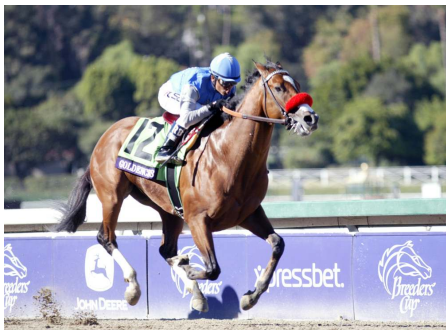

WHO'LL SMILE AFTER THE MILE?

Saturday's GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct has drawn an eclectic field of 11, and the event figures to have an impact on year-end honors in multiple divisions. Five of the entrants represent this year's sophomore class, headed by **Goldencents** (Into Mischieff), the starting 120-pound highweight on the merits of his victory in

the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile over what proved to be a speed-favoring Santa Anita main track Nov. 1. A victory here combined with a loss by Will Take Charge (Unbridled's Song) in Friday's GI Clark H. at Churchill Downs could land the Doug

O'Neill trainee an Eclipse. As a Breeders' Cup winner, Goldencents would earn \$600,000 for a Cigar success. **Verrazano** (More Than Ready) can stake a claim to the title should he emerge victorious. Winner earlier this year of the GI Wood Memorial S. and GI Haskell Invitational S., the striking bay was sixth to Goldencents as the 5-2 chalk in the Dirt Mile and makes the final start of his career. He should be able to secure a stalking trip from his wide draw. **Private Zone** (Macho Uno) makes his second trip to the Big Apple this term, having annexed the GI Vosburgh S. Sept. 28. In a sprint division void of a standout in 2013, he would earn serious championship consideration with a score. **Groupie Doll** (Bowman's Band) will try to atone for an excruciating defeat in last year's Cigar Mile while carrying the same 118 pounds she did 12 months ago. She, too, is running for the winner's share of \$1 million after successfully defending her title in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint. As previous Grade I winners, **Flat Out** (Flatter), who Beyered 116 in taking the GIII Westchester S. Apr. 27, and **Capo Bastone** (Street Boss), the GI King's Bishop S. upsetter, run for the winner's share of \$750,000. **Field p4**

'CHAMPS' COLT BREAKS FIRST-DAY RECORD

Tattersalls' four-day weanling auction got off to a blazing start when the record for a first-session foal was trumped by a Champs Elysees (GB) colt ([lot 272](#)) with a major update courtesy of his G2 Rockfel S.-winning half-sister Al Thakhira GB (Dubawi {Ire}). An ambitious pinhook at 160,000gns, the weanling is heading to Germany after being bought by Philipp Stauffenberg of Stauffenberg Bloodstock, who saw off attempts on the prized weanling by various parties, including Timmy Hyde and Lordship Stud's Tom and Ben Harris.

Anthony Thompson of Australia's Widden Stud had bought the colt in utero when his dam Dahama (GB) (Green Desert) was offered at last year's December Sale. Her auction price of 21,000gns now looks terrific value following the sales turn of her March-born foal who was consigned through Eric Cantillon's Plumton Hall Stud, the day's leading vendor. The appearance of Al Thakhira this season, along with a promising start for Champs Elysees' first runners, which include listed winner Avenue Gabriel (GB), combined to bring about the new benchmark for the first day of foal trade.

HORSES FOR THE COURSE LOOM LARGE

Three of the top four betting choices in today's GII Falls City H. are a combined eight-for-14 over the Churchill Downs main track and they'll look to take full advantage of that home-court advantage this afternoon. **Don't Tell Sophia** (Congaree) is perfect in her two appearances beneath the Twin Spires, a third-level allowance sprinting last Nov. 22 ahead of a last-to-first defeat of **Wine Princess** (Ghostzapper) in the GII Chilukki S. over the one-turn mile Nov. 2. The 122-pound highweight, Don't Tell Sophia spots her rivals anywhere from two to 10 pounds this afternoon. Wine Princess, a daughter of Horse of the Year Azeri (Jade Hunter), has also won half of her six local appearances, but was second to **Flashy American** (Flashy Bull) in the Locust Grove S. Sept. 7 and third in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. Oct. 6 at Keeneland prior to her Chilukki effort. On the heels of her Locust Grove success, Flashy American was sent to California for the GI Zenyatta S. Sept. 28, and while never a serious threat, was hardly embarrassed when fourth, beaten six lengths, behind subsequent GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Beholder (Henny Hughes).

Godolphin announced the acquisition Tuesday of a majority share of this year's G1 Irish Derby hero **Trading Leather (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) and purchase of the unbeaten juvenile **Piping Rock (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}). The former, who was bred and trained by Jim Bolger to annexe the Curragh Classic as well as place in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S., G1 Juddmonte International and G1 Irish Champion S., will stay with Bolger while the G3 Horris Hill S.-winning Piping Rock will also remain in training with Richard Hannon Jr. Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said, "We are delighted both Trading Leather and Piping Rock will race for Godolphin next year. Trading Leather has already shown excellent form at the highest level and we hope Piping Rock can develop into a top Group 1 performer too."

GRIMWADE TO RELINQUISH ROYAL ROLE

“He was a lovely colt and Eric has brought him here in great shape,” said Thompson, who was already familiar with the family having bred Australian Group 2 runner-up Shamal Wind (Aus) (Dubawi {Ire}) from a half-sister to Dahama.

“The original plan was to take Dahama back to Australia, but she has already been sold. I’m planning to try to buy at the mare sale next week though,” he added.

Stauffenberg, who runs the Schlossgut Itlingen stud farm with his wife Marion, was delighted with his purchase, which he described as “my pick of the day, if not the week” and confirmed that the colt has been bought for a pinhooking syndicate which plans to reoffer him next autumn.

Juddmonte’s Champs Elysees enjoyed a good day at Park Paddocks with his four weanlings sold returning an average price of 62,250 guineas from a 2012 covering fee of £7,500. These included a colt out of Pretty Girl (Ire) (Polish Precedent) ([lot 492](#)) who sold to Andrew Black’s Chasemore Farm for 35,000gns from the Biddestone Stud draft.

Nothing else came close to the top lot on Wednesday, but the buoyant market for weanlings seen last week in Ireland appears set to continue with a solid level of trade in evidence through much of the first session.

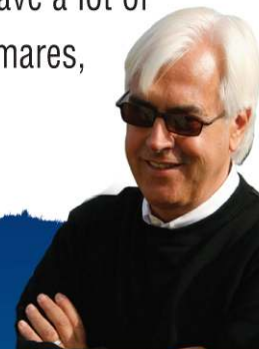

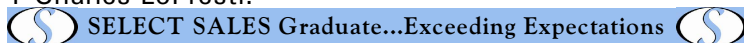

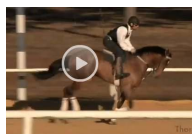
