DP Racing's **Prize Exhibit (GB)** (Showcasing {GB}), fresh off her first graded victory in Santa Anita's GIII Senorita S. June 27, closed decisively down the straight in Del Mar's GII San Clement H. to record another sparkling win Sunday afternoon. The second choice broke well and was content to establish her usual position at the back of the field against the fence as **Spirit of Xian (Ire)** (Kodiac {GB}) set the early pace through splits of :23.27 and :47.25. As favored **Sunset Glow**

(Exchange Rate) made her move toward the front, Prize Exhibit, still in last, angled out and quickly passed rivals on the bend. She continued her determined charge down the stretch to take command from Sunset Glow in the final furlong and score by 1 1/2 lengths.

"This turf seems pretty firm [despite the rain], Cassidy said. "There's no kickback to it at all. You have no idea how tough this filly is to train. She doesn't care. One work she started at the five-eighths pole, pulled up at the half, jogged to the three-eighths, galloped a little bit to the quarter pole, then took off and went all the way back to the five-eighths. But you look at her today and she wasn't even trying to run off. If you looked at her today and didn't know she was quirky, you'd think she was very professional. The GI Del Mar] Oaks [Aug. 15] is next."

"She felt good all the way around," Jockey Santiago Gonzalez, who had three winner's on the Sunday card, said through an interpreter. "I knew I had horse under me. I waited until the quarter pole and then I let her run. She responded very well. This is my first stakes win at Del Mar. This is special, very special."

Prize Exhibit began her career under the care of Upper Lambourn trainer Jamie Osborne. A debut winner as a juvenile at Nottingham in August, the dark bay was off the board in two subsequent starts, but finished a close third in the G3 Oh So Sharp S. at Newmarket Oct. 4. She ran well to round out the GI Breeders' Cup Fillies Juvenile Turf superfecta behind Lady Eli (Divine Park), Sunset Glow and Osaila (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in her first start on North American soil Oct. 31. cont. p3

CALIFORNIA CHROME TO RACE IN 2016

Dual Classic winner and 2014 Horse of the Year **California Chrome** (Lucky Pulpit) will race in 2016, trainer Art Sherman said on Roger Stein's radio show Sunday. The chestnut was originally scheduled to run in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 15, but was taken out of contention after sustaining a bruised cannon bone. Last week, Taylor Made purchased a minority interest in California Chrome and he's currently on their farm in Kentucky.

"He's going to run next year as a 5-year-old and I'll train him and he's coming back to California," Sherman offered. "I feel kind of at ease right now and really good about it. I think it's all for the best, back with people that have horses and been in the game a long time. I'm so happy it turned out this way, give the horse a break, he's going to be a really nice 5-year-old," said Sherman. "Things happen for the best, for a reason. Maybe the injury was a blessing in disguise right now, finally give the horse a chance for a little R and R, let him be a horse. All the vets I talk to say he'll be 100 percent sound in 85 days. I think he's going to come back a tiger. I'm looking forward to 2016 being a big year for him."

She shipped East and never factored when fifth in the Penn Oaks May 30, but redeemed herself with a winning performance in the GIII Seniorita S. June 27, earning a career best 4 *Thoro-graph* figure after rallying from a sluggish beginning.

Are You Kidding Me earned his first graded victory in the 2013 GIII Kent S. at Delaware Park, and was unable to crack the exacta running in graded company in four starts during his 4-year-old season. The bay earned a

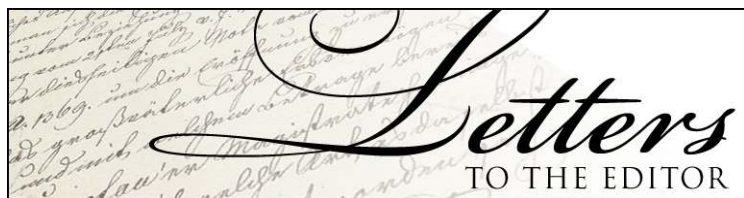

third-place finish in the GIII San Francisco Mile S. to kick off his 5-year-old season at Golden Gate Apr. 25 and returned to the winner's circle last time out when he annexed the GII Eclipse S. over the synthetic June 7, earning a 1 3/4 *Thoroughgraph* figure. The favorite here, Are You

Kidding Me rated off the rail behind the pacesetter through the opening stages, and angled out to the three path on the turn. He bid for the lead at the top of the lane, battled through midstretch, took command and held off the rallying Golden Sabre.

"He's a really nice horse. He always has been," said Attfield. "He's had some problems with his wind. He's had some fairly significant [throat] surgeries. I didn't think they could beat him. The only thing I was concerned about was they said it was supposed to be the hottest, most humid day of the summer. We obviously have [his breathing problems] corrected very well."

Technology, a double edged sword, has come a long way. Today a higher percentage of the cheaters are being exposed. It is what happens after they are exposed that is the problem that does not have a simple solution. I haven't any idea if the USADA will provide a solution; hopefully, they will at least open the door to other ideas.

How much longer can the "blood" of the two major components, the Fans and Owners, involved in our sport be drained? Regulation, taxation, deceptive practices, and outright cheating are more prevalent today than they have been in the past. A few years ago, I wrote an Op/Ed for *TDN* (submitted, but not published) where I attempted to show how the States, tracks and industry participants were ruining the sport for those that provided the fuel for its existence.

Yes, Dr. Ferguson Thoroughbred Racing continues to decline in the USA while flourishing in other countries. We have never made a return on our investment here in the United States. However, we have in other jurisdictions. This may very well be our last year for Thoroughbred investing in the USA. Nothing much has changed in the USA for the player or owner. Many years ago the "book makers" refused to take a straight show bet because some of the unemployed, during the Great Depression, were savvy enough to eke out a small profit. Imagine my surprise on Sept. 23, 2013 when I received a telephone call from "Twin Spires" to limit my show wagers to \$20.00 or they would close my account.

PLETCHER, JACOBSON CASTELLANO TOP BELMONT MEET

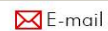

Successful in two conditions races over 10 and 12 furlongs at Saint-Cloud May 5 and May 29, Dariyan was fourth behind the subsequent G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner Erupt (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the G3 Prix du Lys over the latter trip at Chantilly last time June 14.

Anchored in the slipstream of the leader War Dispatch throughout the early stages, the bay traveled easily off the soft fractions and when angled wide produced a telling surge of acceleration to overwhelm that rival in the last 75 meters.

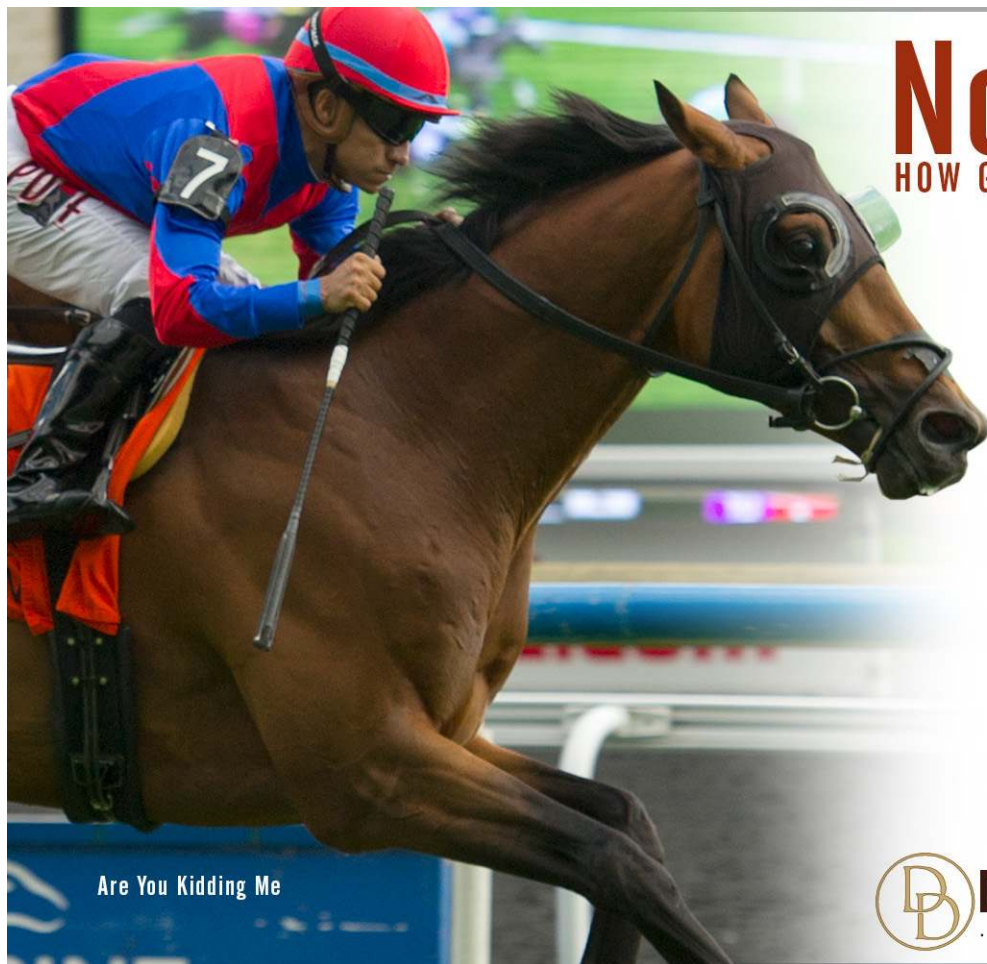
