THREE FOR JOSHUA TREE

Joshua Tree (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) made history yesterday as the only horse to win Woodbine's GI Pattison Canadian International three times, having accomplished that feat with three different trainers.

The defending champ was dismissed at 6-1 and gave his backers reason to worry as the usual front-runner broke slowly and had to be rushed up by jockey Ryan Moore to sit behind the

pace. Joshua Tree moved up to sit along the rail in second as Stormy Len (Harlan's Holiday) free-wheeled in front, he inched closer on the turn to track along the hedge and shifted into gear entering the lane to take the advantage. Joshua Tree immediately opened up and, although laboring at the end, hit the line in front. "He seems to be at home here," said Andrew Stringer, assistant trainer for winning conditioner Ed Dunlop. "He drank well, ate well, and trained well. He settled down. Everything was perfect preparation for him. We had a bit of rain which helped. I just can't believe it that he's won three Group 1 races here for three different trainers with three different training methods. It just goes to show you how tough and genuine this horse is." **Cont. p3**

TANNERY TAKES THE E.P. TAYLOR

Richard Santulli's **Tannery (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) broke through yesterday to collect her first victory at the highest level in Woodbine's GI E. P. Taylor. The Irish import assumed her usual stalking position through the opening stages from off the rail, was still last heading into the turn and circled the field on the bend to challenge the front-runners from the outside in the stretch. She gained a narrow advantage in the final furlong and remained ahead of closing Fitful Skies (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), who was grinding on late. **Cont. p3**

As to Joshua Tree's poor start, pilot Ryan Moore commented, "He started a little slow. I was in a good position and quite happy to let the other horse [Stormy Len {Harlan's Holiday}] take the lead. I didn't want to get into the race too early, so I let Mike [Smith, jockey of Slumber] go and I thought he stays so well, I'll get a good run up the inside and kick home. I went a little sooner than I would have liked ideally, but somehow I knew he'd stay better and outfight most of them."

The veteran first won this even in 2010 for Derrick Smith, Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Khalifa Bin Hamad Al Atty and trainer Aiden O'Brien. He was second in the next year's edition for K Al Nabooda and K Albahou and conditioner Marco Botti, before returning to win last year's Canadian International for those connections.

Winless since last year's race, Joshua Tree has struggled this season for Ed Dunlop, finishing sixth in York's G2 Yorkshire Cup May 17, a well-beaten third to St. Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup June 1, and 10th in the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud June 23. He was given a break after a runner-up effort in Deauville's G2 Prix Kergorlay Aug. 18, but returned to finish 13th in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 6.

Regarding her early positioning, trainer Al Goldberg said, "That's the way she wants to run. I was a little worried about three jumps from the wire when the other horse [Fitful Skies] started coming back. She's a very nice horse and we'll have a nice year with her next year." As for Laughing, who will contest the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf Friday, Goldberg said "They went head and head the other day, so maybe we'll get a little lucky in California, too. If she didn't run well, I'd have said 'Oh man, what am I going out there for?'"

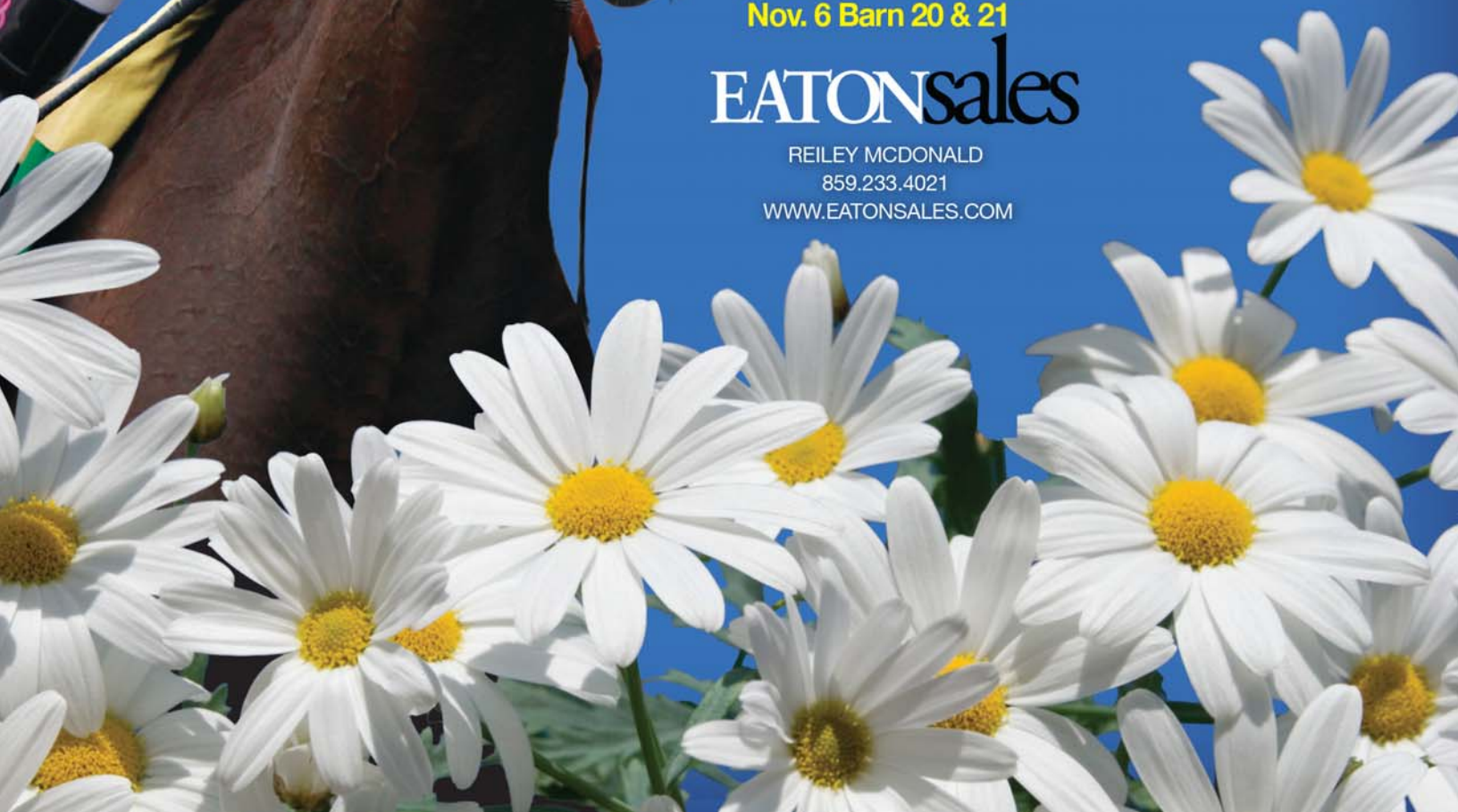

furlongs prior to his sale to Australian interests. Sixth on his first start for the Michael Kent stable in the G3 Geelong Cup 12 months ago, the grey beat only one home in the G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington in November before switching to Marco Botti's stable in

Newmarket. After an encouraging third on his comeback in Goodwood's Listed March S. Aug. 24, he bounded away from the subsequent G3 St Simon S. winner Cubanita (GB) (Selkirk) in Chester's Listed Stand Cup over an extended 12-furlong trip Sept. 14, and was outstayed by Altano (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Prix du Cadran over 2 1/2-miles here on Arc day. Settled a little worse than mid-division early, he was full of run when short of room in midstretch, and was unable to be contained for long as Martin Harley sought an out. Freed shortly before the furlong marker, he picked up in style to wrest the lead from Going Somewhere and drew away in commanding fashion to set his seal on the race. "He loves this kind of ground and seems to have improved since he joined me in the spring," trainer Marco Botti explained. "He is still improving now and is still lightly-raced, so can go on for another couple of seasons. I'll put him away now for the season and he will be targeted at the long-distance Cup races, although he can't run in the summer as he won't have his ground."

Charity Line continued the stellar season of the Stefano Botti stable by holding onto her unbeaten record in gritty fashion here. Rested after her 4 1/2-length success in the G2 Oaks d'Italia over 11 furlongs at the San Siro May 26, the chestnut had warmed up for this test against the older horses by beating the black-type performer Air Mail (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}) by five lengths, handing him three kilos in a course-and-distance conditions event Sept. 21. Settled behind the leading trio throughout the early stages, she was committed on the front end with 1 1/2-furlongs remaining and, after being briefly headed by Path Wind, soon after proved the toughest in the duel to the line.

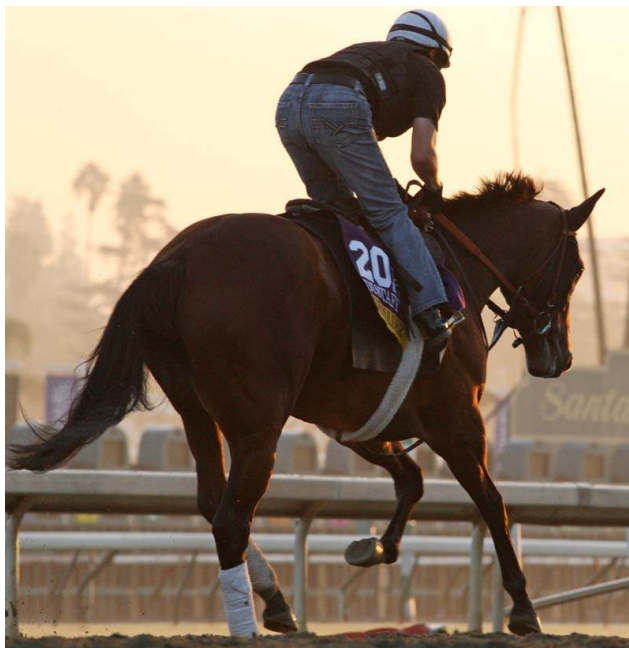

Oct. 5, is possible for the GIII Tempted S. Nov. 3. "We might run, but we're really pointing for the [GII] Demoiselle [S. Nov. 30]," McLaughlin commented. "She's here and we'll look at it, but if [more horses] enter, then we might wait until the Demoiselle."

The Jimmy Jerkens-trained **Wicked Strong** (Hard Spun) will be aimed for a start in the GII Remsen S. Nov. 3. The Centennial Farms colorbearer graduated second out at Belmont Park Saturday. "I think we'll eventually go to Florida, but we might entertain the thought of running in the Remsen," said Jerkens. "We'll have to see. We'll make a decision in the next week or so." Of his recent win, Jerkens added, "He had enough speed to lay pretty close. I wouldn't have minded if [jockey Javier Castellano] had sat there a little longer, but maybe it was the right move. [Wicked Strong] didn't do a thing wrong [Saturday]. He showed a little inclination to lug in during his works. He did it a little yesterday when he made the lead, but he was easily handled. I thought his race was perfect, really."





While some of the top middle-distance horses in Hong Kong, including the reigning Horse of the Year Military Attack (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}) were having their first runs of the year at a one-mile distance short of their optimum, Gold-Fun continued his ascent through the ranks at his pet trip and cemented his status as a top chance for the G1 Hong Kong Mile Dec. 8. The less-heralded of two private purchases for Pan Sutong--the other being Hong Kong Derby hero Akeed Mofeed (GB) (Dubawi {Ire})--Gold-Fun raced admirably in last year's 4-year-old series, winning the Hong Kong Classic Mile and fourth in the Hong Kong Classic Cup at 1800 meters before a third to his stable companion in the Derby over the metric mile and a quarter. Fifth behind Dan Excel (Ire) (Shamardal) in the G1 Champions Mile May 5, the flashy chestnut resumed with a smooth success in the National Day Cup H. Oct. 1. Stretching back out to the mile for this and getting a pull in the weights, Gold-Fun sat a box-seat trip from third and just needed the gaps to come. He peeled off the fence, split rivals into the final furlong and raced away to a convincing victory. "He's certain to go for the Longines Hong Kong Mile, although I wouldn't say we're certain to go for the race Nov. 17 [G2 Jockey Club Mile]. I think the horse has probably had a good prep--we'll just play that one by ear," said Gibson. The venerable California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}) closed well for fourth, while Military Attack, racing for the first time since landing the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup, also finished well in sixth. "It was first up for some of them and they all blew up, which is what we expected-- they'll benefit from it and Military Attack needs the 2000 meters," said Moore. "I'm very happy with them and Military Attack is right on target." The latter pair should rematch in the G2 Jockey Club Cup Nov. 17. [Click for the HKJC.com chart. VIDEO.](#)
