BIG BLUE KITTEN POUNCES IN U.N.

Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Big Blue Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) earned his second GI United Nations S. victory Sunday at Monmouth Park, bounding home a 1 1/2-length winner over **Slumber (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}) and **Twilight Eclipse** (Purim). "Joe [Bravo] knows this horse and rides him best," said winning trainer Chad Brown, who finished one-two in the race, which is a Win and You're In event for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. "This horse is just so consistent. What a great runner."

Eclipse champion and defending U.N. winner **Main Sequence** (Aldebaran), making his first start since finishing seventh in the Mar. 28 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan, was never a factor and checked in seventh.

"We had the perfect trip," Rajiv Maragh said of the beaten favorite. "The pace was there and we sat just where we wanted to, but it just wasn't our day. Graham [Motion] is a great trainer and he will know what's next for him." **Cont. p2**

THIRD QUEEN'S PLATE FOR STRONACH

Stronach Stables homebred **Shaman Ghost** (Ghostzapper) came charging late to overtake favored **Danish Dynaformer** (Dynaformer) in deep stretch and win Sunday's Queen's Plate going away by 1 1/4 lengths. It marked the third Plate win for Frank Stronach, following two other homebreds, Basqueian in 1994 and Shaman Ghost's grandsire Awesome Again in 1997.

"Just as I was walking in the grass near the saddling area I looked down and saw a four-leaf clover," said Stronach. "That's usually a good sign. But I had a good feeling all day long because the horse beat every horse in the race before in better times. I think this time we got a real good horse and he was hardly breathing when he came over here [to the winner's circle]."

Trainer Brian Lynch was second in the 2008 Plate with Stronach's filly Ginger Brew and was winning his first Queen's Plate. "We'll certainly have a good night," Lynch said. "It's a prestigious race. But to win it for the Stronachs, it's great." **Cont. p10**

MERRY MEADOW SINGS IN ROONEY

Merry Meadow (Henny Hughes), off since a disappointing finish as the 1-2 favorite in the Mar. 21 GII Inside Information S., returned to action with a 1 3/4-length victory in Sunday's GII Princess Rooney S., a Win and You're In event for the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint. Favored at 7-5, Merry Meadow chased the fleet-footed **Flutterby** (Congrats) down the backstretch through a quarter in :22.19. The favorite began pressuring the pacesetter on the turn through a half in :44.23. Merry Meadow sailed to the lead with a furlong to run and pulled clear easily.

Merry Meadow's win gave jockey Javier Castellano his third straight victory on the Gulfstream card Sunday. "It was a perfect trip," Castellano said of the Princess Rooney win. "She was sharp, fresh, and a front-running horse. She wanted to race, so I let her do what she wanted today. It feels excellent to win three straight wins, and I love Gulfstream Park. It's very exciting."

Big Blue Kitten Pounces in U.N. (cont. from p1)

Big Blue Kitten tarried near the back of the pack as fellow Ramsey colorbearer and 99-1 longshot **Shining Copper** (Aragorn {Ire}) opened a clear advantage, leading by as many as eight lengths through three-quarters in 1:11.84. The field began to reel in the pacesetter on the final bend, with Big Blue Kitten rallying stoutly four wide into the homestretch. The 2013 U.N. winner bounded confidently to the lead and drew clear full of run. "Man, I keep saying it, but he's just like an old glass of wine--he keeps getting better with age," said winning rider Joe Bravo. "This year, he's just come back bigger and stronger and it looks like better than ever." **Twilight Eclipse** (Purim), who was rallying along the rail as Big Blue Kitten was taking the overland route, was forced to steady in tight quarters in upper stretch and was angled to the outside only to be just nipped by **Slumber (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}), who closed from last at the top of the lane and weaved through traffic with a powerful late rally of his own. **Shining Copper** held on gamely for fourth.

Big Blue Kitten, winner of the 2013 United Nations and GI Sword Dancer Invitational, was making his third start of the year. The 7-year-old won the May 2 Fort Marcy S. and was closing late when second behind **Slumber** in the June 6 GI Manhattan S. last time out.

“Seven-eighths isn't her best distance, especially if you take her out of her game,” trainer Mark Hennig explained of the Inside Information. “She'd rather not be the one having to chase the pace. Last time she kind of just got caught up in the battle early and Javier, to his credit, didn't beat her up.” Hennig added, “But I think Merry Meadow, when she's fresh and you run her three-quarters, she's double tough. We had talked about this race for awhile, that's why we stayed here for the Inside Information. I could give her a long break after that and send her up to my dad at Payson Park, let her freshen there, and get her back down here in a rested state.

Merryland Monroe, with Merry Meadow in utero, sold for \$75,000 at the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Kentucky February sale. In foal to Union Rags, she fetched \$200,000 when selling to Fred Hertrich at the 2014 Keeneland November sale. She produced a colt by the GI Belmont S. winner this spring.

De Francis Memorial Dash at Laurel Nov. 15, he returned off a seven-month hiatus to finish second in Monmouth's Decathlon S. May 9. Last time out, the bay stumbled at the start of Belmont's GII True North S. June 5 and finished fifth.

Away well from the inside, Favorite Tale moved up along the rail to take the lead and tick off the first quarter in :21.84. He was pressured by Wildcat Red and Work All Week at the top of the lane, but shifted into another gear and pulled away to the decisive victory.

"When he ran at Monmouth, he bounced a little bit and came back sore," said winning trainer Guadalupe Preciado. "He bruised his foot and for a week I couldn't even train him. Everything went wrong in that race. We hoped he could run a good race here because last year the owners wanted to go to the Breeders' Cup, but he's not eligible and it costs a lot of money. I told them let's wait a year because hopefully he could win a race and get in. So this was perfect. He's been training beautiful. For this race, he was doing unbelievable and you couldn't ask him to go better than the way he did it. We gave him all winter off. He's a gelding and hopefully we keep him running for a few years."

Strut the Course, Canada's 2014 champion older mare, made her first trip to the winner's circle this term after dramatically holding off late-charging favorite **Watsdachances**. The bay mare, a five-length winner of the **GIII Maple Leaf S.** over Woodbine's all-weather surface last November, ended 2014 with a well-beaten seventh-place effort in the **Nov. 27 GII Fall City H.** at **Churchill Downs**.

She resurfaced with a troubled fifth-place effort, beaten just two lengths, in the grassy **GII Nassau S.** May 23. **Strut the Course** broke alertly and settled in with the stalking contingent as **Smartyfly (Smart Strike)** and **Solid Appeal (Successful Appeal)** set a measured pace and **Watsdachances** trailed a tightly bunched field.

Strut the Course tipped off the rail and began reeling in the pacesetters into the stretch, while **Watsdachances** began picking it up from the rear while buried along the rail. **Strut the Course** overtook **Solid Appeal** in the dying strides just as **Watsdachances** saw daylight and closed powerfully to just miss catching the winner on the wire. "I got a perfect trip," said winning rider **Luis Contreras**. "She broke very sharp and today my filly was trying to lay in down the stretch but we got it done in the end." Trainer **Barb Minshall** added, "She acted like she usually acts. She's a high-strung filly and we know her. We kind of expected she'd get on her toes. This was a big step, going to open company with these fillies on the turf. It's a big difference from Ontario (bred/sired) races."

Grand Bili, a first-out winner at Gulfstream in February, was second behind Chipit (Tapit) in an Apr. 9 allowance before heading north for a lackluster 10th-place effort after a slow start in the May 16 Chick Lang S. at Pimlico. He tired to second after battling on the lead in the track-and-trip Big Cypress S. last time out. The gray colt sprinted out to the early lead and battled Bluegrass Singer (Bluegrass Cat) through a quarter in :22.00 and covering a half-mile in :43.76. Grand Bili asserted control at the top of the lane as returning favorite Barbados was winding up for his best run while six lengths back in fourth. Barbados, making his first start since winning the Jan. 24 Gill Hutcheson S., took dead aim on the pacesetter with a furlong to run, but Grand Bili remained resolute and grimly held on to his fast-diminishing advantage to the wire. "It was a fast pace, but that was what I expected," said winning rider Javier Castellano. "There were a lot of fast horses in the race and I knew Bluegrass Singer would want to set the pace. I just wanted to have us on target. It worked out perfect. That was a dream trip. I give all the credit to the trainer [Gustavo Delgado]. He gave me a lot of tips about the horse and the way he runs. I think he's a nice horse." Grand Bili's full-sister Conquest City Girl, a \$90,000 KEESEP yearling in 2014, sold for \$525,000 at this year's OBS March sale. Woodsmoke, a multiple-stakes winning homebred for Gustav Schickedanz, produced a filly by Proud Citizen last year.

Dogwood Trail, a debut winner at Gulfstream in May 2014, resurfaced to win an optional claimer in Hallandale Feb. 8. The chestnut filly was second behind 'TDN Rising Star' Taylor S (Medaglia d'Oro) in the Mar. 14 Any Limit S. and fourth in the Apr. 4 Sophomore Fillies S. Returning from a two-month freshening, she set a pressured pace before being passed late by the reopposing Huasca when second in the June 6 Tangelo H. last time out. Dogwood Trail was soon at the head of affairs, cutting out fractions of :22.88 and :45.50. Huasca moved to challenge the pacesetter at the top of the lane, but Dogwood Trail would not be denied and determinedly turned back that foe to earn her first graded stakes victory. "Last time they went head and head," said winning trainer Stanley Gold. "This time, they backed off a little bit and she was able to control things. When Huasca came, I said, 'Uh oh, she's got a full head of steam,' but she had enough left. It was a good ride by Jesus [Rios]. It was our turn." We try to stay home when we can, but the opportunities get limited during the summer, so we'll see what's around after this." Dogwood Trail's multiple stakes winning full-sister Redbud Road was third in this race in 2012.

Ladyinaddress, who was also bred and campaigned by Fred Brei's Jacks or Better Farm, produced a filly by Brooks 'n Down in 2014 and a colt by Awesome of Course this spring.

And I'm glad no rain came and he got the turf he liked, firm turf." Winning rider Eurico Rosa da Silva added, "He was very game. He's a very easy horse to relax. He goes anywhere you want. He's a beautiful horse, he was in great shape. When I asked him he really responded, he fought very hard in the stretch. I had a lot of horse."

Bradester bounced back from a disappointing trip to Dubai and a troubled third-place finish at Churchill with an upset of heavily favored Race Day (Tapit) in Monmouth's GIII Salvator Mile Sunday afternoon. The bay raced without blinkers for the first time since January of 2014 and posted the third graded stakes victory of his 18-race career.

Second in both this event and the GII Monmouth Cup locally last summer, Bradester led wire-to-wire to annex Churchill's GIII Ack Ack H. over this same trip Sept. 6. A dull seventh in the GII Kelso H. at Belmont to close out the season, his connections opted to send the 5-year-old to Dubai for the G2 Godolphin Mile Mar. 28. Bradester failed to run his race that day and finished 13th--beaten over 23 lengths by Tamarkuz (Speightstown)--and returned stateside to finish third after a tardy beginning in a one-mile optional claimer at Churchill May 2.

Sent postward at his morning line odds of 6-1 in this return to the Jersey Shore, he tracked the pace set by longshot Fabulous Kid through a quarter-mile in :24.42 and moved to establish a narrow advantage in the two-path through a half in :47.61. Traveling well into the stretch, Bradester turned back a challenge from Valid and maintained a safe margin over a rallying Red Vine all the way to the wire.

"Corey got him to relax early on and settled in nicely," commented winning trainer Eddie Kenneally. "He went a little too quick early last time and that cost him. I took the blinkers off this time because of how aggressive he was last race and it paid off. We will look to most likely run him back in the GII Monmouth Cup [Aug. 2] next."

Shaman Ghost was unhurried early and settled well off the pace as the filly Academic (Henny Hughes) and longshot Sweet Grass Creek (Wando) battled through an opening quarter in :22.99. Sweet Grass Creek pounced to the lead entering the backstretch and swiftly opened a clear advantage after a half in :45.76 and three-quarters in 1:10.82. Shaman Ghost inched closer on the turn as the pacesetter packed it in and was overtaken by a host of challengers. Billy's Star (Perfect Soul {Ire}) came out of the turn in front, but favored Danish Dynaformer was making rapid progress on the outside, shadowed by Shaman Ghost. Danish Dynaformer hit the front with a furlong to run, but Shaman Ghost began closing inexorably from the center of the track and surged past the favorite in the dying strides. Conquest Boogaloo (Scat Daddy), who trailed the field for much of the race after a slow start, closed to be third.

"I thought it was a great ride, very patient," trainer Brian Lynch said. "I thought a few jocks panicked at the quarter-pole, but you can see him [Rafael Hernandez] sort of sitting. We had the best horse on the day. I could just see Rafael [Hernandez]'s red cap moving forward, moving forward, trying to get himself in a good position. I knew this horse would have some finish to him and I knew I had the right rider. He is very patient and would give this horse a fabulous ride."

Hernandez added, "[Danish Dynaformer] made a move too early, I let him pass me. I know my horse always has a kick. So he did his thing. He made his kick down the lane. Brian said he had been training well. He is a great horse. He gave me everything today."

Shaman Ghost broke his maiden over the main track at Gulfstream Mar. 14 in his fourth try. He added a Keeneland allowance Apr. 9 before returning to Woodbine to win the May 16 Gill Marine S. Danish Dynaformer, who went on to win the Plate Trial, was third that day.

Shaman Ghost is out of Getback Time (Gilded Time). The mare, in foal to Awesome Again, RNA'd for \$70,000 at the 2013 Keeneland November sale. In foal to Point of Entry, she sold for \$42,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale. Her Awesome Again colt RNA'd for \$47,000 as a weanling at Keeneland last November. She produced a colt by Point of Entry this year.

“We’ve got a very nice group of stallions represented with the first crop of yearlings,” Browning said. “We saw a lot of very good physicals, which is a trademark of the July sale. Those horses by first-crop stallions are in the sale because of their conformation and pedigree, not because they’re by first-crop stallions. We don’t try to lower the bar or give them any ‘advantage’ in entering the sale. If they’re in the catalogue and on the sales grounds it’s because they’re good horses and we’re trying to have them represented.”

GOLDEN HORN FRESH AND WELL

Trainer John Gosden believes it will be at least a week before deciding whether to point undefeated G1 Epsom Derby and this Saturday's G1 Coral-Eclipse S. winner **Golden Horn (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) towards the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 25.

"I'm very pleased with him," Gosden told *At The Races*. "He ate up everything last night. He had a good lead out this morning. He had a good pick of grass and is on very good terms with himself. That is always a major bonus out of any race. You've got to watch your horse over the next week to 10 days. Obviously if everything is fine I will firm up on it later."

After Golden Horn's unprecedented treble of the G2 Dante S., the Derby and the Coral-Eclipse, the race Oppenheimer would dearly love to win now is the King George VI And Queen Elizabeth S. as his company, De Beers, were the race sponsors from 1972 to 2006.

Added the colt's owner/breeder Anthony

Oppenheimer, "If the horse is looking good and John has no problem with him, of course we'll go for the King George. It would be the most exciting thing for me as the company I work for, De Beers, sponsored the race for 34 years and I was closely involved with the sponsorship."

Oppenheimer reiterated his position about racing Golden Horn past his 3-year-old year and with an eye to the colt's future at stud.

Remarked Oppenheimer, "As for racing next year, I am not enthusiastic. It's not something I really feel strongly about, but I would prefer not to. I've no intention of selling the horse. I would want to have some sort of control over the horse when he goes to stud and I want him to go to stud, if possible, in Newmarket."

The Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, for which the John Gosden-trained colt would have to be supplemented, could be his swansong as long as the ground was not soft at Longchamp Oct. 4.

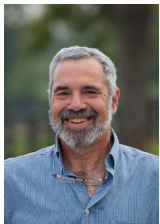


