TAYLOR MADE ACQUIRES CHROME INTEREST

Taylor Made has acquired the interest in dual Classic hero and reigning Horse of the Year **California Chrome** (Lucky Pulpit--Love the Chase, by Not For Love) previously owned by Steve and Carolyn Coburn.

"We are thrilled to be part owners of such a historic racehorse as California Chrome, and are most grateful to Steve and Carolyn Coburn and Perry and Denise Martin for giving us this exceptional opportunity and entrusting him with our care," said Duncan Taylor, President and CEO of Taylor Made. "California Chrome is simply the all-time leading earner from the A.P. Indy sire line, and he's a tremendously good-looking, athletic, and well-balanced horse who possesses great speed. Remarkably, he

became the fifth Kentucky Derby winner from his deep female family, and he embodies the incredible toughness and soundness of the throwbacks from his family. You won't find many horses of his quality that made 18 starts in 23 months. He's just now getting his first break from training."

Following his runner-up effort in the \$10-million G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 28, California Chrome was sent to the Newmarket yard of trainer Rae Guest with an eye on the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot. He was forced to miss that engagement and was withdrawn on the eve of the race and was mooted as possible for the G1 Sussex S. this month. California Chrome was instead returned to the U.S. and was stabled at Arlington Park, with the G1 Arlington Million as the target. But news emerged this week that he was suffering from bone bruising. California Chrome was examined in Kentucky by Dr. Larry Bramlage, who suggested a return to training is very much a possibility.

"California Chrome's x-rays showed all of his joints to be remarkably clean. He has the early signs of bruising to the bottom of the cannon bones," Bramlage commented. "Horses training at high levels for long periods of time, like California Chrome has, gradually get behind in the bone's response to the stress because we train them and then ask them to stand in the stall for most of the day. Horses evolved as grazing animals and that is how their bone's blood supply works best. So the treatment is to get them back to their natural state, let them be a horse in the paddock until the bone returns to normal. The return rate for horses with this problem is very high. When we researched prognosis for distal cannon bone bruising, we found that recovery rate was 95% after giving time in the paddock to heal."

After showing that she is pattern-race class when beating Giovanni Canaletto (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in this track's G3 Gallinule S. over 10 furlongs May 24, the bay upstaged the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Pleascach (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) with something in hand in Royal Ascot's G2 Ribblesdale S. at this distance

June 18. One of Ireland's most-improved performers in 2015, the homebred shows no sign of stopping yet.

"Curvy seems well and we are very happy with her, so we decided to take our chance in this," trainer David Wachman commented. "She is a very straightforward filly who we have had no problems with. She has been improving from run to run and she will need to step up again if she is to win, as she is going from Group 2 to Group 1 level. I am not worried about the ground for her, as she has run on fast ground, good ground and slow ground, so she seems to handle anything. As for the trip, she won the Ribblesdale well but she has also won well over a mile and a quarter, so she seems pretty adaptable." **Cont. p8**

A maiden winner at second asking over the Hollywood synthetic track, California Chrome helped bring a close to the Inglewood oval with a victory in the King Glorious S. in December 2013. That was the first of six consecutive added-money scores, a streak that included a 7 1/4-length score in the GII San Felipe S. and a 5 1/4-length tally in the GI Santa Anita Derby ahead of his 1 3/4-length success in as the 5-2 favorite in the GI Kentucky Derby. The blaze-faced chestnut followed with a 1 1/2-length victory in the GI Preakness S., earning a date with destiny in the GI Belmont S., but he stumbled slightly at the start and finished in a dead-heat for fourth. A wide-trip third to Bayern (Offlee Wild) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic following an imperfect preparation, California Chrome added a victory in the GI Hollywood Derby, an effort which clinched Horse of the Year honors. In two starts this year at four, he finished a game runner-up to Shared Belief (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GII San Antonio S. Feb. 7 ahead of his excellent effort in the World Cup.

Bred by Steve Coburn and Perry Martin, California Chrome currently owns a record of 18-9-3-3--all within a 23-month period--and earnings of \$6,322,650. The plan for California Chrome going forward is to monitor his progress closely to see if he will return to racing in 2016 or start his stallion career for the current owners, Perry and Denise Martin and Taylor Made.

Frivolous will look to follow in the hoofsteps of another daughter of Empire Maker--future Hall of Famer Royal Delta--who used the Fleur de Lis as a springboard to Delaware H. glory in both 2012 and 2013.

Sheer Drama, favored at 2-1 on the morning line, aired by 6 1/2 lengths in Gulfstream's GII Royal Delta S. Mar. 21 over next-out graded winners House Rules

(Distorted Humor) and Molly Morgan (Ghostzapper), checking in second behind the latter in the La Troienne. She has finished off the board just twice from 13 tries on conventional dirt, and was second on debut here in 2013. **America** (A.P. Indy) was seventh in the La Troienne and fifth in the Fleur de Lis.

The aforementioned Fortune Pearl defeated **Joint Return** (Include) in the GII Delaware Oaks here some 53 weeks ago before finishing a decent fourth in Saratoga's GI Alabama S. Aug. 16. After taking that Keeneland allowance in her 4-year-old debut, she was seventh in Pimlico's GIII Allaire du Pont Distaff S. May 15 and fourth in the local GIII Obeah S. June 20--two spots behind Joint Return. **Cont. p4**

Reserve Turf Classic on GI Kentucky Derby day May 2, the bay rallied resolutely from dead last to get his head in front. He was a late-charging fourth behind Woodford Reserve also-ran Slumber (GB) (Cacique {Ire}) and next-out GI United Nations S. hero Big Blue Kitten (Kitten's Joy) in the GI Manhattan S. at Belmont June 6, and was a decent fourth last time in the GI Gold Cup at Santa Anita on the dirt June 27.

Eddie Read S. cont.

Midnight Storm (Pioneerof the Nile) has turned a serious corner since transferring from Jorge Gutierrez to Phil D'Amato almost a year ago. He took an optional claimer here last August, and scored a 17-1 front-running upset in the course-and-distance GII Del Mar Derby three weeks thereafter. The dark bay crushed **Gabriel Charles** (Street Hero) by 7 3/4 lengths while earning a 106 Beyer Speed Figure at Santa Anita Apr. 16, and settled for second at even-money in the GI Shoemaker Mile S. last out June 13. He figures to show the way, but could face pressure from **Big Cazanova (Arg)** (Giant's Causeway).

Gabriel Charles took the quicker division of the GII Del Mar Derby over distance and surface in 2013, but went missing after a runner-up finish in the GII Twilight Derby that November. His first start after the long break came in that Apr. 16 allowance, after which he finished third behind well-regarded Bal a Bali (Brz) (Put It Back) and subsequent Shoemaker upsetter Talco (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}) in the May 9 GIII American S.

ANOTHER DERBY TRY FOR 'Z'

The omnipresent **Mr. Z** (Malibu Moon) looks to build on a breakthrough win in Thistledown's June 20 Ohio Derby in Saturday night's GII Indiana Derby. Five times graded stakes-placed as a juvenile--including twice at the highest level--the D. Wayne Lukas pupil hit the board three more times on the Triple Crown trail, including a third behind then-fellow Zayat Stables colorbearer American Pharoah (Pioneerof the Nile) and **Far Right** (Notional) in the Apr. 11 GI Arkansas Derby. He could only manage 13th with some trouble again in back of American Pharoah in the GI Kentucky Derby, and was a last-minute purchase by Brad Kelley's Calumet Farm before settling for fifth in the GI Preakness S. May 16. Let go at nearly 7-1 in the Ohio Derby, the chestnut went right to the front and refused to lose, holding on by a game nose.

Third that day--by just a head--was Roy and Gretchen Jackson homebred **Divining Rod** (Tapit), who filled the same slot in the Preakness and in the GII Tampa Bay Derby in March. Second by a neck at long odds in January's GIII Sam F. Davis S., the son of MGISW Precious Kitten (Catienus) was a good-looking winner of Keeneland's GIII Coolmore Lexington S. in April. Far Right, winner of the Smarty Jones S. and GIII Southwest S. over Mr. Z at Oaklawn in the winter, was 15th in the Kentucky Derby and sixth in the Ohio Derby. **Island Town** (Hard Spun) won a second-straight race in Churchill's GIII Matt Winn S. June 13, but will likely need to run faster than he ever has before--he earned just an 88 Beyer Speed Figure for his last-out score.

AHH CHOCOLATE RETURNS IN INDY OAKS

Lightly raced Stoneway Farm homebred **Ahh Chocolate** (Candy Ride {Arg}) faces a solid group of 10 foes, but has a good shot to earn her first graded stakes tally in Saturday's GII Indiana Oaks. A rallying debut winner sprinting at Fair Grounds in February, she added a Keeneland allowance on the stretch out in April. The bay ran extremely well to be third considering circumstances in Pimlico's GII Black-Eyed Susan S. May 15--she was hung very wide throughout behind a glacial pace set by upset winner Keen Pauline (Pulpit). Second that day was Include Betty (Include), who put herself into the running for champion 3-year-old filly with a powerful last-to-first score in the GI Mother Goose S. last month. **Oceanwave** (Harlan's Holiday) was just a neck second to Include Betty in the GIII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn in April, before rallying from far back to be seventh in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1. She was most recently fifth in the GI Acorn S. at Big Sandy June 6, and will likely need to show more early interest to give herself a chance here. **Cont. p6**

She donned cap and gown two back sprinting May 30 over two easy next-out winners, and was third--one spot behind **Emmajestic** (Zensational-- after setting an honest pace when stretching out at Churchill June 20. **Pangburn** (Congrats) missed GIII Iowa Oaks glory by just a nose June 27, and was a half-length in front of **Sweetgrass** (Street Sense) in third. The latter is one of two for trainer Ian Wilkes, who also sends out GI Ashland S. third **Silverpocketsfull** (Indian Charlie).

Winner of Churchill's GII American Turf S. May 2 and Belmont's Pennine Ridge S. May 30, the bay raced wide behind a slow early pace and checked in seventh in the GI Belmont Derby Invitational July 4.

"He came out of the race well," Bradley said. "Unfortunately we didn't have the trip we needed in that race. He went his last half in about :46, so I think he was definitely extending himself, he just doesn't need to be as far back as he was during a slow pace. He was tugging."

"He trained lightly last week and now is back in full-on training," Bradley noted. "He's full of energy right now. I think he can run closer to the pace next time if need be. Hopefully he runs his race and shows how good he is."

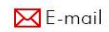
Yesterday a bill to unify Thoroughbred horse racing rules was introduced to congress. It was a positive step in the right direction--it had the backing of The Jockey Club, the Breeders' Cup and WHOA, the grassroots movement to end all raceday medications.

While it was an attempt to clean up racing and establish U.S. Racing as congruous with the rest of the world, it failed to eliminate raceday drugs. The rest of the world bans raceday drugs.

WHOA was created by George Strawbridge, Julia Jenkins, Staci and Arthur Hancock, Paul and Melissa Sullivan and Roy and Gretchen Jackson. We all trained to Washington to meet with congressmen and senators to implore their help before our beloved sport imploded from chemicals. We worked hard and none worked harder than the Hancocks. Congressman Pitts and Senator Udall heard us and wrote a very powerful bill that they introduced before congress several months ago.

This bill states that race day drugs will not be tolerated. USADA will be in charge of running the testing--random, out-of-raceday testing will be in place and, most importantly, the bill would place American horse racing on par with the rest of the world and its standards. The diminishing European buyers would again frequent our sales. American stallions would be authentic talent and in just a handful of years we would help our Thoroughbreds to be healthier, stronger horses, possibly eliminating bleeders altogether. Looking back, honestly, we really have let our standards get lower and lower

To sum up my feelings and thoughts about WHOA at this point: WHOA without consent of all its founding members, and advisory board, has signed up and supports the wrong bill. If other members are disappointed and confused I share their stance, Roy and I and others are sticking to our desire to see all raceday drugs eliminated and join the rest of the world in knowing we are doing the right thing by our horses.

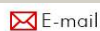

**Amanda Simmons Luby:**

From a big picture perspective, I am happy to see bi-partisan support for the Thoroughbred Horseracing Integrity Act of 2015 (THIA). To all of those Congressional leaders who support oversight by the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) and the banning of raceday medications, thank you for putting your name behind legislation that is aimed at helping our industry. I am also very encouraged to see USADA put its muscle behind such legislation. Moreover, I share in [Barry Irwin's sentiments](#) published in the *TDN* July 17 that those opposed to independent oversight of drug testing and enforcement have yet to raise a viable argument. There are many things to like about the bill.

Nonetheless, the THIA could be better. It actually does not ban raceday medications and only adopts the status quo with respect to "therapeutic medications" and Lasix use. As someone who spends her life in court debating statutory interpretation, I can tell you that legislative drafting 101 is this: put it in black and white. If something is not included in a bill then its omission is considered intentional which could ultimately backfire if that statute is challenged one day in court. Thus, because the THIA fails to actually ban all raceday medications, its omission is deemed intentional. This is so even though within the bill there is the possibility that maybe, perhaps, just one day down the road at the whim of this new alphabet oversight group, the Thoroughbred Horseracing Anti-Doping Authority (THADA), all such medications could ultimately be banned. Why leave it to chance? Why are those groups behind the THIA so afraid of putting such a ban in writing if that is the ultimate hope anyway? Why not take a stand and be on the right side of history?

Aidan O'Brien has won four renewals to date and based on the G1 Epsom Oaks shock of **Qualify (Ire)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), it is not easy to decipher which is the leading protagonist. Ironically, it is the least-experienced of the quartet **Words (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) who heads the betting among them, and the daughter of the 2008 winner Moonstone (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) has obviously been giving all the right signals at Ballydoyle. Her defeat of Thursday's G3 Meld S. winner Carla Bianca (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) in the G3 Munster Oaks at Cork June 14 is notable, but it lacks the strength of the Epsom victory of **Qualify (Ire)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) and even the solidity of the G3 Musidora S. second placing of **Together Forever (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who also annexed last year's G1 Fillies' Mile.

Daltawa was a two-time winner at the races for His Highness the Aga Khan and trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre, including the Listed Prix Ronde de Nuit and a runner-up effort in the G3 Prix Penelope in 1992. Bred

to her owner's 1988 G1 2000 Guineas hero Doyoun (Ire) in her first year at stud in 1993, Daltawa produced the globetrotting Daylami (Ire), Europe's Horse of the Year and a U.S. Eclipse Award winner in 1999 who counted such prestigious races as the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Diamond

S., the G1 Irish Champion S. and G1 Breeders' Cup Turf amongst his 11 career victories. Daylami has since gone on to be a proven sire under both codes.

Daltawa's produce of 2000, Dalakhani (Ire), was indisputably the mare's best foal. Once defeated in his nine career appearances, the grey stallion, a Group 1 winner at two, added the G1 Prix du Jockey Club, the G1 Prix Lupin and the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at age three en route to matching Daylami's accomplishment as European Horse of the Year. The sire himself of seven individual Group 1 winners, Dalakhani is well on his way to becoming a broodmare sire of considerable importance.

Other of her male offspring included SW & MG1SP Daymarti (Ire) (Caerleon) and GSW Dalghar (Fr) (Anabaa), but Daltawa's producing daughters and granddaughters have done their part to secure her legacy. Daltaiyma (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) is the dam of GSW Daltaya (Fr) (Anabaa), who in turn produced Dalkala (Giant's Causeway), winner of the 2013 G1 Prix de l'Opera. Daltawa's daughter Dalmiya (Ire) (Kalanisi {Ire}) is responsible for GSW Dalwari (More Than Ready), while Daltama (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) is the dam of Dolniya (Fr) (Azamour {Ire}), victorious in this year's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic.

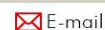

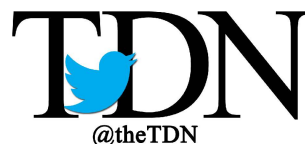
