--she moves and settles well and loves the track, so there are no qualms." Charlie Hills added, "When she was beaten at Haydock last time, Gerald Mosse rode her and he said he'd got there way too soon because he didn't think she would change gears that quickly and she should have won. We'll see how she is in the next couple of weeks, but it is either America or prepare for next year's Classics." Part-owner Willie Carson said, "It wasn't a surprise, as Charlie has always said she works as good as [G3 Albany S. winner and G1 Moyglare Stud S. third] Kiyoshi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}). She went to Deauville and we were so disappointed. ## EURO PREVIEWS

### SECONDS OUT...

Today's G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket sees the rematch between **Sky Lantern (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}) and **Elusive Kate** (Elusive Quality), who clashed on the July Course in the G1 Falmouth S. with what many regard as an unsatisfactory outcome. Ben Keswick's grey was second in that July 12 showdown, but with Teruya Yoshida's charge carrying her left across the track, the stewards' decision to leave the result as it stood created some controversy. What is clear is that both are high-class in their own right, with Sky Lantern demonstrating her authority over her peers in the June 21 G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot, having annexed the G1 1,000 Guineas over this track and trip May 6, and Elusive Kate now a four-times winner at this level after winning a second consecutive G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville July 28. Both have unplaced efforts to rebound from, with Sky Lantern suffering interference when fifth in the G1 Nassau S. at Goodwood Aug. 3 and Elusive Kate only seventh in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois back at Deauville Aug. 11. Sky Lantern's trainer Richard Hannon commented, "Elusive Kate is just one of six classy fillies that we have to beat, but everything we have seen at home suggests that Sky Lantern is at the top of her game. We were worried earlier in the week about the prospect of rain and whether they would risk watering if it did not arrive, but the jockeys are adamant that the ground is riding on the fast side of good, and with a dry forecast Sky Lantern should get her perfect underfoot conditions. She has thrived through the summer and now weighs in at an awesome 495 kilos and, while it was not lack of stamina which beat her in the Nassau S., she has proved herself a champion over the mile so it makes sense to come back in trip here." Elusive Kate's jockey William Buick is hopeful she can confirm the form of the Falmouth. "You can be sure that both fillies will be going into this on the top of their game, but I have genuine faith in Elusive Kate and the boss, John Gosden, is a genius with fillies and has got her there in top shape," he said. "Although she's performed well on soft and won when there's give in the ground, she is at home on a quicker surface so I don't have a concern about the weather. She's got speed and I know that she stays, so all options are there to be explored." Qatar Racing and the Sangster Family's **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) was only a half length behind Sky Lantern in the Guineas and, after her subsequent success in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later, was believed capable of getting the better of her rival in the Coronation before finishing a slightly disappointing third. Injured when trailing in the Nassau, she has been nurtured back by trainer Charlie Hills, and he is hoping for a bold show. "She ripped a shoe off at Goodwood and the break has done her the world of good," he said. "I'm sure she'll run well as long as the ground is not too firm, and we know that this track suits her."

Newmarket plays host to some fast fillies in today's G1 Cheveley Park S., and few can boast the speed of the French raider **Vorda (Fr)** (Orpen) as she bids to become the third to annex the race for her native country since 2007. Successful in the July 21 G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte, Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Thani's bay was finishing best of all behind No Nay Never (Scat Daddy) in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville last time Aug. 18, and had the subsequent G1 Moyglare Stud S. winner and G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up Rizeena (Ire) (Iffraaj {GB}) behind. "She has come on from each of her races, physically and mentally," trainer Philippe Sogorb told *PA Sport*. "Following the Morny, where she didn't have a hard race, she has been in good form and I'm very happy with her. She is full of speed and quick off her feet. She is very easy to ride and to train. I cannot find the slightest flaw with this filly. If there is no rhythm in the race she adapts, if there is loads of pace she follows, if it is good ground or soft, she just goes. This is not her last race of the season, as we are looking at the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' Turf. If she wins, we would look at that race." **Kiyoshi (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), who for a long time looked the best 2-year-old filly in training by virtue of her dazzling success in Royal Ascot's G3 Albany S. over this trip June 21, had to settle for second, before being demoted to third, in the Moyglare Stud S. trying seven furlongs in her only subsequent start at The Curragh earlier this month. Qatar Racing's representative deserves another opportunity to underline her class, having been chased home at a commanding distance by a host of subsequent black-type performers, including the group scorers Sandiva (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}), Lucky Kristale (GB) (Lucky Story), Wonderfully (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and **Princess Noor (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}). Trainer Charlie Hills, who saddled a 28-1 winner of yesterday's G1 Fillies' Mile here in Chriselliam (Ire) (Iffraaj {GB}), is hoping she can register a top-level success. "Things didn't really pan out the way we wanted in Ireland, but she still ran a very good race and this looks ideal for her," he said. "The track will suit her and I'm not worried about dropping back to six, as she has plenty of speed and a great turn-of-foot. Victor of the James W. Murphy S. at Pimlico May 18, the Wesley Ward trainee was fifth in the GII Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs July 13 and ran a respectable third in a division of the GII Del Mar Derby Sept. 1. The Ramseys will also be represented by Wayne Catalano trainee **Gentleman's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy). Kellyn Gorder saddles morning-line favorite **General Election** (Harlan's Holiday) in hopes of a second graded stakes victory after capturing the GIII Arlington Classic three starts back May 25. The WinStar Farm colorbearer followed that win with a seventh in Arlington's GIII American Derby July 13 and a fifth in the other division of the Del Mar Derby. homebred. He stumbled and dropped pilot Brian Hernandez Jr. before running an impressive, albeit very unofficial, "race" in the Mar. 9 GII Gulfstream Park H., and simply failed to fire when fifth at 1-2 in the Apr. 13 GII Oaklawn H. The 5-year-old was back to his old self in the track-and-trip GI Stephen Foster H. June 15, however, blitzing a solid field by 6 1/4 lengths and earning a gaudy 115 Beyer Speed Figure. Favored against the likes of Cross Traffic (Unbridled's Song) and Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) when seeking back-to-back GI Whitney H. titles Aug. 3, the bay chased out wide before fading to a dull fifth. "I'm happy," Wilkes said of Fort Larned's condition since that race. "The horse is healthy. He's very bright, he's very alert." With Foster runner-up **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown) having shipped to California for today's GI Awesome Again S., Zayat Stables's **Prayer for Relief** (Jump Start) assumes the role of most likely upsetter. The multiple graded stakes-winning \$1.5 million earner almost always shows up, and enters off a victory over **Worldly** (A.P. Indy) in Remington's Governor's Cup S. Aug. 17. Lightly raced Klein homebred **Windswept** (Arch) earned a best last-out Beyer of 103 for a 9 3/4-length Saratoga optional claimer romp going this distance Aug. 8.

Lethal Force registered a previous high in last year's G2 Hungerford S. before blossoming this season.

Following his course record-breaking July Cup victory, Lethal Force finished second to French standout Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 4, and was most recently ninth in the G1 Betfred Sprint Cup at Haydock Sept. 7.

He retires with four wins in 17 starts and earnings of \$1,152,501. Cheveley Park earlier this month completed the deal to stand the 4-year-old in 2014, while international targets including the Breeders' Cup were still being contemplated for later this year.

"Lethal Force has been an absolute joy to train and a pleasure to deal with," said trainer Clive Cox. "His talent and potential was clearly visible from an early stage. His natural pace and amazingly high cruising speed never failed to fill me with excitement both in his races and at home on the gallops. His soundness and willing temperament is every trainer's dream. This season has been fantastic, with Lethal Force's Group 1 successes in the Diamond Jubilee at Royal Ascot followed up by a course record-breaking success in the July Cup at Newmarket. I couldn't be more proud of being part of such an amazingly successful racing career. Both myself, my team, and his previous owners Alan and Robin Craddock are so pleased that Lethal Force is now about to start his exciting stud career at Cheveley Park Stud, and we look forward to him passing on his talents and good nature to future generations."

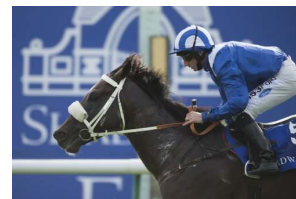

He is a handful, but he loved that ground today." Mike de Kock is prepared to aim high now.

"It is a relief to win for Sheikh Hamdan as he is sponsor, but he deserves it as he has been very patient with the issues we have had with the horse," de Kock explained. "He's got a lot of speed and is a very fast horse who gets a mile. He's a horse who you have to be careful doesn't do too much in the mornings and he'd be one of the few horses I've seen who can stride eight-and-a-half meters or more for a good four furlongs. That's what sets him apart--not only is he fast, he can hold his speed. Dubai was about sheer guts and courage and I like to bring them on with racing, so he came on plenty from Newbury. Today, luckily he had the speed in the race and everything went right, so we've got to go for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Oct. 19] now. It will be the best against the best there and let's see how good he is. As he's racing in the Northern hemisphere now, relatively he's six months behind the rest and so we would be very tempted to keep him in training, especially if he doesn't get a Group 1 under the belt as he is capable, I think. I'm sure that Sheikh Hamdan would be pretty keen for that as well."

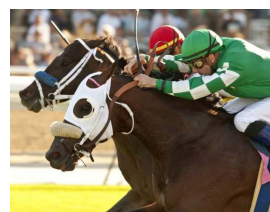

He's fit, he's sharp and he was in game condition. So after getting warmed up, I'm convinced he can and he will bounce back. I've got nothing but positive thoughts now. I want people to expect a lot from him. I'm really excited about this fall, I want people to see just how good of a racehorse he is." Goichi Kawasaki's Hakusan Moon was recording his second-straight graded victory in the Centaur, having toppled **Forever Mark (Jpn)** (Falbrav {Ire}) in the G3 Ibis Summer Dash at Niigata July 28. After winning the mile conditions race that used to be the Listed Masaka S. on Kempton's Polytrack Apr. 13, Zurigha ran with credit when a staying-on fourth from a tough post position in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 12. Disappointing when unplaced in the Listed Sandringham H. at Royal Ascot June 19 and the G3 Sceptre S. over seven furlongs at Doncaster last time Sept. 12, the bay rebounded to cause an upset despite a troubled start to this contest. Bumped exiting the stalls and subsequently left to languish in rear among the far-side group taken along by Igugu, she was full of run when angled off the fence at the quarter pole and picked up in style to reel in that South African champion in the final 50 yards. "Zurigha finished fourth in the French Guineas, but it took a long time for her to recover from her exertions at Longchamp," Richard Hannon Jr explained. "She had a hard race to get in the money from a bad draw in France and she lost more weight than we would have anticipated, so we had no option but to give her a break. When Zurigha ran at Doncaster earlier this month it was her first race since Royal Ascot, so she probably needed it, but Ryan [Moore] was not too complimentary about her on Town Moor. However, his first words when he dismounted here were 'I owe you an apology'. He reckons she is a lovely filly and we think he is right. The owner, Saeed Altayer, comes from Dubai, so we might think about taking Zurigha out there for the Carnival and a race like the Cape Verdi could suit her well." Igugu's trainer Mike de Kock said, "She had the problem where she was cycling all the time and she's been better here, so I thought she'd win today. She ran out of steam up the hill and there's no doubt there's more to come. I know she will improve as she was still a bit burly today, so we're on the right road with her. She is capable of a lot more, but it's hard for fillies crossing the hemisphere and something hormonally happens to them. We might think of the G1 E.P. Taylor S., as the competition at Ascot [in the G1 British Champions Fillies & Mares S.] will be a bit tough."
