### VELAZQUEZ SETS EARNINGS MARK

With a runner-up finish in Sunday's ninth race at Belmont Park, Hall of Fame jockey John Velazquez became North America's all-time leading money-earning rider. The 41-year-old has now ridden the winners of \$297,922,320. The previous record was set by Pat Day in 2005. "It's something that had to happen, and I'm glad it happened," said Velazquez. Velazquez, the all-time leading rider at Saratoga, has been named champion Eclipse rider three times and has won 11 Breeders' Cup races.

### PLETCHER CLASSIC PAIR TUNE UP

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out a pair of contenders for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic to work at Belmont Sunday. John Velazquez was aboard GI Belmont S. winner **Palace Malice** (Curlin), who worked four furlongs over the training track in :48.40. "I thought Palace Malice was his normal, very good self," said Pletcher. "A good work and a strong gallop out." Exercise rider Hector Ramos was aboard **Graydar** (Unbridled's Song), who worked five furlongs in 1:01.32. The 4-year-old gray is coming off a win in the Sept. 28 GII Kelso H. "Graydar also was very good," said Pletcher. "A strong five-eighths for him. Hopefully, we're making progress towards the Breeders' Cup Classic with both."

### PHIL'S DREAM STORMS TO NEARCTIC WIN

The consistent **Phil's Dream** (Philanthropist) earned the first graded stakes tally of his career with a stylish two-length victory in Sunday's GI Nearctic S. at Woodbine. The six-furlong grass race was the final Breeders' Cup Win and You're In event of the year and offered an automatic berth to the Nov. 2 GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint. "He's a really nice horse, super talented," winning jockey Justin Stein said of the 5-year-old gelding, who is not Breeders' Cup nominated and not expected to make the trip to Santa Anita. **Cont. p3**

### PRIORE PHILIP STEPS OUT OF THE SHADOWS

While the focus was squarely on the Stefano Botti-trained **Arpinati** (GB) (Lucky Story), it was that previously unbeaten colt's stable companion **Priore Philip** (Ity) (Dane Friendly {GB}) who stepped up to the mark to fly the flag for that dominant yard in Sunday's G1 Gran Criterium in Milan. Beaten in a claimer on debut, the chestnut had since risen to prominence with wins in minor events at Varese in July and Florence in early September and the Sept. 21 Listed Premio Rumon at the Capannelle. **Cont. p4**

### MEISHO MAMBO VICTORIOUS IN SHUKA SHO

There may have been a sense of anticlimax heading into Sunday's G1 Shuka Sho on the heels of Gentildonna (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn})'s dramatic Filly Triple Crown sweep last year and with the absence of G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas) winner Ayusan (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) due to injury, but **Meisho Mambo** (Jpn) (Suzuka Mambo {Jpn}) gave the Kyoto faithful something to cheer about with a resounding come-from-behind victory. It was the second Classic score for the Yoshio Matsumoto homebred, who took the G1 Yushun Himba May 19. **Cont. p7**

Velazquez was also board GI Breeders' Cup Turf hopeful **Point of Entry** (Dynaformer). The 5-year-old, returning from surgery to repair a condylar fracture suffered while winning the June 8 GI Manhattan H., went five furlongs over the inner turf course in 1:01.74. "He worked very well," said trainer Shug McGaughey. "I think we're on the right track. He galloped out good and strong and finished up good."

Phil's Dream settled in mid-pack as 8-year-old veteran Fatal Bullet (Red Bullet) sprinted out to the early lead, setting fractions of :22.80 and :46.47. The pacesetter yielded at the top of the lane and a host of challengers were in with a chance at midstretch, but it was Phil's Dream who split rivals and surged to the lead within the final furlong before powering clear to score easily.

"I did have to sit and wait a little bit, but I had lots of horse to carry me to where I needed to be when it was time to ask him to run," winning rider Justin Stein commented.

Off the board only twice in 12 career starts, Phil's Dream had made only one previous start on the turf, winning a state-bred allowance in June. He was coming into his graded stakes debut off a pair of wins over the main track, in a Sept. 1 optional claimer and, most recently, in the Sept. 22 Overskate S.

Phil's Dream is a homebred for veteran trainer Paul Buttigieg, who operates Buttigieg Training Centre in Egbert. He has campaigned stakes winners Rushiscomingup (Bold Executive) and Gypsy Ring (Where's the Ring).

Arpinati was only able to stay on at the one pace late on, while the favorite Fanoulpifer (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) had every chance but was short of the required pace when it mattered and plugged on into fourth.

O'Brien gave the lowdown on plans for his leading lights yesterday. "**Darwin** [Big Brown] could drop back to six furlongs [for the G2 British Champions Sprint S.] and we have Camelot and Kingsbarns in there, too," he added. "**Giovanni Boldini** [War Front] could go for the Breeders' Cup, although he's still in the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 26], but most of the other 2-year-olds are finished for the season now."

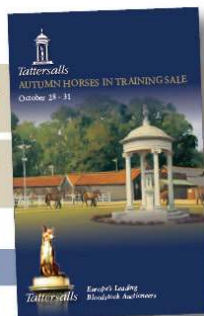

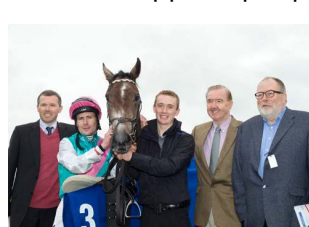

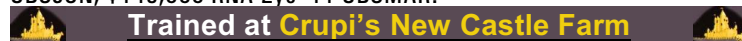
