## 'CAVIAR' HALF SUFFERING FROM LAMINITIS

A Redoute's Choice (Aus) 2-year-old half-brother to undefeated champion Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}), purchased by BC3 Thoroughbreds for an Australian record A\$5 million at the Inglis Easter Yearling Sale this past April, was reportedly bitten by a white tail spider two weeks ago and is being treated at the Werribee Veterinary Clinic. Craig Cameron, chief executive officer of BC3 told Sky Sports Radio in a live interview Thursday morning (Australian time) that vets were called in after farm staff noticed swelling in his right foreleg.

He was taken to Werribee, and Cameron indicated that the bay responded well to initial treatment, but later suffered a "severe reaction to anti-biotics, lost weight and became dehydrated."

As a result, toxins traveled through the colt's system and laminitis has developed. "It's a tragedy," Cameron told Sky Sports Radio. "Anyone whose ever met the horse knows he's a great personality and has a great nature. He's in a fight for his life at the moment. If he has another setback from here, we have some serious issues." The son of Helsing (Aus) (Desert Sun {GB}) became the third consecutive of his dam's produce to top the Easter sale earlier this year. BC3 Thoroughbreds also owns a 3-year-old filly by Redoute's Choice named Belle Couture (Aus), the A\$2.6-million Easter topper in 2012, while the colt who came to be known as All Too Hard (Aus) (Casino Prince {Aus}), fetched A\$1.025 million to top the 2011 Easter Sale. Cameron emphasized that the next 48 hours are critical, but remains optimistic that the colt can pull through. "He's a tough fella, he is eating well, and vets are keeping him comfortable standing in ice boots," Cameron told Sky Sports Radio. "He had a good night [Wednesday night], but it's important that he doesn't have another setback. We hope to see improvement and no further deterioration."

## TREVE PLANS OUTLINED

Trainer Crique Head-Maarek yesterday gave a rough indication of the program for Sheikh Joaan Al Thani's **Treve (Fr)** (Motivator {GB}) following her Cartier Horse of the Year award on Tuesday night. Last year's brilliant G1 Prix de Diane, G1 Prix Vermeille and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine could start the season off at Longchamp in April before heading to Royal Ascot. "She will have a prep race in France, maybe the G1 Prix Ganay, and then I'd like to go to Ascot during the Royal meeting," Head-Maarek said. "The G1 Prince of Wales's S. would be a good race for her and then we'll run in the Vermeille and the Arc. We will decide where we go after that, but it is difficult for a horse to go unbeaten like that. It's too far away to make a definite plan."

## KEENOV CONTINUES STRONG RESULTS

The Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale continued its run of strong results during its ninth session Wednesday in Lexington. During yesterday's session, 271 horses grossed \$3,998,100. The average of \$14,753 was up 30%, while the median soared 50% to \$10,500. The buy-back rate Wednesday was a sparkling 10.3%. Through nine of 10 sessions, 2,208 horses have sold for \$194,313,100. The cumulative average is up 26% to \$88,004 and the median is up 33% to \$40,000. The buy-back rate is 14.9%. The 5-year-old mare **Surmount** (Speightstown) ([hip 2938](#)) attracted Wednesday's top price when selling for \$92,000 to the bid of Dr. Oscar Benavides, as agent for St. George Stables. **Cont. p6**

## Smith, Stevens Test IJC Waters...

Hall of Fame jockeys Mike Smith and Gary Stevens have both been invited to compete in the Longines International Jockeys' Championship to be held at Happy Valley Racecourse on Hong Kong Island Dec. 4. Smith, who is expected to pilot Priscilla Vaccarezza's Little Mike (Spanish Steps) in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 8, is having an outstanding 2013 season, with a victory aboard Palace Malice (Curlin) in the GI Belmont S. and three victories during the Breeders' Cup meeting at Santa Anita, earning a second straight Bill Shoemaker Award for the championship's leading rider. It will be Smith's first trip to the IJC. Stevens has made a remarkable return to the saddle this season following a seven-year retirement. He teamed with trainer D. Wayne Lukas to upset the GI Preakness S. in May and completed a rare GI Breeders' Cup Distaff/GI Breeders' Cup Classic double with Beholder (Henny Hughes) and Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno, respectively. Stevens is scheduled to appear in the IJC for the second time, having finished seventh in 2001. Other world-class jockeys set to compete for a HK\$500,000 (about US\$65,000) first prize include Kerrin McEvoy (Australia); Christophe Soumillon (Belgium), dead-heat winner of the IJC in 2004; Maxime Guyon (France); Mirco Demuro (Italy); Suguru Hamanaka (Japan); Ryan Moore (United Kingdom), a two-time winner of the event; and perennial leading local rider Douglas Whyte, victorious three times in the IJC (2002, 2007, 2008). Joao Moreira was originally amongst the 12 invitees, but copped a three-raceday ban for careless riding Wednesday and will be forced to miss both the IJC and the International Races meeting Dec. 8. A replacement has yet to be named.

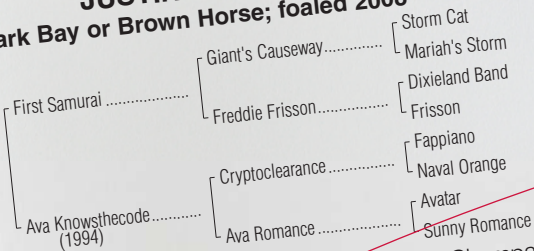

**Blue Heaven Purchases Champ Roxy Gap...**

Not all the major mare purchases happened at Keeneland or Fasig-Tipton over the past two weeks. Privately, Bonnie Baskin's Blue Heaven Farm acquired the dual Canadian champion **Roxy Gap** (Indian Charlie--Harts Gap, by Saint Ballado) from her owner/breeder, Eugene Melnyk. The 5-year-old mare will be retired and bred to Speightstown, according to Baskin's son and Blue Heaven General Manager Adam Corndorf.

"She was a very talented racehorse," Corndorf said yesterday. "She was on the board in 16 of 19 starts and earned nearly a million dollars. She was a

multiple graded stakes winner, and was beaten less than two lengths in five additional graded stakes. She showed up every time, and consistently displayed heart and grit."

Under the tutelage of trainer Mark Casse, Roxy Gap won the Shady Well S. at Woodbine at two and the Fury S. at three, then went on a tear at four last year, capturing the GII Hendrie S., GIII Whimsical S. and GIII Royal North S.--all at Woodbine. Roxy Gap was subsequently named champion female sprinter and champion older female in Canada in 2012.

Earlier this year, Roxy Gap was offered as part of a reduction of Eugene Melnyk's horses at the Fasig-Tipton Winter Mixed Sale in February, and was hammered down for \$850,000. She reappeared still wearing Melnyk's colors, however, and made three more starts this year, running second in the GIII Seaway S. Aug. 31 and winning her career finale, a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer at Woodbine Oct. 5.

"She was a versatile race filly," added Corndorf. "She was a graded black-type horse on all three surfaces, and was a stakes winner at distances ranging from 5 1/2 furlongs to a mile."

Corndorf said Roxy Gap looks the part, too. "She is exactly what we look for in a broodmare prospect," he said. "She's very pretty and correct, has a beautiful neck and shoulder, is racy and athletic, and has good size, bone and muscle. Physically, she looks like she will fit a wide variety of stallions, so we should have plenty of exciting options."

**Keeneland, Cross Gate Team on Art Auction...**

Some of the best offerings in the country were on display over the last two weeks at Keeneland November, and it's possible the priciest among them won't be of the equine variety. That's because a unique and broad collection of fine art has been assembled at the Keeneland sales pavilion, with rare works by the likes of American luminaries Mary Cassatt and Andrew Wyeth expected to fetch up to \$7 million.

The collection is part of the inaugural Sporting Art Auction, to be held at the Keeneland sales pavilion Wednesday, Nov. 20 beginning at 4 p.m.

The event is a collaboration between Keeneland and Greg Ladd's Lexington-based Cross Gate Gallery, and features 174 "high-quality lots focusing on 'sporting' paintings and sculpture by British and American artists and works by important American realist and impressionist painters," according to event literature.

Artists include Sir John Frederick Herring, Sir Alfred Munnings, Edward Troye, Franklin Voss, Peter Curling, and André Pater, as well three generations of Wyeths--grandfather N.C., father Andrew, and son Jamie. It was Jamie's wife Phyllis Wyeth who bred and raced last year's GI Belmont S. winner Union Rags.

Racing fans will also be familiar with names like Richard Stone Reeves and LeRoy Neiman, who is represented by a massive 7' x 17' mural that was once displayed at the now demolished Sportsman's Park.

"We haven't seen a gathering of sporting art like this in at least 15 years," said Keeneland's Vice President of Sales Walt Robertson, who has helped put together the event, and who will be handling the auctioneering duties--along with Ryan Mahan--Nov. 20.

The auction indeed will be unique. According to Cross Gate owner Ladd, major auction houses like Christie's and Sotheby's regularly held sporting art auctions in the 1970s and early '80s. Changes to the tax law, however, diminished demand for them.

"We were talking with the folks at Keeneland, and thought it would be a perfect time to come back in and do one--especially in Lexington," said Ladd. "It's the horse capital of the world, and everyone would be here for the sales. Hopefully, it's good timing."

The auction didn't happen overnight. The idea germinated 13 months ago, and since then, Ladd has spent considerable time and effort soliciting works. He made several trips to England, France and Canada, and all across the U.S., recruiting primarily private owners who might want to enter a piece.

The original focus was strictly on sporting art. The parameters broadened, however, when works by Cassatt and Andrew Wyeth became available.

"I thought we could do Wyeth, at least, because of the ties to Union Rags," laughed Ladd, who nonetheless wasn't about to let a chance to sell a Cassatt slip through his hands. "Of course, it's still mostly sporting art, but we changed the description to 'Sporting Art, American Paintings and Sculpture.'"

Cassatt (1844-1926), a friend of Edgar Degas who spent much of her adult life in France and was greatly influenced by the Impressionist movement there, is represented by her 1908 work "Children Playing With a Cat," which carries an estimated value of \$5-6 million.

Andrew Wyeth (1917-2009)'s painting is titled "Marsh Hawk" and has an estimated value of between \$5 and \$7 million. The painting, which gets its name from the hawk perched on post in the background, depicts a millhouse at the Wyeths's Chadds Ford Farm in Pennsylvania--the same name under which Phyllis Wyeth breeds. The work was executed in 1964.

Ladd said both paintings are rarities in the marketplace. "There hasn't been a major Cassatt or Wyeth go through an auction in eight, 10 years," he said. "The Cassatt was on the cover of the Sotheby's auction catalog in 1998, and it subsequently made \$3.2 million. It's an important piece. The same with the Andrew Wyeth. We've seen some of his minor pieces go through in recent years, but not a really major piece like this. In 1981, [Marsh Hawk] was the highest-priced painting ever for a living American artist at the time when it sold for \$420,000."

Don't have seven figures to drop on a painting? Don't worry. The catalog offers a variety of pieces that should appeal to an array of art lovers, including several handsome pieces valued at \$5,000 or under.

Robertson said the response to the auction has been terrific. "We've had a lot of people in the last two weeks who have never been to a horse sale come in just to see this," he said. "Plus, there are a lot of people who came from all over the world for the sale, and they've spent an hour or two going through and looking at all the works."

Including the word 'inaugural' in its literature implies Keeneland and Cross Gate hopes to make the auction a regular event, and Robertson and Ladd confirmed that it could become an annual fixture at Keeneland. "We'll see how this first one goes, but yes, we're very interested in this becoming a regular event," said Robertson.



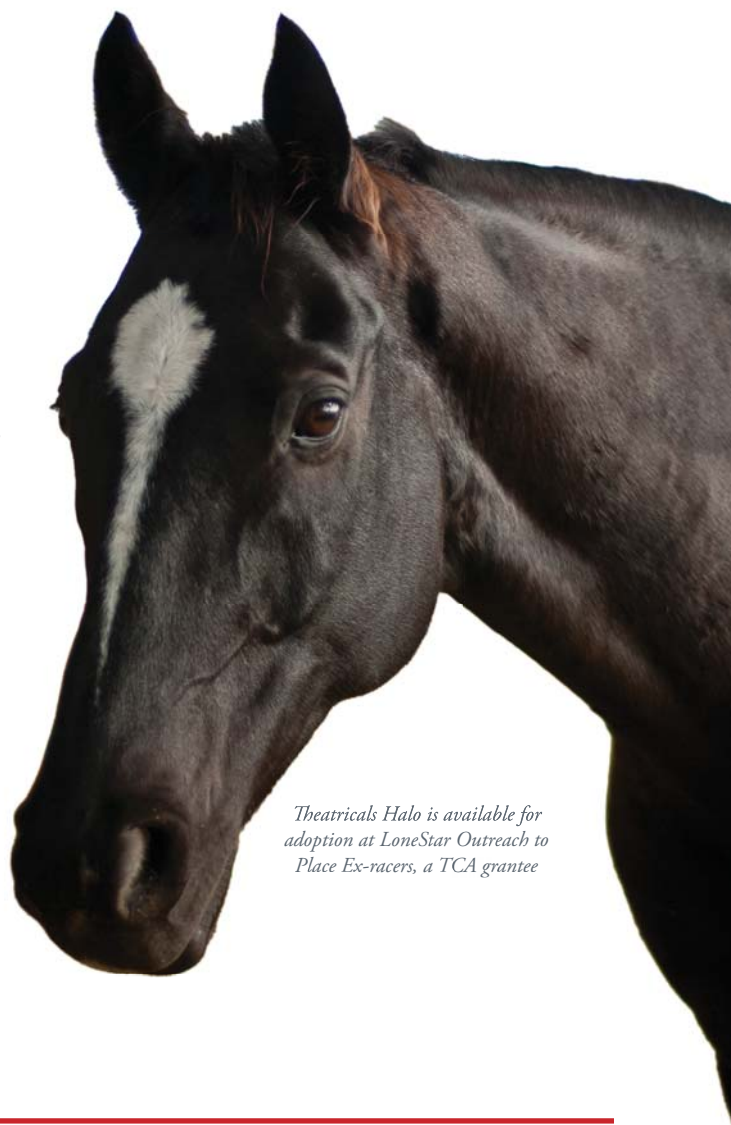
