'BELIEF' IN SPLENDID ISOLATION IN PREVUE

Despite having to play second fiddle to the well-backed 4-5 choice Kobe's Back (Flatter) ahead of Sunday's GIII Hollywood Prevue S. at Betfair Hollywood Park, second choice Shared Belief (Candy Ride {Arg})

didn't waste any time grabbing the spotlight and stealing the show when powering home an emphatic winner over his stakes-winning rival. Shared Belief was up to press the pace through an opening quarter in :22.50, while 4-5 favorite Kobe's Back (Flatter) was away

slowly and soon trailed the five-horse field. The gelding easily overtook the pacesetter after a half in :46.06 and he began inching away as Kobe's Back was winding up four wide for his run into the stretch. It briefly looked like it would be a horse race, but Shared Belief kicked into gear and stormed clear. Brother Soldier (Brother Derek) rounded out the trifecta. The final time of 1:22.17 was the fastest in the GIII Prevue since Jack O'Lantern won in 1:21.89 in 2008. cont. p3

\$185,000 MARES DRIVE KEENOV SUNDAY

A pair of mares brought \$185,000 each and there was lively trade throughout Sunday's sixth session of the Keeneland November Sale in Lexington, which closed out its Book 3 with significant gains from a year ago. A total of 276 horses sold for \$13,435,500 on Sunday, good for an average of \$48,679 that was up 20.1% over last term. The median of \$40,000 represented a 25% advance from 2012, while the buy-back rate was a very low 14.6%. "The weather has been lovely, and there's been great traffic through the barns," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Showing has been spectacular. Our consignors are consistently telling us they are showing their horses more this year than at any other November Sale. There's lots of energy around the sales grounds, and it's being reflected in the strong trade." The \$185,000 co-toppers book-ended another strong day at November. The first, One Foxy Grey (Big Brown--Irish Smoke, by Smoke Glacken), came early as hip 1619. Nancy Shuford purchased the 3-year-old, a daughter of a Grade I-winning juvenile in Irish Smoke and in foal on an Apr. 26 cover to Midnight Lute, from the draft of Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency. Irish Smoke is herself a half to SW King Puma (Forest Wildcat), as well as to the dam of last year's GI La Brea S. winner Book Review (Giant's Causeway). One Foxy Grey was purchased as an FTKJUL yearling for Cory Wagner for \$220,000. cont.8

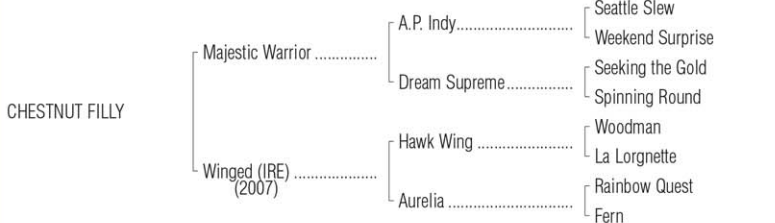

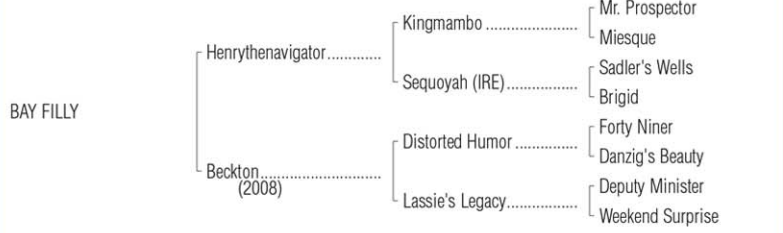

"I didn't think he'd be close to the lead like that," winning trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said of Shared Belief. "[Papa Turf] was the only speed in the race, but [Corey Nakatani] got away well and decided to lap off him. It

was a good decision on his part. I think he ran his last eighth in :11 and change. We'll just enjoy this race and then pick something out."

Shared Belief kicked off his career with a sharp seven-length victory going six furlongs at Golden Gate Oct. 19 while racing for his breeders Pam and Marty Wygod. He was purchased privately by a partnership that includes radio and

television personality Jim Rome, Alex Solis II, Jason Litt, George Todaro and Hollendorfer. Despite posting a pair of impressive works over Hollywood's CushionTrack--a five-panel move in 1:00 flat Oct. 30 and a bullet six furlongs in 1:13 1/5 Nov. 5--the gelding came into his stakes debut as the second betting choice behind Kobe's Back, who graduated in his career bow in the 5 1/2-furlong Willard Proctor Memorial at Hollywood June 15.

"That was an impressive 2-year-old right there," said Nakatani. "Being by Candy Ride, he's got the breeding to be any kind. He was very focused. When I worked him, he did everything so easily, but I didn't ride him the first time and I didn't know he'd be so relaxed. When they do the things this horse did today, it's pretty exciting."

As for the runner-up, Rafael Bejarano said, "He broke OK, but he's just not that quick. Rafael Bejarano, aboard runner up Kobe's Back, added, "I was in a good position right behind the winner at the three-eighths. My horse ran his race, but I was never going to beat the winner. My horse was still running to the end, but the winner was much the best."

According to John Sadler, Kobe's Back will be targeted at the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 14.

Meisho Mambo had displayed considerable talent when landing a Classic double with the G1 Yushun Himba (Japanese Oaks) and G1 Shuka Sho earlier this year, and yesterday's victory—her first try against older rivals—cemented her status as one of the leading females in the country. A first-out winner last year over this course, Meisho Mambo landed her first black-type victory in the Listed Kobushi Sho Feb. 16. She

doubled up in the G2 Hoshi Hai Fillies Revue next out Mar. 10, but could manage no better than 10th in the G1 Oka Sho (Japanese 1000 Guineas). She looked a different horse, however, when stretched out to 2400 meters for the Yushun Himba, where she caused a 28-1 upset May 19. Fourth in Hanshin's G2 Sho Rose S. when cut back to 1800 meters Sept. 15, Meisho Mambo redeemed herself with a victory in the Shuka Sho four weeks ago. Traveling midpack through the early stages here, the bay was forced five wide on the turn into the straight, but promptly shrugged off that inconvenience with a devastating rally down the center of the course.

She hit the wire 1 1/4 lengths ahead of Lachesis, while Aromatico made a late run from the back of the pack to be third. "This race was much tougher than the previous race, but she's a really strong filly," said jockey Koshiro Take. "We raced while marking Verxina (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) on the inside, and the filly responded well to my urging."

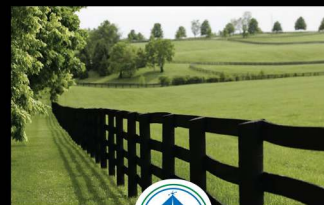

Adriana followed a conditions win over 1 9/16 miles at Deauville Aug. 2 with a third when tanking her way through the G3 T Von Zastrow Stutenpreis over 11 furlongs at Baden-Baden at the end of that month. Fifth returning to France behind the subsequent G1 Premio Roma winner **Feuerblitz (Ger)** (**Big Shuffle**) in the Sept. 29 Listed Grand Prix de la Region Alsace at Strasbourg, the bay was fourth when attempting to make all in the G1 Premio Lydia Tesio over this trip at the Capannelle Oct. 27. Taking no prisoners here, she dominated from pillar to post and forged further clear in the closing stages as **Petit Chevalier** labored his way into second.

Rosendhal, who won this contest in 2010, ran third in 2011 and dead-heated for first last year, continued his love affair with the six-furlong dash by delivering a record third renewal with his most decisive victory yet.

Campaigned mainly at Meydan and in France this term, his best effort was a second in the May 19 G3 Premio Tudini over this course-and-distance, and he lined up coming off the unorthodox route of winning an Oct. 16 Longchamp claimer. Racing fourth after an alert getaway, he challenged on the bridle passing the two pole and was ridden out in the closing stages to claim a unique hat-trick in game fashion.

FEI/IFHA UNITE IN NEW ORGANIZATION

The Federation Equestre Internationale and the International Federation of Horseracing Authorities have joined forces to create the International Horse Sports

Confederation, the first formal alliance and vehicle for cooperation between the racing and sport horse worlds. The IHSC's primary mission will be the exchange of information and technical knowledge and collaboration on issues that affect

both parties, including horse welfare, anti-doping, coordinated communications and fair play. The formation of the IHSC was formally signed by FEI President Princess Haya and IFHA Chairman Louis Romanet at the FEI General Assembly Thursday. "The creation of the International Horse Sports Confederation is an outgrowth of the FEI's collaboration with the OIE, and our efforts to join forces with our sister federation, the IFHA, will ensure that we move forward together in this effort for the mutual benefit of both our industries," said Princess Haya. "It represents one of the most profound milestones for the global growth of racing and horse sport. Our negotiations have taken place since the end of 2012, and now with the International Horse Sport Confederation established, we are firmly joined together to pool our knowledge and capabilities, and move forward with strength as horse sport continues to grow around the world. Our key priorities will be facilitating the movement of horses to compete in international competitions, protecting horse welfare, maintaining strong doping control policy, and ensuring fairness in our sports for participants and the general public." Romanet added: "The creation of the IHSC means that we can now link the wealth of our expertise in the racing world and within the equestrian sports governed by the FEI. Both federations will be fully cooperating to protect the welfare of the horse and to facilitate the international movement of horses in close liaison with the World Organization for Animal Health. The news is wholeheartedly welcomed by our members and we now have an exceptional opportunity to promote strong regulation and best practice on an international scale with the FEI. We are looking forward to this exciting new chapter for horse sport and we are very grateful to HRH Princess Haya for her outstanding leadership, which made it possible to achieve our common goals."

Later in the day, the 14-year-old mare **High Maintenance (GB)** (Danehill--Speak Softly to Me, by Ogygian) matched One Foxy Grey's price tag. Sold by Paramount Sales as [hip 1932](#), the stakes winner and Grade III performer was purchased by FD Bloodstock. She was covered by Quality Road. From the immediate family of Storm Bird, High Maintenance is the dam of the Group 3 runner Silver Black (Hennessy). A colt by Scat Daddy was the day's highest-priced weanling. Candy Meadows Farm, LLC purchased [hip 1982](#) for \$145,000 from the consignment of Four Star Sales. The colt is a half to SP McKenzies Way (Wildcat Heir) and is from the family of Point Given. (*For more, see 'Nothing But Net' column.*) The November sale resumes today at 10:00 a.m. and continues through Thursday. For more, visit www.keeneland.com.

Racing Age Session Tomorrow...

Seven years ago, Keeneland moved to concentrate horses of racing age catalogued for its November Sale down to the second Tuesday of the auction. It allowed owners and trainers to come in for a single session of the sale and target ready-to-race prospects, while providing a new showcase for sellers. It's a move that has borne fruit for all involved. Typically led by a large draft of horses from WinStar Farm, the session has turned out the likes of the recent GI Breeders' Cup Sprint second **Laugh Track** (Distorted Humor), acquired by trainer Mark Casse for \$180,000 a year ago.

(Laugh Track was offered by WinStar, who stayed in for a piece of the colt.) Last year's sale also featured **Flashy Gray** (Flashy Bull) who, after topping the session at \$775,000! went on to romp in a Gulfstream optional claimer. She later finish second in both the GII Fair Grounds Oaks and GIII Honeybee S. The New York-bred **Pinball** (Unbridled's Song), sold in 2012 as a twice-raced maiden for \$185,000, broke his maiden for new connections two starts later as an odds-on pick at Aqueduct, then took his next two in allowance company by a combined 10 3/4 lengths. The 2011 racing-age session turned out several more good runners, including **Grassy** (El Prado {Ire}) (\$220,000), who went on to run second in the 2012 GII Breeders' Cup Marathon, as well as the **Spring Hill Farm** (Smart Strike) (\$60,000), who won three of his first five starts for Stonestreet Stables and George Bolton. WinStar Farm once again brings several eye-catching racing-age prospects to the market tomorrow, including GIII Arlington Classic hero **General Election** (Harlan's Holiday) ([hip 2807](#)) and the promising juvenile **Commendment** (Sky Mesa) ([hip 2788](#)). The session also gets a big boost from the addition of nearly 100 horses from Adena Springs, which brings a collection that includes many runners that populated its Horse Racing League. Adena launched the League in 2012. It included 120 juveniles that were separated into six teams, each named after a famous Adena runner--Awesome Again, Ghostzapper, etc. Fans could then follow the progress of the runners on horseracingleague.com.

"It was always part of the business plan that those horses would sell in November of their 3-year-old years, and here we are," explained Jack Brothers, representing Adena. "But we also have a number of horses here from the Adena racing stable."

Some of the stars of the draft include [hip 2713](#), the 3-year-old filly **Montana Native** (Yes It's True), who won the nine-furlong Broom Dance S. at Saratoga July 24 and more recently led gate-to-wire to win the \$200,000 Remington Park Oaks by a nose

Sept. 29. "She's coming off a nice win in the Remington Oaks, and she's nominated to the Zia Park Oaks Nov. 23, which is a \$300,000 race at 1 1/16 miles, and she'd probably be one of the favorites," said Brothers. "She's also nominated to the GIII Comely S. at Aqueduct Nov. 30, which is \$400,000 race. So whoever gets her has some pretty nice spots for her."

[Hip 2812](#) is the 3-year-old colt **Hardest Core** (Hard Spun), who ran Balance the Books (Lemon Drop Kid) to a neck in the Stroll S. at Saratoga Aug. 13 before winning by a head in a Belmont optional claimer Oct. 13. "He's another one who's in great form," said Brothers.

"He's won three of his last five and just got beat in the Stroll S." The Classic-placed **Pyrite Mountain** (Silent Name {Jpn}), [hip 2727](#), has hit the board in eight of 10 and earned over \$270,000. He ran third to Up With the Birds (Stormy Atlantic) in the Breeders' S. on turf Aug. 18 and was third in the GIII Ontario Derby on the main track Sept. 15. "He shows up every time," said Brothers.

One of the more unexposed types is the colt **Palm Island** (E Dubai), who is offered as [hip 2720](#). In training with David Hofmans in California earlier this year, he broke his maiden in Betfair Hollywood Park maiden special company June 8.

"He won his second start at Hollywood Park on Belmont Day, and earned a 97 Beyer," said Brothers. "We had to back off him, but he's back in full training now at Keeneland. He's another who looks like he could be any kind."

Brothers added that, regardless of budget, shoppers will find something that suits their program at the Adena barns. "If you look at the horses we put in, we didn't just cherry pick them--they're all here to sell," he said.

He now owns two Lexington dealerships. McCauley purchased the 270-acre Cuttaway Farm in 1997 and bought his first broodmares a decade later. McCauley and his wife Angela have five sons, including Tevis, who has enjoyed success training in Kentucky.



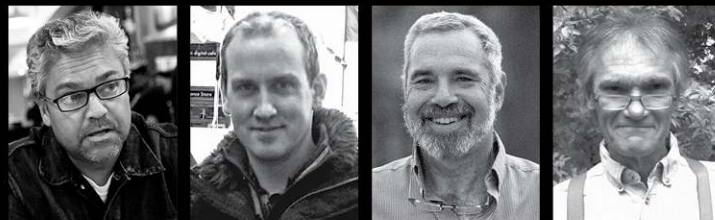
