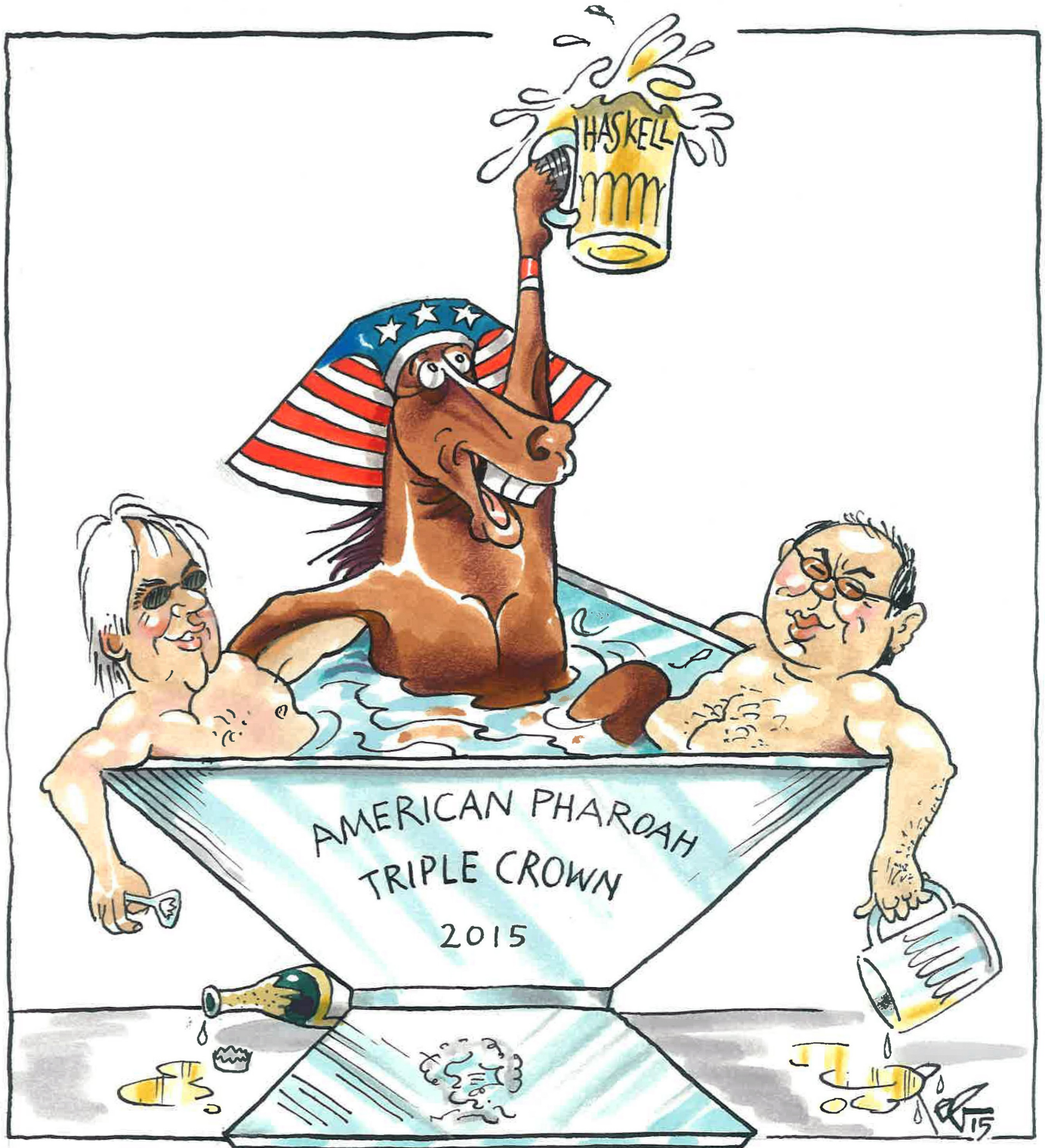

### PHAROAH IMPOSING, BUT NO 'SHORE' THING

Zayat Stable's **American Pharoah** (Pioneer of the Nile) already cemented his name in history when he became only the 12th horse to win the Triple Crown, but the bay looks to add to his legacy Sunday in the GI William Hill Haskell Invitational S. at Monmouth Park, a

"Win and You're In" qualifier for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. This will be the Bob Baffert trainee's first start since his romp in the GI Belmont S. June 6. The morning line 1-5 favorite--who could very well be backed down to 1-9 if the local reception he has received since arriving in New Jersey is

any indication--will start from the four hole, but is not without worthy adversaries, perhaps in part due to the \$750,000 purse bump to \$1.75 million the race received. Assistant trainer Jimmy Barnes, however, is unconcerned with the competition. "We just want him to get a good break, get to the outside, and work his way around there," Barnes offered. "If he gets a clean trip, he'll do the rest."

GI Holy Bull S. winner **Upstart** (Flatter) will make his first afternoon appearance since finishing a puzzling 18th in the GI Kentucky Derby. The dark bay was controversially disqualified and placed second in the GI Fountain of Youth S. in February and was runner-up in the GI Florida Derby Mar. 28 before that disappointing effort in the Derby. He draws the rail here and is given a 6-1 chance on the morning line, and appears capable of contending with the favorite on his best day. The 105 Beyer Speed Figure he earned for his Holy Bull romp--also off the bench--matches the best American Pharoah has received to date, and the 108 he got for the Florida Derby is the field's best. The Rick Violette, Jr. pupil, who bypassed Saturday's GI Jim Dandy S. for this, fired a :47.20 (1/109) warning shot for this over the Spa main track July 25. **Cont. p3**

### 'TEXAS' HOLDS 'EM IN JIM DANDY

Saturday's GI Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga was the loser--numerically speaking, anyways--in the confluence of sophomore stakes events carded for this always busy weekend of racing. With Tekton (Bernardini) having scratched in favor of Friday's Curlin S. and with Upstart (Flatter) and 'TDN Rising Star' Competitive Edge (Super Saver) traveling the NJ Turnpike for Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational S., just four horses faced the starter in the main local prep for the GI Travers S. Aug. 29, but the race did not lack for excitement, as GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero **Texas Red** (Afleet Alex) outfooted odds-on **Frosted** (Tapit) by a measured half-length. **Cont. p9**

### 'LEGA' EAGLE

Probably below her best last time when second in The Curragh's G1 Pretty Polly S., Michael Tabor's G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Legatissimo (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) bounced back to her formidable best at Goodwood on Saturday when storming to success in the G1 Qatar Nassau S. Sent off the 2-1 favorite, the bay was held up towards the rear early by Wayne Lordan while trapped out wide, but was always traveling with intent and cruised down the outer to enter the fray approaching the quarter pole. Launched on the front end passing that marker, she surged into a decisive lead and was well beyond reach as the same owner's **Wedding Vow (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) stayed on into second, with 2 1/4 lengths the winning margin. **Cont. p15**

"He could not be coming in to the race any better," Violette said of Upstart. "We'll ship first thing [Sunday] morning and show up at the Shore ready to go."

**Mr. Jordan** (Kantharos), a 'TDN Rising Star,' will represent the hometown contingent. The grey has never been out of the exacta in six career starts. He finished runner-up in Gulfstream's Tamarac S. Feb. 27 and was DQ'd from first to second in the Tarpon S. Apr. 25 before annexing the GIII Pegasus S., a local prep for this event, June 21.

Trainer Todd Pletcher, who has a trio of Haskell wins already to his credit, has three chances to inch closer to Baffert's record seven wins. He'll saddle 'Rising Star' **Competitive Edge** (Super Saver), **Nonna's Boy** (Distorted Humor) and **Dontbetwithbruno** (Tiz Wonderful). Competitive Edge was one of 2014's most exciting juveniles, as he romped on debut at Saratoga last July before cruising to a 5 3/4-length tally in the GI Hopeful S. Sidelined for the rest of the season, he picked right up where he left off with an 8 1/4-length drubbing of Mr. Jordan in the Tamarac, and facile score in Churchill's GIII Pat Day Mile May 3. Cut back for the seven-panel GII Woody Stephens S. June 6, he was a no-excuse last of six at odds on, but appears to be working very forwardly at Saratoga since that outing. Nonna's Boy was second in Belmont's Gold Fever S. May 1, third in the Easy Goer S. there June 6 and finished ahead of stablemate Dontbetwithbruno to take Monmouth's turf LAMPLIGHTER S. July 18.

Dontbetwithbruno completed the Pegasus superfecta before his effort in the Lamplighter last out.

Donegal Racing's **Keen Ice** (Curlin) has only one lifetime victory, but has performed well in a number of graded stakes, including a third in the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 21 and fourth in the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 28. He was seventh in the Derby and rallied to complete the trifecta in the Belmont.

He doesn't run often, but when he does, he runs fast, and Rock Fall laid claim to the title of nation's best sprinter with a tough-as-nails victory in the Vanderbilt. The progressive short-tracker followed in the hoofprints of his sire, who gave trainer Todd Pletcher his only other Vanderbilt winner 11 summers ago.

Accorded '**TDN Rising Star**' status off a 9 1/4-length maiden score in an off-turf test last May, the \$250,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga graduate proved he could transfer that form over to a dry strip with a 3 1/4-length allowance tally the following month, but went missing thereafter. Workmanlike when the one-length winner of his Mar. 15 allowance comebacker at Gulfstream Park, he sizzled home the nine-length winner of a stakes-quality Keeneland allowance--MGSW Delaunay (Smoke Glacken) was third--Apr. 18, and took care of a half-dozen overmatched rivals by a facile 3 3/4 lengths in the June 5 GII True North S.

Off at even-money in search of the six-bagger, Rock Fall settled in the second flight of horses, outside of Salutos Amigos (Salute the Sarge) as Favorite Tale sped to the front, allowing The Big Beast to wait for him to clear and assume a stalking position. Allowed to

establish comparatively soft fractions of :22.74 for the opening quarter-mile and :45.31 to the half, Favorite Tale cut the corner and set sail for the wire, but was quickly under siege, as the hulking The Big Beast headed him off at the eighth pole. But Rock Fall, pulled out three deep at the head of the

lane, followed suit inside the final sixteenth of a mile and willed his way to the line first, to lead home a Rising Star triple.

"The bob could have gone either way; I was lucky it went my way," admitted Javier Castellano, remarkably winning the Vanderbilt for the first time. "He was a really nice horse the way he did it today, off the pace.

There was a lot of speed in the race and he covered up perfect. Turning for home I let him go outside; that's where he likes it, and it paid off today. My horse fought back to win the race. I give all the credit to him."

The winner's dam, the first stakes winner from her successful sire's first crop which also included Rachel Alexandra, scored a pair of stakes at two in 2008 before finishing runner-up in the GII Forward Gal S. in 2009. Renda, purchased by SF Bloodstock for \$130,000 with Rock Fall in utero at the 2010 Keeneland November Sale, has a 2-year-old colt of this season named Coup d'Oeil (Sidney's Candy) and is the dam of a yearling filly by Bodemeister, who sells during Book 2 of the Keeneland September sale. Rock Fall represents the first Grade I winner as a broodmare sire for Medaglia d'Oro.

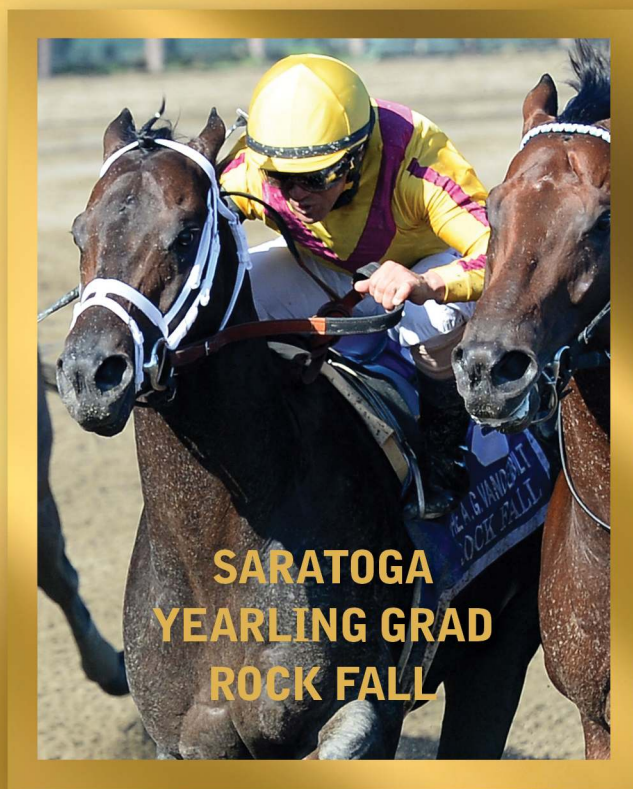

“We may take a look at the [GI] Pacific Classic [Aug. 22],” Mandella said. “It’s been in the back of my mind a while. The timing is good. We’re far enough away from the Breeders’ Cup to do it. It’ll be up to her and Mr. Hughes, obviously. I’ll have to get his approval.”

Winner in seven of her eight most recent trips to the post--the only blemish being a close fourth in the 2014 GI Ogden Phipps S. in New York--Beholder was more workmanlike than brilliant in winning her next

appearance in the 2014 Zenyatta, scoring by 3/4 of a length. She was struck by illness in the weeks thereafter, canceling not only a potential title defense of her GI Breeders’ Cup Distaff title, but also a trip to the Fasig-Tipton November Sale, and she instead called it a

season after just three starts. She kicked off 2015 the same way she did her 4-year-old campaign, with a handy score in the restricted Santa Lucia S. Apr. 10, but was forced to miss this year’s Phipps with a minor illness.

Much to the chagrin of five other females, she showed up instead in the GIII Adoration S. June 13, and came from just off the pace to take it by a 1 1/4-length margin that belied the ease with which it was accomplished.

Drawn in pole position for just the second time in her career, Beholder was not especially fast from the barriers and did not appear to be entirely comfortable while held up in fourth just to the inside of Yahilwa and behind the early speed of My Sweet Addiction (Tiznow). Keen beneath Gary Stevens as they made their way onto the backstretch, Beholder tugged her way up into a joint second, dropped back briefly into a three-wide third and was into a share of the lead by the time they reached the half-mile marker. Stevens could hold the 5-year-old mare no longer and allowed her to stride into the lead with a little more than three-eighths of a mile to travel and she soon had My Sweet Addiction hard at it to her inside. Yahilwa loomed up with a four-wide challenge at the head of the lane, but Stevens kicked Beholder into a clear advantage and she rolled home under a masterful and cool, calm and collected ride from her Hall of Fame jockey.

“She’s just amazing” said Stevens. “She’s scary. She’s just too much. This isn’t work, this is fun.”

Another of the Pletcher platoon to strike Saturday afternoon, Madefromlucky endured a difficult trip, but managed to outstay New Jersey raider Souper Colossal to better than double his career earnings in the GII West Virginia Derby.

Trained to a 4 3/4-length maiden win by John Mazza for owner Mac Nichol at Gulfstream Dec. 23, Madefromlucky had a new partner in the form of Cheyenne Stables' Everett Dobson and a new trainer in Pletcher when proving a 1 1/2-length allowance winner

in Hallandale Feb. 4. The distant runner-up to future Triple Crown hero American Pharoah (Pioneerof the Nile) in a sloppy renewal of the GII Rebel S. Mar. 14, the chestnut was a distant fourth to that one in the GI Arkansas Derby and connections opted to pass on a start in the

GI Kentucky Derby. The colt rewarded that decision with a one-length success in the GII Peter Pan S. May 9 and he was having his first run since a sixth in the GI Belmont S. June 6.

Drawn just to the inside of Souper Colossal in gate 10, Madefromlucky had less zip from the stalls than his naturally speedier rival and raced in that one's wake from seventh position, about four wide into the first turn, as Alliseeisgold (Purge) took them through ordinary fractions of :24.19 for the opening quarter and :48.67 to the half-mile. Souper Colossal made the first serious move leaving the 3 1/2-furlong pole and loomed up four deep under a confident Paco Lopez, but Madefromlucky was just a few lengths behind and Iron Fist (Unbridled's Song) was coming with a dangerous run further down towards the inside. The California invader split horses decisively with a little more than a furlong to race, but Madefromlucky and Souper Colossal were doing better work down the center of the track, with the former coming away late to a hard-fought tally. War Story flashed home from the tail of the field for third.

"We were lucky to draw the post that we did," commented winning jockey Joe Bravo. "I tried to take advantage of it and when we got to the top of the lane, I knew I could pick up the horses in front of me."

Pletcher also won the Vanderbilt and the Bowling Green Saturday at Saratoga.

The Dwyer form was further supported by Smart Transition (Smart Strike)'s victory in Friday's Curlin S. at the Spa, and Texas Red was the second wagering selection behind the Classic-placed Frosted.

With little other speed signed on in the scratch-depleted affair, Japan jumped well and tried to take the race by the throat early, but Texas Red--previously never closer than four lengths from the front at the first call in any of his races--had no other choice but to do the chasing from second, with Frosted three wide and to his outside. Japan had things very much his own way as he lobbed along through an opening four panels in :48.15, but Texas Red remained within easy striking distance a couple of lengths behind, with a similar distance back to Frosted in third. Kent Desormeaux was the first to come after the pacesetter, getting the jump on the more one-paced Frosted, and--despite cornering a fraction wide into the stretch--collared the front-runner with relative ease. Firmly in front at the eighth pole, he began reaching for the wire and stayed on well with a single left-handed crack of the whip in the final 50 yards. Frosted, giving the winner four pounds, was far from disgraced in second.

"He just galloped along to the quarter pole," said Desormeaux, who rides Texas Red for his brother and co-owner Keith. "I had so much left that I got to the [front] quicker than I thought I would. He kind of idled on the lead a little bit that last three sixteenths of a mile, but when challenged he had tons left. The most encouraging thing about the entire ride was the energy left galloping out. I think I'm sucking more wind than he is from the race."

Frosted's trainer Kieran McLaughlin was happy with the effort.

"Four-horse races are always tricky, but it will be a different race in four weeks," he opined. With a ground-saving trip, the versatile Red Rifle capped a particularly successful hour for conditioner Todd Pletcher, who had already scored in the GI Alfred G. Vanderbilt H. with Rock Fall (Speighstown) and in the GII West Virginia Derby with Madefromlucky (Lookin At Lucky). A winner of the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup H. on the main track to close out last season Nov. 29, the chestnut was third as the favorite in the GIII Mineshaft H. at Fair Grounds Feb. 21, and fifth in that venue's GII New Orleans H. Mar. 28. Stretched back out to 10 panels to finish a close second

behind last month's GII Suburban H. winner Effinex (Mineshaft) in Aqueduct's GIII Excelsior S. Apr. 25, he faded to a distant ninth behind Innovation Economy (Dynaformer), who sadly suffered a catastrophic breakdown in the Bowling Green. Red Rifle shipped to Woodbine to annex the GIII Dominion Day S. on the Polytrack July 1, and his connections opted to stay at the Spa rather than ship for Sunday's GIII Seagram Cup in Etobicoke.

Saving all the ground while unhurried after breaking from the rail, Red Rifle stepped into the pocket hitting the top of the lane. Javier Castellano encouraged his mount to charge through fading pacesetter Iron Power (Mizzen Mast) and Imagining, and he responded willingly, squeezing through that tight seam and kicking clear. "Beautiful trip--perfect trip," Castellano said. "I was able to take advantage all the way inside on the rail. In a long distance, on the grass, the most important thing is to save all the ground. And that's exactly what I did. He did it very professionally today and I'm very satisfied with the way he did it."

Pletcher added, "I think he's just maturing, mentally and physically. He's really just found his groove this year. I always felt, prior to this year, that he's a horse, when he gets things his way, 24, 48 [seconds], that he's very dangerous. But we've kind of stumbled onto a new dimension and decided that, for a race like this, there looked like plenty of pace. So we tried to save ground, take advantage of the one hole through three turns. He relaxed very kindly and rated nicely. It was a super ride and he delivered a big performance."

Of what could be next, Pletcher said, "He's now won big races on three different surfaces. He's just a throwback kind of horse, he's hardy, he's tough. He's a gelding now, we just need to look at the opportunities and place him where he fits. He won the Hawthorne Gold Cup last year, he just won a race on Polytrack at Woodbine and now on the turf. She is re-opposed by **Rizeena (Ire)** (Iffraaj {GB}), who was second in the former contest and also the Falmouth fourth and fifth **Bawina (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and **Fintry (Ire)** (Shamardal), respectively. “She’s been fine since Newmarket and got there okay--all is good,” O’Meara said. “She’s in good form and we’re hoping for a good run.” Bawina represents the Wertheimers, who enjoyed success with their elite performer Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) every year from 2008 to 2011, and looks the hard-luck story of the Falmouth. Running for the first time since taking the G2 Prix du Muguet over this trip at Saint-Cloud at the start of May, the homebred ran out of room at a crucial stage at Newmarket and ended up being just over a length behind the winner.

RICHARD HUGHES HANGS UP TACK

Saturday's Goodwood card marked the finale of the riding career of three-time champion jockey Richard Hughes, who will hang up his tack and shift his focus to a training career.

"I love racing, it's in my blood," said Hughes, who rode 2,440 winners in Britain over the flat and jumps. "No matter what I was doing, if I was driving the [horse] box, I'd still like it. I was very lucky to be a successful jockey and I want to go out on top. I look forward to my next career as a trainer and I'm very lucky to walk into it."

Hughes said he will likely start off with 10-15 horses with aspirations to gain more owners, as well as to pick up horses-in-training at the sales.

"Plenty of people have said they will send me horses; it's not set in stone, but I'll take their word they will send me some horses and I'm happy with that. I hope to end up with about 60 by Christmas."

Hughes, notoriously one of the tallest riders in the jockeys' room, began his career over jumps. He served his apprenticeship on the flat with his father Dessie Hughes.

Hughes moved to Britain in 1994 and was the retained rider to Khalid Abdullah from 2001 to 2007. He cites Khalid Abdullah's Oasis Dream (GB) (Green Desert) as one of the greatest he rode, but said Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}), whom he partnered under his agreement with Richard Hannon, was likely the best.

"If Oasis Dream got the mile it might have been a bit different, but he didn't, and Canford Cliffs was just a wonderful horse," Hughes reflected. "We'll probably never see another Coventry winner like it. He actually ran away with me in the Coventry and still won."

Hughes began his incredibly lucrative association with trainer Richard Hannon Sr.--also his father-in-law--in 2008, and has continued the partnership with Richard Hannon Jr. after the latter took the reins of the training operation last year. Among the luminaries he rode for that stable in addition to Canford Cliffs are the four-time Group 1 winner Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}), who gave him a first British Classic in the 2013 G1 1000 Guineas; champion miler Toronado (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}); and Group 1-winning miler Olympic Glory (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}). He also had successful partnerships with multiple Group 1 winners Sole Power (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}); The Fugue (GB) (Dansili {GB}); and Nebraska Tornado (Storm Cat). He also won the G1 Epsom Oaks in 2013 aboard Talent (GB) (New Approach {Ire}).

Hannon Jr. led the tributes to Hughes, saying, "He's been great; he hasn't missed a beat for years. He's been very reliable and massively important to our success. [Being part of the family] has made everything easier, as he's with us all the time--

Sunday lunches, socially and things like that." "It's always dangerous to compare people with Lester Piggott, but for us, he's been better than Lester Piggott," Hannon added. "A lot of the racing public won't agree with that, but for us he's been an example of a stable jockey, and we'll miss him."

Piggott himself weighed in, saying, "Having been a tall jockey myself I know only too well the challenges that Richard Hughes will have faced during his career. Despite being as close to six foot as any flat jockey would want to be, he has had an outstanding career. His style is elegant, his determination is steely and he is always so patient as a rider. It was a pleasure to watch him all these years."

Johnny Murtagh, another jockey-turned-trainer who stopped race riding in 2014, said, "Richard is a very good friend of mine and I know he's retiring at the right time. He's a great man, a great jockey and I'm sure he'll do a brilliant job training."

Ryan Moore, currently sidelined by injury, told *Betfair*, "It is strange to think that, when I return to race riding, Richard Hughes will not be in the weigh room anymore. Hughesie has had a massive influence on my career. Before I ever started riding, he used to ride for my dad. I used to love watching him ride. He was one of the riders that I used to watch closely before I started riding, and I watched him even more after I started riding."

"The weigh room will be a poorer place without him," Moore added. "I have no doubt that he will be very successful as a trainer. He is a deep thinker, he is clever and he is seriously motivated. I am sure that we will still see him lots."



**LATHARNACH COULD DROP IN TRIP**

Godolphin's Latharnach (Iffraaj {GB}), who pegged himself a horse to watch when second in the G1 St. James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot but failed to fire when third in the G3 Thoroughbred S. last week, could be set for a drop back in trip, according to trainer Charlie Appleby. Latharnach, who also bested the exciting Time Test (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) in a Sandown conditions event last September, was tackling a mile in his last two outings.

"We were a little bit disappointed," Appleby admitted. "The only thing we did different is ride him closer to the pace, whereas last time we rode him to finish second. He traveled well, but he just didn't go forward with his run. We are a little bit undecided what to do now, as to

whether to keep him at a mile or go back to seven furlongs."

Appleby said a potential target is York's seven-furlong Listed York S. at the Ebor meeting later this month. The conditioner also added that **Space Age (Ire)** (New Approach {Ire}), winner of Royal Ascot's King George V H., may be done for the year after finishing fifth in Glorious Goodwood's G3 Gordon S.

Futura bounced back from two recent off-the-board finishes to win Saturday's G1 Champions Cup, his fourth career Grade 1 victory. Futura kicked off his 5-year-old campaign with a win in one of South Africa's most important races, the G1 L'Ormarins Queen's Plate Jan. 10, and followed up in another prestigious contest, the G1 J&B Met, three weeks later. The bay returned from a four-month break to take Greyville's Pinnacle S. May 17, and was off the board for the first time in his career when fourth in that track's G1 Rising Sun Gold Challenge June 6. He filled the same position in the G1 Durban July a month later. With this card pushed back a week due to deteriorating track conditions caused by heavy rain, Futura was technically making his 6-year-old debut here. Off a beat slow, he stalked the pace in fifth in the two path through the early stages. Called on for his rally by Bernard Fayd'herbe as the field swung into the straight, Futura was under a drive to hold off the late thrust of Ice Machine down the center of the track.

Jerry Dutton, a prominent trainer on the California circuit for 50 years, died last Thursday in his native Idaho. He was 87. Dutton retired from training in 2006.
