TREVE ON TRACK

Building on her comeback win over 10 1/2 furlongs in the G2 Prix Corrida here May 29, Al Shaqab Racing's **Treve (Fr)** (Motivator {GB}) returned to upstage some of France's premier performers in the venue's feature G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud on Sunday without being asked a serious question. Sent off the 3-5 favorite, the bay raced keenly in customary fashion for Thierry

Jarnet tracking the pace and, after easing ahead of **Flintshire (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) with 300 meters remaining, was always holding him in the run to the line for a 1 1/4-length verdict. "She's just terrific, but we've all known that for a long time," trainer Criquette Head-Maarek said. "She's a once-in-a-lifetime horse for a trainer and I've been

the lucky one. Thierry gave her a perfect ride, as he didn't want to give her a hard race and didn't have to. She is on holiday now and, as we have said all year, the [Oct. 4] G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe must be her target so she will run in a trial, either the G2 Prix Foy or G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 13] before trying to win it for a third time." **Cont. p5**

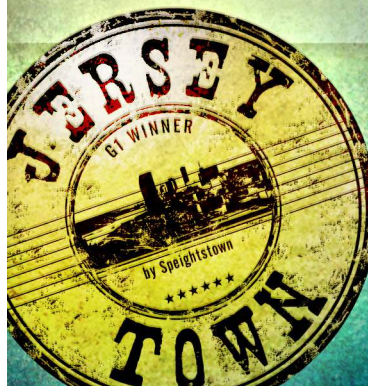
effort in an optional claimer seven days earlier. Crucero saved ground as he stalked the pace from the inside rail through the opening stages as heavily favored **Going Somewhere (Brz)** (Sulamani {Ire}) led early, floated a bit wide on the turns and had to settle in a

pressing position after **Tiz Futurity** (Tizbud) slipped up the rail to take command. Crucero angled out four wide on the final turn, duked it out with Going Somewhere in the stretch and gained control late for the win.

"Keith prepped him in a mile and a quarter race just seven days ago and I think he was a better horse today because of it," winning pilot Kent Desormeaux noted. "He was aggressive last time and he just cantered around the racetrack today and had tons left down the lane. Some horses want a mile and three quarters; he could run two miles. He should probably live in Europe where they run that distance often. America needs some more two-mile races." **Cont. p3**

As for wheeling him back on seven days rest, trainer Keith Desormeaux said, "The typical signs after a horse runs a tough race are, they come out of the feed tub, they might not have as much enthusiasm during training, they lose a little weight; typical stuff, and he didn't show any of those signs during the week."

I did the best I could to convince myself not to run back in a week. But this race stared me in the face, a mile and three-quarters, and with that long, lumbering stride he has, plus the fact that he can cover it so well, I just had to do it. Definitely [Going Somewhere, getting out on the turns] helped us out. I just told Kent in the paddock that it's all about putting the horse to sleep the first part of the race. It doesn't matter if they run the half in :46 or :51, it's how well your horse is relaxed during the first part of the race. It's of ultimate importance in a mile and three-quarter race, and that's exactly what he did; he put him to sleep."

Neil Drysdale, trainer of Going Somewhere, noted that the horse had trouble on the turns due to his equipment. "We had trouble with the bit, we had the wrong bit on him," Drysdale said. "He ran dynamite considering Mike couldn't steer him."

Crucero was claimed off of Hronis Racing and trainer John Sadler for \$40,000 after finishing fifth going a mile over the main track here in January. He graduated in his next start against \$20,000 taggers Feb. 15 and was fourth in an allowance back on the turf Mar. 8. Third in both an optional claimer Apr. 2 and wheeled back in an allowance Apr. 9, he the finished fifth stepping up to graded company in the Gil Charles Whittingham S. stretching out to 1 1/2 miles May 24. He was runner-up in a 1 1/4-mile optional claimer June 21.

The well-traveled Golden Lad added a second graded stakes triumph to his resume with a determined score over longshot Ecleto Red in the GIII Prairie Meadows Cornhusker H. Saturday night. Winner of the GIII Razorback H. at Oaklawn last March, the dark bay has raced in seven different states in fifteen career starts. Fifth in Gulfstream's GIII Hal's Hope S. over one mile Jan. 10, he returned to Oaklawn to annex the 1 1/16-mile Essex S. Feb. 14 and checked in fourth in that venue's GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 11. The Robsham Stables homebred recently powered home to a dominant win in the Mountainview H. over this same trip at Penn National May 30, and was bet down to heavy favoritism to register the repeat score. Away in good order, he established position tracking Ecleto Red through a half-mile in :48.59 and was asked for more moving in tandem with Page McKenney on the far turn. When she heads to post--barring accidents--for this year's Arc, Treve will not be anything like the 14-1 on offer in 2014, with her season going as smoothly as last term's proved tumultuous. Surprisingly beaten for the first time but not disgraced when second to Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) on her 4-year-old bow in the G1 Prix Ganay over 10 1/2 furlongs at Longchamp last April and only third in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, the bay was restored by Criquette Head-Maarek only just in time to vault to a second triumph in the autumn showcase and become only the seventh horse to win it twice. Back amongst her own sex in Saint-Cloud's G2 Prix Corrida last time, she turned in a reassuring display of dominance to best last year's G1 Prix de l'Opera heroine We Are (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) by four lengths and had ticked all the boxes leading up to this first major test of the year. **cont. p6**

Kept closer to the pace than has been the case in the past by Thierry Jarnet, Treve stalked the leading trio, which included her lone-running pacemaker and Arc runner-up Flintshire, who was at the head of the main contenders. Allowing him first run at the top of the straight, she never looked likely to do anything other than beat him hollow and it may have been the fast ground that led her to drift slightly right when sent past with 1 1/2 furlongs left. Straightened by some light

taps with the whip, she was comfortably on top at the end of a race, which served only to further advertise her considerable talent as a peaking 5-year-old. Harry Herbert, racing advisor to Al Shaqab Racing, was delighted with the outcome.

“That was really exciting. It just shows

she’s as good as ever or better than ever, because it was a very impressive performance on ground that was certainly quicker than ideal,” he said. “She was a little bit free, but Thierry got her beautifully settled and she’s just a champion. It’s fingers crossed. Everything’s gone well so far and it’s been a great performance by Criquette. We hope now the plan can be executed. We’re halfway through the plan.”

Off the mark over 11 furlongs at Lyon-Parilly May 15, Sea Calisi was finishing strongly when a neck second to Kataniya in Chantilly's G3 Prix de Royaumont at this distance at the end of that month and readily reversed that form to reward Martin Schwartz's recent purchase. We know the dam well and I'm delighted for [part-owners] Richard and Roisin [Henry]. We'll ride her a bit more patiently over a mile-and-a-half, and Qualify and Words will also run in the Irish Oaks." **cont. p8**

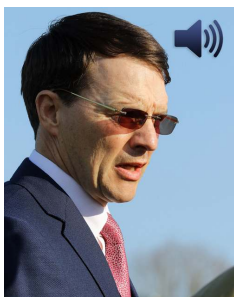

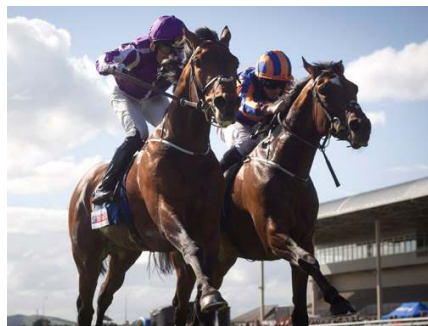

Spring May 3. Lovely Day added his third stakes win of the year when dropping back to 2000 meters to take the G3 Naruo Kinen June 6, and was dispatched the sixth choice of 16 here. Breaking well from the widest gate as two-time defending winner Gold Ship (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) played up badly one slot to his inside, blowing all chance, Lovely Day traveled a length second off an easy pace down the backstretch. Inheriting the lead when the front-running Red Davis (Jpn) (Agnes Tachyon {Jpn}) began to tire at the top of the lane, Lovely Day pulled about two lengths clear and found the wire just in time to hold off the fast-finishing Denim and Ruby and earned an automatic start in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf in this 'Win and You're In' qualifier. The talented but typically unruly Gold Ship, who spotted the field at least 15 lengths at the break after repeatedly rearing in the gate, faced an insurmountable gap and beat one home in his quest to win this for a third straight year.

"I was able to position him behind the frontrunner with ease, as the pace was slow," said winning jockey Yuga Kawada. "He responded really well. I was aware of the mare closing in and prayed that he could fend her off. I rode him for the first time [in about a year] after he claimed three graded-race titles and felt that he was growing with every race."

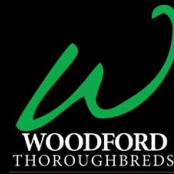

TRADE FAIR FILLY TOPS PERTH SALE

A daughter of Trade Fair (GB) topped the single-session Magic Millions Perth Winter Yearling Sale Sunday when selling to Justine Hornby for A\$27,000. The sale saw decreases across most indicators. A total of 40 were sold from 68 offered for A\$245,200 (compared to A\$523,500 for 53 sold last year), at a buyback rate of 41% (up from 7% last year). The average dropped 39% to A\$6,130; however, the median climbed 6.7 points to A\$4,000.

The 3-year-old gelding On Trend (Aus) (Nicconi {Aus}) topped the Perth Winter Thoroughbred Sale later in the day when selling to Colin Webster for A\$23,000.

"The board and management of Magic Millions are committed to the industry in Western Australia," Magic Millions Managing Director Vin Cox said. "With the proposed development of [racetrack and sales complex] Belmont we are exploring all avenues as to future selling venues, where no decisions have been made at this point. While ever Belmont is available to us we will use that facility, but we look forward to servicing and being long-term players in the Western Australian industry."
