PREAKNESS PURSE INCREASED

Officials at the Maryland Jockey Club have announced that the purse for the 2014 GI Preakness S. will be increased from \$1 million to \$1.5 million, the first hike in the purse since 1998. "The Preakness S. is the centerpiece of a terrific stakes program that weekend," said Maryland Jockey Club president Tom Chuckas. "Seventeen of the 26 races on Preakness and Black-Eyed Susan

days are stakes. With this increase, the total value of our stakes program over the two-day period is nearly \$4 million." The Preakness eve card features the \$500,000 GII Black-Eyed Susan S. and the \$300,000 GIII Pimlico Special S. Preakness day itself will feature eight added-money events, including the \$300,000 GII Dixie S. and a trio of Grade III events, each worth \$150,000. "I support the move," said Maryland Racing Commission chairman Bruce Quade. "It is another step in bringing Maryland racing back to a preeminent spot in the racing landscape."

RIA ANTONIA HEADED TO THE BIG EASY

Christopher Dunn and Looch Racing Stable's **Ria Antonia** (Rockport Harbor), promoted to first in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Santa Anita Nov. 2, is set to arrive at the Fair Grounds Dec. 27, co-owner Ron Paolucci announced Thursday. Trained by Jeremiah Englehart, the bay is currently being targeted at a Run for the Roses against the boys in the GI Kentucky Derby. "She'll be there to train up to a start in the [GII] Risen Star [Feb 22]," Paolucci said. "I doubt we'll get a race into her

before then." The Risen Star serves as Fair Grounds' final tune-up for the \$1-million GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 29. "Obviously, I plan to be there for the Risen Star, but I also might have a horse running in the Bonapaw [Dec. 21] and be at Fair Grounds for that one, too," Paolucci concluded.

TWO CHANCES FOR SADLER

Trainer John Sadler will saddle two live runners for Saturday's GI CashCall Futurity at Betfair Hollywood Park. **Kobe's Back** (Flatter), a visually impressive debut winner of the Willard L. Proctor Memorial June 15, reported home a distant second as the 4-5 chalk behind **Shared Belief** (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the seven-furlong GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 10. **Candy Boy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) posted a breakthrough maiden victory at fourth asking when stretched to 1 1/16 miles and tried on the Cushion Track for the first time Nov. 22. Both are owned by Lee and Susan Searing's CRK Stable. "They're both doing well, but this is a very good field," Sadler said. "I thought Shared Belief was brilliant in the Hollywood Prevue. He was the most impressive 2-year-old winner of the meet." Kobe's Back, drawn widest of all in post 13, has broken poorly in both of his career starts. "We've had him back at the gate several times since the race," Sadler said. "We're working on it." Sadler added of Kobe's Back, "When I saw where he was drawn, I got a little sick."

DWCC ACCEPTANCES RELEASED

The Dubai Racing Club has released the list of acceptances for next year's Dubai World Cup carnival, which comprises 13 meetings at Meydan Racecourse beginning Jan. 9, and culminating in the Dubai World Cup card Mar. 29. The list features 26 Grade/Group 1 winners among the 228 acceptances, including this year's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}), G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf and G1 French 1000 Guineas winner **Flotilla (Fr)** (Mizzen Mast), **Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), **Joshua Tree (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), **Side Glance (GB)** (Passing Glance {GB}), **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), and **Dunaden (Fr)** (Nicobar {GB}). South African trainer Mike de Kock has been one of the most successful conditioners in the carnival's history, and he brings a team including last year's G1 Al Quoz Sprint winner **Shea Shea (SAf)** (National Emblem {SAf}), as well as G2 Godolphin Mile victor **Soft Falling Rain (SAf)** (National Assembly). His new recruits include G1 Durban July winner **Heavy Metal (SAf)** (Silvano {Ger}), and dual South African Horse of the Year **Variety Club (SAf)** (Var).



Marco Botti, successful in last year's G2 Dubai City of Gold with **Jakkalberry (Ire)** (Storming Home {GB}), has lined up an extended string this year, including American St. Leger winner and G1 Melbourne Cup fifth **Dandino (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) and G1 Prix Royal Oak winner **Tac de Boistron (Fr)** (Take Risks {Fr}), as well as new recruit **Linton (Aus)** (Galileo {Ire}) and a four-strong team from Brazil.

SYMPOSIUM COMES TO A CLOSE

The final general session yesterday of the 40th annual Global Symposium on Racing & Gaming, presented by the University of Arizona's Race Track Industry Program, focused on *Current Legal and Policy Issues in Racing and Gaming*. Given the breadth of the topic, each panelist presented different experiences related to regulation.

First up was Mike Berry, Attorney, Rutledge Ecenia, P.A., who gave a very detailed history of how Florida went from the classic-track wagering to issues surrounding alternative-race wagering options associated with barrel racing. In the end, Berry explained that an administrative judge presiding over a case in the state sided with Florida Quarter Horse Association and ruled that barrel racing permits in the state should be invalidated on the grounds that current laws forbid pari-mutuel wagering such races. The decision is currently being appealed. Berry's key take away was that "weak statutes and regulations" lead to a breeding ground of shortcuts.

Peter Murray, Head of Gaming, GBGroup, then spoke on the importance of identification and verification. He stated that it is imperative to work directly with regulators when building an online presence in the gaming industry. While there is a need to know certain information about a customer and where they really are (geolocation), Murray said, the process should not be so tedious (i.e. printing and mailing forms) that the casual customer will not complete the process and thus take his or her business elsewhere.

Sean Pinsonneault, Executive Vice President & COO, Woodbine Entertainment Group, presented a summary on the changes to regulations for racing in Ontario, Canada following the end of the Slots at Racetracks program. A lack of complete understanding of the economic and employment impact that racing (both Thoroughbred and Standardbred) had on the entire province meant a major loss in jobs (approx. 9,000) and a 60% reduction in mares bred.

These are impacts that will be felt for a few more years, but as Pinsonneault stated, the "Industry is built on hope and passion." That hope and passion are shared, he said, by new government leadership that has made a commitment to support racing with a new five-year transition plan.

Wrapping up the panel, Jay Hickey, President, American Horse Council, brought news from Washington, D.C. The biggest news outside of the two-year budget agreement reached on Wednesday was that there are nine bills in committees that have the word 'horse' in them. Hickey also reminded guests about the tax benefits that expire at the end of this year.


