## 'BEIR' HUNTS DOWN JEROME RIVALS

Not everything went according to script for Zayat Stables' ★ "TDN Rising Star" ★ El Kabeir (Scat Daddy) in the lead-up to and during the running of Saturday's GIII Jerome S. at Aqueduct. First came news that Calvin Borel, who guided the gray colt to his first graded stakes win in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 29, would be forced to take off the mount in light of the untimely death of his sister-in-law, Debbie Borel. The Florida-bred drew the outside stall and bobbled a few strides out of the gates and was three wide the trip in yesterday's race. But in the end, class prevailed and El Kabeir emerged a convincing 4 3/4-length winner from Pennsylvania invader **Nasa** (Smarty Jones) and the late-running **General Bellamy** (Bellamy Road).

"He tried to beat the gate and stumbled a little bit leaving there, but I gathered him up," explained winning jockey C. C. Lopez, who deputized for Borel. "I never panicked; I was riding the best horse in the race. I just bided my time, and when I was ready, I pushed the accelerator and he went. I think he'll go further as he develops. He won pretty easily and switched off after he got past, so he was kind of cool. I hope I get to ride him [again]." **Cont. p3**

Bred in Florida by Karen Russell's Rustlewood Farm, El Kabeir was consigned through the Summerfield sales agency to the 2013 OBS August sale and fetched \$250,000, the joint-second most-expensive of the 69 Scat Daddy yearlings to go through the ring that year. Part of a first batch of Zayat 2-year-olds to be turned over to John Terranova II, El Kabeir was a troubled third behind subsequent undefeated MGSW Blofeld (Quality Road) in his Aug. 14 bow at Saratoga, but came out of that race well and was back in the starting gate at the Spa just over two weeks later. Leaving nothing to chance on that occasion, he sprinted clear early, got his opening half-mile in :44.98 and charged home a 10 3/4-length winner to earn Rising Star status. A disappointing fourth behind Daredevil (More Than Ready) in a sloppy renewal of the GI Champagne S. at Belmont Oct. 4, the March foal was a solid runner-up to Blofeld in the GII Nashua S. going a mile in the mud over the main track here Nov. 2. Terranova and Zayat decided to send their charge away from the Big Apple for his 2-year-old finale in the GII KY Jockey Club S. Nov. 29, and it paid dividends, as El Kabeir was allowed to dictate terms beneath Borel and held sway late at 7-1 as Imperia (Medaglia d'Oro) closed to within a head at the finish.

Any hopes for a coast-to-coast theft in the Jerome evaporated when El Kabeir stumbled leaving the gate, allowing second choice Ostrolenka (Musket Man) to seize early command, with Ackeret (Mach Ride), Nasa (Smarty Jones) and the favorite across the track in that order.

But instead of hitting the gas early, El Kabeir switched off well enough in third and Ostrolenka's lead over Nasa was tenuous as they raced towards the far turn. Asked by Lopez to come after them at the three-eighths, the favorite launched his bid three wide outside of Nasa at the quarter pole as Ostrolenka began to back up. Firmly in front a furlong and a half from the wire, El Kabeir worked further clear to register a decisive victory over Nasa and General Bellamy, who closed from far back to be third.

"It was nice seeing him sit off horses for the first time," the winning conditioner admitted. "I was kind of curious about that because I didn't know if that scenario played out how he'd react this time, but certainly it worked out fine. That's what we've been seeing in the mornings; his maturity level has just gotten [better]."

Subject to discussions with Team Zayat, Terranova said El Kabeir could go next in the GIII Withers S. Feb. 7 or the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 7.

## A 'REA'-LLY GOOD DAY

**Seduire** (Elusive Quality) gave owner Nat Rea's Regis Farms an initial black-type victory in the Wine Country Debutante S. last August and provided the Canadian native a breakthrough graded-stakes success in Saturday's GII Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita.

The first of eight weanlings--four colts and four fillies --purchased by Rea at the 2012 Keeneland November sale, **Seduire** soundly defeated ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Enchanting Lady (Tale of the Cat) in their respective racetrack debuts over this surface May 22, but had the tables turned by that rival when runner-up in the June 22 Landaluce S. Following her wire job in the Wine Country Aug. 8, the Ontario-bred miss was fifth to Sunset Glow (Exchange Rate) in the GI Del Mar Debutante Aug. 30, but improved to round out the exacta behind stablemate **Light the City** (Street Sense) in this track's Anoakia S. Oct. 12. She was most recently the runaway winner of the Golden Gate Debutante Nov. 29, whose third-place finisher, Lutine Belle (Bellamy Road), gave Alex Solis career win number 5,000 in Thursday's grassy Blue Norther S.

Perfectly drawn at the fence to take full advantage of her speedy tendencies, **Seduire** flew the gates and set sail beneath Rafael Bejarano, getting the opening quarter-mile in :21.76 while pressed along by **Xoxo** (Majestic Warrior) and a three-wide **Light the City**. **Callback** (Street Sense) advanced steadily along the rail to race just behind **Seduire** and inside **Light the City** as they reached the head of the stretch. Popped the question by Bejarano at the three-sixteenths marker, **Seduire** pinched a winning break and was always holding **Callback** in the run to the wire.

"**Seduire** broke sharp from the gate," the winning jockey commented. "I was hoping she would because she likes to be on the lead and I had a bad post. She broke well so I took advantage. I got her relaxed and tried to give her a breather. When I felt pressured going into the stretch, I let her go and she showed me a big kick."

**Conquest Harlanate** (Harlan's Holiday) dropped far back early on and was eased by jockey Mike Smith.

"She just wasn't comfortable the first 100 yards out of the gate," the Hall of Famer explained. "I gave her a chance to get comfortable and she just didn't. I tried to make her go a little bit after that but the more uncomfortable she got, I just said 'You know, let's just pull her up, get her back to the barn safe and we'll figure it out later.' Other than that, she came back fine and that's the important thing."

Earlier in the day, Rea's **Shook Up** (Tapit) became a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ in New Orleans. **Cont. p5**

After getting blanked in 2013, Finnegans Wake continues to turn it on. The bay--second in the 2012 GI Secretariat S.--posted his long overdue first stakes success in the GIII Arlington H. last July, then closed out his tenure for Dale Romans with a fifth-place finish in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 16. With Rockingham Ranch listed for the first time as co-owner, Finnegans Wake began his West Coast campaign for trainer Peter Miller with a second-place finish in the GII John Henry Turf Championship Sept. 28. A punchless 10th at 58-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf here Nov. 1, Finnegans Wake righted the ship with a narrow come-from-behind win over Patrioticandproud in the 1 1/2-mile GII Hollywood Turf Cup most recently Nov. 27. Overlooked a bit at the windows to put them back to back here, Finnegans Wake took his customary spot at the back of the pack. Seventh through a half mile in :48.80, he began to advance entering the far turn, was swung out four wide for the stretch run and outkicked his aforementioned rival to the wire for the second straight time. "I was concerned this might be a little short; he just won at a mile and a half, but when I looked at his form, he had won at a mile and an eighth before [2012 Churchill allowance]," Miller said. "He's just such a neat horse. He's a stud, but he's just the coolest guy to be around."

Miller continued, "We'll look at all our options, including maybe even Dubai. The horse trains well on dirt and he ran well in the Clark, so perhaps even the [GI] Santa Anita H. [Mar. 7]. I don't know. I've got to get with the owners, enjoy this for now, and maybe next week set up a game plan." The winner's stakes-placed dam Boat's Ghost produced a colt by Medaglia d'Oro in 2014 and was bred back to the Darley stallion. Jerry Crawford's involvement with the winner's family can be traced back to the third dam Native Boat. and rallied furiously to be third, beaten a nose and a head for all of it behind stablemate Chief Kitten (Kitten's Joy) and Croninthebarbarian.

Drawn one from the outside in this newly upgraded affair, Night Prowler was off without incident, allowed all of the early speed to clear and was guided down towards the inside to save ground as longshot Kutuzov (Hold Me Back) took them into the first turn from the slow-starting **"TDN Rising Star"** Smokem Kitten (Kitten's Joy). The gray, one of three in the race for Ken and Sarah Ramsey, was given his head by Edgar Prado and wrested command midway up the backstretch and shook clear, while further back in the field, A Lot was making steady progress as was Night Prowler, who had snuck up into a midfield position nearing the entry to the final turn.

Patently handled on the circle by Javier Castellano, Night Prowler slipstreamed the move of A Lot into the final quarter mile and came off that one's heels to launch his bid a furlong from home. A Lot looked for a stride or two to have the race in the bag, but Night Prowler came with a stinging finish to score impressively. Croninthebarbarian was a wide-trip third.

"I'm real proud of this horse," commented winning trainer Chad Brown. "He was real unlucky last time. We ran two horses in that race and luckily the other barn mate of his won the race for me. To be fair, this horse actually ran the better race." Brown added, "He likes to have something to run at. He likes to have a little pace in front of him. I think he's about a miler, I think that's his distance. We can run him a touch shorter and maybe just a shade longer but I think a mile will prove to be his best trip."

Mary's Follies won half of her first six career starts for trainers John Forbes and Pat McBurney and was purchased privately by Paul Pompa Jr. following a victory in her turf debut in the 2009 Gill Boiling Springs S. She made a half-dozen appearances for trainer Rick Dutrow and added that year's Gill Mrs. Revere S. Retired to stud after a single unplaced run at age five in early 2011, Mary's Follies, who produced Night Prowler Apr. 10, 2012, is the dam of a 2-year-old filly of 2015 by Tiznow named Withhold and dropped a colt by Bernardini in 2014.

With Fashion Alert--the field's lone previous graded winner--taking all the pari-mutuel support, Ekati's Phaeton drifted up from her 9-2 morning line and jumped well to argue the pace outside Concealedwithakiss (Political Force). Fashion Alert was off a touch slow from the inside stall and gave John Velazquez all he could handle early before pressing forward to split the front-runners and make a line of three into the turn. That trio raced as a team around the bend and Fashion Alert, though in tight, remained in with every shot if good enough. She was the first to call it a day in upper stretch and Concealedwithakiss packed it in soon after, leaving Ekati's Phaeton and perfect-trip R Sassy Lass to settle it. The latter had dead aim for the final eighth of a mile, but Ekati's Phaeton stayed on gamely for the narrow victory.

"We had a perfect trip," said winning jockey Luis Saez, who rode East Hall (Graeme Hall) to victory for trainer Bill Kaplan in the GII Indiana Derby. "My filly broke good. It looked like she could have taken the lead, but I didn't want to do that. I saw a replay of her last race and she looked like she waited for horses. Today, I wanted to come from behind. When we came to the stretch, I had to let her run. When she saw the other horse passing her, she started running again."

Ekati's Phaeton is one of five horses acquired by the fledgling Phaedrus Flights operation at the OBS August sale in 2013. She breezed an eighth of a mile in a smart **:10 1/5** ahead of last year's OBS March sale, but was retained by her owners after bidding stalled out at \$150,000.

**Dettori Plans On Hold...**

European star Frankie Dettori's plan to ride regularly at Gulfstream's Championship Meet this winter is up in the air at the moment.

In a phone interview Saturday, Dettori said he will have a better idea whether he will ride in Florida in about 10 days, after he completes a holiday with his family and takes a look at his riding commitments. He is under contract to Al Shaqab Racing, owned by Sheikh Joaan al-Thani of Qatar.

"Basically, I've got no firm plans for what I'm doing," he said. "If I do come it will be in the middle of February."

In early October, Dettori said that he hoped to be at Gulfstream Park by late January and spend about three months at the South Florida track.

In recent years, Dettori, 44, has developed a friendship with American trainer Wesley Ward. He took Ward up on his offer to ride at Saratoga Race Course

last summer and piloted the Ward-trained Hootenanny to a victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Oct. 31. Dettori won twice and was second three times on 11 mounts during the opening weekend of the Saratoga season, his first appearance at America's oldest track.

Dettori was noncommittal about riding at Gulfstream but said he would be talking with Ward after he understood

what his commitments are to Al Shaqab.

"I have to check what I've got going," he said. "It depends what they've got running. Until I know exactly what's going on I'm not really sure about that."

Since 1989, Dettori has had at least one mount in North America in every year except 2013. According to Equibase, he has a record of 33-24-25 from 265 mounts and earnings of \$25.3 million in North America.

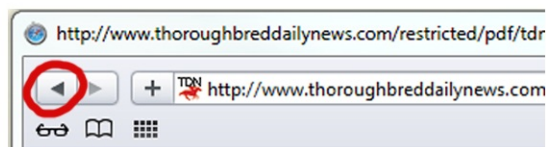
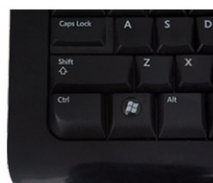
**Firefox:**
