### CANDY CRUSH IN CASHCALL FUTURITY

Jungle Racing LLC, Hollendorfer, Litt, Solis II, KMN Racing and Todaro's **Shared Belief** (Candy Ride {Arg}) put an exclamation point in the Hollywood Park history book yesterday, streaking home a super-impressive winner of the GI CashCall Futurity--the final graded race to be run before the Inglewood oval closes for good next Sunday. Longshot **Candy Boy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) completed the exacta for his sire, while Shared Belief's stablemate

**Tamarando** (Bertrando) rounded out the trifecta for a Jerry Hollendorfer barn that had already swept the top three slots in the GIII Native Diver H. two races earlier.

Backed at even-money off a smashing 7 3/4-length romp in the seven-panel GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 10, the gelding took up a perfect spot in second through swift opening splits of :22.86 and :46.59 that spread the field out. Candy Boy soon caught the eye with what looked like a suicidal early move to sweep to the lead out wide entering the home bend, as Corey Nakatani waited to pull the trigger aboard the favorite. Shared Belief came to even terms with his paternal sibling at the head of the lane, seized command without much resistance and powered home to air by 5 3/4 lengths and throw his hat in the ring for year-end honors. "Wow!" said Nakatani, won this race in 2010 Comma to the Top (Bwana Charlie). "My horse has a pretty high cruising speed and when [Candy Boy] made that early move, I couldn't go at that time." He continued, "I'm just very thankful to Jerry Hollendorfer and his team, [assistant trainer] Dan Ward, and, obviously, [Alex Solis II] for finding this horse and buying him. He did all the work and I was just a quiet passenger."

**Tap It Rich** (Tapit), considered by many to be the winner's main competition, fought rider Mike Smith's restraint throughout and checked in 11th. **Cont. p3**

### CARAMBOLO GETS PELLEGRINI GLORY

**Soy Carambolo** (Arg) (Val Royal {Fr}) showed his heart with a come-from-behind triumph in yesterday's G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini at San Isidro--the most important race on the South American calendar.

The 6-year-old Soy Carambolo edged Ecologo (Arg) (Easing Along) by a short neck, with favored Cooptado (Arg) (Equal Stripes {Arg}) four lengths behind in third. Ridden confidently by Juan Carlos Noriega, Soy Carambolo stayed true to his typical rallying running style. With Ecologist leading in the final 600 meters, Noriega let the Alberto Domine and Gustavo Rapetti silkbearer loose. He cut the distance with every stride and secured the lead in the final furlong.

Shared Belief was a well-backed seven-length debut graduate for breeders Pam and Marty Wygod and trainer Jedd Josephson at Golden Gate Oct. 9. That effort caught the shrewd eye of Hollendorfer, who reached out to bloodstock agent Alex Solis II to put together a partnership and purchase the horse privately. Solis, whose father has ridden four Futurity winners, enlisted sports personality Jim Rome--who also co-owned this year's defending GI Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint winner Mizdirection (Mizzen Mast) under his Jungle Racing banner--as well bloodstock agent Jason Litt, frequent Hollendorfer partner Dr. George Todaro, and Kevin and Kimberly Nish's KMN Racing. The group scored an immediate success when Shared Belief blew away favored Kobe's Back (Flatter) in the Hollywood Prevue with a 99 Beyer Speed Figure, and the only questions here seemed to be distance-related. **Cont. p4**

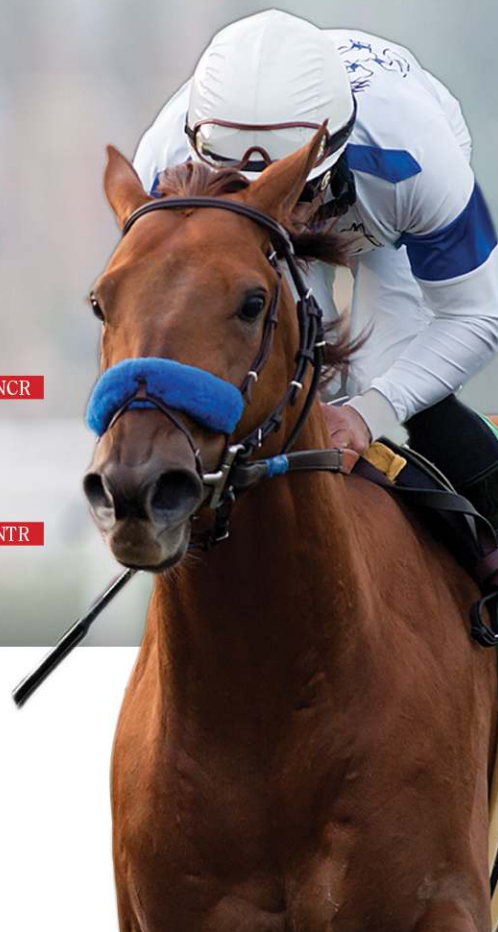

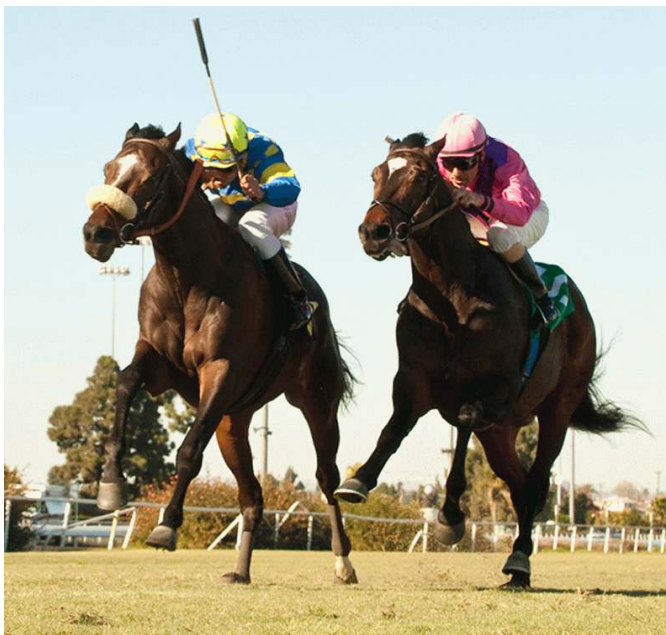

With a perfectly timed ride from new pilot Joel Rosario, French Group 1 winner Lucayan finally broke through Stateside in his seventh start for Hall of Famer Neil Drysdale. A 27-1 upset winner of the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp last May for Francois Rohaut, the bay was shipped to Southern California after a trio of subsequent off-the-board finishes in Europe. He showed immediate promise with a runner-up effort behind Obviously (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}) in this venue's one-mile GII American H. May 25, but could do no better than fifth in the GI Shoemaker Mile S. Stretched out to be second in the GII Del Mar Aug. 24 and GII John Henry Turf Championship at Santa Anita Sept. 29, Lucayan had been off since a ninth-place finish over yielding turf in Woodbine's 12-panel GI Pattison Canadian International Oct. 27.

Well-held by Rosario in last early through sensible fractions for the distance of :25.67, :50.14 and 1:14.21, the 4-year-old mounted a three-wide bid along the turn for home. He kept on coming as they straightened, and struck the front inside the final sixteenth to win snugly. "The key to this guy is getting him to relax and [Rosario] did a lovely job of relaxing him," offered trainer Neil Drysdale, who was winning this event for the first time and his 83rd stakes race overall at the soon-to-close Inglewood oval. "He's had an unlucky year. At Del Mar he tried to come up the middle and got stopped. In the John Henry he also got stuck. And then in Canada it was just a bog and he couldn't handle it. We felt that it was just too fast for him in this country to go a mile and he really needed nine or 10 [furlongs]. But there weren't any races at those distances, which kind of pushed us into running him longer. My heart was going a little boom, boom, boom because they were going so slow, but this horse is talented."

GII Breeders' Cup Marathon runner-up Blueskiesandrainbows went right to the front and never looked back, leading home a one-two-three finish for Hall of Fame trainer Jerry Hollendorfer. A close third behind I'll Have Another (Flower Alley) in last term's GI Santa Anita Derby and a winner of the GII Swaps S. over track and trip while with Bob Baffert, Blueskiesrainbows had been solid, if not quite as flashy, since joining the Hollendorfer barn this term. He took the Ralph M. Hinds H. going about this distance at the Barretts bullring three back Sept. 22, but the chestnut faded to fifth at odds-on in Fresno's Bull Dog H. Oct. 13. Forwardly placed in the Nov. 1 Marathon, he looked on his way to victory until late in the game, but still held well to complete the exacta. Pushed along for speed by Martin Pedroza from the gate, Blueskiesandrainbows took a half-length advantage down the backside with several foes breathing down his neck, including stablemates Hear the Ghost and Rousing Sermon. Asked for more effort after a half in :47.89, the pacesetter looked likely to be collared when the real running began, but he kept digging deep in the lane to hold off his familiar foes.

"When I was thinking about this race and discussing it, we thought that if Blueskiesrainbows was on the lead in the lane, he'd be hard to get by," said Hollendorfer, who revealed that he considers all three of his runners as GI Santa Anita H. prospects next year. "[Blueskiesandrainbows has] been running better and better. If he keeps it up, he looks like a good prospect for the coming year."

Hollendorfer was also pleased with the effort turned in by Hear the Ghost, who looked like a Triple Crown contender after annexing the GII San Felipe S. in March, only to be sidelined soon after with a knee injury. "He was in between horses down the backside, with a hard way to go," the trainer said of the sophomore's trip. "He might be better prepared when we run him in the [GII] Strub [S. at Santa Anita Jan. 18], which is the next race we are pointing for with him." He added, "I've run 1-2-3 before in the El Camino Real Derby [in Northern California], but you don't ever expect to do it in Southern California. I'm a very fortunate guy."
