## DREAM TO REALITY

Even the most ardent Andre Fabre fan would have struggled to suggest that **Make Believe (GB)** (Makfi {GB}) brought top-class form into Sunday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp, but the undisputed maestro of French training yet again produced some Classic magic as Prince Faisal's representative made virtually all to score by three lengths. Losing his unbeaten record on his black-type debut when second to Ride Like the Wind (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) in the G3 Prix Djebel over seven furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 2, the bay looked to have something to find after that rival went to Newmarket and flopped in the G1 2000 Guineas. Demonstrating Fabre's unceasing innate skill at fostering large improvement from his charges, the 6-1 shot was in a league of his own throughout Sunday's contest while under a masterful front-running ride from the similarly accomplished Olivier Peslier. In leading home his badly drawn stablemate **New Bay (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) for a stable one-two, Make Believe was extending his conditioner's record of Poulains winners to six. "The better ground made all the difference," commented his trainer in reference to his defeat in testing ground at Maisons-Laffitte. "He is very nice--a proper colt." **Cont. p6**

## LOOK AT ER

Undermined by her wide draw in 12 in a race that is always heavily biased by post position, His Highness The Aga Khan's **Ervedya (Fr)** (Siyouni {Fr}) just had more class than her rivals, and that ultimately told in Sunday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches at Longchamp. At the top at two, the homebred was so impressive in the G3 Prix Imprudence over seven furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 2 that it seemed possible that last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac runner-up had improved over the winter, and she was hammered into 13-10 despite the misgivings of the draw. Christophe Soumillon knows enough to not panic in such a situation and with his mount's potent turn of foot in mind, delivered her with accuracy to swoop on the 35-1 outsider **Irish Rookie (Ire)** (Azamour {Ire}) in the last 150 meters and score by a length. "She has all the qualities--class, speed, is easy to train and to ride and also goes on any ground," trainer Jean-Claude Rouget commented. "She got the perfect trip and deserved that Group 1." **Cont. p7**

## KENTUCKIAN CRUISES IN LAZ BARRERA

**Kentuckian** (Tiznow) gave Rick Porter's Fox Hill Farms its second graded stakes victory of the weekend at Santa Anita, storming to an easy 6 1/4-length victory in Sunday's GIII Lazaro Barrera S. Fox Hill, in partnership with Siena Farms, won Saturday's GIII American S. with Brazilian import Bal a Bali (Brz) (Put It Back).

Tabbed a "TDN **Rising Star**" after an 11-length debut victory at Golden Gate Mar. 7, Kentuckian was a troubled third behind reopposing **Yiannis** (Midshipman) as the 3-5 favorite in the Apr. 12 San Pedro S. With a bullet six-furlong work in 1:11 1/5 May 4 on display, the gray colt was sent off at even-money to avenge that loss Sunday.

Breaking from the outside in the seven-horse field, Kentuckian settled off the pace as Yiannis zipped through fractions of :21.84 and :43.64. Kentuckian swept into contention with a three-wide move on the turn, powered to the lead without being asked and sailed clear down the lane with effortless ease. The performance drew high praise for first-time pilot Mike Smith. "He reminds me of Holy Bull," said Smith, who also rode the gray champion. "He has an unbelievably high-cruising speed and stride." **Cont. p3**

Local hope **Bodhisattva** (Student Council) tuned up  
 for Saturday's GI Preakness S. with a five-furlong work  
 in 1:04 at Laurel Park Sunday ([video](#)).

"I think he did pretty good," owner and trainer Jose  
 Corrales said. "I did not want a fast work or anything  
 like that. I just wanted to stretch him out and let him  
 feel good about it. He really just galloped next to the  
 other horse. [Jockey] Trevor [McCarthy] said he could not  
 hold him in the beginning,  
 but he managed to do it."

Bodhisattva is coming off a  
 1 1/2-length victory in the  
 Federico Tesio S. at Pimlico  
 Apr. 18. The Preakness will  
 be his 12th career start and  
 the first Triple Crown  
 appearance for Corrales.

"This is like a dream," Corrales, who is the  
 fifth-leading trainer at the current Pimlico meet with six  
 winners from 26 starters, said. "It's like a lottery ticket  
 that we got, and we'll see what happens. It gives you  
 motivation because you're running against the best  
 horses. I'm already down at the bottom. The only thing  
 I can do from here is improve. Some of the media has  
 already called my horse a pony, but sometimes the  
 ponies can beat the others."

Corrales continued, "The horse has improved and he's  
 done what I've needed to do with him. I've taken into  
 consideration that he might not be the best horse [in  
 the Preakness field], but his father was a good horse  
 and he's bred for the distance. If you don't buy the  
 lottery ticket, you never have a chance to win."

### Tale of Verve Joins Preakness Line Up

Charles Fipke's **Tale of Verve** (Tale of Ekati) will take his place in Saturday's GI Preakness S., trainer Dallas Stewart confirmed Sunday. The decision to run came after the colt worked five furlongs at Churchill in 1:00.40.

"He is fit and fresh and we are excited to see what we have," Stewart said after the work. "[Joel] Rosario will ride. He was on him when he broke his maiden."

With exercise rider Pedro Velez aboard and working with Sir Barton S. candidate Lemon Drop Title (Lemon Drop Kid), Tale of Verve produced fractions of :12.60, :24.60, :36.60 and galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.60.

"Twelves all the way around--beautiful," Stewart said. "I may jog him in the morning and we might van up Tuesday. I'm still working on that."

Tale of Verve, who was an also-eligible in the GI Kentucky Derby field, is coming off a Keeneland maiden win Apr. 23 ([video](#)).

### Mr. Z to Skip Preakness

**Mr. Z** (Malibu Moon), 13th in the GI Kentucky Derby, will skip Saturday's GI Preakness S., owner Ahmed Zayat confirmed Sunday. "I'm not running," Zayat said. "I just don't see any merit for that. I know he didn't have a chance to run in the Derby. I know he was in huge traffic. But I think at this juncture I need to get him confidence."

### MUBTAAHIJ RETURNS TO WORK TAB

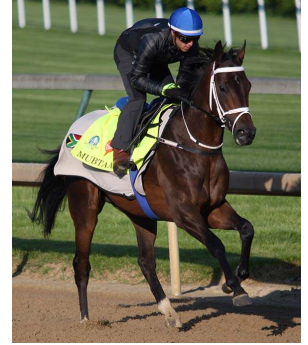
Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa al Maktoum's **Mubtaahij (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) returned to the work tab Sunday for the first time since finishing eighth in the GI Kentucky Derby. The colt went a half-mile in :49.40 in preparation for the June 6 GI Belmont S. at Churchill.

"This was his first piece of work since he ran, so we're still on target for Belmont," Trevor Brown, assistant to trainer Mike de Kock, said. "I was pretty satisfied with the work."

Mubtaahij earned his way into the Derby field with an eight-length romp in the G2 UAE Derby at Meydan.

Brown expects Mubtaahij will be closer to the pace in the Belmont than he was when beaten 9 1/2 lengths in the Kentucky Derby.

"We'll have to be [closer]," he said. "It [Belmont] has a shorter home stretch and we're going to have to be closer and sharper. American horses are a lot sharper out of the stalls in the first two furlongs than we are. We'll have to sharpen up a bit. I don't know if he handled the run on the rail; I would have liked for him to be a little more out."

## DERBY WHIPPING

Seemingly lost in the discussion of whip use in this year's Kentucky Derby is that Kentucky prohibits whipping on the flanks unless necessary to control a horse. See Section 15, subpart 7, of 810 KAR 1:016. It is abundantly clear in video of the race that the winner, and other runners, were whipped on their flanks without any indication that they were out of control. Yet Kentucky's chief steward stated that she and her colleagues had watched the race "many, many times" and whipping "wasn't anything that got our **attention**." How can a violation of the rules the stewards are supposed to enforce not get their attention? The rule exists to protect the welfare of the horses and it should be enforced. **Aaron Mason**

After beating the smart Sinfonietta (Fr) (Sinndar {Ire}) on debut over 7 1/2 furlongs at Deauville in late October, Make Believe overcame heavy ground to follow up over the same trip at Saint-Cloud the following month before entering winter quarters as another exciting prospect to grace his illustrious stable. Unlike his sire, Make Believe failed to win the G3 Prix Djebel on his reappearance, but was swooped on late by Ride Like the Wind and was unable to react quickly over a seven-furlong trip that may have been on the sharp side. Taking full advantage of his favorable low draw to take up the running after the first 100 meters of this prize, Make Believe was allowed to roll at a comfortable pace by Olivier Peslier and it was clear turning for home that he was still well within himself. Clinching the win with a decisive kick two out, he was given four half-hearted smacks to secure a comfortable success from the race's hard-luck story New Bay. That fast-improving Juddmonte homebred overcame a wide draw to gallop on strongly from rear and wear down Mr. Owen late on, catching the eye, with the May 31 G1 Prix du Jockey Club in mind. Fabre is keen to keep the first two apart for now and said, "At this stage, I want to keep Make Believe at a mile so the French Derby is unlikely. I will speak to the owner of course, but he is more likely to go to Royal Ascot for the [June 16] G1 St James's Palace S. New Bay ran a fantastic race from his draw and is an improving horse. He will probably stay farther, so he will now go to the Jockey Club." Ballydoyle's strongly supported 27-10 favorite Highland Reel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) failed to make a meaningful impact on the race and, after racing freely early without cover, plugged on to be sixth.

Make Believe is a first-crop Classic winner for his Classic-winning sire Makfi, who took the 2010 G1 2000 Guineas. After starting out at Tweenhills Stud in Britain, Makfi is standing the 2015 season at Haras de Bonneval in France. Makfi also shuttles to Westbury Stud in New Zealand where he has enjoyed early success with the Group 1-winning juvenile Marky Mark (NZ).

One of the rare Aga Khan juvenile representatives to display sprinting speed early on in the campaign, Ervedya captured her first two races at Tarbes in May and Maisons-Laffitte in June before making light work of keeping her unbeaten sequence running in the six-furlong G3 Prix de Cabourg at the start of Deauville's August festival. Third behind the powerful colts The Wow Signal (Ire) (Starspangledbanner {Aus}) and Hootenanny (Quality Road) in the G1 Prix Morny there later that month, the homebred received a poor draw in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac over this track and trip on the Arc card and may have been used up too early before 'TDN Rising Star' Found (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) swooped late. On her return in the Imprudence, Ervedya served notice that she would be a force to be reckoned with in whichever Guineas she was sent to when swamping the G3 Prix Miesque winner Ameenah (Fr) (American Post {GB}) and G3 Prix du Calvados scorer Queen Bee (Fr) (Le Havre {Ire}) in a display of raw talent on easy ground. Keen early here having been inevitably exposed by her draw, she was helped by a sound pace as she stayed anchored in rear with main market rival Mexican Gold just ahead. At the top of the stretch, it looked conceivable for a brief period that Criquette Head-Maarek could be on to an eighth edition, as her representative Fontanelice (Ire) (Vale of York {Ire}) kept turning the screw in front, but Sunday's G1 1000 Guineas sixth Irish Rookie became the new target as she cut loose with 300 meters remaining. Delivering her surge out wide along with Mexican Gold, Ervedya had the extra measure of dash required to reel in the British raider 150 meters from the post and secure a third renewal and second straight for Jean-Claude Rouget. Her trainer is planning to stick to a mile for now and said, "We'll wait and see how she comes out of this, but at this stage I am keen to go to Royal Ascot for the [June 19] G1 Coronation S."

Irish Rookie rewarded the bold decision of Martyn Meade to run her back just a week after finishing sixth in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, and her trainer was understandably delighted with her effort. "I am thrilled to bits and it's such a shame she had to go so early, because she is such a battler," he told *Racing Post*. "If someone had taken her on earlier, it might have been a different matter, but she has still run a great race. She is still a little bit inexperienced, as it's only her fourth race and it was her first time away from Newmarket and around a bend. She loved that bit of cut in the ground and she has run a cracker."

Khalid Abdullah's racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe said of Mexican Gold, "She has run a good race and enjoyed a good trip, but we are not certain she stayed the mile so we will have to see where she comes back."

temporarily as Cape Clear Island took the lead off Canndal with a quarter-mile remaining. Responding to Mickael Barzalona's increasingly urgent requests, Ampere battled gamely to overhaul his only serious rival in the last 100 meters and extend his conditioner's record. "He is a late-maturing horse who will stay very well," Fabre commented. "The G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp July 14] is where I would choose to go and I'd like to keep him fresh for that. I would pass on the Prix du Jockey Club, but I will have to discuss it with his owner."

Cleo Fan never ran a bad race in his career but was rated the second choice of trainer Stefano Botti, well behind his stablemate Priore Philip (Ity) (Dane Friendly {GB}), the 2-5 odds on favorite for the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica. Priore Philip, who defeated Cleo Fan by six lengths in the G1 Premio Roma last year, was rank despite the solid pace set by Cleo Fan and failed to respond when asked by jockey Dario Vargiu, crossing the line in sixth place. Cleo Fan, who was second in his comeback in the G3 Premio Ambrosiano Apr. 19, opened up by four lengths at the 400-meter pole and stayed on bravely while the German raider Magic Artist finished fast but not in time and the other shipper, Wake Forest, lacked a finishing kick. Jockey Umberto Rispoli collected his second win in the Presidente Della Repubblica. He said, "Stefano Botti was confident and asked me to give a positive ride to Cleo Fan. The others were looking for Priore Philip and my horse kicked for home at the right moment. When Magic Artist came fast, I had the win in my pocket." Botti added, "Cleo Fan was a Derby candidate last year, but he had some niggling problems and I was forced to give him a break. He came back fresh and strong in the second half of the season. Cleo Fan is a lovely horse and deserved a big win. Priore Philip pulled a lot in the early stages; he was too keen and paid a huge toll."

"He handles that ground so well and as long as the rain keeps coming we'll be happy," his rider commented. "Again, he wasn't doing a stroke in front up the straight and I haven't had to get stuck into him. He was entitled to win on form, but he's been very impressive again and you never feel like you are going fast enough on him. He had a bit left in the tank and without doubt a mile and a half will be no problem to him, but the important thing is the ground."

Foley added, "He eats and sleeps and does just what he has to do in his work, but he does it at the racecourse and I'm looking forward to him being in against a better type of horse now. If he gets a lead, I think you'll see a different horse again."

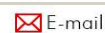
