DRAMATIC WHITNEY WIN FOR HONOR CODE

Honor Code (A.P. Indy), who stormed to a dominating victory in the June 6 GI Metropolitan H. last time out, added the GI Whitney S. to his resume with a dramatic late-gasp win over pacesetter **Liam's Map** (Unbridled's Song) Saturday at Saratoga. The Whitney is a "Win and You're In" race for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

"It was a spectacular race," said trainer Shug

McGaughey, who was winning his first Whitney since Easy Goer captured the historic race in 1989. "A spectacular horse. He's an amazing horse. He has been, really, from the start, from his maiden race here in the slop when it looked like he was hopelessly beaten,

and he won. He's really grown into himself. We're very excited and very happy about today. To be able to win a race like the Whitney is a big feather in our cap."

Honor Code, still facing lingering doubts about his distance limitations, gave fans further room to wonder when he refused to breeze over the Oklahoma training track last Sunday and was rerouted to work over the main track. But McGaughey's faith in the handsome dark bay never wavered.

"People have always held him in high regard, but wondered if he could run around two turns," the trainer said. "He's got some quirks about him, could he overcome them? I guess he answered all that today. I'm glad it's over with and I'm glad we won, so I don't have to worry about that part of it." *Cont. p3*

CAVORTING PASSES WITH FLYING COLORS

Stonestreet Stable's **Cavorting** (Bernardini) came from well back and bound clear late to score an easy 2 1/2-length victory in Saturday's GI Longines Test S. at Saratoga. "It's a great win," said winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "Grade I wins are hard to come by and it was a great team effort. It's great to win for [owner] Barbara [Banke] and her team also. The Grade I wins are most important for fillies, and it's great she's by Bernardini, who stands at Darley, who I train a lot of horses for. It's a win-win for everybody." Last year's champion juvenile filly **Take Charge Brandi** (Giant's Causeway), making her first start since winning the Jan. 31 Martha Washington S., set a moderate pace to upper stretch before fading badly and finishing 10th and last. *Cont. p5*

NYQUIST DOMINATES BEST PAL

Nyquist (Uncle Mo) continued the hot streak of owner Reddam Racing and trainer Doug O'Neill with a dominant display in Saturday's GI Best Pal S. at Del Mar. The 2-year-old became the second graded stakes winner for his freshman sire, 2010 juvenile champion Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie).

"I think it's safe to say he stays number one of our 2-year-olds," O'Neill, winning his third stakes of the Del Mar meet, smiled. "Physically and mentally, he's the best.

But you never know, things can change so quickly, good and bad, for 2-year-olds. If he stays injury-free, he's got the mind of a champ."

The Best Pal's field of six was away in good order, bar **Paynes Prairie** (Tale of Ekati), who swerved and looked to take an awkward step before dropping out the back. Fellow Reddam colorbearer **Found Money** (Square Eddie) was quickest of the bunch, but each of his rivals was tugging against their riders, as the opening sectional was posted in just :22.82. **Bistraya** (Haynesfield) tried to slide up the fence to prompt the pace, but Mario Gutierrez always had Nyquist ready to roll and edged up three wide into the lane.

Dramatic Whitney Win for Honor Code (cont. from p1)

Liam's Map sprinted out to the early lead and blitzed through fractions of :22.79 and :46 flat. Honor Code meanwhile was racing with the tailing group some 15 lengths off the pacesetter. Liam's Map shrugged off the challenge of defending Whitney winner **Moreno** (Ghostzapper) and set sail for home after three-quarters in 1:09.72. Honor Code, still 12 lengths off the pacesetter turning for home and five lengths back with a furlong to run, stormed past the tiring field while racing along the rail and produced a determined late rally to reel in the tiring pacesetter in the final jump.

"I don't have anything to do on my horse; that's his style," commented winning jockey Javier Castellano. "At the three-eighths, I felt like he was going to go to the leader and at the quarter pole, he didn't kick off. When he got to the eighth pole, he switched leads, on the right lead in the right place at the right time. He ran unbelievable, like he always does."

Trainer Todd Pletcher was far from discouraged by the performance of Liam's Map.

"I could see Honor Code was coming, so I knew it would be really close until the finish," Pletcher said. "He ran unbelievably well, setting those fractions to start and being there to the end. He just couldn't hold off a really good horse." **Cont. p4**

Tonalist (Tapit), favored by just over \$5,000 and who was racing with Honor Code through much of the contest, closed for third to complete a Rising Star trifecta. "We tried our best today, and that's it," said trainer Christophe Clement. "He ran a very good race, and we live to fight another day." John Velazquez, aboard the beaten favorite, added, "We got in the position we wanted to be in, and tried to make a run. It took a long time to get him going and other horse passed him. He finally started running at the quarter pole and then he kept running."

Honor Code, tabbed a 'TDN Rising Star' off an improbable debut victory at Saratoga in 2013, ran himself into Triple Crown consideration with a narrowly beaten runner-up effort in that year's GI Champagne S. and a win in the GI Remsen S. His sophomore campaign got off to a rocky start with a runner-up effort in a Gulfstream allowance and he was sidelined until taking a November optional claimer at Aqueduct. He opened 2015 with a win in the Mar. 7 GI Gulfstream Park H. over a one-turn mile and was a lackluster fifth in the May 1 GI Alysheba S. before his tour de force performance in the Met Mile.

Cavorting Passes with Flying Colors (cont. from p1)

Cavorting was unhurried out of the gate and raced at the tail of the field as Take Charge Brandi rushed up to set the pace through fractions of :23.21 and :46.21. Cavorting inched closer along the rail on the turn and swept out to the middle of the track for running room at the top of the stretch. Bar of Gold assumed command and opened a clear lead, but her advantage was short-lived as Cavorting was finding her best stride and reeled in that foe in the final sixteenth before striding home a confident winner.

“I thought it would be a faster pace early, but it worked out well,” said trainer Kieran McLaughlin. “I knew she was running and was hoping she would get space to run. She normally doesn’t like a lot of dirt in her face, but she was covered in dirt today. Irad [Ortiz, Jr.] rode a great race and she ran huge. She deserves a Grade I win and she got it. She’s a very nice filly.”

Bar of Gold, a 15-1 outsider, was producing a breakout performance Saturday after a troubled sixth-place effort in the June 6 GI Acorn S. and a fourth-place finish in the July 11 GIII Delaware Oaks.

“We wheeled her into the Acorn off of a couple of New York-bred wins and she got annihilated basically at the start,” explained trainer John Kimmel. “Then we marched her down for her first two-turn race and I thought she made a winning move there. She broke the track record that day and looked like she got flat the last sixteenth of a mile; I thought maybe just shorten her a little bit.

“She looks like her pedigree says run all day, maybe this is what she’ll do this year,” Kimmel continued. “Maybe next year she grows up a little bit, she’ll be able to carry herself a little further. She got me screaming a little bit. This was a good race. I was reminiscing about my first Grade I win, the Test with Twist Afleet.”

Tabbed a ‘TDN Rising Star’ after an 11-length debut victory at Belmont last July, Cavorting returned to capture the GII Adirondack S. in her second outing. She tired to seventh after setting the pace when stretched to a mile in the Oct. 4 GI Frizette S. and resurfaced with a dull ninth-place effort at that same distance in the Feb. 21 GII Davona Dale S. She regained the winning thread when reverting to six furlongs last time out with a 3/4-length victory in the June 5 Jersey Girl S. at Belmont.

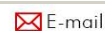
Cavorting’s dam Promenade Girl, who sold for \$1.125 million as a 5-year-old at the 2007 Keeneland November sale, brought \$335,000 while in foal to War Front at the 2012 Keeneland November sale. Her then-weanling colt by Stay Thirsty sold for \$240,000 at last year’s Keeneland November sale, while her then-yearling filly by War Front brought \$290,000 at the Keeneland September sale. The mare, who was a graded stakes winner and multiple Grade I placed on the racetrack while racing for her breeder Sondra Bender, produced a colt by The Factor this spring and was bred back to Uncle Mo.

Nyquist quickly put a few lengths on his foes and was never in danger from there, coming home 5 1/4 lengths as **Swipe** (Birdstone) made belated and green progress to finish just ahead of **Annie's Candy** (Twirling Candy). The final time of 1:16.84 was just 0.26 seconds quicker than the time recorded by 'TDN Rising Star' Young Brian (Hard Spun) in race three.

"It didn't really go as we thought, the pace was slower than we expected early," Doug O'Neill added. "But Mario got him settled down behind a slow pace and he finished strong and showed the quality that he is."

Asked if the Sept. 7 GI Del Mar Futurity would be next for Nyquist, O'Neill said, "I like the sound of that."

Nyquist's win was the second stakes win of the Del Mar meeting for J. Paul Reddam's Reddam Racing, which now has nine winners at the stand.

A \$400,000 purchase out of this year's Fasig-Tipton Florida March sale after breezing an eighth of a mile in :10 2/5, Nyquist fought every step of the way to earn a head decision over Annie's Candy in a five-furlong maiden at Santa Anita June 5. The winner's dam, Seeking Gabrielle, with this foal in utero, RNA'd for \$90,000 at the 2012 Keeneland November sale. In foal to Blame, she brought \$100,000 at the 2013 Keeneland November sale. Seeking Gabrielle produced a filly by the GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner in 2014, and was bred to Flatter this year. The mare is a half-sister to the dam of Grade I winner Sahara Sky.

The bay filly, twice group-placed in France for trainer Freddie Head, opened her campaign with Christophe Clement with an Belmont allowance victory last October and a half-length tally in Gulfstream's Dec. 13 South Beach S. She opened 2015 with a sixth-place effort in the Mar. 28 GII Honey Fox S. before runner-up finishes in Belmont's June 4 Intercontinental S. and Perfect Sting S. Making her first start on synthetics, Marbre Rose raced near the back of the field under a snug hold as pacesetter Endless Light set fractions of :23.22 and :46.06. Shaken up turning for home as the pacesetter kicked clear, Marbre Rose found running room late and burst into contention in the final sixteenth before just overtaking Endless Light in the last jump. Winning rider Alan Garcia reported he had received simple directions from trainer Christophe Clement, who was at Saratoga to saddle Tonalist (Tapit) to a third-place finish in the GI Whitney H. "He asked me to take her back and save all the ground I could and make one run at the top of the stretch," said Garcia. "He said, 'If you're good enough, you're going to win.'" Garcia was confident he had won the head bob. "I was comfortable that I got up," he said. "I was always comfortable with my filly. Her last two times she had a good kick at the end. I was waiting for the turn for home, looking for room, and letting her run." Marbre Rose's 3-year-old half-brother by Raven's Pass sold for 62,000gns (US\$100,124) at this year's Tattersalls July sale. Manerbe produced a colt by Frankel (GB) this spring.

Building on an impressive win in the Listed Steventon S. over 10 furlongs at Newbury last time July 18, 'TDN Rising Star' Intilaaq put up a power-packed performance to underline his still-untapped potential in this contest, often seen as a stepping stone to greater things. In hindsight, the decision by connections to supplement what was a raw colt for the G1 2000 Guineas was a mistake, with him trailing in 15th in that May 2 Newmarket Classic, but it was an understandable risk to take given his eight-length rout in a mile maiden at Newbury Apr. 18. Granted a break to regroup afterwards, the imposing homebred found a step up to 10 furlongs ideal in the Steventon and duly forced the G1 St James's Palace S. third Consort (Ire) (Lope de Vega {Ire}) to wave the white flag. In second initially before his natural strength carried him to the lead after three furlongs, the bay looked briefly under threat as Master Carpenter loomed approaching two out, but maintained his relentless top-end gallop to see off that rival without recourse to the whip.

“It wasn’t ideal having to make all the running. It was a shame he had to do the donkey work, but he did it well,” jockey Paul Hanagan commented. “He has got a lovely long stride and he relaxed lovely all the way round. I was really happy with him. He is improving all the time and we are really excited. I like him a lot.”

Richard Hills, who steered Nayef to success in this race 14 years ago before that celebrity went on to write his name in the stars, added, “He is a very similar horse to Nayef. We know Nayef was tough and had a good cruising speed. This horse quickens and lengthens and keeps building on it. I actually said to Roger last week that he was like Nayef. We are really excited.”

Trainer Roger Varian has Ascot’s G1 Champion S. in mind Oct. 17, but is looking even further ahead. “Whether he is a Champion S. horse this year, we’ll have to see,” he commented. “I think he is a horse who can win a nice race this year. Next year he is very exciting for all the top middle-distance races. I think we need to look to next year and build the horse to that.”

Off the mark at 20-1 on debut over six furlongs at Haydock June 10, Blue Bayou was that price again a month later when outrunning market expectations and finishing just a neck behind Illuminate (Ire) (Zoffany {Ire}) and the subsequent G3 Princess of Margaret S. winner Besharah (Ire) (Kodiac {GB}) in this track's G2 Duchess of Cambridge S. at that trip. Staying on strongly but running out of real estate on that occasion, the chestnut received due respect from the punters this time as she covered a more suitable distance and rewarded that faith to open her black-type account in tenacious fashion. Anchored in rear early by Dane O'Neill after being hampered at the start, she was delivered with her telling surge out wide to gradually wear down the positively-riden pair of Fireglow and Marenko passing the furlong marker. "I'm delighted with her; this race was the natural progression from the way she ran in the Duchess of Cambridge," trainer Brian Meehan said. "She's missed the break twice now, but that seems to suit her. She's a lovely filly who will just keep getting better. I can say she's as good a filly as I've trained; she's a proper filly and was very good today. She's a class performer and has the right temperament. There's more to come from her--she has the potential to be a Guineas filly. She's in the G2 Rockfel The Curragh Sept. 13] and she will get a mile. We'll take stock next week and take a view where we go next."

DON'T STOP ME NOW

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Muhaarar (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) is showing a voracious appetite for success in a sprinting scene he is poised to dominate, and the 3-year-old heads to Deauville on Sunday for the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. Despite his impressive win in the G1 Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot June 19 and battling display when adding the G1 July Cup to his tally at Newmarket July 11, trainer Charlie Hills is looking forward to sending him back up in trip for this 6 1/2-furlong test.

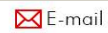
Intriguingly, Andre Fabre sends the Rothschild Family's 5-year-old mare **Esoterique (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) down in trip, having never tackled anything short of a mile. Last seen finishing second to Solow (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) in the G1 Queen Anne S. at that distance June 16, the homebred showed dash to win a tactical dawdle-and-sprint in last year's G1 Prix Rothschild here. "We want to see her over the shorter distance. It will be interesting to see how she performs," Fabre commented. "She ran a very good race at Ascot, but we feel, even though she has won over the distance, a mile stretches her a little bit. She could go back to a mile in the future, but we want to try this distance, just to see."

Richard Hannon is looking to get last year's summer juvenile sensation **Ivawood (Ire)** (Zebedee {GB}) back on track, having suffered five straight defeats since his wins in the G2 July S. and G2 Richmond S. Although two of those were fully excusable when stretched too far over a mile and finishing third in both the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas at Newmarket and The Curragh May 2 and May 23, his latest effort when 14th in the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot June 17 was a rare flop.

"This has been the plan for Ivawood for some time, as the 6 1/2-furlong trip looks ideal," his conditioner explained. "His one blip came in the Jersey S. at Royal Ascot, but he hit the wall soon after halfway and looked to be feeling the effects of those two cracking efforts behind Gleneagles in the English and Irish Guineas."

"We have freshened him up and he has thrived for the break, so we expect a big run from him," Hannon concluded.

Hannon also saddles the Aug. 31 G3 Prix de Meautry and Apr. 25 Listed Leicestershire S. winner **Coulsty (Ire)** (Kodiac {GB}), and he said of him, "He likes Deauville and deserves his place in the field, too. Obviously, this is a big jump up in class for him, but he has surprised us before and has the ability to do so again and get in the money."

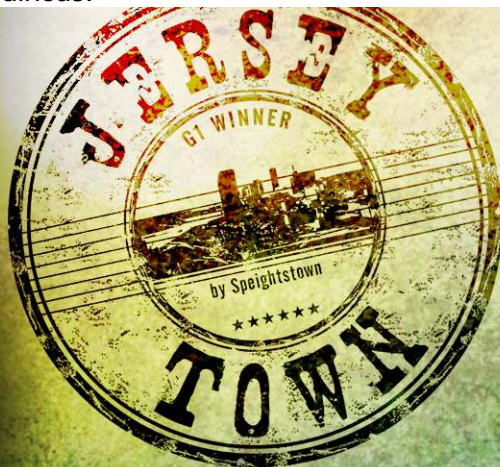

Tackling Aidan O'Brien in a race like The Curragh's G1 Keeneland Phoenix S. takes nerve, considering the stranglehold that the Ballydoyle conditioner has exerted over the juvenile feature in recent times, but Mark Johnston has never been one to duck a challenge, and he is in Kildare Sunday with a worthy opponent in **Buratino (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}). Having dismissed the apparent Rosegreen number one **Air Force Blue** (War Front) by two lengths in the G2 Coventry S. when last seen at Royal Ascot June 16, the already battle-hardened colt--who had also taken Epsom's Listed Woodcote S. by six lengths 10 days

previously--enters this test with the upper hand. "It is the best 2-year-old race of the season so far," Johnston commented. "Buratino won the Coventry, which is arguably the best 2-year-old race before August. He has been exceptionally well and this has been his target since Ascot. He is quite

an experienced horse for a 2-year-old, having had six runs, and he is coming back off what for him has been a long break."

O'Brien, who has garnered a record 13 editions since 1998, withdrew Air Force Blue from Glorious Goodwood due to the heavy rain that fell on the eve of the meeting and jockey Joseph O'Brien is happy that he will have his favored fast ground here. "He's a lovely, big horse and he's improving all the time--whatever he does this year is going to be a bonus. I think he's the classiest horse of our three and there's no doubt in a year's time he's going to be the best horse. My only worry is if the race is coming a bit early in his career, as he has a bit of progression to come yet."

Team Ballydoyle also field the June 27 G2 Railway S. winner **Painted Cliffs (Ire)** (Canford Cliffs {Ire}), who put the re-opposing **Rockaway Valley (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) firmly in his place when successful by 2 3/4 lengths in that course-and-distance contest.

Washington DC (Ire) (Zoffany {Ire}) was also scratched from his intended engagement at Goodwood and is no lesser light based on his win in Royal Ascot's Listed Windsor Castle S. over five furlongs last time June 16.

She was fourth off a seven-month layoff in the G1 Dubai Turf, and--after being controversially scratched behind the gates after refusing to load for the G2 Duke of Cambridge S. at Royal Ascot in June--was second behind the Duke of Cambridge and subsequent G1 Prix Rothschild winner Amazing Maria (Ire) (Mastercraftsman {Ire}) in the G1 Falmouth S. July 10.

'THE GIRLS' WIN SHERGAR CUP

Team 'The Girls' won Ascot's Shergar Cup for the first time Saturday. The team, comprised of Canada's Emma-Jayne Wilson and Britain's Hayley Turner and Sammy Jo Bell, earned 80 points to edge Team Great Britain and Ireland. Team Rest of the World finished third, and Team Europe was fourth.

"It's an amazing feeling--just amazing," said Wilson, team captain for The Girls. "I've got champagne all over me but that's exactly what I wanted at the beginning of the day. I'm so glad to have ridden a winner and, although my horse in the last race didn't quite get the trip, it was enough to win."

Bell earned the Alistair Haggis Silver Saddle Award for accumulating the most individuals points on the day, which included two victories. Bell had been filling in for the injured Cathy Gannon.

"I got the call on Wednesday to say that Cathy wouldn't make it for today and would I like to take her place," she said. "I admit I was a bit nervous coming into today, because I wasn't just riding for myself, I was on a team, and wanted to ride my best for the girls."

"This was the best day of my career," Bell added. "I can't believe the opportunity I was given and to ride two winners and win the Silver Saddle was just amazing."

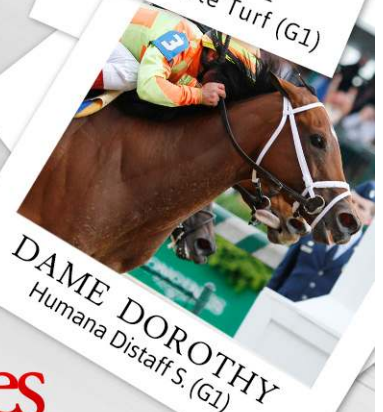
