'JORDAN' SHOWS HE HAS GAME IN PEGASUS

'TDN Rising Star' Mr. Jordan (Kantharos) won a gritty battle with Tekton (Bernardini) to collect his first graded stakes success in Monmouth Park's Gill Pegasus S., a traditional prep for the GI William Hill Haskell Invitational S. Aug. 2. From the first crop of Kantharos, the gray became the first black-type winner for his sire

last season and is now the young stallion's first graded stakes winner as well. Pressing from second rather than taking up his preferred position on the front end, the 2-1 chalk, who was running without blinkers, patiently waited as Tekton carved out modest early splits of :24.06, :47.95 and 1:11.93. Drawing even with Tekton entering the far turn, Mr. Jordan drifted out several paths in the lane as he attempted to take control from that ultra-game rival, who continued to fight on from the rail. Brought back in a few paths in the final furlong with the aid of a few right-handed reminders from Paco Lopez, Mr. Jordan edged clear just in time to score a narrow victory in a close photo finish with Tekton.

"It's a graded race and it's important for the stallion, who I'm a big proponent of," winning trainer Eddie Plesa, Jr. said. "He's been off a long time and he ran real well today. He's a peculiar horse. He's the type of horse that's always feeling good and does what he likes. We'll look at the Haskell, obviously, but wait to see how he comes out of this." Lopez added, "I didn't want to go to the lead because I knew there was some other speed in the race. He was able to relax nice for me and even though he drifted out a little, he was still running hard."

An impressive debut winner sprinting at Monmouth Sept. 14, Mr. Jordan captured the state-bred Juvenile Sprint S. at Gulfstream Park West next out Nov. 8. He was victorious once again when extending to a mile for that venue's Smooth Air S. next out Nov. 29 to close out a perfect juvenile season. Second to fellow Rising Star and GI Hopeful S. winner Competitive Edge (Super Saver) in his seasonal debut in Gulfstream's Tamarac S. Mar. 27, the gray crossed the wire first in Hallandale's Tarpon S. last time Apr. 25, but was disqualified and placed second for interference in deep stretch after a steward's inquiry and jockey objection. **Chart p3**

'CHROME' TO RETURN HOME

Reigning U.S. Horse of the Year California Chrome (Lucky Pulpit) will ship from England to Chicago this month to train up to the GI Arlington Million Aug. 15. After an abscess caused him to be a late scratch from last Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, California Chrome's owners Steve Coburn and Perry Martin were briefly considering leaving the homebred in England for Sandown's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. July 4, but have decided against it and will instead send the chestnut back to America.

"California Chrome is recovering well and we hope to have a shoe back on his foot on Monday," trainer Rae Guest, who has been overseeing the dual Classic winner's Royal Ascot preparations, told *Racing Post*. "However, we have run out of time to get him ready for the Eclipse and the decision has been made to send him home."

Following a runner-up effort in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 28, California Chrome was shipped directly to Guest's Newmarket yard to prepare for Royal Ascot.

Guest continued, "Him missing Royal Ascot was a shame for the meeting, a shame for the owners and a shame for racing. It's been wonderful being associated with the horse and thanks to Art and the owners for thinking of us."

Tower of Texas collected his first graded stakes win in as many tries while trying turf for the first time in the King Edward. Away well, the crowd's second-choice bided his time near the back of the pack, skimming the rail through moderate early splits. The early leaders

moved well off the rail in the lane, leaving it wide open for Tower of Texas, who instantly surged to the lead and drew away to continue his perfect season with a third straight success. "I was pretty confident that he'd run well on the turf, but I'd never been able to work him on it," winning conditioner Roger

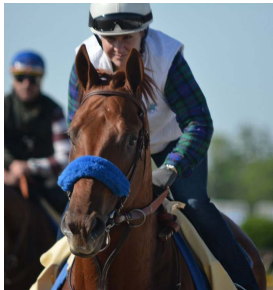
Attfield said. "I was a little concerned when he was a little closer to the pace than where we wanted him, but Eurico [Da Silva] rode him really well because he let the [speed] go on and sat patiently until the head of the lane, and then he just exploded." Earning his diploma at sixth asking on the Woodbine synthetic last May, Tower of Texas was fourth in the Marine S. just two weeks later and third to We Miss Artie (Artie Schiller) in the Plate Trial last June. The gelding was a well-beaten 14th behind Canadian Horse of the Year Lexie Lou (Sligo Bay {Ire}) in the Queen's Plate last July and was subsequently shelved for the season. The bay made his seasonal debut a winning one in a seven-panel allowance here May 10, and took his 4-year-old record to two-for-two with an optional claimer success over the main track here May 31.

'PHAROAH' JOGS & DORTMUND BREEZES

Triple Crown winner **American Pharoah** (Pioneer of the Nile) was back on the track jogging at Santa Anita Sunday morning.

"He jogged today," trainer Bob Baffert said. "The weather is still pretty hot, but he'll probably start galloping tomorrow. He'll parade here Saturday, but he won't breeze."

Baffert's other top sophomore **Dortmund** (Big Brown) breezed a half-mile in :47.40 in Arcadia Sunday. The 'TDN Rising Star' worked in company with GIII Affirmed S. winner **Gimme Da Lute** (Midnight Lute), who stopped the clock in :47.

"He went nice," Baffert said. "He went an easy half. "We're slowly keeping him fit, but he still has a ways to go. He lost a lot of weight but he's slowly getting it back."

Winner of his first six starts, including the GI Santa Anita Derby, the Kaleem Shah colorbearer was handed his first defeat when finishing third behind American Pharoah and Firing Line (Line of David) in the GI Kentucky Derby May 2. Dortmund was last seen finishing fourth in a sloppy renewal of the GI Preakness S. May 16.

STELLAR WIND POSSIBLE FOR COTILLION

Hronis Racing's GII Summertime Oaks heroine **Stellar Wind** (Curlin) seems to have exited Saturday's victory in good order and is being considered for Parx's GI Cotillion S. Sept. 19.

"I haven't really put my hands on her as yet this morning, but I saw her walking around and she looked good," trainer John Sadler said. "It looks like she came out of it well, but I don't have any thoughts on where I'm going to run yet. I'll enjoy this for a few days, but she might run at Del Mar and she might travel, too. It looks like a lot of the big 3-year-old filly races are out of town. The Cotillion is one we'd consider. I like that track."

Sadler was kept busy Sunday morning by fellow Hronis Racing colorbearer **Hard Aces** (Hard Spun), who worked six furlongs in 1:13 in Arcadia in preparation for a start in Saturday's GI Gold Cup at Santa Anita. The 5-year-old was most recently third in the GII Californian S. May 30.

"It was a good last work before the Gold Cup," Sadler said. "He went in company [with Native Ride (Candy Ride {Arg}) 1:13.60] and looked good. He's not a particularly fast work horse, but for him, it was a real nice work."

WORK ALL WEEK PREPS FOR NEXT START

Champion sprinter **Work All Week** (City Zip) fired a best-of-16 five-furlong bullet in :59.40 Sunday at the Churchill Downs Training Center in preparation for his next start in Gulfstream's GII Smile Sprint S. July 5.

The chestnut was last seen finishing second in his seasonal bow in Churchill's GIII Aristides S. May 30, and came out of that race with a bruised foot.

"The work went the way we planned," said owner/breeder Richard Papiese of Midwest Thoroughbreds. "He kind of did it easy.

We'll see how he comes out of it. His foot doesn't seem to be bothering him. He seems to be responding. The plan is to work probably next Sunday. If everything's 'a go,' he'll get on a plane."

After winning a series of listed stakes in the mid-west last term, Work All Week captured Keeneland's GIII Phoenix S. Oct. 3 and clinched the Eclipse award with a victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Nov. 1 at odds of 19-1.

'SILVER' WORKS TOWARDS VICTORY RIDE

Robert Luttrell homebred **Promise Me Silver** (Silver City) worked a half-mile in :49 at Churchill Downs Sunday in preparation for her next start in Belmont Park's GIII Victory Ride S.

July 4. It was the speedy gray's first work since suffering the first loss of her career last time when 10th in Belmont's GI Acorn S. June 6.

"She went good and she felt great," said jockey Robby Albarado, who was aboard for the filly's work, as well as her last victory in Churchill's GIII Eight Belles S. May 1.

Albarado was not aboard the Bret Calhoun pupil in the Acorn as he was already committed to GI Kentucky Oaks runner-up Shook Up (Tapit), who was eased and vanned off after cutting her leg when clipping heels with Promise Me Silver.

"The last time she ran, they both had awful trips," Albarado said. "My filly [Shook Up] and [Promise Me Silver] had a tough trip herself. She stumbled really badly and had to rush up there to the front."

Calhoun also blamed a bad trip for the filly's disappointing finish in the Acorn, saying "She broke real bad and had to rush from sixth to first. I think you can throw that race out. We broke fast way too early."

Promise Me Silver's eight straight wins prior to the one-mile Acorn came at distances of seven furlongs or less, and she cuts back to 6 1/2 furlongs for the Victory Ride.

"Going back into this upcoming race, we feel very confident," Albarado said. "I do for sure, after the work this morning it was really nice. She came back good. I think she will stretch out fine, she rates kindly. I've sat behind a couple horses with her a couple of times."

"He came out of the race absolutely fine and is such a gentleman of a horse with a super attitude", reported Cowell before adding. "He went out in the field and had a

buck and a kick, but then he just eats grass and is a very sensible horse. As things stand, I think he'll probably go straight to York. I had a chat with the owner after the race and while it is quite a long time between now and the Nunthorpe on August 21, he is so easy to train I think he would get himself straight."

CHARLTON PONDER'S NEXT TIME TEST

Royal Ascot saw some epic displays from horses and riders last week, but one horse many will look forward to seeing again is **Time Test (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}). Khalid Abdullah's homebred 3-year-old, who is out of Group 1 winner Passage Of Time (GB) (Dansili {GB}), looked a future star when annihilating his rivals in the G3 Tercentenary Cup last Thursday. Trainer Roger Charlton now has the enviable task of mapping out a summer and autumn campaign for Time Test and is considering a range of options.

"The [G1] Juddmonte International at York Aug. 19 appeals to me as being a race for him and it's a question of what races we run in prior to that," explained the Beckhampton trainer. "There is a lack of suitable races in this country for those horses, so we'll have to probably look at France or look at taking on the older horses. If we went to France, the G1 Prix Jean Prat July 12, which is a mile is a option. The alternative is the Prix Eugene Adam, which is a Group 2 and a week later at Maisons-Laffitte."

Charlton is not overly concerned about Time Test dropping back slightly in trip and added, "He showed a terrific high cruising speed and acceleration and I think he's classy enough to win at a mile. If you believe Timeform ratings, he's rated above Gleneagles (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and a pound below Golden Horn (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and I've every reason to think they're right and we should take this horse very seriously."

had an interrupted career, but Weld feels those problems are now behind the Moyglare Stud homebred and the trainer is keen to step him up in trip before he retires to the Irish National Stud at the end of the year.

Free Eagle benefitted from a masterful Pat Smullen ride last Wednesday to get the better of **The Grey Gatsby (Ire)** (Mastercraftsman {Ire}) in a thriller and Weld commented, "It was just one of those special days. He's a very talented horse. Unfortunately a lot of people never got the opportunity to see his real talent, but we're beginning to see it now."

When quizzed on future targets Weld added, "We haven't made final decisions yet, but you look at the [G1] Juddmonte International, you look at the [G1] Irish Champion Stakes and hopefully the [G1] Arc would be the final aim for him. He's a very high-class horse over a mile and a quarter, but I have every reason to believe he'll get a mile and a half."

Weld reported that **Forgotten Rules (Ire)** (Nayef {GB}) was no worse for wear after his gallant effort to finish third in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup and is eyeing a return to Group 1 company in the Irish St Leger at The Curragh in September. "He'll be back, he's a very high-class horse and the trip was probably just a bridge too far. I'd say his next race will be one of the prep races for the Irish St Leger."

South America added a second GI Breeders' Cup Turf contender after longshot Barolo punched his ticket to North America's richest turf race with an upset victory in the Grande Premio Brasil at Hipodromo Da Gavea in Rio de Janeiro Sunday. In an electrifying stretch drive and under vigorous urging from prominent jockey Waldomiro Blandi, hard-knocking Barolo prevailed over Sao Paulo classic winner Concilium to earn a trip to Keeneland for the Oct. 31 Breeders' Cup Turf. Barolo registered his most important career victory to give champion trainer Venancio Nahid his fourth win in the nation's marquee event. Fourth in two-thirds of the Rio de Janeiro Triple Crown last season, Barolo entered off an unplaced finish in the G1 Grande Premio Sao Paulo on May 3. The Grande Premio Brasil captured by U.S. import Bal A Bali (Brz) (Put It Back) last year, is the third international "Win and You're In" berth for a spot in the Turf offered by the Breeders' Cup this year. Ordak Dan (Arg) became the second qualifier when he won the G1 Gran Premio 25 de Mayo at Palermo in Buenos Aires, before that, Criterion (NZ), won the G1 Queen Elizabeth Stakes at Royal Randwick in Australia.

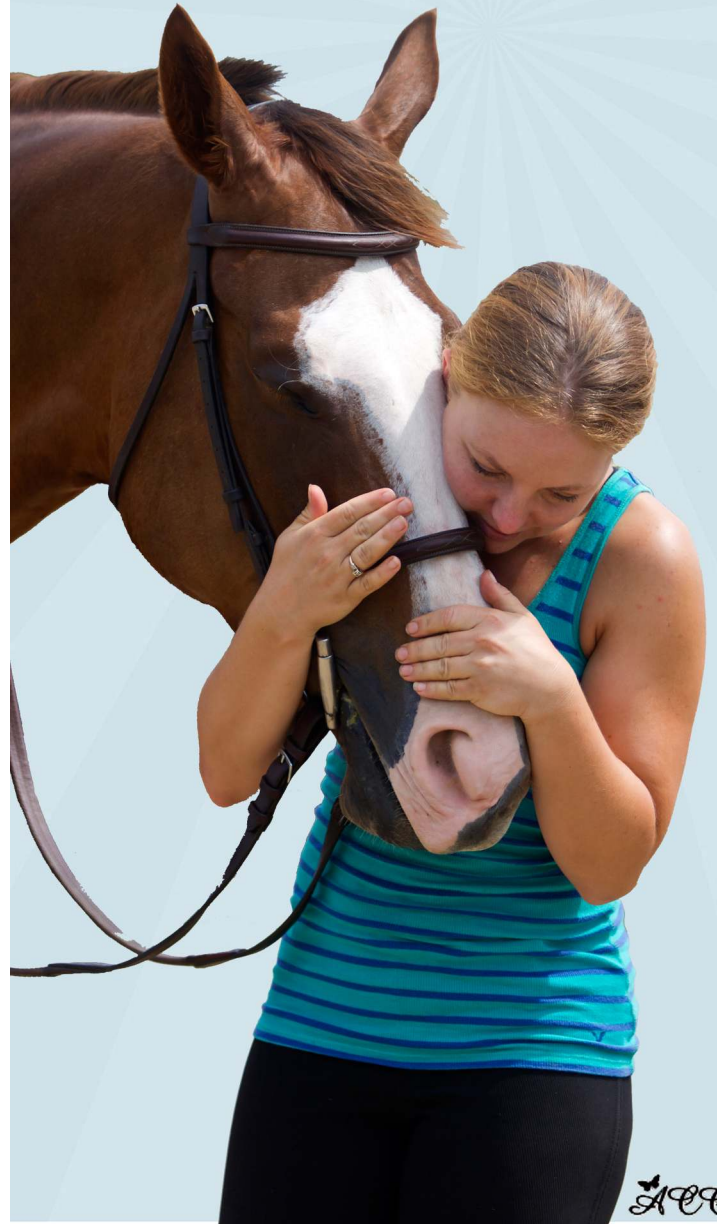

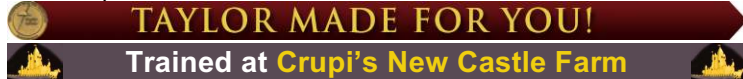

sold privately for A\$150,000, having been passed in through the ring for A\$140,000. Topping his purchases at A\$100,000 was lot [60](#), by Not A Single Doubt (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) and a granddaughter of the legendary Makybe Diva (GB) (Desert King {Ire}). Inglis Victorian Director Peter Heagney was quite pleased with the days takings and commented, "The innovative structure of this year's sale with a Platinum session and a General session has already delivered exceptional results, and we are extremely pleased to see today's average increase by nearly 60% on the 2014 average. Pinhookers were extremely active as were investors looking to buy weanlings to retain to race."
