last-to-first to post an impressive 3 1/4-length victory in the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont Park Saturday. The chestnut, owned in partnership by Brereton C. Jones and Timothy Thornton and trained by Tom Proctor, trailed the field early behind

scorching early fractions of :22.66 and :45.50. With Drayden Van Dyke in town for the ride, the 5-1 chance picked up the chase approaching the far turn. Spun six wide turning for home, she stormed down the center of the course to gain command in midstretch and powered home to win for fun. Favored **Wonder Gal** (Tiz Wonderful) won the photo from **Chide** (Blame) for second. "It was a perfect trip," Van Dyke said. "I know they were going fast up front and I knew this long stretch should really help her out, she makes that nice little last run and I knew it'd work out just perfect for her." **Cont. p3**

THE GOLDEN TOUCH

Hronis Racing continued its hot hand with its private purchases in Southern California with a heart-stopping victory courtesy of **Hard Aces** (Hard Spun) in the GI Gold Cup at Santa Anita Saturday. The 5-year-old

raced well off the pace beneath Victor Espinoza in 10th as **Big Cazanova** (Arg) (Giant's Causeway) set swift early fractions of :23.37 and :45.90. Asked to pick up the chase on the far turn, the 7-1 chance took the inside route and hit the front in midstretch. Hard Aces

appeared home free inside the final sixteenth, but had to hold off one late surge from **Hoppertunity** (Any Given Saturday) to prevail by a game nose. The Gold Cup is a 'Win and You're In' event for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. The Hronis brothers and trainer John Sadler have also recently teamed up for victories in the June 13 GI Shoemaker Mile with Talco (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}); and Stellar Wind (Curlin) in the June 20 GII Summer Oaks S. "We didn't leave the gate very well and just got really far behind, a little too far behind, I thought," Kosta Hronis said. "But we had good splits, which he needs, and it all worked out. John's done a great job with him." **Cont. p4**

Second only to Golden Horn (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the G1 Epsom Derby June 6, **Jack Hobbs** (GB) (Halling) proved that form to be by far the strongest in Europe when inflicting a heavy defeat on the home contingent and upholding the form of the blue riband with

Storm the Stars (Sea the Stars {Ire}) in Saturday's 150th renewal of the G1 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby at The Curragh. Always traveling with prowess under William Buick, the 10-11 favorite was going almost too well in Godolphin's royal blue in early stretch as the Epsom third Storm the Stars had everything else in trouble. When the button was pushed with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, the dark bay duly opened up to score by five lengths with **Giovanni Canaletto** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) faring best of the domestic runners a full 5 1/2 lengths away in third. "He's a great horse and he was even better than at Epsom," his rider said. "He's improving all the time and he's been handled brilliantly by John [Gosden]. He's a late-maturing horse who is really coming to himself now and it went pretty smoothly. Races have come thick and fast for him and he's had to learn how to run fast quickly. He's got better with every run; he's a horse with a great turn of foot. He's a quick horse that stays. It means so much to Sheikh Mohammed and all of us in the team who work so hard." **Cont. p12**

Include Betty, a maiden winner at Tampa at fourth asking Jan. 31, followed up with a narrow come-from-behind win at 18-1 in that track's Suncoast S. Jan. 31. Fifth in the grassy Gill Florida Oaks Mar. 7, she survived a stewards' inquiry in a roughly run renewal of the Gill Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Apr. 4, then never got a serious chance to run when eighth in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1. Include Betty ran out of real estate in the Baltimore equivalent last time. Van Dyke has been aboard Include Betty in her two most recent starts. "I don't think she'll have any problems stretching out further, Tom [Proctor] and I were saying she's a filly that really doesn't like to be hit a whole lot so it's more just getting along with her and keeping her happy," he said.

Wonder Gal, tabbed as a 'TDN Rising Star' after airing in her debut in Belmont's Lynbrook S. last July, earned her fourth Grade I placing in the Mother Goose.

Hard Aces made the first 19 starts of his career for his breeder Dreamchaser Thoroughbreds and trainer Larry Jones. Second in last December's Tenacious S. at Fair Grounds, he was purchased privately after posting a breakthrough victory, good for a career-high 104 Beyer Speed Figure, in the Louisiana H. at Fair Grounds Jan. 17. A respectable fourth behind Shared Belief (Candy Ride {Arg}) while making his debut for these connections in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 7, he failed to fire when sixth in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 11. Hard Aces entered off a good third behind Catch a Flight in the GII Californian S. at Santa Anita May 30.

Espinoza has been aboard Hard Aces in all four of his attempts for Sadler. "I think by the half mile pole, I was committed," Espinoza said. "I already lost ground at the start from being bumped a little by Batti Man; he took me out of the race a little. I decided not to encourage him early and save ground. I thought my best shot was to save ground and get through on the inside and it worked out well. He's improving. Every race, he's getting better and better. When he was back east he wasn't quite there but in his last race he ran good and today he ran great."

"We got a good trip," Sadler added. "We were hoping the pace would be there; we saw :45 and change, it looked like there was a lot of speed, but it's got to come together.

Victor did a beautiful job with him. He's ridden him a few times and he's not an easy horse to ride. He's a very difficult horse to ride, so Victor's gone forward with him for two or three races. He was a good fourth in the Big 'Cap, then he came back with a good third here and put it all together in the big one today."

Sadler continued, "We thought the last race was key. He really stepped forward with a strong race right at the end of a mile and eighth and he got some more pace today. The [GI] Pacific Classic [will be next at Del Mar Aug. 22]. He'll stay home and run right in our own back yard at Del Mar."

Hard Aces's dam All in With Aces (Quiet American), a winner of three of 23 career starts, produced colts by Proud Citizen in 2012-13; a filly by Divine Park in 2014; and a colt by Creative Cause in 2015.

The progressive Masochistic--a game last-out winner of the GII Kona Gold S. here Apr. 11--unleashed a new dimension while registering a career high in ultra-impressive fashion. A three-time winner and runner-up in the Los Alamitos Mile S. Sept. 6 from his first six career starts while under the care of trainer A.C. Avila, the speedy gelding was transferred to Ron Ellis after Jay Em Ess Stable purchased a partial interest following his sharp 6 1/2-panel allowance score in his seasonal debut at Santa Anita Feb. 28. He was backed accordingly to reel off his third straight decision here after firing a six-furlong bullet in 1:10 4/5 in Arcadia June 19. Away in good order, Masochistic settled kindly beneath Tyler Baze to track San Onofre (Surf Cat) from the outside through a quarter-mile in :22.85 and moved to challenge for the lead through a half in :45.16. Kept under confident handling turning for home, Masochistic spurted clear down the lane and wasn't for catching en route to a dominating performance.

“It’s awesome [how he’s progressed],” trainer Ron Ellis said. “That’s why we took the two and a half months [off from Feb. 28 to Apr. 11]. Departing, third in last year's GI Stephen Foster H., was a narrowly beaten runner-up in the GII Fayette S. at Keeneland before ending 2014 with a seventh-place effort in the Nov. 28 GI Clark H. He resurfaced in 2015 to finish third in his turf debut going 1 1/16 miles over the Churchill lawn in the May 30 Opening Verse S. Outfooted in the early going, the bay gelding was content to settle off the pace near the back of the pack around the first turn, but inched closer down the backstretch. He snuck through a narrow opening along the hedge into the homestretch, was briefly squeezed back and soundly brushed the hedge, but battled back bravely and was all out to hold on. "Miguel [Mena] did a great job riding him right up the hedge," confirmed Claiborne Farm's Walker Hancock. "He might have even brushed it, I don't know. It was very exciting though. I'm just glad he finally put it together and could get back in the winner's circle." Departing's victory gave historic Claiborne its 33rd Churchill stakes victory, tying Calumet Farm for the all-time record by an owner. "It means a lot to all the farm employees and everyone that's put in so much work over the years," Hancock said of the record. "It's definitely a special accomplishment. ... I've only been around for a few of these, but hopefully I'm around for many more to come." As for what is next for Departing in the wake of his first turf victory, Hancock said, "I'll talk to [trainer] Al [Stall Jr.]. Maybe the [Aug. 15 GII] Fourstardave or [Sept. 7 GII] Bernard Baruch...something like that. This opens up a whole other set of races for him. Maybe we can even target the GI Breeders' Cup Turf or something at Keeneland. We'll have to figure it out, but it opens a whole new avenue for us, which is very exciting."

Winning rider Joe Talamo added, "We had a great trip. She settled good off Birdlover and ran a real good race today. I thought the fractions were perfect. We went slow enough that it helped me and Mike [Smith, aboard Birdlover]. I'm glad we drew outside of Birdlover; we were able to track her and it worked out from there." Off the board only once in 17 trips to the post now, Fanticola opened 2015 with a front-running victory in the Jan. 17 Megahertz S. Third behind Birdlover in the Feb. 8 Wishing Well S., she lost by a nose to Queen of the Sand in the Santa Barbara and was a neck second behind Hard Not to Like (Hard Spun) in the Gamely last time out. Breeder Hedgestone Management purchased Fanticola's stakes-placed dam Catalina Cat, for \$13,000 at the 2007 Keeneland January sale.

Tabled as the slight favorite, the filly assumed command soon after the start, dictated terms through a half-mile in :48.06 and felt pressure from a duo of rivals turning for home. Sarah Sis reestablished command in midstretch and was fully extended to hold off a late rush from Pangburn by the narrowest of margins.

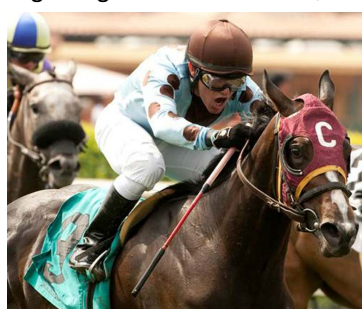

He’s Comin in Hot, third behind subsequent Tremont S. winner Cocked and Loaded (Colonel John) in his Apr. 9 debut at Keeneland, was second at Churchill May 8, finishing ahead of Acapulco (Scat Daddy), who was third that day, but who has since won the G2 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot. Winning trainer Bret Calhoun added, “He broke very sharp, just like he did last time. He got his feet out under him very well in the first few jumps and was able to clear and not

take early pressure. That was my main concern with the one hole. But I thought he was the kind of horse that could overcome it, but you’ve got to have gate speed. He got a comfortable lead.” As for what is next, Calhoun said, “We’ll take a look at the [July 25 GIII] Sanford next or race at Prairie Meadows on the 18th of July [in the Prairie Gold Juvenile].” He’s Comin in Hot is the first foal out of stakes winner Shocktime, who was trained by Calhoun on behalf of owner/breeders Wayne Sanders and Larry Hirsch. The 6-year-old mare produced a filly by My Golden Song in 2014 and a colt by that Valor Farm stallion in 2015.

BROWN STARS & STRIPES RUNNERS BREEZE

Trainer Chad Brown holds a strong hand for both the GI Belmont Derby and GI Belmont Oaks July 4 and all five of his contenders worked Saturday at Belmont.

Leading the quintet was the undefeated **Lady Eli** (Divine Park), the likely favorite to give Brown his second renewal of the Belmont Oaks, which he won last term with Minorette (Smart Strike). A perfect five-for-five, the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf heroine won the Wonder Again S., the local Oaks prep, last time May 31. The dark bay breezed five furlongs on the turf Saturday in 1:01.66 (7/23).

"There's always some pressure when you have an undefeated horse; you'd like to keep it going," said Brown. "She's given us every indication in the morning that she's going to continue to run her 'A' race, but as she goes on, the races are always going to get harder. I'd anticipate this being the most difficult race she's been in, but she seems like she's up for it. She continues to improve."

Also pointing for the Oaks is Brous Stable LLC, Gary Barber and Wachtel Stable's **Consumer Credit** (More Than Ready). Last seen finishing third in the GI American Oaks May 30, the GIII Sweetest Chant S. victress also worked five panels on the turf in 1:02.55 (20/23).

"Consumer Credit breezed well," Brown commented. "She showed in her last race that she has the ability to stretch out to a mile and a quarter. She's coming into the race in good form."

Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence's **Strict Compliance** (Into Mischief) completes Brown's Oaks trio. The Penn Oaks winner equaled Lady Eli's time of 1:01.66 for five panels on the sod.

"Strict Compliance is lightly raced," the conditioner commented. "She's in good form, a little bit of a later developing filly than the other two, but I'm confident she can handle the distance. It's going to be a big class test for her, but she can get the mile and a quarter and it's a big purse. She deserves a shot."

Brown launches a two-pronged attack on the Belmont Derby with Klaravich and Lawrence's **Takeover Target** (Harlan's Holiday) and **Startup Nation** (Temple City).

The pair breezed together, covering five furlongs of turf in 1:03.24 (22/23). Takeover Target won his first two outings before finishing second last time behind fellow Belmont Derby contender Divisidero (Kitten's Joy) in the Pennine Ridge S., the May 30 prep for the Derby. Winner of last term's GII With Anticipation S., Startup Nation was third last time in the Pennine Ridge.

"Takeover Target and Startup Nation breezed together as they have been all along," said Brown. "It was more of the same from them, a steady, easy work. We didn't want to do too much with them today and they went perfect. I believe they both will have no problem with a mile and a quarter, as well."

Six months to the day after he had been introduced in a Wolverhampton maiden, Jack Hobbs was making himself a household name in Kildare and were it not for his stable companion Golden Horn would be an unbeaten and unchallenged dual Derby winner. Allowed the chance to fully exploit his ridiculously lenient handicap mark over 10 furlongs at Sandown Apr. 24, he defied even the most optimistic expectations there by surging to a 12-length score over rivals who have since shown smart form in similar races. In the May 14 G2 Dante S. at York he was no match for Golden Horn, and John Gosden was wondering if his physique meant that he was being asked too much too soon, but he continued to thrive prior to the Derby and was sent there to re-oppose the Oppenheimer colt. Traveling arguably better than his barnmate coming down Tattenham Hill, he was again swamped late on, but finished clear of the remainder in a show of domination from the Gosden stable.

Despite the ground coming up quick at this meeting, which has often been plagued by unfavorable weather in recent times, and his conditioner's continuing misgivings that he was asking too much of such an imposing and unfurnished individual, Jack Hobbs arrived at The Curragh full of bounce and showed that zeal in the early stages. Held on to by William Buick in third as Storm the Stars and Giovanni Canaletto provided the tow, he was sent between that pair turning for home and it was there that the Curragh faithful witnessed the visible spark that lights his fire. Buick was keen to hold back for a while with Storm the Stars covered and the rest struggling in behind and, when the question came inside the last quarter mile, the Godolphin flagbearer was quick to reply. For Gosden, the current campaign keeps getting better, as his star colts set the bar too high for their contemporaries. "It was genuine good-to-firm ground and it's nice to see the form from Epsom working out so solidly," he said. "He traveled really well and William just waited after he came at the head of the straight, and I loved the way he finished off his race. The second horse has run a blinder and he was third at Epsom." Gosden confirmed Jack Hobbs would now enjoy a break. "We'll put him away now and go for the G2 Prix Niel [at Longchamp Sept. 13] and then on to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 4]," the conditioner said. "He needs a holiday. He's a big, rangy horse and he just needs some time to fill out." **Cont. p13**

After his first success in this with King of Kings (Ire) in 1997, Aidan O'Brien captured all but two of the next 12 renewals, but had been without a winner since 2009 as he loomed near Dr Vincent O'Brien's record of 14.

Step forward the underestimated Painted Cliffs, who was fitted with blinkers after running eighth on debut in the course-and-distance maiden won by stable companion and subsequent G2 Coventry S. runner-up Air Force Blue (War Front) May 24. Off the mark in a Leopardstown maiden again at this trip June 18, the bay stepped up markedly to register an emphatic first group-race success for his first-season sire and add further weight to the opinion of the current crop of Ballydoyle juveniles. Tracking the free-running leader Log Out Island in second under Ryan Moore, he was sent ahead with a quarter mile remaining and stretched clear as the favorite Rockaway Valley made only labored progress past the tiring long-time leader. "We liked him before he ever ran, but he disappointed the first day and Joseph said he was very idle and babyish," his trainer said. "We put the blinkers on him at Leopardstown to help him concentrate and I wasn't sure if it was just a bad race or that the blinkers worked. Ryan said he's a very nice horse. He likes him. Maybe we could leave the blinkers off him in future." Painted Cliffs's dam is a half-sister to Excellent Art (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), who won the G1 St. James's Palace S. in 2007 in the same colors.

Campaigned by Ed McMahon at two and three, Aeolus quickly showed above-average ability and followed an impressive York nursery success with a second to Night of Thunder (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the Listed Doncaster S. in October 2013. After an authoritative first black-type score in Haydock's Listed Sandy Lane S. over this trip last May, the chestnut had only been seen three more times that term, with a fourth in Deauville's G3 Prix de Meautry on testing ground his finest effort in August. Switched to Ed Walker's yard for his 4-year-old campaign, he started inauspiciously with a tame fourth in the Listed Spring Trophy over seven furlongs back at Haydock May 9, but regained his old verve here on the quickest surface he had encountered for over a year. Anchored in last early, Aeolus was always comfortably in touch traveling strongly and, when delivered with a sustained run towards the stand's side, gained a slight lead a furlong out and held the 3-year-old Mattmu and last year's winner, Danzeno, in a three-way go. "First time out for us, he really disappointed at Haydock but he's been a different horse since and has completely woken up and switched on," Walker said. "He's been training really well, but we haven't been able to run because of the ground. We just about got away with the ground today and we were worried it was going to be too quick. He needed every yard of that trip and he's so ground-dependant, so we have no major plans and we'll take our chances when they come."

Admirably consistent in pattern-race company without being able to break through at the peak level, Odeliz was racing for the 13th consecutive time in group company, having made the first three on seven occasions. Second to Just the Judge (Ire) (Lawman {Fr}) in the GI E. P. Head-Maarek is confident that she can show her true colors here. "She's fine, she is in great form and I think she has improved quite a lot since her last race," she commented. "She has been going very well at home. I think this race is the normal progression for her and she looks good physically. The ground might be a little firm,

but normally they water the track well at Saint-Cloud and I don't think we can have any excuses."

Greeting her in this affair are two of France's higher-profile characters in **Dolniya (Fr)** (Azamour {Ire}) and **Flintshire (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who have been interlocked in battle on three occasions so far this term with the former ahead each time. First and second, respectively, in a Mar. 3 Chantilly conditions event and the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan Mar. 28, they were second and third in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom June 6 and it is hard to see how Flintshire can reverse form here. His Highness The Aga Khan's Dolniya was the subject of an upbeat bulletin from racing manager Georges Rimaud, who said, "She is in good form, everything is well, but there is the favorite in the race and she will be hard to beat. It's a good race and we've got to give it a go."

If Flintshire fails to fire for Andre Fabre, it could be that the yard's May 31 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly winner **Manatee (GB)** (Monsun {Ger}) steps up to the plate as a still unexposed type. Prior to that latest career-best, Godolphin's 4-year-old had finished fourth under a seven-pound penalty in Longchamp's G3 Prix d'Hedouville over this trip May 6 and faces that race's winner **Meleagros (Ire)** (King's Best) on level terms here.

PRETTY PICTURE

Denied the coveted 1000 Guineas-Oaks double by Qualify (Ire) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) as her stamina ebbed in the final yards at Epsom last time June 5, Michael Tabor's **Legatissimo (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) drops back to what looks an ideal trip of 10 furlongs on Sunday for The Curragh's G1 Sea the Stars Pretty Polly S. Having come a long way in a short space of time at three, the bay--who followed a win in the Listed Victor McCalmont Memorial S. over an extended nine furlongs at Gowran Park Apr. 26 with a commanding score in the Newmarket mile Classic a week later--was only beaten a short head in the Oaks and meets some older rivals on highly favorable weight-for-age terms here.



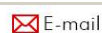

"She seems well at home, so we'll just have to wait and see what happens," trainer David Wachman commented. "She's won over seven furlongs and a mile and was touched off in the Oaks over a mile and a half, so she's obviously pretty adaptable trip-wise. I don't think the ground should be an issue. She'd go on most ground and it should be goodish this weekend, which will be fine."

Also among the sophomore challenge is Godolphin's **Pleascach (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}), who was re-routed from an Irish Derby tilt after her surprise defeat in last Thursday's G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot. Second to the upwardly mobile Curvy (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in that 12-furlong contest, Jim Bolger's homebred may be better suited to this distance, having shown enough pace to win the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas here May 24.

Of the older brigade, the Elite Racing Club's G1 Prix Jean Romanet scorer **Ribbons (GB)** (Manduro {Ger}) and Qatar Racing's **Secret Gesture (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) offer a high standard to aim at and they renew rivalry from York's G2 Middleton S. May 14. Secret Gesture was on top on that occasion with 1 3/4 lengths separating them, but Ribbons has a three-pound pull here. Khalid Abdullah's unbeaten **Brooch** (Empire Maker) is another fascinating contender tackling the Classic generation after wins at listed, Group 3 and Group 2 level. The latest came in the Lanwades Stud S. on good-to-yielding ground over a mile here May 23 and this rise in trip looks set to help her chances.

"She's done very well and is a very consistent mare," jockey Pat Smullen said. "She's come up steadily through the ranks. She's only had four runs, which is typical of the boss, taking her along nice and steadily. The step up to a mile and a quarter will suit but she'd want a little ease in the ground. We think a lot of her and she's only filling her frame now."

HUGHES COULD START TRAINING THIS YEAR

Three-time champion jockey Richard Hughes, who earlier this year announced plans to retire from riding at the end of the season and begin training next year, told *Racing Post* he could in fact start training later this year, pending approval by the British Horseracing Authority. Hughes said he still plans to ride through the end of the year and seek a fourth riding title, but he

said when he gets his training license, his new career will come first.

"I still want to ride for the remainder of the season and still want to be champion jockey for the fourth time; that has not changed," Hughes told *Racing Post*.

"However, whereas at the start of this year retaining the title meant everything to me, that is no longer the case. I cannot allow my training career to be jeopardized by my championship ambitions. If I can be champion again that would be great, but if the riding looks like hurting the training I will have to knock the title on the head."

Hughes currently sits third in the jockeys' standings behind Ryan Moore and Silvestre de Sousa.

Also ruled out of the Arc due to injury is Japan's Epiphaneia (Jpn) (Symboli Kris S), winner of last year's Japan Cup and last of nine in the G1 Dubai World Cup when last seen Mar. 28. Epiphaneia has injured a suspensory ligament with no timeline given on his return.

Quiz Kid, who was fourth in the May 25 G1 Gran Premio 25 de Mayo, is owned by Stud Dark Horse and was bred by Haras Santa Maria de Araras, which had an unforgettable day, winning three of the seven races on the card. Feel the Race (Arg) (Orpen), winner of the G1 Sprint and Seresta (Arg) (Jump Start), who conquered the G1 Juvenile Fillies, were also born at the Bozano family's farm.

Dual champion Kalithea (Arg) (Exchange Rate) was another of the stars, taking the G1 Distaff. She is a homebred of Alessandro Misserochi's Haras Santa Ines, the same farm which raised U.S. Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg) (Candy Stripes). Cont. p18

Popular TVG analyst and former trainer Simon Bray was recently diagnosed with multiple myeloma, a rare form of cancer.

"A month ago I was in the healthiest and best condition of my life, so it was surprising when I broke a vertebra in my back after one of my routine workouts," Bray said in a statement released Saturday through TVG. "It was a rare fracture. My doctor therefore ordered a battery of tests and scans. Unfortunately, the results of those tests turned my life upside down in an instant.

"I have multiple myeloma, a rare form of blood cancer, and while not curable, it is treatable. Obviously this has been very hard to come to terms with, but my primary focus will now be fighting this disease. I am extremely lucky to have a very strong and supportive family including my wife, my young son and a baby daughter due in one month.

"With the help of doctors at the City of Hope Hospital, I will be getting some of the best care in the country.

"I appreciate the overwhelming support from TVG and look forward to returning to the job I love so very much. Thanks for your support."

NYRA Endorses NYSGC Amendments:

The New York Racing Association has endorsed two New York State Gaming Commission proposals to provide enhanced wagering opportunities for bettors: decoupling entries in stakes races of \$50,000 or more, and adding superfecta wagering to the betting menu of races with coupled entries.

According to a statement from NYRA, the proposed amendments are designed to boost handle by making races more palatable to the betting public. Currently, entries are only decoupled in races worth \$1 million or more. The new rule will encompass all stakes races run on the NYRA circuit.

"The New York Racing Association fully supports decoupling entries in stakes races as it will increase field size, wagering opportunities and wagering revenue," said NYRA President and CEO Christopher K. Kay. "Given additional betting interests and corresponding added handle, significant economic benefits will flow to horsemen, the New York Thoroughbred Breeders and Development Fund, the State of New York through taxes and regulatory fees, and NYRA."

The superfecta amendment is expected to have an even greater impact on handle, according to Kay, and is modeled after the Gaming Commission's existing rule regarding trifectas in races with coupled entries.

"NYRA firmly believes that the proposed rule would make superfecta wagers more competitive and attractive to all bettors," said Kay.

Final Frontier, sent off as the 15-8 favorite, broke professionally and enjoyed a perfect tow under cover in fifth throughout the early stages. Working his way to the lead with a furlong remaining, Final Frontier drew

away to register an impressive 4 1/2-length score from Aspar (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}). Final Frontier becomes the third winner for his first-season sire (by Diktat {GB}). "I thought he was a nice horse," said trainer Jessica Harrington.

"He was working well

with [Saturday's G2 Railway S. second] Rockaway Valley and I was hoping he'd come here and do that. He's entered in a few races, including the [G1] National S. at The Curragh in September], but we'll let the dust settle until later in the day and see what happens. He seemed to stay that six furlongs very well; he was pretty professional about it and when [jockey] Shane [Foley] asked him to go he did." Harrington won the National S. in 2010 with Pathfork (Distorted Humor).

Final Frontier was purchased by BBA Ireland's Patrick Cooper for €37,000 at the Goffs Sportsman sale last year, and Cooper said he had been keeping his eye on the colt due to his interest in Final Frontier's elder half-sister Lola Beaux (GB) (Equiano {Fr}), GSP-Ire. "We bought the sister the year before, and she was a winner and Group 3-placed and sold to America earlier this year," Cooper explained. "That's really why we were following this horse so closely. We waited all day to buy him and he came out late at night, and we just loved him."

Final Frontier's breeder, Vimal Khosla, stayed in for a third of the colt the day after selling a Sea The Stars (Ire) filly out of his Group 1-producing mare Green Room (Theatrical {Ire}) for €1.1 million as the second-highest price at the Orby sale.

Cooper reiterated that Final Frontier would target the National S., and would likely take in the G2 Anglesey S. in the interim. "His main aim will be the National S., and he'll probably run before that in the G2 Anglesey S. back at The Curragh in three weeks' time, unless of course somebody buys him in the meantime," Cooper said.
