Hoppings S. scorer **Covert Love (Ire)** (Azamour {Ire}) justified all his faith to beat off the home challenge under a finely judged ride from Pat Smullen.

Settled in a clear second early as Seamie Heffernan sent **Together Forever (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) several lengths into the

lead, the 7-1 shot closed down that rival to take control approaching the furlong pole and kept up the relentless momentum to the line, where she held a 1 3/4-length margin over **Jack Naylor (GB)** (Champs Elysees {GB}), who edged out the 15-8 favorite **Curvy (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) for third by a head. "I'm terrified I'll wake up and find myself still in my bed in Newmarket--I couldn't be more excited," commented Palmer, who is due to be married next Saturday. "It was an incredible ride and it worked out perfectly, with Aidan's horse going off like a scalded cat and Pat making his own running and letting that one go as a hare. Full credit to the syndicate, not one of them had to think twice about coming here, as the €40,000 supplementary entry was at that point every penny she had won in prize-money. You have to have faith in your horses, particularly one like this who doesn't show you an awful lot at home, and take that leap." **Cont. p9**

by two lengths in the G1 Delaware H. **America** (A.P. Indy) was along for third. The chestnut, a runaway winner of Gulfstream's GII Royal Delta S. Mar. 21, turned the tables on Frivolous after finishing second to her in Churchill's GII Fleur de Lis H. June 13. Content to stalk her

familiar foe through early fractions of :24.45 and :48.83, the 5-2 chance locked horns with that rival into the stretch, and eventually put her away to record a career high. Favored **Rosalind** (Broken Vow) never factored while fifth. **Cont. p3**

Sheer Drama, second at big prices in both the Florida Sunshine Millions Distaff Jan. 17 and Gill Rampart S. Feb. 21, followed her big win in the Royal Delta with two more runner-up finishes. She rallied to complete the exacta as the 2-1 favorite in the GI La Troienne S. May 1 and came within 1 1/2 lengths of Frivolous going 1 1/8 miles in the Fleur de Lis last time.

Sheer Drama's dam Riveting Drama (Notebook), a \$36,000 OBSMAR 2-year-old purchase by Queen in 1996, never made it to the races, but has certainly been kind to her connections in the breeding shed. In addition to champion sprinter Big Drama (Montbook), she has also produced stakes winners Drama's Way (Farma Way); Little Drama (Burning Roma); and Queen Drama (Burning Roma). She produced a Chapel Royal filly in 2012.

She came into this race great and I loved her sitting second. Joe [Bravo] and I had talked about it the race before and I did not think she was going to make the lead.”

Gabriel Charles, a 5 1/2-furlong debut winner over the former Del Mar Polytrack, scored in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint Preview S. going down the hill before concluding his 2-year-old season with a runner-up finish in the Eddie Logan S. that December. He faced the starter only three times at three, but made them count. In addition to his win in the Del Mar Derby, he

was second in Del Mar's Oceanside S. and Santa Anita's GII Twilight Derby. Sidelined all of 2014, he resurfaced to finish a distant second behind Eddie Read favorite Midnight Storm (Pioneerof the Nile) in a Santa Anita optional claimer Apr. 16 and entered off a third-place finish in a lively renewal of the GIII American S. in Arcadia Apr. 16.

Gabriel Charles added to an already red-hot start to the Del Mar meet for trainer Jeff Mullins, who took the Oceanside S. on opening day and a

2-year-old maiden special weight one race earlier on the card.

"The early fractions were well enough that I thought we were OK," Mullins commented. "He was perched up on him like they were going a two-minute mile and when he swung him into the clear, I could see he had plenty of horse. How many horses bow a tendon and come back and win a Group I? We took our time with him and that was the key. We knew he had this caliber of talent, it was a matter of keeping him healthy. We were worried about the turf course after the rain, but Mike [Smith] said the course was great."

Smith added, "I don't think it rained on the turf course; only the main track. It was plenty fast. My horse was so nice and comfortable; going along so easy. I was watching the competition up front, but I thought I could handle them. I was worried about that one in the back [Finnegans Wake]. I knew he was going to be coming and he's run some big ones. [Gabriel Charles] was impressive."

Tiz Shea D pressed Mr. Z early on here, and was floated extremely wide by that rival at the head of the lane. Undeterred, he splashed home out wide by some 1 1/4 lengths from the fighting on Mr. Z, who just held off race favorite Divining Rod. A debut winner at Parx in February for Daniel Shea and trainer Jason Servis, the bay was second in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct in March after being privately acquired and sent to Hall of Famer Bill Mott. A well-beaten fifth at 6-1 in the GI Wood Memorial S. in April and fourth in the GII Peter Pan S. in May, he was most recently second behind GIII Dwyer S. third Tommy Macho (Macho Uno) in an allowance on the GI Belmont S. undercard June 6. Tiz Shea D's dam Ender's Sister (A.P. Indy) produced a colt by Hard Spun in 2013; a filly by Giant's Causeway in 2014; and a filly by Distorted Humor in 2015.

High Dollar Woman, a second out maiden winner over recent GI Acorn S. heroine Curalina (Curlin) in the Saratoga mud last summer, broke through with a career high here. A front-running allowance victress at Parx last December, she closed out her tenure for trainer Tony Dutrow with a well-beaten fifth-place finish behind champion Take Charge Brandi (Giant's Causeway) in the Martha Washington S. at Oaklawn Jan. 31. She resurfaced for Steve Hobby with a second-place finish going six furlongs in the slop here in a \$40,000 optional tagger June 26. Sent to the front by Joe Rocco Jr., High Dollar Woman posted splits of :24.21 and :48.04 and fended off constant pursuer Sweetgrass to take it by a measured length. Favored Oceanwave rallied for third. "I let her get comfortable and she had plenty to come home for the drive," Rocco said. "I thought we'd be close—not necessarily in front, but that's how it worked out. I think Steve [Hobby] is a tremendous horseman and he did a great job getting her ready."

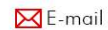

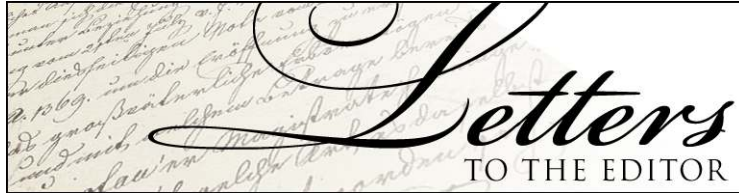

It's amazing really; we either don't get it, or, to paraphrase WC, "When we've exhausted all other possibilities, we will do the right thing." The success of racing isn't about raceday medications, or federal regulations with the U.S. Yada-Yada whatever watching over us. It's about people, fans, bettors, interested in an emotional endeavor, a racehorse bound with unsurpassed beauty, power, and spirit trying to win a race. People, probably dulled through their daily grind of an existence, seek something interesting and entertaining. Sports don't attract people with corrupt business practices, shady dealings, drugs shot up into innocent horses, or even gimmicks. Sports attract people with knowledge, which leads to understanding. It's not about the car going around the track; it's about the knowledge of all that goes together to make it happen. Nothing explains it simpler than NASCAR. And people involved with the NFL want to know everything about the players, as much as the emotional aspect of the game itself. So really, racings salvation lies in transparency. And that's a bitter pill to swallow. From the sales ground where horse's sale from "Jack n Jill Farm" to "Up the Hill with Water Stable," to the racetrack where the innocent horse, at least 85% of them, are trapped in an upside down economy running once every two weeks trying to sustain a living. But bitter pill, or no bitter pill, transparency, across the board is our only out. Give horses an advocate and you give them a chance. Hong Kong goes up 5%, we go down 5%. It's that simple.

Hugo Palmer, whose first pattern-race success came under 12 months ago courtesy of Aktabantay (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G3 Solario S., has continued to enhance the reputation of his middle-division string in Newmarket since and his bold call to pay the €40,000 fee to supplement the unproven Covert Love was something to note.

Quickly into her stride with her slow-starting days well behind her, she was soon denied the lead as Together Forever took no prisoners, but settled perfectly with that rival providing the ideal point of reference up ahead. Shaken up on the home turn, she gradually ate into the Ballydoyle protagonist's sizeable advantage and once she had worked her way past with just over a furlong remaining, was never going to be drawn back by the chasing Curvy and Jack Naylor.

"We went some gallop, but we were very confident she would stay," rider Pat Smullen said. "I wasn't letting Seamie away too far, because his is probably a very good filly but Hugo said this filly was in serious form. She'll go further--stamina is her forte. She's a lovely big mare who is improving all the time and there is more in her. She's as genuine as the day is long and although she isn't blessed with a great turn of foot, she is a classy grinder."

Her trainer may have a tilt at the G1 St Leger in mind at Doncaster Sept. 12.

"She's a lightly-raced, young filly and I genuinely believe her biggest days, if they get any bigger than this, could well be ahead of her," he said. "She traveled over here perfectly and seems to have a cast-iron constitution, but Pat said this is as quick as she'd want the ground to be. It never seems to stop raining half the time, so I think we'll be alright. There's still time to put her in the St Leger and we'll see what the weather does next month and maybe think about putting her in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks [at York Aug. 20]. I'm kicking myself now, as I wrote her name down for it and then crossed it out the day before the entry, but she was a 92-rated handicapper then. A huge amount of the credit must go to my team at home, particularly Glen McGee who has ridden this filly every day this year and has been certain for a long time that she is top-class."

Hugo Merry, who forms part of the Fomo Syndicate, added, "She was bred on my farm in Cork and I loved her as a foal and a yearling, so we re-syndicated her with some friends after we didn't sell her at Goffs. We are all here today, except for one pal in Hong Kong. She puts her ears forward and loves it, but might be a better 4-year-old as she's still a bit lean and lacks a bit of girth. Hugo Palmer had her on the button today and he's having a phenomenal year without having a huge string. I am partial to Azamour and although some of them can be one-race wonders, she just seems to thrive on it. None of us are particularly in debt, so I think she may stay in training and hopefully she will."

Azamour, who won the 2004 G1 St James's Palace S. and the G1 King George & Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. the following season in the colors of His Highness the Aga Khan, died in April 2014 following an accident in his stall.

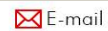

Still a maiden until his seventh and latest start, having been disqualified from his debut success over five furlongs here last July, Strath Burn used that recent confidence boost as propulsion to pattern-race glory in this beleaguered renewal.

Fourth in the G3 Prix du Lys over 12 furlongs at Chantilly last time June 14, His Highness The Aga Khan's **Dariyan (Fr)** (Shamardal) is worth closer attention dropping back in distance particularly as the winner of that contest Erupt (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) has since annexed the G1 Grand Prix de Paris.

Jockey Richard Hughes says he is "comfortable with the decision" to retire at the end of the Qatar Goodwood Festival Aug. 1.

The three-time champion jockey announced earlier in the year this would be his final season, but the 42-year-old has now decided to hang up his saddle earlier than had been anticipated.

Hughes is poised to embark upon a training career as early as the autumn, and admitted the demands of preparing for his new vocation, allied to performing to his best on a racetrack, hastened the decision to move forward

his retirement plans.

He told *Press Association Sport*, "I've always given 100% in everything I've done and I don't want to stop doing that now. To be a champion jockey and to be successful you have to be totally committed. It's become clear in the last two weeks that I've realised what that [training] will entail. I always knew this was going to be my last year, and I'm comfortable with the decision [to retire after Goodwood]. Whenever I was going to retire I was always going to miss out on riding good horses. Now is the time."

In a related matter, Betfair Sportsbook have decided to refund all bets placed on Hughes for the 2015 British Flat Jockey Championship. The firm now has Silvestre de Sousa the 1-4 favorite ahead of James Doyle in second on 6-1.

"The problem with him is he's very important to the breeding operation," Gold told *Racing UK*. "Sheikh Hamdan is mad about his breeding and we've been looking for a

horse like this for a very long time--a well-bred, good-looking horse with speed.

Gold continued, "He's won two Group 1 as a 3-year-old and a group race as a 2-year-old--he's exactly what we need at the stud. If I was a betting man I would say he'll probably be at stud [next year], but let's see what happens for the rest of the year. It's obviously Sheikh Hamdan's decision."

The G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville next month remains Muhaarar's most likely next objective.
