EL KABEIR HEADLINES JEROME

Zayat Stable's ★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ El Kabeir (Scat Daddy) will look for his second consecutive graded score in the 145th edition of Aqueduct's GIII Jerome S. Saturday. The Florida-bred sophomore broke his maiden at Saratoga Aug. 30 and finished fourth in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 4. He garnered his first black-type when second in the GII Nashua S. Nov. 2 and annexed the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. at Churchill Downs with jockey Calvin Borel in the irons for the first time Nov. 29.

"We're very happy with the way he and Calvin connected in Kentucky," said trainer John Terranova. "The horse came out of the race great, and he's heading into the Jerome ideally [having

worked a half mile in :48.55 Sunday]. He's gotten much stronger moving from the Champagne to the Nashua to now, and he's a lot more focused as well. We've gotten over the two-turn question; now, we have to see how he progresses, how he stretches out his speed, and his ability to rate."

The 2-1 morning-line favorite will have to face Sleepy Hollow S. winner **Ostrolenka** (Musket Man). The Fein and McKenna colorbearer bounced as the 4-1 second choice when finishing last of 13 in the GII Remsen S., but trainer Todd Pletcher thinks the colt can comeback from that disappointing effort.

"The first thing we're looking for is for him to rebound from the disappointing performance in the Remsen," the trainer explained. "My feeling is that he was compromised by a bad post [No. 11] and the fact there was a lot of residual moisture in the track, even though it was labeled fast. [Pilot] Johnny [Velazquez] felt he didn't like the track surface at all, just as he didn't like the sloppy track in his first start, so we're hoping for a fast track and a better performance. He's a colt with some potential, and as he continues to develop and improve, should he run well, we'll come up with a game plan for him."

Chrome to be Honored at Santa Anita for Vox Populi Edited Press Release

Santa Anita Park will honor **California Chrome** (Lucky Pulpit) as the winner of the Secretariat “Vox Populi” (Voice of the People) Award Saturday, Jan. 10, with “Chrome’s” connections scheduled to be on-hand prior to the races for a special autograph session that will include a free California Chrome poster to the first 2,000 fans attending the session, which begins at 11 a.m.

Presented annually for the fifth time, the “Vox Populi” Award was established by Mrs. Penny Chenery, owner of 1973 Triple Crown Champion Secretariat. California Chrome was a handy winner among a record number of online voters. “Chrome” basked in the national spotlight throughout 2014, winning six of his nine starts, including the GI Santa Anita Derby, GI Kentucky Derby, GI Preakness S. and GI Hollywood Derby.

Regular rider Victor Espinoza and trainer Art Sherman, along with California Chrome owners Steve Coburn and Perry Martin, will be available to sign autographs beginning at 11 a.m. in Santa Anita’s East Paddock Gardens. The actual presentation of the “Vox Populi” Award will take place later in the day in a winner’s circle ceremony between races.


California Chrome joins previous “Vox Populi” winners Mucho Macho Man (2013), Paynter (2012), Rapid Redux (2011) and Zenyatta, who was the inaugural winner in 2010.

“Everyone loves a Cinderella story, and this one was no exception,” said Mrs. Chenery. “California Chrome, a proven champion and formidable competitor, reminded us that it doesn’t matter from whence we came but rather how we dance when we get to the ball.” Furthermore, his inspiring story and engaging popularity reached beyond the racetrack stands and into the conversation of a nation. I am looking forward to seeing California Chrome build upon his success during his 4-year-old season.”

The Vox Populi Award ceremony will be broadcast live on HRTV and Coburn and Martin have announced they will be donating race-worn silks from “Chrome’s” winning effort in the GI San Felipe S. for auction, with proceeds to benefit the Secretariat Foundation and other equine charities.

Mr. Jordan Exits Surgery Well

🌟 "TDN Rising Star" 🌟 Mr. Jordan (Kantharos), winner of Gulfstream Park West's Juvenile Spring S. Nov. 8 and Smooth Air S. Nov. 29, has been sidelined after undergoing surgery earlier this week. The Eddie Plesa, Jr.-trainee was originally thought to have torn a ligament, but the prognosis was even better than thought. "It's a better-case scenario than I would have thought," Plesa said. "They did surgery on him Monday and the prognosis is that he'll come back 100%. The time frame--the actual down time--will be 45 to 60 days, not as long as I had originally thought." As for the surgery, the conditioner stated, "It's hard to explain. There's a bone that can protrude above the knee that can rub on the ligament. That's what it ended up being. When we first did the ultrasound of him, it looked like his check ligament was torn. But we did it immediately after the injury and it was kind of a foggy picture, because you can't see as clearly as you'd like to. After we took the initial one, we sent him up to Ocala and took another ultrasound and it showed what I just said and they went ahead with the surgery. But until you get in there, you don't know the extent. It was one of those cases where it went so well, the surgeon called me. I kind of liken it to a trainer calling an owner. Sometimes they don't want to call, but when they do, there's usually a winner involved. That was the case with the surgery."

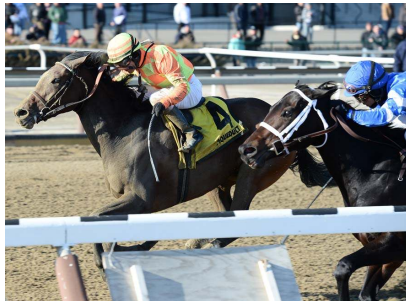

America, third in last year's GII Gulfstream Park Oaks and GI Mother Goose S., was looking for her third straight Big A victory after a front-running 6 3/4-length win in a Nov. 2 off-the-turf allowance and a 1 3/4-length triumph over the inner track Dec. 3. America

dropped back to last soon after the break as Penwith forged to the lead. The Godolphin runner set the pace through fractions of :23.94 and :47.93 with heavy favorite Belle Gallantey (After Market) in close attendance. Penwith began opening up on the field in upper stretch as Belle Gallantey faltered and America was winding up for a powerful stretch run in the middle of the track. Penwith still had a three-length advantage with a furlong to run, but America closed relentlessly to just get her nose in front on the wire. "She broke and got a little bit squeezed at the break, I just let her relax and get in a nice rhythm," commented winning rider Junior Alvarado. "She's actually a filly where previously, at the half-mile pole, you had to start riding her hard because she didn't have a strong kick and would start to drop back, but today as soon as I started to pick it up with her she was ready to go--picking it up real fast.

"As soon as we turned for home, I didn't know if we would get there, but I knew it was going to be close because she was responding well for me," Alvarado added. Leanna Willaford, assistant to winning trainer Bill Mott, added, "There was plenty of pace up front. Normally, you have to really pedal on her to get her going, but Junior said she really took him today. You could see on the turn, she ran around the turn a little better than normal, and continued to finish well from there. It was great to get her a stakes win; that's obviously what we've been shooting for, for many starts." America's dam Lacadena was a \$290,000 Keeneland November weanling purchase in 2005. Racing for Bobby Flay, the mare was second in the 2007 Victoria S. before RNA'ing for \$1.4 million at that year's Fasig-Tipton Kentucky November Sale. 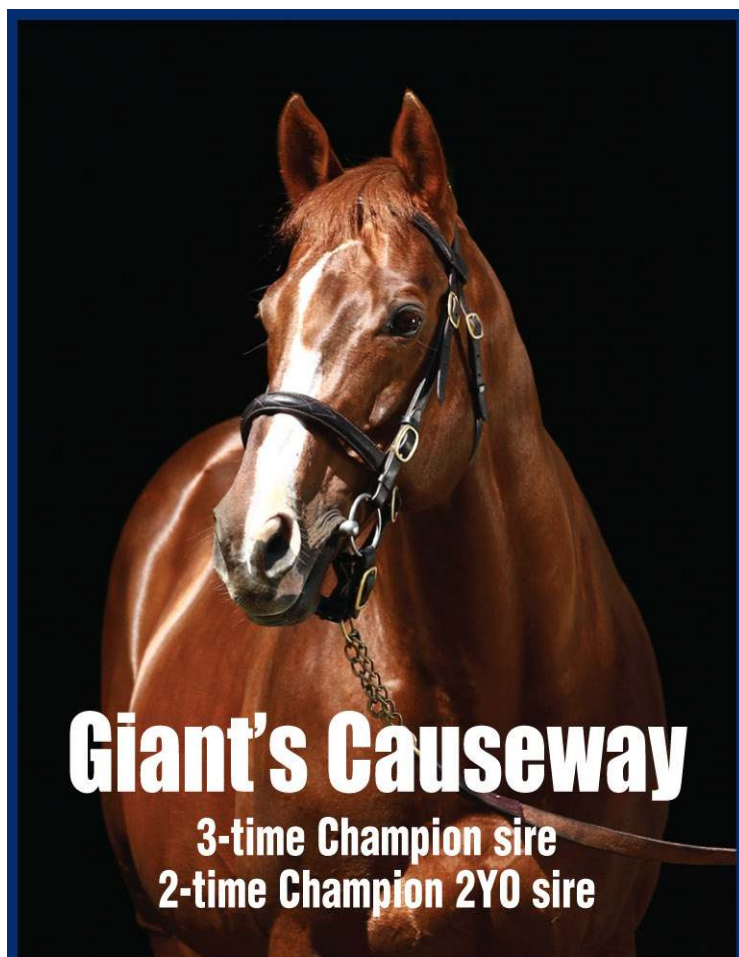
