CROWNING MOMENT

Prince Gibraltar (Fr) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) stepped up markedly to outclass his rivals under enterprising tactics in Saturday's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. Third behind the subsequent G3 Prix Thomas Bryon winner and G1 Criterium International runner-up Earnshaw (Medaglia d'Oro) on debut over a mile at Chantilly Sept. 4, Prince Gibraltar was off the mark in style over that trip at Maisons-Laffitte 22 days later for the Henri-Alex Pantall stable. Switched to Jean-Claude Rouget in the interim, the chestnut was settled in last for much of the contest by Christophe Soumillon. He was brought over to the stand's rail at the top of the straight as his rivals opted to save ground and remain up the far rail. Despite racing alone, Prince Gibraltar showed a professional attitude with the hedge to guide him and gradually forged clear from the furlong pole. "He is a very well-balanced horse who obviously liked the ground, but he gave me the feeling that he would be the same on good ground," Soumillon commented. "He is a horse to look forward to next year." **Cont. p3**

ANOTHER STRONG DAY AT KEENOV

A little more than halfway through its 10-day stand, the 2013 Keeneland November Sale has already outpaced its 2012 counterpart by gross receipts. Following Saturday's Book 3 opener at November, the 2013 gross was \$157,021,200, compared to the \$143,025,600 that was grossed during the entirety of last year's 11-session sale. It was, needless to say, another strong day of selling at Keeneland. The session average of \$51,240 was up 20.4% from a year ago, while the median of \$40,000 was up 14.3%. Those gains gain added luster when considering that last year's session five saw seven horses bring \$200,000 or more--including a \$435,000 session-topping mare--compared to just one this year. The difference was a much deeper market in 2013's session five, where 38 horses brought \$100,000 or more. Last year, there were just 19 such horses. The cumulative average now stands at \$147,715, up 21.6%. The cumulative median is \$85,000, up 41.7%. The session RNA rate was a scant 14.3%, lowering the cumulative RNA rate to 18.3%. **Cont. p9**

KOBE COMES IN OFF THE BENCH

C R K Stable's **Kobe's Back** (Flatter) has not been seen since blowing the break before inhaling his competition on debut in this venue's June 15 Willard L. Proctor Memorial S., and will look to rebound off the bench against a compact field in today's Gill Hollywood Prevue S. The \$480,000 OBSMAR buy, who trainer John Sadler says did not miss time due to injury, shows a pair of six-furlong bullets locally among his morning preparations for this. "I just decided to give him some time because he was a bit immature," explained his trainer. **Shared Belief** (Candy Ride {Arg}) aired by seven lengths for trainer J. B. Josephson and breeders Pam and Marty Wygod in a Golden Gate maiden test Oct. 19, and was subsequently purchased privately by Jim Rome's Jungle Racing, new trainer Jerry Hollendorfer and George Todaro. The 84 Beyer Speed Figure he earned for that unveiling is the field's best. **Papa Turf** (Yes It's True), a second-up graduate when switched from Del Mar Polytrack to Santa Anita dirt Sept. 28, figures to show the way early and appears the main danger to the top two. **Cont. p14**

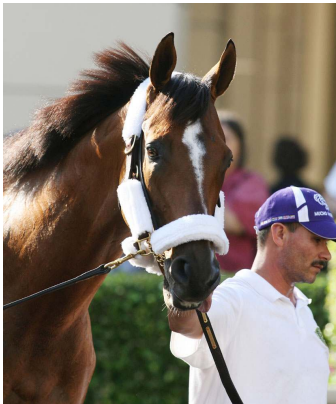

Buffering, so long at the mercy of star sprinters Black Caviar (Aus), Hay List (Aus) and Sepoy (Aus), recorded his first Group 1 score after 18 tries in Moonee Valley's G1 Manikato S. last out Oct. 25, and asserted his dominance with a resounding victory in this ninth leg of the Global Sprint Challenge. Taking up the early running from his inside barrier, Buffering galloped up the Flemington straight about a length the better of his closest pursuer, Moment of Change, while favored Lucky Nine (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire})--second to Buffering in the Manikato--traveled a close-up fourth down the middle of the course. While Lucky Nine came up empty when shaken up by Brett Prebble at the 400 meters, Buffering continued to cruise, drawing clear by two lengths. Jockey Damian Browne went to the whip inside the final 300 meters to hold off a late rally from Shamexpress, but the veteran was never truly in danger in posting his second A\$1-million victory in two weeks. **Cont. p5**

An A\$22,000 Magic Millions Queensland yearling, Buffering quickly earned back his price tag with four straight victories in that state to open his career. He traveled to Sydney to post his first group score in the G2 Roman Consul S. in 2010, and won four additional group events prior to his Manikato breakthrough. He placed at the Group 1 level 10 times, including three times behind Black Caviar. "There were probably a few unanswered questions after the Manikato, a thought that he might have been a little bit lucky," Heathcote told *Racingandsports.com.au*. "But there was no luck in that today. That was pure guts, determination and ability." Heathcote noted that his charge would not continue down the Global Sprint Challenge road to the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 8. Lucky Nine will return home to try to win a third renewal of that event, according to trainer Caspar Fownes. Buffering closed out a big day for his Vinery Australia-based sire Mossman, who also sired the Listed Hilton Hotel & Resorts S. winner Dothraki (Aus) earlier on the card.

The winner of just three of 13 starts prior to this campaign when racing primarily in Queensland and Victoria, Boban came alive this season for the red-hot Chris Waller stable. The gelding capped a perfect five-for-five prep with this victory, which made him the first horse in 27 years to capture the coveted G1 Epsom H./

G1 Emirates S. double. A listed winner last May, Boban kicked off his 4-year-old campaign with a victory in a Rosehill handicap Aug. 31, and scored his first win at the group level next out in

the G3 Bill Ritchie H. at Randwick Sept. 21. Backing up in the Epsom two weeks later, Boban upended the favored Streama (Aus) (Stratum {Aus}), with his paternal half-brother Toydini (Aus) checking in third. Boban kept the streak alive on another two-weeks rest' when annexing Caulfield's G3 Moonga S. Oct. 19, and capped an excellent Melbourne Cup Carnival for the Waller stable with this victory. Settling midpack one spot off the fence, Boban used the length of the stretch to wind up and hooked up with Mull of Killough (Ire) (Mull of Kintyre) at the 100-meter mark.

He outpaced that rival and also managed to fend off a fast-finishing Smokin' Joey on the outside and a game Speediness on the rail. Boban provided Waller with his third Group 1 win of the four-day carnival, which followed last Saturday's Group 1 double courtesy of Zoustar (Aus) (Northern Meteor {Aus}) in the G1 Coolmore Stud S. and Red Tracer (Aus) (Dane Shadow {Aus}) in the G1 Myer Classic. Waller told *Racingandsports.com.au* that his charge will likely target Randwick's G1 Queen Elizabeth S. next April, while the G1 Cox Plate will be his primary target this time next year. "I thought he was the winner at the 100 meter mark, but he had to find a lot," Waller said. "And that showed that he fights as well as has brilliance. He's a pretty exciting horse looking towards the autumn and beyond."

Abaco, a winner of four straight last term, broke through with a career high here. A close second in Gulfstream's GIII Suwannee River S. Feb. 9, she came within a head of getting her picture taken in Laurel's Lady Baltimore S. Sept. 21. She entered off a respectable second to Pianist (More Than Ready) in Belmont's GIII Athenia S. Oct. 12. Well-supported at the windows, Abaco was roughed up a bit at the start and was settled in eighth through an opening quarter in :23.83. With Rosie Napravnik in the irons, Abaco was produced in the stretch and came flying on the outside to get the money. "I was tickled to death with her," trainer Shug McGaughey commented. "She never had won a stakes. She had been second in three. She's so deserving of winning one and I was really glad. She should have won down in Baltimore [in Laurel's Lady Baltimore], but today we wanted to make sure she didn't get in trouble. Rosie rode a big race on her and we're all really, really pleased." As for what's next, McGaughey added, "I talked to Mr. Phipps about it and said there was a race at Gulfstream that would fit her Feb. 8 and I'll try to run her before that. She's run well over the Gulfstream turf course and I wouldn't think there's any reason why we wouldn't want to keep her training."

Topping the session was the 5-year-old stakes winner **Dontbeshy I'll Buy** (Cherokee Run), who sold to Abdullah Saeed Almaddah for \$260,000. The dark bay mare was offered as the property of Frank Stronach's Adena Springs as [hip 1450](#) and sold in foal to Adena's Ghostzapper.

Dontbeshy I'll Buy was produced by Eye of the Artist (Old Trieste), a half to a pair of stakes winners by Dontbeshy I'll Buy's sire Cherokee Run: SW & MGSP Cherokee Artist and SW & GSP Cherokee Girl.

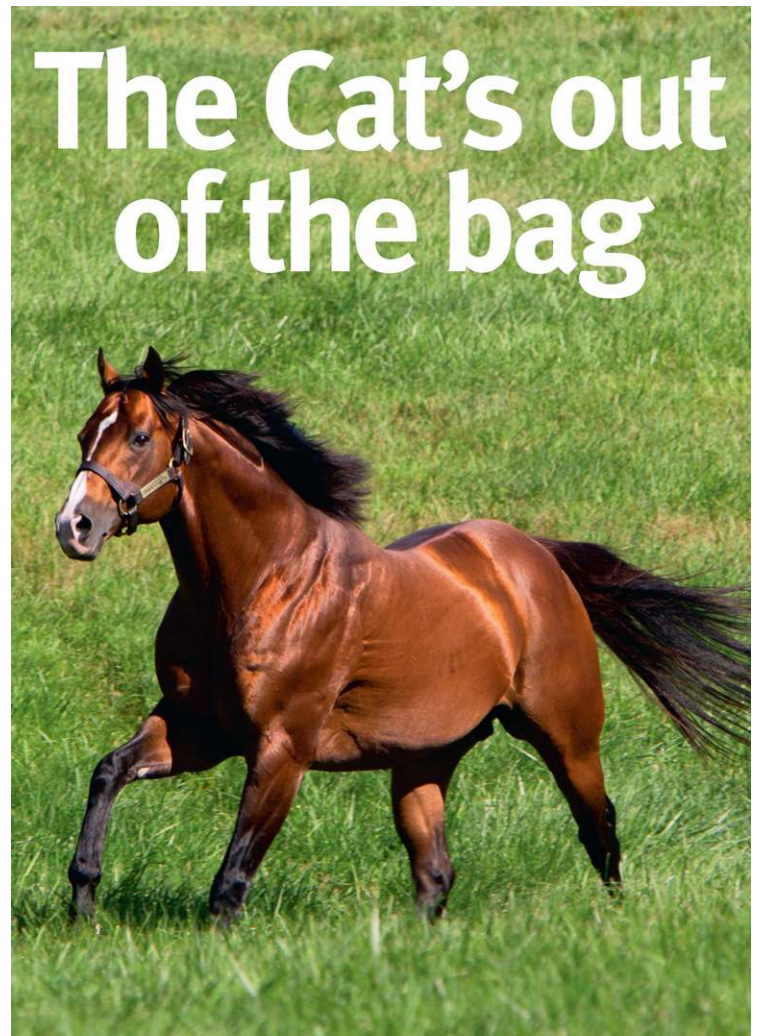
Dontbeshy I'll Buy herself won the Bold Brat S. and placed in the GII Distaff H. at Aqueduct while earning \$142,541. Adena Springs purchased her as a broodmare prospect for \$145,000 at last year's November Sale and put her in foal to their star stallion on an early Feb. 14 cover.

"Frank agreed to purchase her last November, and obviously she was a very good, high-quality mare," said Adena General Manager Eric Hamelback. "It's certainly part of Frank's program of finding mares with pedigrees that he think will match one of our stallions, and then turning them right back around and selling them. She was quite popular at the barn; she ticked all the boxes for a lot of people."

Adena had a strong day at Keeneland Saturday, selling three of the top four lots, including the \$160,000 **Smart Cash** (Awesome Again) ([hip 1306](#)), in foal to Speightstown, who went to Ken and Sarah Ramsey; and the \$155,000 **Suave Voir Faire** (Suave) ([hip 1324](#)), in foal to Ghostzapper, who sold to Town and Country Farm.

"I would definitely say there is a renewed strength in the mare market," said Hamelback. "In-foal mares are definitely coveted. I think we brought a lot of good, quality mares up here, and we've been rewarded. Obviously, having stallions like Awesome Again and Ghostzapper, and the success they've had, as well as Macho [Uno], helps a lot. But everyone was seeking those types of mares, ones that were in foal to quality stallions. We had a lot of people on a lot of our mares. Honestly, they were very fairly reserved, and many of those mares went right past the reserve."

Pam and Marty Wygod have reached the very top of Thoroughbred racing as the owner and/or breeders of Grade I winners like **After Market** (Storm Cat), **Life is Sweet** (Storm Cat),

Tranquility Lake (Rahy), and champion **Sweet Catomine** (Storm Cat). Now, their daughter Emily Wygod, 28, is beginning her own breeding and racing operation, and yesterday at Keeneland enjoyed a nice transaction when selling a homebred weanling colt by Candy Ride (Arg) for \$105,000 to Foxtale

Farm.

The colt, consigned by Lane's End as [hip 1350](#), is a son of the 11-year-old Trusten (Mt. Livermore), a half-sister to GISW My Trusty Cat (Tale of the Cat). It was Wygod's first six-figure transaction as a breeder--by a long ways.

"I think my previous best was \$10,000," she laughed.

She explained that she targeted November for the Jan. 21-foaled chestnut after seeing the strength of the yearling sales this year.

"I was hoping the weanling market was going to be pretty hot this sale, because it seemed the other sales were really picking up," Wygod said. "He was an early foal and has grown really evenly, and is really well-balanced. We just thought this would be a good market for him. Plus he's got a great walk on him, which is what I think the buyers liked about him."

Wygod purchased the colt in utero when acquiring Trusten for \$40,000 at last year's Keeneland November Sale. She knew the family well--her father had purchased the mare for \$250,000 at November five years earlier, and she was buying the mare off of him.

"My father bought her to breed to After Market, and we sold the resulting foal because it was so good looking," Wygod said. "Since then, she's had pretty consistent, nice foals--all by Candy Ride--so I really thought she'd be a nice addition and would fit my long-term plans. I've been trying to build a small broodmare band."

Wygod reports that Trusten was bred back to Quality Road this spring.

Wygod currently has eight broodmares of her own, and also owns a few in partnership with her parents. She boards some at Lane's End, where both After Market and Candy Ride stand, and some at Willow Oak Farm on the old Elemendorf property. Kate Sheehan manages her mares.

"They're mostly younger mares that I either bought in California, or bought off my dad [laughs]," she said of her broodmare band. Asked what she's looking for in prospects, she said, "I like bigger, scopier mares, and obviously you want them to have good bone and be correct. And then something that crosses well with our stallions, Candy Ride and After Market."

As she builds her operation, Wygod said she'll primarily sell the colts and keep and race fillies. "If there's a really special colt, I'd love to hang on to it, but I'd like to sell enough to make it a smart business," she explained. "I'd like to keep on doing it for years. My parents really love it, and I really love it, so I'm thinking long-term."

Wygod was raised in both New Jersey and then California, but currently calls upstate New York home. She works at Pegasus Therapeutic Riding in Brewster, where she teaches kids with special needs to ride.

"I really just love being around horses," she said. "I've brought some Thoroughbreds in to work with the kids, and they're just so smart and intuitive and just love the kids. Any horses that don't make it [on the track or breeding shed], I'm like, 'Oh! Want to come work with me?!'"

For Latham, Artistry in Motion...

A year or two ago, Kentucky-based horseman Davant Latham purchased the mare **Artistry** (Theatrical {Ire}) from long-time clients that were getting out of the business. Yesterday, he was rewarded when the first foal he bred out of the now 16-year-old--a weanling colt by Majesticperfection--made \$150,000 at November. That was the top price for a weanling on Saturday. Stuart Turlington's Stoney Lane Farm and partners purchased the Mar. 25-foaled bay, who is a half-sibling to 2006 GIII Arlington Classic winner Kingship (King Cugat). Sweezy and Partners consigned him as [hip 1387](#).

"We were very fortunate; he was a lovely colt from Day 1," said Latham. "But sometimes those are the ones that scare you--because you realized what they are in 30 days, and you just hope they stay that way! He's a bit of an elegant horse. He's got some length and scope to him, and is just a lovely horse."

Ashford's Majestic Warrior is the leading second-crop sire in the nation by both earnings and stakes winners. His seven black-type winners include GI Kentucky Oaks winner Princess of Sylmar.

"I was turned on to him as a sire when I saw his first yearlings, and then again when I saw his 2-year-olds, which was when this mare was bred," explained Latham. "They are horses with very nice physicals, in general."

Asked about the decision to sell the colt as a weanling, Latham explained, "I had a 35-acre farm and downsized to an eight-acre farm because I was gone so much doing the 2-year-old [sales], so I didn't really have the facilities to keep him. But I was very happy to bring him to the market now. It's a great year to be selling anything, and the people that bought him are very astute. I look forward to them doubling their money next year at the yearling sales!"

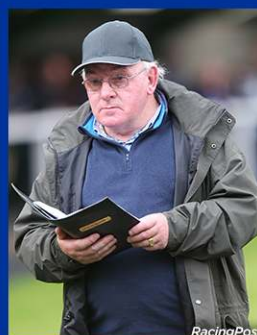

Richard Hughes was reflecting on his second consecutive British jockeys championship yesterday after the traditional ceremony at Doncaster on the final day of the country's Flat season. With the current

campaign heralding a first domestic Classic on Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}) in the G1 1000 Guineas and another courtesy of Talent (GB) (New Approach {Ire}) in the G1 Epsom Oaks, he was also the first rider since Kieren Fallon 10 years earlier to exceed 200 winners. "It's a fabulous day and this is why you do it," he told *PA Sport*. "I

wanted to show last year wasn't a fluke. I went hard early in the year and got my quickest 50 and 100. I thought if I could ride 200 winners, that would nearly clinch it and I did. I've been on some wonderful horses and I'm under no illusions I wouldn't be champion jockey without the Richard Hannon stable behind me. My ambition from day one has been to win a Derby. I've haven't had enough rides in it to win it yet. This is my busiest time of the year. I'm off to South Africa, Japan, India and Hong Kong. I shall then have three weeks with the family in Barbados and be back in February." Richard Hannon claimed his fifth trainers' title, while the champion apprentice Jason Hart was also crowned, with the champion owners being Godolphin for a ninth time. Racing manager Simon Crisford said, "We are delighted to be British champion owner again and it has been a fantastic team effort by the whole operation. This is a great achievement for everyone involved and we are looking forward to defending our title next year."

Five-year highs in both all-sources and on-track handle were among the highlights of figures released by the New York Racing Association for the recently concluded Belmont Park fall meeting. All-sources handle, which includes wagers on Belmont Park races both on-track and from simulcast outlets nationwide, was \$326,878,686--the highest of the past five years. The figure represents an increase of 9.8% from \$297,670,005 in 2012 and a jump of 24.3% from \$263,037,788 in 2011. On-track handle on Belmont fall meeting races was \$47,238,016--also the highest of the past five years. The total was up 11.1% from \$42,499,742 last year and 13.4% over the \$41,656,097 wagered on-track in 2011. Attendance for the meet was 126,469, a 10.7% increase from 114,294 in 2012.

Paul Moran Dead at 67:

Eclipse Award-winning turf writer Paul Moran died Saturday in Saratoga Springs, N.Y. at age 67 following a long battle with lung cancer. A veteran reporter who covered horse racing since the 1970s, Moran was a mainstay in the press boxes of New York Racing Association racetracks since joining the staff of *Newsday* in 1985. That year, he won a media Eclipse Award for a piece on *Daily Racing Form* columnist Joe Hirsch, and five years later, he won another Eclipse for his story on Go for Wand's catastrophic injury during the stretch run of the 1990 Breeders' Cup Distaff. He also won a Distinguished Deadline writing award from the National Association of Newspaper Editors.

Moran, a president of the New York Turf Writers Association, retired from the newspaper business in 2008, but stayed very active in horse racing reporting and commentary, chiefly through a regular column on espn.com. He also dabbled in ownership, owning several New York-breds that were trained by James Bond. Known for his extremely artful prose, his keen opinions on racing issues of the day, and a cutting wit, Moran was surrounded by several of his closest friends and colleagues from the New York racing circuit at the time of his death.
