EAST MEETS WEST IN BELMONT DERBY

Nine sophomore turfers have come from all over to contest Saturday's second running of the \$1.25-million GI Belmont Derby Invitational. California-based **Bolo** (Temple City) gets the 7-2 nod on a morning line that Eric Donovan surely mulled over a little longer than usual. A promising grass stakes winner for Carla Gaines last season, the dark bay certainly did not disgrace himself on the Triple Crown trail earlier this season. Third

behind 'TDN Rising Star' Dortmund (Big Brown) in the Mar. 7 GII San Felipe S. and Apr. 4 GI Santa Anita Derby, he checked in 12th in the GI Kentucky Derby. Put back on the turf after that, Bolo was a very easy winner of a May 29 allowance in Arcadia in which he controlled the race from start to finish. "[The Belmont Derby] was on our radar after the [Kentucky] Derby," said Gaines. "We just decided to give the Derby trail a try, obviously, because he had enough points to get in, but in the back of our heads we thought that eventually we'd go back to grass. He's doing very, very well. He had a nice workout the other day and everything looks really, really good." **Cont. p3**

'LADY' LOOKS TO REMAIN PERFECT IN OAKS

Sheep Pond Partners's **Lady Eli** (Divine Park) looks to continue to dazzle the racing community by extending her perfect record to six-for-six in Saturday's GI Belmont Oaks Invitational S. The bay's trainer, Chad Brown, won the inaugural running of this "Win and You're In" test for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf last year with Minorette (Smart Strike). A debut winner at Saratoga last August, Lady Eli followed that with a victory in Belmont's GIII Miss Grillo S. a month later and was ultra-impressive when capturing the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf in Arcadia Oct. 31. Kicking off this term with a win in Keeneland's GIII Appalachian S. Apr. 12, she unleashed a furious rally to take the Wonder Again S., the local prep for this, last time May 31, and will navigate 1 1/4 miles for the first time in this event. **Cont. p4**

GOLDEN OPPORTUNITY

With just four older horses lining up to test his mettle in what has long been known as the "first clash of the generations" in Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse at Sandown, the path is clear for **Golden Horn (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) to extend his autocracy into the wider sphere. A week after the dominating display of his stable companion Jack Hobbs (GB) (Halling) in an Irish Derby that only served to confirm the gravity of the latest renewal of Epsom's blue riband, Anthony Oppenheimer's bay has that unbeatable aura around him as he lines up in Esher's prize contest. With that barnmate 3 1/2 lengths behind in the June 6 Classic and the Irish Derby second and third Storm the Stars (Sea the Stars {Ire}) and Giovanni Canaletto (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) much further adrift, there is no denying that he sets a lofty standard, especially as he enjoys an 11-pound weight-for-age pull with this trio of 4-year-olds and one 7-year-old. Trainer John Gosden is taking nothing for granted, however. "I think the odds are a little bit unusual and I don't think they're representative of the chances the other horses have," he said. **Cont. p9**

Lightly raced **Divisidero** (Kitten's Joy) and **Takeover Target** (Harlan's Holiday), separated by a neck in the local Pennine Ridge S. May 30, book-end Bolo in the three and one holes, respectively. Gunpowder Farms's



Divisidero defeats Takeover Target

Divisidero blew up the tote with a first-out success at Gulfstream in February, and was stymied by traffic trouble before

settling for third in the GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 7. He closed like a freight train on Derby day to get up in the GII American Turf S. May 2, and bested Takeover Target last out despite mounting a rarely successful wide, premature move into a soft pace.

Takeover Target was a first-up graduate here in October, and returned a winner in an optional claimer May 7. He was 1 1/4 lengths ahead of fellow Chad Brown trainee and Klaravich/Bill Lawrence colobearer **Startup Nation** (Temple City)--last year's GII With Anticipation S. winner--in the Pennine Ridge. "They breezed together [on Saturday] like they have been all along and it was more of the same from them," Brown said, referencing a 1:03.24 (22/23) drill going five panels over the Belmont lawn with the dogs up. "It was a steady, easy work. We didn't want to do too much with them and they went perfect. I believe both of those horses should have no problem with a mile and a quarter."

Richard Santulli homebred **Force the Pass** (Speightstown) broke through in graded company last time in the lucrative GIII Penn Mile May 30. 'TDN Rising Star' **Granny's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) was third there.

Two European shippers further add to the intrigue. The Aga Khan's **Canndal (Fr)** (Medicean {GB}) was third in Longchamp's GII Prix Hocquart May 10, and might have won Compiègne's Prix Ridgway June 20 if not for interference that saw him promoted from third to second. Juddmonte homebred **Postulation** (Harlan's Holiday), no worse than third since his debut, defeated older horses--including MGSW Parish Hall (Teofilo {Ire})--in The Curragh's Silver S. June 7.

"There's always some pressure when you have an undefeated horse; you'd like to keep it going," said Brown. "She's given us every indication in the morning

that she's going to continue to run her 'A' race, but as she goes on the races are always going to get harder. I'd anticipate this being the most difficult race she's been in, but she seems like she's up for it. She continues to improve." Brown will also saddle two other runners in Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence's

Strict Compliance (Into Mischief) and Brous Stable LLC, Gary Barber and Wachtel Stable's **Consumer Credit** (More Than Ready). A neck second on debut over this course Oct. 19, Strict Compliance earned her diploma over the sod at Gulfstream Mar. 11 and won a grassy allowance at Keeneland Apr. 19. Successful in the Penn Oaks last time, the bay will have to overcome the outside post in this 14-horse affair. A third-out graduate over the local lawn Oct. 25, Consumer Credit captured Gulfstream Park West's Wait a While S. Nov. 29 and the GIII Sweetest Chant S. in Hallandale Jan. 24. Second in Tampa's GIII Florida Oaks Mar. 7, the dark bay won Aqueduct's Memories of Silver S. Apr. 23 and was third to **Spanish Queen** (Tribal Rule) last time in Santa Anita's GI American Oaks May 30. Jack Nakkashian's Spanish Queen demolished a field of overmatched fellow Cal-breds to earn her diploma first time out on the Arcadia lawn Mar. 5 and was a neck second next out there in the GIII Providencia S. a month later. Victorious in that venue's GII Honeymoon S. May 3, the Richard Baltas pupil successfully took things to the next level with a win in the American Oaks. Martin Schwartz's **Olorda (Ger)** (Lord of England {Ger}) is one of two European invaders looking to steal the show. The Michael Figge pupil graduated at third asking over the sod at Munich Apr. 19, followed suit with a win in Longchamp's G3 Prix Vanteaux S. May 3 and was third in that venue's G1 Prix Saint-Alary last time May 24. "Olorda is doing really good, she's relaxed," said the filly's exercise rider, Gerlinde Muhlrichler. "We were kind of worried since she's traveling alone for the first time and she's only ran five times, so she's still a baby, but she likes the track." **Cont. p5**

TONALIST TOO TOUGH IN SUBURBAN?

Sporting a 5-4-1-0 record at Belmont which includes wins in last year's GI Belmont S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, Shel Evans's **Tonalist** (Tapit) will take some serious beating in Saturday's GII Suburban H. The Christophe Clement pupil ended his sophomore campaign with a late-on-the-scene fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and made a successful comeback when cruising in this venue's one-mile GIII Westchester S. May 2, earning a career-top Beyer Speed Figure of 111. He settled for a good second last time to fellow 'TDN Rising Star' Honor Code (A.P. Indy) in the GI Metropolitan H. June 6, and stretches back out to what might be his optimal distance while shedding the hood. "He wore the blinkers for the Westchester and the Met Mile and he was very sharp," said Clement. "At a mile-and-a-quarter, he doesn't need to be that sharp. He's been training very well and we are excited about running him." Tri-Bone Stables's **Effinex** (Mineshaft) took his first two races this season, including Aqueduct's 10-panel GIII Excelsior S. Apr. 25 over Wednesday's GIII Dominion Day S. winner Red Rifle (Giant's Causeway). **Cont. p6**

Among the favorites for the GII Brooklyn Invitational S. here June 6, Effinex was very headstrong throughout, bolted on the second turn and had to be eased. "I'm not sure what went wrong in his last race," said trainer Jimmy Jerkens. "He's trained well since then, and we're hoping it was just an anomaly." Trainer Todd Pletcher has two chances at his first Suburban title. Repole Stable's **Coach Inge** (Big Brown) annexed the Brooklyn by a neck over last year's GI Travers S. winner V. E. Day (English Channel), while 2013 GI Preakness S. third **Mylute** (Midnight Lute) annexed an eight-panel optional claimer here May 29 in his first stat since being transferred from Tom Amoss.

himself well-armed for this affair, despite having won it "only" twice before, and will saddle two major contenders in **Blofeld** (Quality Road) and **Tommy Macho** (Macho Uno). The former annexed both the GII Futurity S. and GII Nashua S. last year, but was a disappointing third at 4-5 in Churchill's William Walker S. Apr. 25. Paul Pompa, Jr. purchased a majority interest in Tommy Macho from All American Horses LLC after the bay ran on for third in a Gulfstream maiden for Roddy Rodriguez Feb. 21. The colt earned his diploma first-time Pletcher here May 2, and scored by daylight in a competitive GI Belmont S. day allowance at a sixteenth farther than this June 6.

GETTING IN THE 'ZONE'

Multiple Grade I winner **Private Zone** (Macho Uno) faces seven formidable foes in Saturday's GIII Belmont Sprint Championship S., the finale on a blockbuster Fourth of July card. Transferred from Alfredo Velazquez to the high-percentage Jorge Navarro barn after running away with Aqueduct's GI Cigar Mile H. in November, the Good Friends Stable colorbearer finished second to 'TDN Rising Star' Honor Code (A.P. Indy) in the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 7. **Belmont Sprint cont.**

He cut back a furlong to this distance and romped in the GII Churchill Downs S. May 2, and settled for third behind an extremely impressive Honor Code in the \$1.25-million GI Metropolitan H. June 6. The bay makes the same distance move he made for the Churchill Downs, and boasts two prior wins at Belmont- in the 2013 and 2014 renewals of the GI Vosburgh Invitational S. "He's been training really well for the race," offered Navarro. "Initially, our plans were to give him a couple months off and head to the [GI] Forego [Aug. 29 at Saratoga], but he came out of the Met Mile so well we decided to run him here." Lightly raced '**Rising Star**' **The Big Beast** (Yes It's True) has also tasted victory at the highest level, having annexed last August's GI King's Bishop S. at Saratoga. Sidelined with an ankle chip for the rest of his sophomore season, the hulking bay was brought back by Tony Dutrow for an Oaklawn allowance win over subsequent MGSW Alsviid (Officer) Mar. 1, but he settled for a non-threatening fourth as the chalk in Aqueduct's GI Carter H. Apr. 4. Longshot **Green Gratto** (Here's Zealous) was second that day, and enters off a track-and-trip optional claiming win June 6. Up Hill Stable's **Clearly Now** (Horse Greeley) turned in one of the best performances of last year when he took this race by 6 1/4 lengths with a gaudy 113 Beyer Speed Figure, but the off-and-on sort has been more off than on since then, hitting the board just once in four subsequent runs. Seventh on seasonal debut in the Carter, he was a close second to **Stallwalkin' Dude** (City Place) in the local Diablo S. May 10, but faded to sixth after breaking slow and making a wide move in the GII True North S. June 5. The David Jacobson-owned and trained Stallwalkin' Dude, who raced twice in each of the months of April, May and June, was second last out in Parx's Donald Levine Memorial H. June 20.

"She was impressive today," Todd Pletcher assistant trainer Anthony Sciametta Jr. said. "She stumbled just a bit out of the gate, but seemed to overcome that just fine. It looked like she was on cruise control out there and Paco [Lopez] just steered her in the right direction." Got Lucky's dam Malka is a half-sister to GI Vosburgh S. hero Girolamo (A.P. Indy) and Supercharger (A.P. Indy), the dam of GI Kentucky Derby hero Super Saver (Maria's Mon).

Gosden continued, "I've no illusions about it. It's a mile and a quarter on a track that can favor front-runners and against older horses. I've bags of respect for those horses and nothing is a given. Any horse can get beaten, it happened to Nijinsky, Kingman in the Guineas; I'm never going to let that worry me." Despite his caution, Gosden is happy with how the homebred is coming into this challenge. "He has a good constitution--his favorite two occupations are eating and sleeping," the conditioner added. "There's no harm in that. He's quite relaxed and quite lazy sometimes in his work. He's lazy in his races sometimes as well, but he's a grand horse."

Anthony Oppenheimer is another who is not treating the race as a penalty kick and added, "I believe he is developing and I believe he's going extremely well, so I think it's going to be a fantastic race. When you get only four or five runners then it's completely tactical, but it could be one of the most exciting races you'll see all year. It's anybody's race. The betting is mad. They should all be almost the same price." **Cont. p10**

As for future targets for the star sophomore, Oppenheimer added, "The G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 25] is certainly on the agenda. We haven't got to the bottom of him, so I'll be disappointed if he doesn't run in the King George."

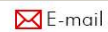

Dubai Turf at Meydan Mar. 28 followed by a below-par fourth in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 24. Back to something like his best fitted with first-time cheekpieces when a seemingly unlucky second to Free Eagle (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in Royal Ascot's G1 Prince of Wales's S. last time June 17, Frank Gillespie's colt holds Sandown specialist **Western Hymn (GB)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) on that form. Trainer Kevin Ryan's son Adam Ryan commented, "The Grey Gatsby has come out of Royal Ascot fantastically well--he was bucking and squealing the very next day. He has his own idiosyncrasies, but the course at Sandown should not be a problem. He's such a fluid mover that he's at his best on good ground; soft ground blunts his turn of foot. The quicker the better for him. It's going to be very hard work for him trying to give 11 pounds to Golden Horn, who looked very special in the Dante and even better in the Derby. To do that in any sort of race is tough enough, but to do that in a Group 1 against a horse that looks fairly special is a tough ask and it will probably take a career-best effort to beat him."

Golden Horn's stable companion Western Hymn is unbeaten over this track and trip, with his three visits yielding wins in the G3 Classic Trial last April, the G3 Gordon Richards S. Apr. 24 and G3 Brigadier Gerard S. May 28 prior to his third at the Royal meeting. He proved on the last two occasions that he handles quicker ground, but would hold stronger claims if this was staged on his favored soft ground. "He clearly likes Sandown and he's in good form," Gosden said. "He could probably have done with the thunderstorms that were forecast, but failed to materialize. He has won on good-to-firm, but easier ground might have inconvenienced others more than him."

Michael Tabor's **Cougar Mountain (Ire)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) remains relatively unexposed from Ballydoyle and made a significant jump forward when a staying-on third in the G1 Queen Anne S. over a mile at Royal Ascot last time June 16.

Thought speedy enough to contest the G1 Nunthorpe S. over five furlongs at York in August after finishing a close-up fifth in the G1 July Cup on only his second start at Newmarket a month previously, the bay is an intriguing contender upped to this trip for the first time.

next. "I don't know where Time Test will go, as no firm decisions have been made at the moment," the Beckhampton conditioner said. "The first option had been the Prix Jean Prat on Sunday week, but he is not going to run in that.

Next up is the Prix Eugene Adam [at Maisons-Laffitte], which comes later in the month and that is a possibility."

Time Test, never worse than second in five outings, was making his stakes debut in Royal Ascot's Tercentenary, which he won by an eye-catching 3 1/4 lengths.

"He is not going to all of a sudden make an appearance and if all is well, we will plan for the autumn but only time will tell us if we can do that."

PURSE INCREASES FOR HONG KONG

Purses for Hong Kong's 2015/16 racing season will rise to an all-time high, and will be up 7.5% from last season. Class 1 races will be worth HK\$2.4 million (US\$309,556), an increase of 9.1%, while Class 2 races see the greatest rise; they will be up 10% to HK\$1.65 million (US\$212,819). Class 3 races will be up 9.9%, while Class 4 and 5 races will rise by 5.3% and 4.3%, respectively.

While there will be no change to the purses for Hong Kong's International raceday, four local Group 1 contests will receive a boost: the Hong Kong Classic Mile and Hong Kong Classic Cup will each be worth HK\$10 million (US\$1.3 million), while in the speed series, the Centenary Sprint Cup and Chairman's Sprint Prize will both be worth HK\$8 million (US\$1 million). The Sprint Cup has also seen a change in distance, up to 1200 meters from 1000 meters.

Hong Kong's international and local Group 2 races will rise by 3.2% in value to HK\$4 million (US\$515,926); and local Group 3s will be worth HK\$3 million (US\$386,944), up 9.1%.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club implemented the High Achievement Bonus last year to incentivize owners to import high-quality horses, and that scheme--which has thus far paid bonuses for 28 horses--will continue next season. The HAB pays out bonuses up to HK\$1 million (US\$128,981) for horses reaching certain levels before the age of five.

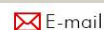
"The overall increase in prize money and incentive awards for next season upholds the Club's objective to maintain and improve the quality of Hong Kong racing," said Bill Nader, the Hong Kong Jockey Club's Executive Director of Racing. "We appreciate the increasing financial pressures that our loyal owners are experiencing when purchasing high-class horses, and continued efforts to increase prize money over the past seasons demonstrates our ongoing commitment to strike the right balance."

OVERDOSE DIES OF COLIC

Overdose (GB) (Starborough {GB}--Our Poppet {Ire}, by Warning {GB}), dubbed the 'Budapest Bullet' while winning 16 of his 19 races, has died at age 10 due to colic, according to *Racing Post*. A 2,000gns Tattersalls November yearling purchase by owner Zoltan Mikoczy, Overdose initially raced in Hungary before traveling to win group races in Germany and Italy. Overdose recorded his most important victory in the 2008 G1 Prix de l'Abbaye in France, only to lose the race in controversy. Due to a rival's starting gate failing to open, the race was void and re-run. Overdose was not made to run again, but his final time was faster than the official winning time. Overdose also came close in the 2011 G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot, finishing fourth, beaten 1 1/4 lengths. Foot ailments plagued the latter part of his career and he was retired in early 2012.

"He was slow moving out of the stalls today as the plan was to make all, but they set good fractions so it didn't matter," revealed rider James Doyle. "It was a step forward and he stuck it out well, but he didn't do a whole lot in front. He needs to step up to six [furlongs] now."

LENNOX LIKELY FOR STAR SPRINTER LIMATO

Three-year-old sprinter **Limato (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}), a last-out second in the G1 Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot, could step up a furlong for his next assignment in the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood July 28. Trainer Henry Candy revealed the Paul Jacobs colorbearer would skip next weekend's G1 July Cup.

"It will take a few weeks to pick Limato back up again as the race at Ascot took a lot out of him, so he won't be running in the July Cup," Candy said. "Having been very slowly away, he had a hard race to get back into it. We might go to Goodwood now and try him at seven furlongs in the Lennox S. There is big money in it so it is worth a try. If he is going to be slow away, that trip might help him."

Limato won his first five outings, including the G3 Pavilion S. at Ascot in April, before finishing second in the G2 Sandy Lane S. May 30 and the Commonwealth Cup.

SNAILWELL STUD FOR SALE

The Joel family's Snailwell Stud in Newmarket is for sale with an asking price of £3 million, according to *Racing Post*. The 77-acre stud has been owned by the Joel family since 1945, and has been home to the likes of Busted and Chamossaire, both accomplished sires. Snailwell has recently been used as a boarding facility and a quarantine station. The facilities include 70 boxes, a horse walker, lunging ring and seven homes.

"The family have been here since the 1940s," stud manager Nick Angus Smith told *Racing Post*. "It's sad to see that part of the stud's history wrapping up, but things move on. We had about 65 mares boarding on the stud this season, which is just about finished now, and around 12 permanent boarders. Our own mares have been dispersed at Tattersalls over the past couple of years.

George Windsor Clive of Windsor Clive International, which is handling the sale, added, "Snailwell Stud resonates with history, and is so close to Newmarket's hub. We are quoting £3 million and have a waiting list to view."
