DE KOCK EYES SEVENTH AL RASHIDIYA

Mike de Kock, who has trained the winner of the last three renewals of the G2 Al Rashidiya S. and holds a total tally of six wins in the 1800-meter contest, is set to saddle exactly half the field in the 2015 edition, following the late withdrawal of Salem bin Ghadayer's Army Bulletin (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}).

The De Kock three-strong squad is headed by last year's impressive G1 Jebel Hatta scorer **Vercingetorix (SAf)** (Silvano {Ger}), who went on to suffer his first-ever defeat on his seventh start in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. That loss was at the hands of subsequent Longines "World's Best Racehorse" recipient Just A Way (Jpn) (Heart's Cry {Jpn}). Vercingetorix hasn't been seen since running third to Designs On Rome (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 27 and will be reunited with his regular partner in Dubai, Christophe Soumillon. **Cont. p4**

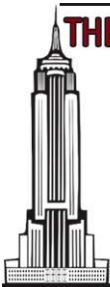

De Kock Eyes Seventh Al Rashidiya cont. from p1

De Kock said of the 6-year-old, "We have said many times Vercingetorix is a lazy work horse and nothing has changed. He has a touch of class and hopefully we will see that again on Thursday. You cannot get excited with his work, but it was the same last year and he won well first time."

De Kock stressed that the same comment could apply to **Mujaarib (Aus)** (Nadeem {Aus}), who won this event a year ago but has not run since finishing down the field in the G2 Dubai City of Gold, Mar. 8.

"Mujaarib showed little in the mornings last year, before surprising us in this race," De Kock said. "Hopefully he will go well as he certainly seems to run his best when fresh."

The South African trio is completed by **Sanshaawes (SAf)** (Ashaawes {SAf}), the only one with the benefit of a recent race under his belt. That came Jan. 8 when fourth to Godolphin's **True Story (GB)** (Manduro {Ger}) in the Listed Singspiel S. over course and distance. The latter will be bidding to present Godolphin with a fifth victory in the Al Rashidiya, and trainer Saeed bin Suroor has expressed satisfaction at the horse's progress.

Japan raider **Sociologa Inc (Arg)** (Include), will make her Dubai debut on Thursday. The 5-year-old mare is a Group 1 winner in her native country, and was last seen when landing a Group 2 event at San Isidro Aug. 24, on the back of which she was sold to Japan Health Summit Inc. Another interesting contender is French import **Mr Pommeroy (Fr)** (Linnari {Ire}), a €250,000 purchase at last October's Arqana Arc Sale, whose first start at Meydan resulted in a short-head second in the Jebel Ali Port H., Jan. 15, after his rider dropped his whip early in the straight.

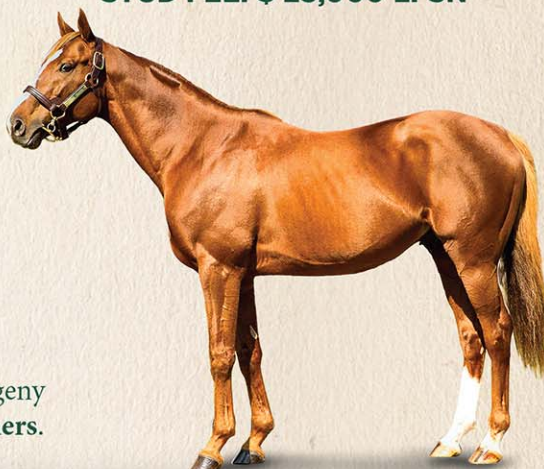

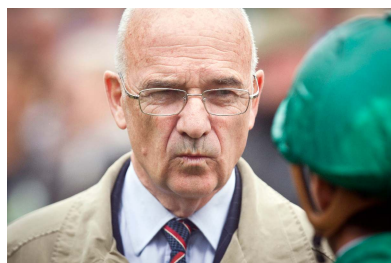

sent out the winner of this race in Sanaya (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}), and the Chantilly conditioner will be hoping for a repeat scenario with Haras de la Perelle's **Cladocera (Ger)** (Oasis Dream {GB}). The 4-year-old won the Listed Prix des Lilas at Longchamp last June, and ran a fast-finishing second to GI Donn H.-

bound Sloane Avenue (Candy Ride {Arg}) in a Listed event on Kempton's all-weather last time out Nov. 19.

Cladocera is likely to face a strong challenge from Michael Halford's **Slipper Orchid (Ire)** (Verglas {Ire}), who made quite an impression Jan. 15 when producing a late run to take fifth in a blanket finish in a handicap event over course and distance.

Richard Hannon's **Zurigha (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) is the only other in the field with fresh form, although she hasn't saluted the judge since September 2013. She was a first starter at Meydan for Richard Hannon Jr. when eighth behind the impressive Umgiyo (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) last week, and could show some improvement here.

A pair of former French-trained fillies will make their Meydan debut in the race. **Victoria Regina (Ire)** (Mastercraftsman {Ire}), a €150,000 purchase at the 2014 Arc Sale, will be making her first start for David Simcock. She won twice in France and was last seen in public when fourth in a Listed event at Chantilly Sept. 3. **Anahita (Fr)** (Turtle Bowl {Ire}) cost €180,000 at the same sale last October. Now in the care of local trainer Salem bin Ghadayer, who celebrated his first winner last Thursday at Meydan, she will attempt to build on her 3-year-old form, which saw her finish second in the G3 Prix de Psyche and a close third to Joe Allen's Beauty Parlor (Elusive Quality) in the Listed Prix Occitanie.

Reigning South African Horse of the Year **Legislate** was officially declared from the Met yesterday by trainer Justin Snaith. Last year's G1 Durban July S. winner returned to action with a smashing victory in the G2 Green Point S. in November, but trailed in last behind **Futura (SAf)** (Dynasty {SAf}) in the G1 L'Ormarins Queen's Plate Jan. 10. He was subsequently found to be suffering from an infection, and while that ailment is now in the past, Snaith said the colt "is unlikely to produce his best," and was removed from consideration.

TARTAN FASHION AT KARAKA

A former Epsom Derby runner-up who once commanded a mere 50,000gns as a stallion prospect emerged from well under most people's radars to make the headlines at Wednesday's inaugural session of the Karaka Select Sale. **Tartan Bearer (Ire)** (Spectrum {Ire}),

the winner of the 2008 G2 Dante S. and second to New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Derby, had only one yearling on offer at Karaka, and that colt (lot **610**) smashed the sale's previous record when knocked down for

NZ\$525,000 to South Australian trainer Philip Stokes.

Overall trade on day one of the three-day Select Sale was solid, with the average price reaching NZ\$52,019, up 6.5% on last year's corresponding figure, while the median of NZ\$36,000 declined by 10% from last year's opening session. The aggregate for 135 horses sold from 207 horses catalogued was NZ\$7,022,500.

"It's been a great start to the Select Sale," commented NZB's Co-Managing Director Petrea Vela. "The top lot exceeded everyone's expectations and just shows what can happen when two people have their hearts set on an outstanding individual. *Cont. p7*

A full-brother to G1 2000 Guineas and G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. hero Golan (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}), Tartan Bearer raced for Sir Michael Stoute in the colors of his breeder, Lord Weinstock's Ballymacoll Stud. The flashy chestnut ran only eight times over three seasons, and was forced into retirement in September 2010 when failing to recover from an injury sustained when runner-up to his stablemate and fellow color-bearer Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in the previous year's

G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. It was first announced that the colt had been sold to a stud career in Lybia, yet political unrest in the country meant that the deal never materialized.

Instead, Tartan Bearer spent the summer in Ireland before making the shorter trip to Newmarket for the 2011 Tattersalls December sale, where Turkish agent Omer Halim Aydin snapped him up for a scarcely believable 50,000gns on behalf of the Turkish Jockey Club. As bad luck would have it, that plan, too, fell through.

Turkey's loss, however, turned out to be Hallmark Stud's gain. The Te Kauwhata-based farm has been standing Tartan Bearer for NZ\$5,000 since the 2012 South Hemisphere season. The horse is owned by Hong-Kong based Andrew Chui Koon Ming, who boards mares at Hallmark and has been breeding most of them to his stallion. The Karaka sale-topper is one of only 12 foals from Tartan Bearer's first crop. He is out of Pink Pier (Aus) (Galileo {Ire}), already the dam of the talented Thunder Fantasy (Aus) (Lucky Owners {NZ}), a Group 2 winner and runner-up in the G1 Rosehill Guineas in Chui's colors.

The colt will remain in Hong Kong hands as successful bidder Stokes said to be acting on behalf of Kong Kong businessman Thomas Li, whose Australian string includes last year's G1 Emirates S. winner Hucklebuck (Aus) (Elvstroem {Aus}) and Group 3 scorer Eclair Big Bang (NZ) (Savabeel {Aus}). Stokes sole other purchase at Karaka so far this week has been a half-brother to Eclair Big Bang for NZ\$130,000.

Stokes told *breednet.com*, “Thomas said to me he was keen on the colt so I went and had a look at him although I didn’t really know too much about his sire. Once I saw him, I had him out a few times and was impressed with what I saw and when you see what the female side of his pedigree has done, there is plenty to like about him.” Regarding the colt’s future plans, Stokes offered, “He looked like a good type of staying horse. We’ll give him the time and aim him for the likes of Derbies.”

The previous record at the Select Sale was NZ\$300,000, set in the bumper year of 2008, the year that the Select Sale’s record aggregate, average and median prices were set, which still stand today. The figure of NZ\$525,000 was the third-highest price at Karaka this week, with only two yearlings at the Premier Sale selling for more.

In addition to the Tartan Bearer colt, three lots fetched prices in excess of NZ\$200,000 during Wednesday’s session, while only one horse had surpassed that mark a year ago. A son of the recently deceased O’Reilly (NZ), from the ever-popular draft of Waikato Stud (lot [455](#)), sold for NZ\$240,000 on a bid from the Hong Kong Jockey Club. Arrowfield Stud’s first season sire Smart Missile (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), whose yearlings sold for up to A\$700,000 at Magic Millions earlier this month, was responsible for the third-highest priced yearling at Karaka yesterday (lot [500](#)), a colt consigned by Wellfield Lodge who went the way of Palmerston North trainer Mike Breslin for NZ\$220,000. The fourth horse to reach NZ\$200,000 was lot [560](#), a Thorn Park (Aus) colt out of the imported mare Naturally (Ire) (Mtoto {GB}), purchased by New Zealand Bloodstock as agent for a Queensland-based client from Lime Country Thoroughbreds.

Selling continues on Thursday, with lots 651 to 850 going through the ring from 11 a.m.

James confirmed that the mare’s 2015 campaign was likely to include a start in The Championships at Royal Randwick [Apr. 4 and 11] en route to the Arc.

MCDONALD AND HAWKES FALL OUT

Leading Sydney-based jockey James McDonald’s relations with father-and-sons training team Hawkes Racing have taken a turn for the worse following the jockey’s decision to remain freelance and lack of communication around it.

In an interview to RSN Radio, McDonald confirmed, “I am keen to go freelance but I would definitely love to continue riding for the Hawkes stable. I want to look at as many opportunities throughout the autumn carnival as I can, this includes riding for the Japanese during The Championships.”

McDonald has also been riding increasingly for Godolphin since John O’Shea took over the reins, and on several occasions gave preference to the ‘Boys in Blue’. This was never as blatant as during a trial session at Warwick Farm on Tuesday, when McDonald chose to partner Godolphin’s Memorial (Aus) (Street Cry {Ire}) ahead of Hawkes Racing’s Mossfun (Aus) (Mossman {Aus}), aboard whom he won last year’s G1 Golden Slipper.

Speaking on RSN Radio’s *Racing Ahead* program, John Hawkes expressed disappointment at the unfolding of events, saying, “He didn’t want to ride ours anymore, he just wanted to ride Godolphins. It was his call that he wanted to move on and that was fine.” Hawkes added, “He got his manager to ring, I haven’t spoken to him personally, he didn’t want to ring us and that’s his prerogative.” However, McDonald admitted, “In hindsight, I probably should have called and likely will. I am keen to continue riding for them.”

Last of 16 in last year's G1 Dubai World Cup over the Tapeta track, Hokko Tarumae will look to capitalize on the return to a conventional dirt surface following a measured success in this lead-up event. Sidelined via illness after his non-effort in last year's World Cup, the bay resumed with a useful fourth-place effort behind Copano Rickey (Jpn) (Gold Allure {Jpn}) in the JBC Classic at Morioka Nov. 3, but improved for that effort next time out, besting upset-minded Namura Victor (Jpn) (Zenno Rob Roy {Jpn}), with Copano Rickey 12th, in the G1 Champions Cup (ex Japan Cup Dirt) at Chukyo Dec. 7. He cemented his status as the country's top dirt runner with a four-length defeat of Copano Rickey in the G1 Tokyo Daishoten at Ohi Dec. 29 and was offered here as a money-back proposition in the wagering to successfully defend his title. Forwardly placed in this three-turn test, Hokko Tarumae (post/saddle cloth five, yellow cap, white jacket) remained prominent while a bit wide and was asked to improve about four deep entering the final turn. He hit the front in upper stretch and was not fully extended to score by a cozy margin. [VIDEO](#).
