A SOLID KARAKTAR

Chantilly's G1 Prix du Jockey Club has been the property of His Highness The Aga Khan on six occasions since 1979, and it could be a case of seven up in Sunday's edition with the likely favorite **Karakar (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) charged with sporting the emerald green. Mastering testing conditions when annexing the Mar. 28 Listed Prix Francois Mathet over this trip at Saint-Cloud, the homebred was equally at home on a fast surface when following up in the G3 Prix Noailles--also at this unique distance --at Longchamp last time Apr. 20. "He's climbed up the ladder, his form is good and he's improved since last year," commented Georges Rimaud, the French stud and racing manager to his owner-breeder. "He seems to be pretty efficient at the distance, so it will be interesting to see how he goes against better competition

and in a bigger field. He's in good form and has done everything he's been asked to do up until now."

One of the least-known quantities in opposition is Hspirit's **Silverwave (Fr)** (Silver Frost {Ire}), who put the previously unbeaten Epicurus (GB) (Rail Link {GB}) to the sword in the G3 Prix la Force at Longchamp Apr. 6 and he has Classic pedigree, being by the 2009 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner and a half-brother to Stormy River (Fr) (Verglas {Ire}), who was placed in that contest. Joseph Allen's **War Dispatch** (War Front) is on a roll, with his last five outings resulting in successes and culminating in the G3 Prix de Guiche over nine furlongs here May 8. "He has been doing very well, no problem at all," said trainer Jean-Claude Rouget. "We have no form lines with the favorites, but I think he can be competitive and run a good race. He always does the minimum and is never impressive. He has been winning every time, but in lesser company. This is the target and I think he is arriving in good shape for it."

Intriguingly, Joseph O'Brien is back on the May 10 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains sixth **Highland Reel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), with Ryan Moore partnering **Cape Clear Island (Ire)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) as Aidan O'Brien looks for a first renewal. The latter was second to Ampere (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}) in Longchamp's G2 Prix Hocquart over 11 furlongs May 10 and is fitted with blinkers for the first time. One of the lesser-exposed types is Mutebin Abdullah's **Mostaneer (Ire)** (Dutch Art {GB}), who booked his ticket with a game win in the Listed Prix de Suresnes over nine furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 17. **Field p12**

QUEEN COMES THROUGH IN AMERICAN OAKS

Spanish Queen (Tribal Rule), favored at 3-5 off a win in Santa Anita's GII Honeymoon S. May 3, returned to the Arcadia winner's circle Saturday with an ultimately comfortable score in the GI American Oaks. Away well from the inside post, the Bederian, Kamberian and Nakkashian homebred set in the pocket while perhaps a bit keen as last-out GIII Edgewood S. stealer Feathered (Indian Charlie) showed the way honest-enough splits for the 10-panel distance of :23.97, :47.68 and 1:12.24. Swung out into the clear by Brice Blanc as they hit the top of the straight, Spanish Queen kept on coming to collar the pacesetter in the final sixteenth and prevail in hand by 3/4 of a length. East Coast invader **Consumer Credit** (More Than Ready) completed the trifecta over stablemate **Mrs McDougal** (Medaglia d'Oro). "She's just eating up the ground and getting better with every race," offered Blanc, who noted that his saddle slipped during the race. "She keeps improving and she loves her job. She has started trusting me more, so I can do a little more with her. I think she's learning how to be a good racehorse." He continued, "She looks like she's on the bridle all the time, but she does it in a way that she's actually relaxed... She does it in a way that doesn't affect her breathing and she does it nicely; that's why she's able to accelerate like she does the second part of the race." **Cont. p3**

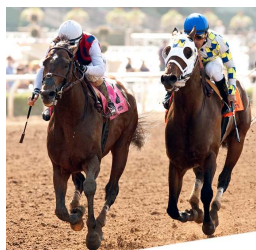

“It was a great ride by Brice,” said trainer Richard Baltas, who was celebrating his 54th birthday. “He saved ground, she had to earn it and she got it done. Brice has been on her every breeze; he’s gotten to know her really well. She’s not very big, but she’s got a big heart and she’s a lovely filly.” Baltas added, “It was a pretty big deal when Big Macher (Beau Genius) won the [GI] Bing Crosby [S. last July at Del Mar], but I was never favored in a Grade I race like I was [Saturday] with Spanish Queen. There’s so much pressure, and when you win, there’s a big sigh of congratulations and relief. This is a very special horse and I just got lucky to get her. This is the best birthday present I could ever have.”

Spanish Queen is the first foal out of Spanish Bunny, who was campaigned in part by Jack Nakkashian and Harry Bederian. She has a yearling half sister by California sire Sundarban (A.P. Indy).

“We’ve been partners, Jack and I, almost 20 years,” revealed Bederian. “I didn’t even realize his saddle slipped. We didn’t want to see that! She’s unbelievable. I’ve never had a Grade I winner, so I’m still not sure it’s reality, especially when we saw the 4-5 odds on her. As you can see, I’m all sweaty, I was shaking I was so nervous.”

Strict Compliance (Into Mischief) was scratched from this spot in favor of a winning start in Penn National’s Penn Oaks.

Catch a Flight overtook favored GI Whitney H. winner Moreno in the final strides to score his second straight black-type victory in the Californian. Dispatched as the crowd's second choice, the bay was sitting pretty in an eager third just off the flank of Moreno as Big Cazanova (Arg) (Giant's

Causeway) clocked early splits of :22.86 and :46.94. Moreno took control on the backstretch and attempted to run away with it as the field turned for home, but Catch a Flight was right on his tail and full of run. Under a hand ride from Hall of Famer Gary Stevens, the 5-year-old swept up three wide on Moreno's outside in the stretch and

skipped clear of the favorite in the final strides to score. "We figured he'd be off of those two [Big Cazanova and Moreno]," winning trainer Richard Mandella said. "Then it was whether he could catch them or not. When [Gary Stevens] goosed him at the quarter-pole, he responded pretty quickly. Gary knows him well enough. I didn't try to tell him how to ride him. This was a step forward. The time of the race was good and he beat Moreno. Every step he's made has been forward. We'll look at the [GI The] Gold Cup [at Santa Anita June 27] next."

Stevens added, "Ever since his first win here he's shown me a lot of tenacity and it was just a question of if he was fast enough to win. He's just now starting to figure out American racing, I think he's still improving and I don't think we've seen the best of him yet." Catch a Flight captured six of his 10 races in his native Brazil, five of which were consecutive allowance wins. Third in the G1 Sao Paulo S. in April of 2014, the bay was a head scratching 10th in the G1 Brasil S. that June behind now-stablemate Bal a Bali (Brz) (Put It Back), who overcame a series of health issues to capture his U.S. debut in this venue's grassy GIII American S. May 9. Catch a Flight finished third in his first American outing in a local one-mile optional claimer Jan. 19 and came back to score next out in the same conditions, but going a furlong farther, Feb. 13. Third behind champion Shared Belief (Candy Ride {Arg}) and Moreno when taking a big step up in class in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 7, the bay returned to his winning ways next out in this venue's GIII Precisionist S. May 2.

Having displayed a propensity for firing fresh throughout his career, Lockout managed to overcome a six-month absence to break through at the graded-stakes level for the first time with a last-to-first rally in the Connaught Cup.

Seventh to Something Extra (Indian Charlie) in this event in 2013, Lockout returned from nine months of inactivity to take out a course-and-distance allowance 367 days ago and was fifth in a rained-off test last June before running on to be third behind Something

Extra and Phil's Dream in the six-furlong GIII Highlander S. the following month. The dark bay closed from dead last to be runner-up to the classy Kaigun (Northern Afleet) in the GII Play the King S. Aug. 10, but was sixth in the GI Woodbine Mile Sept. 14 and in the GII Nearctic S. Oct. 19 before closing out the season with a two-length allowance victory going a mile over Churchill's Matt Winn turf course Nov. 16.

Drawn widest in this field, Lockout raced in midfield early on, but was content to drift back to the tail, as River Seven and defending race champion Excaper (Exchange Rate) locked horns on a relatively easy pace. Relegated to last inside the final three-eighths of a mile, Lockout commenced his rally in earnest inside leaving the quarter pole, then shifted out to about the four path at the furlong grounds. River Seven refused to give an inch and battled on gamely, but Lockout sustained his run and was able to get home first. Phil's Dream out-nodded River Seven for second.

He started off just behind a horse and stayed a little wide. He was happy to stay behind the horse until the quarter pole and as soon as I asked him to go, he kicked on. It was really good."

Zito knows a thing or two about spoiling Triple Crown bids with longshots, having upset Smarty Jones (Elusive Quality) in 2004 with Birdstone (Grindstone) and Big Brown (Boundary) in 2008 with Da' Tara (Tiznow). The Hall of Famer feels his charge is more than ready to follow in those upsetters' hoofprints next week.

"Last Saturday when he worked, he just kept going," Zito said of the colt's half-mile breeze in :49.30 May 23. "Max [Correa] does a good job on him. He went pretty darn good last weekend, and this is what we wanted him to do today, just sharpen him up a little bit. He's over-ready."

The conditioner continued, "Everything is good. He's developed nice, he's held his flesh and he's held himself. He's doing everything right."

Frammento finished fourth to fellow Belmont contender Carpe Diem (Giant's Causeway) in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 4 and was 11th last time in the GI Kentucky Derby May 2 after drawing in off the also-eligible list. The flashy chestnut gains the services of Hall of Famer Mike Smith for next Saturday's "Test of a Champion."

Shuffled back after being hampered early, she took time to recover her poise but gradually entered contention down the outer in the straight. Hooking up with Wonderstruck inside the final furlong, Miss Marjorie had something extra to give in the last yards and dug in for a career-best.

"She got a bump on the first bend and got out of her rhythm, so I had to sit and suffer and she came good when I turned in," jockey Paul Hanagan said. "They went a good pace and that probably contributed to her being outpaced early on, but she's really genuine and doesn't want to be in front too soon." Connections are looking at a return to the same track and trip for the July 4 G2 Lancashire Oaks.

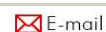

This season, the gold and blue silks of Scuderia Effeve collected the G3 Premio Parioli with Hero Look (Ire) (Lope De Vega {Ire}); the G3 Premio Regina Elena with Sound Of Freedom (Ire) (Duke Of Marmalade {Ire}); and the G2 Italian Derby with Goldstream (Ity) (Martino Alonso {Ire}). Sunday, Effeve will be represented by the unbeaten **Wordless (GB)** (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}) and **Reset In Blue (Ire)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}). Retained jockey Fabio Branca decided to stay loyal with Reset In Blue, the filly he rode in the Regina Elena, leaving the winner, Sound Of Freedom, to Cristian Demuro. Reset In Blue, who won her first three races--including the Premio Cesare Degli Occhi, a well reputed trial--ran flat to finish fourth and was reported to be in season.

Wordless could put her dam, Holy Moon (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}), in the record books as the only broodmare to foal four consecutive Classic winners. Wordless's half-sisters Cherry Collect (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}), Charity Line (Ire) (Manduro {Ger}) and Final Score (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) have won each Oaks since 2012 and have all since moved to Japan following the purchase by Katsumi and Teruya Yoshida. Wordless snatched her third win in the Premio Zanoletti Apr. 25 at San Siro. **Cont. p14**

German fillies have won the Oaks seven times since 1999. This year, three fillies will challenge the home team including **Lovelyn (Ger)** (Tiger Hill {Ire}), who scored gamely in a maiden at Koln Apr. 19, defeating the subsequent Group 2-placed Amona (Ire) (Aussie Rules).

She was very impressive at Newbury, but she may not be quite as streetwise as some of the others as she has not really been seen in a battle, so that is a bit of an unknown. It would be great to pick up a ride like this in the Oaks, which has been a lucky race for me."

Second in the G1 Australian Oaks Apr. 11, Winx was heavily favored for this contest off a decisive score in the G3 Sunshine Coast Guineas two weeks ago. Settling slightly worse than midpack and one off the fence the first time past the stands, Winx and jockey Hugh Bowman lost a few positions down the backstretch but began to roll outside rivals as the field rounded the final turn. Seven-wide and with half the field still ahead at the top of the lane Winx appeared to have a tall task ahead of her, but she employed a devastating turn of foot to sweep to the lead down the middle of the track at the 100-meter mark and win eased down and going away.

SPEED LOOKS FOR C&C CUP REPEAT

One of the most versatile horses in Hong Kong, **Blazing Speed (GB)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) looks to build on another successful season in Sunday's G1 Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup at Sha Tin Racecourse.

Upset winner of the Stewards' Cup going 1600 meters in January 2014, the former James Fanshawe trainee capped that campaign with an more surprising victory in this event 12 months ago, accounting for a field including 2-5 Designs on Rome (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) and reigning G1 Longines Hong Kong Vase hero **Dominant (Ire)** (Cacique {Ire}). Following a score in the G2 Jockey Club Cup in November, the bay dropped his next four--including a

sixth to **Harbour Master** (Mizzen Mast) and **Mr Gnocchi (Aus)** (Hard Spun)--in the Premier Plate H. Mar. 29, but bounced out of that to register a two-length tally in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. going the metric mile and a quarter Apr. 26.

"The horse is in great form and I'm looking forward to it," trainer Tony Cruz commented. "He's very well, his trial was great and he pulled up good so I'm happy," said Cruz, in reference to an impressive 1200-meter all-weather barrier, in which Blazing Speed cruised to an easy third-place finish.

Though he is weighted 20 pounds inferior to Blazing Speed in the handicap, **Helene Happy Star (Ire)** (Zamindar) has some things in his favor as he steps up in class Sunday afternoon. A good fourth to Luger (Aus) (Choisir {Aus}) in the Mar. 15 Hong Kong Derby, the 4-year-old was eighth, but beaten just three lengths, in the QE II. Pitched in at this distance for the first time in the Queen Mother Memorial Cup H. May 9, the former Barley Mow reverted to front-running tactics and proved not for catching, scoring by 3/4 of a length over yielding turf. His chances will only be enhanced with the addition of Joao Moreira at the controls.

CASTILLO CLEARED, ANOTHER IMPLICATED AT PARX

Slightly more than two weeks after jockey Angel Castillo was accused of being in possession of an illegal electrical device and was removed from his mounts at Parx Racing, stewards at the Bensalem oval have issued a ruling revoking the license of jockey Pierre Hernandez-Ortega for a similar offense.

Castillo was abruptly scratched from the remainder of his rides following the fourth race at Parx Tuesday, May 12, and was escorted off the premises after Walter Remmert, the acting executive secretary of the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission said that Castillo was in possession of the device, commonly referred to as a buzzer. One day later, Castillo's attorney Alan Pincus told the *TDN* that he and his client "categorically deny having anything to do with an electronic device" and that track officials "have gotten the wrong guy." Castillo was subsequently granted a stay of further action by the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission and had been riding regularly at Parx since. Ortega-Hernandez was implicated for his ride aboard the second-placed Calvello in the fifth race that Tuesday afternoon.

The statement from the stewards read, "Based upon the uncontroverted evidence presented at the stewards' hearing, Mr. Hernandez-Ortega is found to be in violation of the commission's regulation (regarding prohibited items). Mr. Hernandez-Ortega's possession of the device and subsequent deceptive actions to conceal the possession are equivalent to an attempt to fix the outcome of the fifth race at Parx on May 12, 2015. ... Based upon the results of its investigation and the evidence presented at the stewards hearing, the stewards hereby REVOKE all licenses presently held by Pierre Hernandez-Ortega issued by the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission."

Reached by the *TDN* Saturday, Pincus is at this point eager to have his client's reputation and image restored.

"There were previous comments attributed to Mr. Remmert and we would await his public retraction of those comments to set the record straight and repair the reputation of Mr. Castillo," Pincus commented.

Turning right and stumbling leaving the gate, Divisidero was taken back to near the rear of the field as Made in Detroit (Arch) crossed and cleared World Approval (Northern Afleet) into the clubhouse turn. "[Rafael] did a great job getting him into position once he realized the pace was pretty slow up front," winning trainer Buff Bradley remarked. "So he got him up there and then sat on him. Coming down the lane, we felt pretty good. We know [Divisidero will] run a horse down. [The Belmont Derby has] been our plan all along. So we hope we can come back and make some noise on July 4." Hernandez added, "Out of the gate, my horse stumbled real bad. I lost my left iron. In the turn he was a little bit wide. On the backside I had to make a move because he's not used to being like that, he always comes from behind. But there was no pace at all so I had to make a move and let him run a little bit and then set the pace. When turning for home, I just let him run. He knows what to do." It was the third win in four tries for the bay, who belied debut odds of 25-1 to graduate at Gulfstream Feb. 7 ahead of a troubled third behind Eh Cumpari (Elusive Quality) in the GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 7. Bet down to 8-1 from a 20-1 morning line in the GIII American Turf in his last visit to the races, Divisidero stormed down the center of the Churchill turf course to best next-out stakes winner A Lot (Tapit) by three-quarters of a length.
