**STARS COME OUT ON FOSTER NIGHT**

With Triple Crown winner American Pharoah (Pioneerof the Nile) receiving a hero's welcome while parading on the GI Stephen Foster H. undercard before a crowd of 28,968, Saturday night's main event at Churchill lived up to the billing, with John Oxley's **Noble Bird** (Birdstone) holding off **Lea** (First Samurai) in a thriller. He was a painful second in the GII Alysheba S. last time May 1. "I've been around a lot of good horses and he's been working about as good as I have seen a horse train, just week after week," assistant trainer Norman Casse said. "He's trained extremely well and he wanted to win just as bad as we did. We'd probably have to look at the older horse races at Saratoga. **SHOE FITS FOR A 'TAL' UPSET**

**Talco** (Fr) (Pivotal {GB})--a respectable second behind the highly regarded **Bal a Bali** (Brz) (Put It Back) in the GIII American S. May 9--punched his ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile with a last-to-first 13-1 upset in Santa Anita's GI Shoemaker Mile Saturday. Last term's GII Del Mar Derby hero **Midnight Storm** (Pioneerof the Nile), favored at even-money, was a half length back in second after sitting a staking trip. "When we saw the early fractions we felt pretty good, and we're happy that this win pays his fee for the Breeders' Cup [Mile at Keeneland Oct. 31]," winning owner Kosta Hronis said. "He was first or second in his last four races and he got the pace today." Jockey Rafael Bejarano added, "My horse gave me such a big kick off the turn, we were able to challenge him right away and then we outran him to the finish. The whole key to winning today was being able to stay inside around the far turn and really kicking well." **Cont. p5**

**CORONATION TIME**

So far, everything that **Queen's Jewel** (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) has done has had the hallmark of stardom attached, and Sunday's G1 Prix de Diane Longines at Chantilly is poised to provide the Wertheimer homebred with her rightful crowning moment. Always highly regarded by Freddy Head, the chestnut managed to look abundantly green but ultimately vastly superior to her peers in the G3 Prix Penelope over this trip at Saint-Cloud Apr. 14 and the 10-furlong G1 Prix Saint-Alary at Longchamp a month later. On the latter occasion, she overcame a slow start and lazy mid-race tendencies to overpower the opposition and win by an unlikely three lengths, and so her wide draw may not be such a disadvantage. Queen's Jewel's mettle will be tested more fully here, with two above-average English fillies in attendance in Jon and Julia Aisbitt's **Malabar** (GB) (Raven's Pass) and Lady Bamford's **Star of Seville** (GB) (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}). The former, who took last year's G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood, was fourth in the May 3 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket before finishing eighth in the Irish equivalent three weeks later, but was denied good fortune by being posted in 14 for Sunday's race. **Cont. p11**

The progressive Noble Bird--a maiden winner at Del Mar at the tail end of that meet last August--took a one-mile Oaklawn allowance Mar. 21 and held on to defeat 'TDN Rising Star' Top Billing (Curlin) at Keeneland Apr. 8 before just being outfinished by Protonico (Giant's Causeway) in the Alysheba.

He took plenty of pari-mutuel action into 9-2 from a morning line of 10-1 here and was away well from the four hole. Noble Bird tugged Shaun Bridgmohan into second as the longshot Paganol (Tiz Wonderful) led through lively early fractions of :23.39 and :46.81. The Mark Casse trainee claimed that one traveling strongly leaving the three-furlong pole and turned for home comfortably in front, but 2014 GI Donn H. hero Lea loomed a menace in upper stretch. Noble Bird kicked hard and put a couple of lengths on the favorite into the final furlong, then just held sway at the wire as Lea whittled the winning margin down to about a neck.

Hoppertunity, winner of the Gil Clark H. here last November, ran on late to be a non-threatening third.

Noble Bird's unraced dam produced a colt by Mineshaft in 2013; a filly by Smart Strike in 2014; and a colt by Tale of the Cat in 2015.

"He just ran in the Alysheba and ran a really big race in that, and he's just gotten better from there and he rewarded our confidence," Casse continued. "Last summer, we had him here before we went out to Del Mar and I told Dad [trainer Mark Casse] back then that I thought that he was a very talented dirt horse. Things just didn't happen that way and then he went to Oaklawn and he had to run on the dirt, obviously. I just think that's a testament to how gutsy this horse is."

Bridgmohan added, "He had been training very well and obviously he showed it tonight. He won three out of his last four races. He's getting better. He's been working like this in the morning so this performance was expected. That [Lea] is why I didn't turn my stick over; I just kind of gave him a little reminder because he was trying and giving me everything he had. He's been training very well and he's a horse that is on the improve. He just ran lights out tonight. He's been maturing and I think he's going to be a horse to watch for. I think in every race he's improved and he's not lacking any talent. He's a very talented horse."


The runner-up Lea was making his first start since a third-place finish in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 28. "He had a good trip and he ran well," trainer Bill Mott said. "We just couldn't get there. It looked like if they'd gone three more jumps we could have had him, but the race was a mile and an eighth. It wasn't a mile and an eighth and three or four jumps." Mott added that Lea would be pointed toward Saratoga's GI Whitney Aug. 8. Jockey Joel Rosario added of the runner-up, "Every time I came to that horse [Noble Bird], he just kept on going. My horse ran well and he did everything well, but every time I began to get to the winner, he would respond. For a second I thought I would get there, but every time I came to him he would just keep on going."

 of 5-1 all the way out to 13-1, Talco was dropped out  
 the back as Winning Prize (Arg) (Pure Prize) outfooted  
 Midnight Storm through  
 a half-mile in a strong  
 :46.53. Talco worked his  
 way into contention  
 inside on the second  
 turn, came out and  
 around the dueling  
 pacesetters in upper  
 stretch and outgamed  
 Midnight Storm to the  
 wire. Seek Again, winner  
 of last summer's GII  
 Fourstardave H. at  
 Saratoga, was up for third. Bal a Bali cornered a bit  
 wide into the first turn and looked slightly unbalanced  
 when getting out a bit as they turned for home. He had  
 aim if good enough, but could not match strides late  
 and finished last of the five. "After the first quarter  
 mile, we were smiling, especially since the grass looked  
 a little longer than normal," Larry Benavidez, assistant  
 to winning trainer John Sadler, said. "It was a big win.  
 We just kind of wanted them to go fast up front, and  
 we figured the one (Winning Prize) was going to go,  
 with the blinkers on. Finally the race played out like it  
 looked on paper and this horse is in top form right  
 now."

With a 19-1 upset in last November's GII Falls City H. at Churchill Downs already under her belt, Frivolous did it again at 32-1 in Saturday night's GII Fleur de Lis H. beneath the Twin Spires. Frivolous pressed the early pace of Yahilwa (Medaglia d'Oro) through fractions of :23.64 and :46.98, overtook that California raider on the far turn and gamely fended off late rallies from market leaders Sheer Drama and Tiz Windy to prevail by a little more than a length in the 'Win and You're In' event for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Fourth in last year's running behind the recently retired Molly Morgan (Ghostzapper), the Humphrey homebred was a comebacking and non-threatening sixth in an Apr. 4 Keeneland allowance, and had run her race after a half-mile and trailed in ninth in the GI La Troienne S. on Kentucky Oaks day May 1. Frivolous also has a pair of runner-up finishes in the 2013 GIII Arlington Park Oaks and 2014 GIII Arlington Matron S. on her resume, respectively.

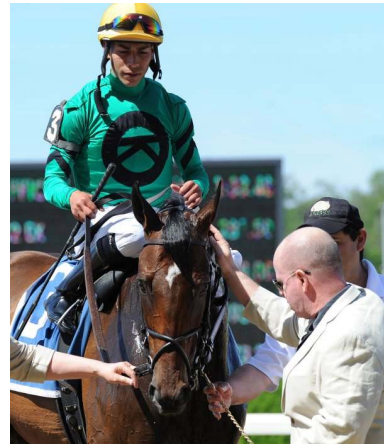

The final margin didn't do two-time champion Beholder justice. Ridden by a very confident Gary Stevens throughout, Beholder was floated wide on the first turn by longshot My Monet, but it really wasn't going to make much of a difference. Always ready to pounce in second through fractions of :23.51 and :47.04, Beholder tugged her way to the front on the far turn while Stevens remained motionless. The Hall of Famer switched his stick to his left hand as Beholder started to get in on him down the lane, but the all-out GI Santa Margarita S. winner Warren's Veneda was never going to get by, chasing the classy mare home to a measured success.

"I'm relieved and delighted," Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella said. "Warren's Veneda is a good filly and she ran at her and made a contest out of it, but I wouldn't trade mine for anybody. We'll look at the [GI] Clement Hirsch at Del Mar [Aug. 1] and the Zenyatta here, with the Breeders' Cup [Distaff at Keeneland Oct. 30] the ultimate goal. That's what we're here for." The 2012 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine and 2013 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff victress only faced the starter three times last term, including a win in the GI Zenyatta S. at Santa Anita Sept. 27. Forced to miss a title defense in the Distaff and a trip to the auction ring due to a fever, Beholder returned to action with a facile win in Santa Anita's Santa Lucia S. Apr. 10. She was scratched from the GI Vanity S. May 9 due to an illness. "It was a pretty easy race for her," Stevens said. "I rode her like she was the best mare out there, and she was. She does things so natural."

Making his first start around two turns, Island Town took advantage of a slow start from 1-2 favorite Fame and Power, set the pace and repelled a challenge from the eventual runner-up for a narrow victory here. May 16. Crying out for room on the turn, Fame and Power was finally able to work away from the fence and launched his bid three wide into the lane. He traveled up to Island Town and looked to have that one at his mercy leaving the furlong grounds, but his mid-race exertions may have come back to haunt him, as Island Town dug down at the fence for the victory. Trainer Ian Wilkes won the 2012 Matt Winn with Neck 'n Neck (Flower Alley). After slipping in 2013, Island Town's dam Humorous Gal, a four-time winner, produced a colt by Lonhro (Aus) in 2014. "He's a seriously talented horse; we always thought that," Wilkes said. "He just took a long time to come around. We don't know how good this horse is yet. I'm going to enjoy this, but the Indiana Derby is a logical spot for him."

A 7 3/4-length debut winner in front-running style Oct. 4, the Owens-trained miss suffered her only loss to date when just failing to stay after setting the pace in the 1 1/16-mile Princess Elizabeth S. to the aforementioned Brooklynsway, with **Shez a Masterpiece** (Mast Track) in second Nov. 2. Back to her winning ways with a 6 1/2-length drubbing of her foes to sign off her juvenile year in the Ontario Lassie S. going 1 1/16 miles Nov. 30, London Tower breezed a grassy five panels in 1:00 2/5 (3/23) June 5.

In addition to Gary Barber's duo of Galina Point and Shez a Masterpiece, trainer Mark Casse, who is hunting for Woodbine Oaks victory number four, saddles GIII Selene S. fourth **Season Ticket** (Lemon Drop Kid) and maiden **Tancook** (Macho Uno). Casse won last year's Oaks with 2014 Canadian Horse of the Year and champion sophomore filly Lexie Lou (Sligo Bay {Ire}). The May 31 restricted Lady Angela S. winner Galina Point is probably the seven-time Sovereign Award winner's best chance. "All our horses are doing well," said Casse. "We think we have a chance, we just need some luck. Last year, Lexie Lou and Wild Catomine [his Oaks one-two finishers] both had come off good races. I just know, after 35 years, anything's possible. It's unfortunate [that all of my horses] come from off the pace. And the horse to beat [London Tower] has got speed, but it is a mile and an eighth, so that helps."

"That's the draw we've been given, so we've just got to get on with it and be as positive as we can," trainer Mick Channon commented. "The filly is in great form and I just hope nothing else goes wrong. She's been a bit unlucky up to now. She ran well [in the Guineas], but then got knocked at the elbow in Ireland, so I'm sure she'll come right one day." Star of Seville was unable to back up her win in York's G3 Musidora S. in the G1 Epsom Oaks nine days ago, finishing ninth after leading and being cannoned into the inside the last quarter mile.

Successful three times since 2009, Jean-Claude Rouget is represented by a duo this time, including Gerard Augustin-Normand, Charley Lauffer and Elisabeth Vidal's unbeaten **Mojo Risin (Ire)** (Lope de Vega {Ire}). While she has avoided the Parisian trials, the bay showed more than a dash of quality when taking the Listed Prix Caravelle over this trip at Toulouse last time Apr. 25, and may have the edge over stable companion **Stay the Night (Arch)**. Joseph Allen's homebred was a latest third behind **Little Nightingale (Fr)** (Muhtathir {GB}) and the subsequently disappointing Epsom Oaks runner Al Naamah (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in a blanket finish to the G3 Prix Cleopatre over this distance at Saint-Cloud May 13. Little Nightingale, who bids to provide the Wildensteins with a first Diane victory since 2002, remains open to a large amount of improvement along with Henri Devin's unbeaten Chantilly conditions scorer **Physiocrate (Fr)** (Doctor Dino {Fr}) and Stall Nizza's May 24 G2 Diana-Trial winner **Nightflower (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}). Bringing further European flavor is Scuderia Effevi's **Sound of Freedom (Ire)** (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}), the four-length winner of the G3 Premio Regina Elena over a mile at the Capannelle Apr. 26 who then returned there to beat all the colts, bar stable companion Goldstream (Ity) (Martino Alonso {Ire}) in the G2 Derby Italiano over 11 furlongs May 17.

The Michael Owen and Andrew Black colorbearer was third in last year's Gold Cup and earned a belated first Group 1 win in the G1 Irish St Leger in September. He took the G2 Dubai Gold Cup on seasonal debut Mar. 28, and was runner-up in the G2 Yorkshire Cup upon returning to Britain May 15.

## IT TAKES ONE TO KNOW ONE

On the perhaps fittingly dark and wet morning of Oct. 19, 2012, Frankel made his final appearance on Newmarket Heath. One steady canter up Warren Hill in company, as ever, with his brother Bullet Train was followed by a walk back through the woods at the top for home. Before he reached Warren Place, where he had been stabled throughout three gloriously unforgettable seasons, he was met by Sir Henry Cecil, who saw him safely across the Moulton Road. The trainer's giant hand clapped his star pupil on the neck

as he crossed, as if to say, "My work is done, it's all up to you now."

A little over 24 hours later, Frankel completed his 14th straight victory and bade farewell to his adoring fans in a blaze of publicity on Ascot's Champions Day. Make that Champion's Day, for there was only one that day.

The huddle of people that had gathered on Warren Hill the previous morning to see that last easy stretch had already said goodbye, with raindrops conveniently

masking tear-strewn cheeks. An important chapter in Newmarket's rich racing history had ended, and we turned for home knowing that in after days the Heath would feel a little emptier without that singular daily presence of greatness.

Of course, long before Frankel came along, his trainer had made Newmarket Heath his own. Plenty of other good trainers have been based in the Suffolk town before, during and after his tenure, but nobody has seemed quite as at home on its swathes of springy turf as Henry Richard Amherst Cecil, whose initials are still borne on the exercise sheets of horses from Warren Place two years after his passing.

It seemed somehow appropriate that the trainer of 25 British Classic winners occupied the sole yard at the top of Warren Hill, keeping Cecil at one lofty remove from his colleagues in stables scattered beneath him, across the town. Not that he treated anyone as if they were beneath him, despite his aristocratic origins and his undisputed place at racing's top stable across four decades. No amount of success could ever quite conquer his diffidence, ensuring that his self-deprecating post-race analyses, conducted with his head cocked to one side in trademark fashion, won him a legion of fans from all social backgrounds.

◇ ◇ ◇

Though born in Scotland and returned to its soil after his death two years ago this Thursday, he will remain one of Newmarket's favorite sons, his name--along with Frankel's--one of six to be embedded in flagstones on the inaugural Walk of Fame in the High Street last year. When it comes to race meetings, however, it is at Royal Ascot that Cecil's absence is most keenly felt. He still holds the record of 75 winners at the meeting, a remarkable seven of which were recorded in 1987 alone. Fittingly, Frankel provided the final brace in the

St. James's Palace S. and Queen Anne S. of 2011 and 2012, though Lady Jane Cecil, cut from similarly modest cloth to her late husband, would doubtless argue that his record stands at 76, with the perfectly named Riposte having secured an

emotional victory in the Ribblesdale S. just nine days after Sir Henry finally succumbed to the cancer that plagued his final years.

To mark the start of this year's Royal Ascot meeting, Britain's *Channel 4* has released a documentary entitled *The Trainer and the Racehorse: The Legend of Frankel*, but it deals as much with the legend of Cecil himself as it does with the equine champion with whom his name is now indelibly entwined.

At a preview screening in London on Monday, Juddmonte's Chief Executive Douglas Erskine-Crum was at pains to point out the pressure felt within at naming a horse after another of the operation's genius trainers, Bobby Frankel, who had himself died from cancer the year after his equine namesake was foaled. The son of Galileo and Juddmonte's blue hen Kind swiftly allayed any such fears and brought his own trainer more comfort than any drugs could deliver as his illness tightened its grip.

Towards the end of the film, Cecil admits what most of us had surmised during Frankel's final season. With significant understatement he says, "I found it a bit of a strain that year, having had about 700 hours of chemotherapy, but Frankel kept me going."

Cecil, who was knighted by the Queen for services to horse racing in 2011, had already engineered a Lazarus-like return to the pomp of his glory days as a trainer following a well-documented and prolonged lean spell around the turn of the century. **Cont. p15**

**EXTENSION REQUESTED FOR SARATOGA RACE COURSE REDEVELOPMENT**

Saratoga Springs Mayor Joanne Yepsen has asked for a 30-day extension of the comment period on the environmental review of a list of proposed changes in the redevelopment of the Saratoga Race Course. The comment period on the multi-year project developed by the New York Racing Association ends Monday.

Yepsen was one of the 13 people who spoke at a public hearing held in Saratoga Springs May 28. Yepsen said Saturday that city residents have reached out to her this week, expressing concerns about some of the proposals.

On Friday, she contacted Robert Williams, executive director of the New York State Gaming Commission and chairman of the Franchise Oversight Board, which monitors NYRA, to ask for the extension. Yepsen said Williams told her he

would look into it the legality of granting an extension and get back to her.

Williams was the moderator of the public hearing at the Saratoga City Center for public comment on the document, the Draft Generic Environmental Impact Statement. NYRA did not participate.

“The binder that describes the project is about six inches thick and our Local Advisory Board hasn’t had a chance to go through it all,” Yepsen said. “I’ve been getting a lot of requests from different neighborhood associations, primarily the ones closest to the track, that they just want a little more time. I think it makes sense for the city just to have a little more time to review a project of this magnitude.”

Yepsen said she doesn’t think the additional 30 days will have a negative impact on NYRA’s project, with the 40-day Saratoga meet beginning Friday, July 24.

“They have a season coming up,” she said.

“They’re not going to be doing any construction until after racing anyway. Hopefully it just allows more local input, time to review the project and to be really careful about this huge undertaking. I’m just responding to the requests I’ve had this week.”

The original redevelopment plans were produced for NYRA by London-based Turnberry Consulting and presented Sept. 1, 2011. Nine months later, New York State took control of NYRA and an interim Re-Organization Board was put in place. Turnberry is no longer involved, but many elements of its proposal are contained in the document presented to the Franchise Oversight Board at its April meeting.

Among the proposed changes to be made to the public frontside at the nation’s oldest racetrack and sports venue:

- Moving the jockeys’ quarters to a new permanent building within the paddock, which many fear will end the Saratoga tradition of jockeys walking through the crowd before and after competing in races.
- Construction of a permanent 34,000-square foot, three-story addition to the clubhouse on the site of the “At the Rail Pavilion” dining tent. The structure, which could be used year-round, would include a restaurant, high-end hospitality venues and luxury boxes.
- Modifying the paddock to make it easier for visitors to see horses being saddled. One illustration in the document showed that all tents around the fencing being removed. In recent years, NYRA has limited some of the access to the public viewing areas by adding a hospitality tent and a tent to house the set for its television broadcasts.
- A new entrance at the corner of Lincoln Avenue and Frank Sullivan Place, an intersection of two narrow residential streets, that is about 75 yards from Siro’s Restaurant.
- The expansion of the backyard picnic area north to Union Avenue, which would eliminate over 600 parking spaces used by trainers, jockeys, handicapped customers and the public.
- Construction of a permanent two-story service building at the corner of Nelson Avenue and Wright Street.
- Reconfiguring the Wright Street clubhouse entrance, which was rebuilt and the fountain added about 25 years ago, to move it closer to the street.
- Removal of the 80-year-old press box and relocating it to the top and rear of the Turf Terrace dining area in the current clubhouse. Television cameras are placed on the roof of the clubhouse for national networks telecasts. An officer of the National Turf Writers and Broadcasters Association spoke at the public hearing and asked that plans to move the press box be abandoned.

### RICHARD 'RED' CURTIN PASSES AWAY

Ocala horseman Richard "Red" Curtin, owner of Shanbally Acres, died Friday. Curtin and his wife Cheryl established Shanbally Acres in 1984 and went on to breed multiple graded stakes winner Limehouse (Grand Slam). The couple boarded mares for Frank Calabrese and Curtin served as a sales advisor to Calabrese. Among the yearlings he broke for Calabrese was champion Dreaming of Anna (Rahy).

"He was a very, very good horseman," said OBS President Tom Ventura. "He was a no-nonsense kind of guy, but anybody who was in need, he was always there to help out. If you needed a helping hand, he'd be the first one there for that."

A native of Co. Cork, Curtin was known as a pioneer of the juvenile pinhooking movement. Among his graduates was graded stakes winner Lil's Lad (Pine Bluff).

"He was one of the original Irish guys in Ocala," said 2-year-old consignor Eddie Woods. "He was part of the original force in pinhooking horses--one of the first ones to pay any money to pinhook horses, trying to buy a better kind of horse."

Woods added, "He did things his own way. He didn't necessarily go by regular rules and regulations. Red was Red. If you didn't want to start work at 4:30 in the morning, you didn't apply for a job there. He could be the best in the world and do things for people under cover that you wouldn't expect. That's just the way Red was. If he liked you, he'd do anything for you. If he didn't like you, you were a dead man walking."

Wavertree Stables' Ciaran Dunne paid tribute to Curtin.

"The passing of Richard 'Red' Curtin leaves a void in the Ocala Thoroughbred community that will not soon be filled. One of the original 2-year-old pinhookers, Red was the stereotypical Hollywood horse trainer. Though he loved to appear gruff and abrasive, he had a heart as big as the County Cork from whence he came and his charity was as silent as it was great. My condolences to, not only his family, but our racehorse community. We just lost a good one."
