BEHOLDER GOING FOR HISTORY AT DEL MAR

Some have tried before. All have failed. But of the four females who have faced the boys in the GI TVG Pacific Classic, only Paseana (Arg) had a fraction of the class of Spendthrift Farm's two-time Eclipse Award winner **Beholder** (Henny Hughes), who will take on the males and try a distance further than nine furlongs for the first time in the late-afternoon hours Saturday 'where the turf meets the surf.'

Paseana was the 17-10 favorite, but could not manage fifth behind Missionary Ridge in the second running of the race in 1992, a performance that ranks as the best by a member of

the fairer sex. Island Fashion, who was runner-up in the GI Santa Anita H., was ninth in 2005, while Amani (Chi) and Byrama (Fr) were sixth and seventh in 2012 and 2013, respectively, over the old Polytrack.

To try a female in a spot like this is the rarest of rare moves for Hall of Fame trainer Richard Mandella, whose three wins in the race includes Dare and Go's streak-snapping defeat of Cigar at odds of 39.60-1 before a record Classic-day crowd of 44,181 in 1996. Mandella also saddled Gentlemen (Arg) the following year and looks for his first score since Pleasantly Perfect landed the 2004 renewal. In Beholder, he believes he has the right animal to give him a fourth.

"I don't often do it, but I don't often get one as good as Beholder," the 64-year-old Mandella commented. "I think she deserves a chance to step up. It has been pretty easy for her for a year and she's not over-raced, so I think there's nothing wrong in trying and I'm pretty confident in her. She's pretty good."

Winner of 13 of her 18 trips to the post and out of the money just once on conventional dirt, Beholder most recently posted the seventh Grade I victory of her career under a brilliant ride from Gary Stevens in this track's GI Clement L. Hirsch S. Aug. 1, scoring by a dominant seven lengths.

"I think when you come to a point when you're winning in your own class so much, you probably ought to try something different," Mandella said. "That's what I'm doing. **Cont. p3**

TWO SHOTS FOR JONES IN ALABAMA

Trainer Larry Jones, who saddled 2008 GI Alabama S. winner Proud Spell (Proud Citizen), has two major chances at another win in the prestigious Saratoga affair Saturday. **Lovely Maria** (Majesticperfection), who carries the same green and orange Brereton Jones silks that Proud Spell did, finished second to stablemate **I'm a Chatterbox** (Munnings) in the Gill Rachel Alexandra S. at Fair Grounds Feb. 21. She was a clear-cut winner of the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 4, and took the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1 with similar ease. Backed at 30 cents on the dollar when returning in the July 11 Gill Delaware Oaks, she never threatened and settled for fifth.

"We used the Delaware Oaks to prep for here," Jones revealed. "All the horses down there went through a little sick spell. Some kind of a virus had gone through the barn and the race came back up a little more sudden for her than for I'm a Chatterbox. [Lovely Maria] hadn't quite gotten over the virus, but she's doing well now. She had two really good breezes for this. I think she's back." **Cont. p4**

Mandella will also send out **Catch a Flight (Arg)** (Giant's Causeway), a horse he has believed in ever since his import from Brazil late last year. Group 1-placed going 12 furlongs on turf in South America, the

October foal has kept a busy schedule and will be making his eighth start of the season Saturday. Winner of the GIII Precisionist S. May 2 and the GII Californian S. four weeks later, he bid prematurely in the GI Gold Cup at Santa Anita and weakened

to finish third behind **Hard Aces** (Hard Spun) and **Hoppertunity** (Any Given Saturday). The bay most recently defeated reigning GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Bayern** (Offlee Wild) in this track's GII San Diego H. July 25, and should appreciate the extra furlong and a half of this test. Flavien Prat takes over for Gary Stevens, who stays aboard Beholder.

Red Vine, a son of 2003 Classic winner Candy Ride (Arg), who sired last year's winner Shared Belief, is a new horse since being transferred to the main track, and if social media is to be believed, will go off nowhere near his 6-1 morning line. A maiden and allowance winner in a dozen turf tries, he annexed his first three starts on the dirt and could not catch loose-on-the-lead Bradester (Lion Heart) when second last time in the GIII Salvator Mile at Monmouth Park July 5. The bay, who should settle around midfield, drew gate five Wednesday morning.

"We're in the middle, which gives [jockey Joel Rosario] choices," opined assistant trainer Lee Vickers.

With Martin Garcia opting for Hoppertunity, Rafael Bejarano gets the call for Bayern, who controversially won last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic when last seen at this 10-furlong distance. His third-place effort in the San Diego was his first try around two turns this season, but he attended a modest pace that afternoon before fading in the final sixteenth of a mile. With the speedy **Midnight Storm** (Pioneerof the Nile) expected to go forward from gate 10, the question is can Bayern win that battle and the war?

I'm a Chatterbox, meanwhile, never off the board in five tries since being transferred to Jones from Ken McPeck at the beginning of the year, grabbed the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 28 before completing the trifecta in the Kentucky Oaks. She set the pace and hit the wire a nose in front of **Curalina** (Curlin) in the nine-panel GI Coaching Club American Oaks here July 26, but was subsequently placed second by the stewards for interference nearing the line.

"You always wonder when they run that big off a long layoff because she had had a couple of months [off heading into the CCA Oaks], but she appears well," Jones said. "Everything seems good."

Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' Curalina finished second on debut here in the mud last July, but has been a win machine since then. She broke her maiden at Gulfstream in March, and relished the stretch out to a route when romping in a Churchill optional claimer on the Kentucky Oaks undercard. Completely left at the start of Belmont's GI Acorn S. at a one-turn mile June 6, she rallied wide to get up over Grade I winner By the Moon (Indian Charlie). Backed down to odds-on in the nine-furlong CCA Oaks, she was relentless in the lane, and proved more distance was up her alley.

"We were very high on her last year, and everything she's done since coming back this year has been what we would hope for," offered trainer Todd Pletcher, winner of the last two Alabamas. "She seems to be getting better, and I believe the mile and a quarter should not be an issue for her."

Include Betty (Include), co-owned and bred by Brereton Jones, was eighth in the Kentucky Oaks and second with an extremely wide journey in Pimlico's GII Black-Eyed Susan S. two weeks later. She mowed them all down in the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont June 27, and came with her patented rally from out of the clouds to be third in the CCA Oaks--one spot ahead of **Danette** (Curlin).

We've given Brian DiDonato and Steve Sherack mythical \$2,000 bankrolls and told them they must bet at least 1% and no more than 10% of their stake in each flat Grade I run at Saratoga. The player with the highest bankroll at the end of the meet wins.

Aug. 8 - By the Moon (-\$100) sat the trip I was looking for in the Test, but failed to fire when it mattered most to finish third at 7-2... **Lea (-\$100)**, meanwhile, couldn't have run much worse in the Whitney, reporting home a distant sixth at 4-1... Not exactly the day I was looking for. **Bankroll: \$1805.**

GI Alabama S. - If Florent Geroux chooses not to be aggressive with I'm a Chatterbox, **Embellish the Lace** may find herself cruising on an easy early lead. The Super Saver half-sister to 2010 GI Travers winner Afleet Express posted a breakthrough performance in her 3-year-old bow at Pimlico in early June, then returned on short notice and got scorched in a supersonic pace in the GI Mother Goose. Tony Dutrow freshened her up, and she's been working smartly at Fair Hill and Saratoga since. The price will be right to see if she can steal it. Curalina is certainly a deserving favorite and is the clear-cut horse to beat. Will be boxing those two in the gimmicks. **Wager: \$44 to Win on #5 Embellish the Lace (10-1).**

Aug. 8 - Bar of Gold (-\$50) looked like a 15-1 winner at the top of the stretch, but ultimately settled for second in the Test. It was a bit frustrating, but was good to see the New York-bred finally run to her early promise against a tough bunch... **Tonelist (-\$100)** got going too late in the Whitney, and proved third best. How huge did runner-up Liam's Map run? **Bankroll: \$1700.**

GI Alabama S. - I admittedly felt a bit guilty for picking against **Include Betty**, my favorite horse in training, last time in the Coaching Club American Oaks. She ran well to be third that day in a race dominated by two runners who were up on the pace, and could get a better set-up here. The top two from the CCA Oaks return, and Sherack's pick Embellish the Lace is added to the mix. Embellish the Lace was part of the meltdown pace that set up Include Betty for a win at 5-1 in the Mother Goose. She's certainly talented, and has the pedigree for 10 furlongs, but seems too fast for her own good to me, and figures to help provide Include Betty with the pace she needs. I'll also use longshot Danette, who was running with Include Betty in the CCA Oaks and galloped out well in front. **Wager: \$170 Win on #6 Include Betty (8-1).**

'DUDE' LOOKS FOR TWO STRAIGHT IN O'BRIEN

Fresh off an 11-1 upset in this track's GI Bing Crosby S. July 26, **Wild Dude** (Wildcat Heir) will look to put them back-to-back in Saturday's GII Pat O'Brien S. at Del Mar, a 'Win and You're In' qualifier for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Keeneland Oct. 31.

Winner of the GII Palos Verdes S. in 2014, the Florida-bred held off a late bid from **Kobe's Back** (Flatter) in the GII San Carlos S. this past March, but dropped three straight thereafter. The bay rounded out the triple in the GIII Los Angeles S. May 27 and in the June 27 GI Triple Bend S. June 27, but rallied nicely to best long odds-on Masochistic (Sought After) and Kobe's Back in the Bing Crosby last time.

Appealing Tale (Tale of the Cat) was entered for the Bing Crosby, but was somewhat audaciously scratched from that spot in favor of the 8 1/2-furlong GII San Diego H. the previous afternoon. Exiting a runner-up effort in the Triple Bend, Appealing Tale alternated on the lead with Bayern in the San Diego and was able to put him away before just failing to hold off the longer-winded Catch a Flight (Arg) (Giant's Causeway). The narrow morning-line favorite has both disputed the pace and has laid off it in his other tries at this abbreviated distance and that versatility could serve him well in this spot.

The rail-drawn **Turnover** (Big Brown) and **Indexical** (Latent Heat) appear to be the ones that will set things up for the late-runners. The latter was frequently ambitiously spotted during his 3-year-old season and placed in a couple downhill sprints over the winter, but most recently earned a career-best 101 Beyer in winning a sloppy second-level allowance July 19. Martin Garcia will probably have to hit the gas from the one hole with Turnover, who couldn't keep pace with Indexical and finished a distant third to that one last time out.

DEL MAR 'CAP IS ANYONE'S RACE

A well-matched group of nine line up Saturday evening for the GII Del Mar H., a "Win and You're In" qualifier for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. Phil D'Amato saddles two runners, including defending champion **Big John B** (Hard Spun). The Michael House colorbearer was subsequently third in the GII John Henry Turf Classic at Santa Anita in September, but settled for fifth against much tougher in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf back in Arcadia. A puzzling last in the GIII Last Tycoon S. on seasonal debut Apr. 25, he bounced back to take a starter handicap June 28 and handled the switch to dirt to grab this venue's GIII Cougar II H. last out July 24. D'Amato also sends

out **Danas Best** (Aus) (Danasinga {Aus}), who excelled in his native country going longer distances such as this one. The bay gelding was a close-up fifth behind **Little Jerry** (Candy Ride {Arg}) and **Power Ped** (Powerscourt {GB}) in a 1 1/16-mile optional claimer here July 30. **Ashleyluvssugar** (Game Plan) turned a corner when put back on the turf this February, defeating eventual GI Shoemaker Mile winner Talco (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}). He added the GII San Luis Rey S. over **Finnegans Wake** (Powerscourt {GB}) Mar. 21, and bested **Ganesh (Brz)** (Sulamani {Ire}) in the GII Charlie Whittingham S. May 24. He took on some of the East Coast's best turfers in the GI United Nations S. at Monmouth July 5, and figures to appreciate this return to the West Coast. Finnegans Wake, winner of the GII Hollywood Turf Cup here in November, annexed the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic May 2. He was fourth in both Belmont's GI Manhattan S. and in the GI Gold Cup at Santa Anita on the dirt June 27, and rounded out the trifecta last time in the local nine-furlong GI Eddie Read S. July 18.

"It's hard to tell which one is better, but I will say that [jockey and son-in-law Jon Court] wanted to ride Will Munnings and these two take turns beating each other in the mornings," Fires said.

NO STANDOUT IN MONMOUTH OAKS

Saturday's GIII Monmouth Oaks produced the winners of the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff in consecutive years (Spain, 2000; Unbridled Elaine, 2001) and in 1999, Silverbulletday--the previous year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies heroine--gave trainer Bob Baffert his only victory in the race to date. While it is not exceptionally likely there is anything of that quality in this year's renewal, the 8 1/2-furlong test should prove challenging to handicappers.

Eskenformoney (Eskendereya) is the mild favorite on the morning line at odds of 7-2 and looks--on paper at a minimum--to be the class of the bunch. A close third in

the GII Davona Dale S. and second in the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks over the winter, the \$225,000 Keeneland September grad was well-beaten behind Lovely Maria (Majesticperfection) in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 1 and most recently dead heated for fifth

behind Include Betty (Include) in the GI Mother Goose S. at Belmont June 27. The waters are far shallower here and Eskenformoney gets Joe Bravo in an attempt to give trainer Todd Pletcher a fourth win in the race.

Chad Brown has yet to post a victory in the event, but in the form of Dell Ridge Farm's **Lady Serena** (Bernardini), he sends out unequivocally the most fashionably bred runner of the bunch. A close relative of MGSW and 'TDN Rising Star' Honor Code (A.P. Indy) and a half-sister to MGSW Noble Tune (Unbridled's Song), the homebred has really put it together in two starts since returning from Florida, winning her maiden by 7 1/2 lengths May 3 before adding a Belmont-eve allowance June 5. She tries a two-turn route for the first time here. The Brown barn is also represented by Belmont allowance winner **Delightful Joy** (Tapit), who will look to give her sire a second straight Oaks (Cassatt, 2014).

New Jersey-bred **Love Came to Town** (Medallist) could prove the exotics kicker. The Sleeter Family homebred was far too tough for state-bred rivals, winning six-furlong events by a combined 12 1/2 lengths in June and July, and showed she could handle a route of ground with a 9 1/2-length defeat of open rivals going a mile at Parx Aug. 3. The shape of this race could work in her favor.

Larry Jones saddled Cassatt last year as the team's fourth Monmouth Oaks winner in seven years. Calumet Farm's **White Clover** (Exchange Rate) posted a 7-1 upset of Delaware's Our Mims S. June 3, but was found wanting when seventh in that track's GIII Delaware Oaks July 11.

ATTFIELD RUNNER LOOKS LIVE IN COLLEEN

The top three horses on the morning line for Saturday's GIII Ontario Colleen S. at Woodbine are drawn in the three inside gates, but **City Wells** (City Zip) looks poised to post a mild upset from a wider barrier Saturday afternoon.

Unraced at two, 'Shel' Evans's homebred overcame a slow pace to graduate going 6 1/2 furlongs over the Polytrack May 2. Off to a studder-step start trying the grass for the first time July 1, the blaze-faced bay was a better-than-it-looked sixth, but she cut back to seven furlongs for her latest and rallied from last to score by a half-length July 24, stopping the timer in a smart 1:20.58. The added distance should be no issue, as her dam is an Irish-bred Sadler's Wells half-sister to champion Pleasant Stage (Pleasant Colony) as well as Colonial Play (Pleasant Colony), winner of the GII Orchid S. over 12 grassy furlongs.

But the favorites should have some say in the finish. **Don't Leave Me** (Lemon Drop Kid), the 2-1 choice, won the GIII Bourbonette Oaks over the Turfway synth in March and narrowly missed in the GIII Selene S. on this Polytrack May 24. Returned to the States for the GIII Regret S. June 13, the Pin Oak homebred was doing her best work late when fourth, beaten just under three lengths. The daughter of GISW See How She Runs (Maria's Mon) should find these easier to deal with.

Mississippi Delta (Giant's Causeway), closely related to Pin Oak stallion Cowboy Cal, also drops in class off an even seventh behind Mrs. McDougal (Medaglia d'Oro) in Saratoga's GII Lake George S. July 24. She'd been on the turf only once before that, but it was a good debut, as she ran out a three-length winner of the 6 1/2-furlong Alywow S. June 14.

If she can transfer her main-track form to the grass, **London Tower** (Head Chopper) can also not be dismissed. The Fury S. victress narrowly missed in the Woodbine Oaks and in the Bison City S., the first two legs of the Canadian Filly Triple Crown, in June and July, respectively, but finally got back to winning ways with a neck success in the Eternal Search S. July 29. While her pedigree doesn't scream turf, her paternal grandsire Mutakddim is a prolific sire of grass runners in South America, while dam sire Military, a son of Danzig, can also be a positive turf influence.

DIVINE INTERVENTION

Despite the main focus falling on **Acapulco** (Scat Daddy) in Friday's G1 Coolmore Nunthorpe S. at York, it was another filly who leapt into the limelight as David Metcalfe's **Mecca's Angel (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) managed to catch the American raider late on in a nail-biter of a renewal. Always lagging off the pace set by Irad Ortiz on the 13-8 favorite, the grey--who was second when odds-on in The Curragh's G2 Sapphire S. July 18--was gradually being worked up into her top gear by Paul Mulrennan. Seemingly in control and gone beyond recall inside the last quarter-mile, Acapulco felt the whip passing the furlong pole and Mecca's Angel sensed the opportunity and duly seized the lead 75 yards out en route to a commanding two-length success at odds of 15-2. "We've been talking about her all year winning a Group 1 and things haven't gone right, but she proved today she is the real deal," Mulrennan said. "She was buzzing down at the start, I got a lovely break and I always had the American horse in my sights. I think she'd probably stay six furlongs and win a July Cup on that ground. She is so tough and when the ground comes, she's special." **Cont. p8**

Showing above-average speed at two, Mecca's Angel took a lowly five-furlong nursery by 12 lengths on Southwell's fibresand prior to placing second in this meeting's Listed Roses S. and Ayr's Listed Harry Rosebery S., but it was not until her sophomore campaign that her natural pace was honed as the potent weapon it has become. After two visually exciting wins in a handicap and conditions race at Thirsk and Hamilton last spring, she proved a flop when only fifth in the Listed Prix Texanita over 5 1/2 furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte last May and was not seen again until the ground eased sufficiently for her at Doncaster's St Leger meeting in September. Just 10 days after a breakthrough win in that track's Listed Scarborough S., Mecca's Angel was at Newbury for the G3 Dubai International Airport World Trophy and duly followed up in impressive style before missing the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp due to the going being deemed too fast.

Back with another authoritative success in that venue's G3 Prix de Saint-Georges May 10, she was forced to sidestep the G1 King's Stand S. as the sun bore down on Berkshire and may have been undercooked when worried out of things by Stepper Point (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}) in The Curragh's G2 Sapphire S. July 18.

After the start was delayed by Take Cover (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) breaking through the stalls and running loose, Mecca's Angel was forced to lead those racing up the center, with Acapulco comfortably commanding affairs on the far side. Nothing was closing to any real effect passing the quarter-pole, with the Knavesmire crowd increasingly raucous as the American juvenile seemed to have killed off her elders, but Mecca's Angel kept grinding way in game fashion in no-man's land. As the margin narrowed a furlong out and Acapulco was coming to the end of her rope, the grey lowered her head and was finishing off too powerfully for any resistance. Owner David Metcalfe was basking in the glory that his bargain purchase had provided.

"He gave her such a fantastic ride and didn't panic.

This vindicated the decision not to run her at Royal Ascot," he said. "I know people were disappointed then, but she needs to get her toe in. This beats Royal Ascot, as it's our local track and it's got to be the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye [at Longchamp Oct. 4] now. I'd like to go back to Ireland first for the G2 Flying Five S. [at The Curragh Sept. 13]."

Trainer Michael Dods added, "It was a marvelous performance and it's great to have a Northern winner of the Nunthorpe. It's been worth waiting for and she's shown today she's a superstar. It was a lot of weight to give to Acapulco and it means a lot to everyone involved. For a 2-year-old to run a race like that, she is a super filly but it's nice to get our revenge. Paul said she'd get six, but I've no intention of stepping her up when she has shown she can do this over five."

Acapulco's trainer Wesley Ward was proud of the gallant effort of the runner-up and said, "She's a lovely filly and has done everything right. I think it was an amazing run and the ground was a little soft today. It was something she's not quite used to. We got beat, no excuses. It would have been great to win, but I'm very proud of her. I'll talk with everybody at Coolmore. She's got a big future in front of her. She's got a world of speed and there are big days for her in the future."

who was third for the John van Handenhove stable in the Listed Prix Francois Mathet and fourth in the G2 Prix Noailles in 2013--rewarded the guile of his trainer by spredeagling some established stayers here. Held up early in fifth as the Goodwood Cup hero Big Orange (GB) (Duke of Marmalade {Ire}) took up his customary position at the head of affairs, the gelding-- who sports the pink Rich Ricci silks so prominent in jump racing circles at the moment--was always traveling with notable ease and moved closer with the minimum of urging in early stretch.

Striking the front passing the three-furlong marker, Max Dynamite lengthened clear when shown the whip and galloped relentlessly to an emphatic score. "It was a top-class field and I knew he'd get me to the line and he won very well," his rider said. "He beat some very good horses very easily; you've got to say he'd be one of the favorites for the Gold Cup next year. I think the ground was key today, as he likes to get his toe in." Ricci added, "We had hopes he might be a Melbourne Cup horse and he was very good today. Willie is a genius and we thought he might improve, so we'll see what mark he gets in Australia. This horse was highly rated on the flat in France, but is not the best hurdler although he nearly won a Galway Hurdle."

Mizzou's trainer, Luca Cumani, was happy with the performance of the runner-up and accepting of the winner's authority. "He got his revenge on the Gold Cup horses, but when the winner went past him I wondered 'where did that come from?' He ran a cracking race. He won't go for the Melbourne Cup, but maybe next year."

Saeed bin Suroor revealed that Hidden Gold might be pointed at Doncaster's G2 Park Hill S. Sept. 10.

IN FINNEGANS WAKE

With the rain-softened ground threatening to exclude **Buratino (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) from Saturday's G2 Irish Thoroughbred Marketing Gimcrack S. at York, the way is open for one of the unexposed brigade to step up to the plate, and the most intriguing is the Wes Ward challenger **Finnegan (Ire)** (Unbridled's Song). Ruled out of a tilt at the June 16 G2 Coventry S. at Royal

Ascot after suffering a bout of colic the morning of the race, the impressive May 16 Pimlico maiden special weight winner has shown his trainer enough at home to suggest he has the requisite class. "He has breezed right with the filly [Acapulco]--both

of them in hand in their last few breezes," Ward said. "But every work, they work together. They're certainly at three-quarter speed, so it's tough to judge which one is better of the two. It is a shame he didn't get a chance to run in the Coventry. I think he was going to fire a cracker that day."

Buratino, who dominated the Coventry, has since been toppled off his perch when third in the G1 Phoenix S. on ground that had been compromised by rain at The Curragh Aug. 9, and connections are keen to avoid a repeat. "At the moment, Buratino is not a certain runner, having put his defeat in Ireland down to slow ground," Charlie Johnston, son and assistant to Mark Johnston, explained. "The plan is to take him to the track. We will walk the track and evaluate the ground. If there is any more rain overnight and the ground is good-to-soft, he is probably unlikely to run." **Cont. p10**

He continued, "If the ground was good or faster then he would take a hell of a lot of beating. Given what we know now, we are keen to avoid soft ground for the rest of the season. It is a tough decision to make, but we have got to do what is right by the horse."

With William Haggas's team in outstanding form this week, respect is due to his pair of contenders headed by Saleh Al Homaizi and Imad Al Sagar's **Ajaya (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). Second in the G2 Prix Robert Papin over 5 1/2 furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte last time July 26, he has stronger form claims than his unbeaten stable companion **Raucous (GB)** (Dream Ahead), but the latter will be suited by any further rain after winning on soft at Sandown June 12 and at Newmarket July 25.

"The ground was a bit too soft for Ajaya in France, but Graham Gibbons really liked him when he won at York and I think he'll run well," their trainer said. "Raucous maybe isn't quite ready for a test like this. He will be a nice horse in time, but this might just come too soon."

TRAINER BANNED FOR COBALT POSITIVE

New South Wales, Australia-based trainer Kevin Moses has been banned for 12 months as a result of a cobalt positive returned by a runner under his care Apr. 16. Moses has not been charged with administering the cobalt, and claims he did not knowingly administer it and intends to appeal.

"I've never touched cobalt," Moses told the inquiry. "Why would I hit a \$7,000 horse in a [benchmark 75 race] with it?"

Moses's wife and stable foreman Jenny Moses told the inquiry the horse in question, Felix Bay (Aus) (Song Of Tara {Aus}), had received vitamins the night before the race.

"I never read the warnings because we don't use [cobalt]," Jenny

Moses said. "I didn't know so many products had it in them."

Ray Murrhly, chief steward of Racing NSW, told Moses and the inquiry, "the responsibility is with you to know what is in the stable products and to read all the necessary publications. How, what, where and why has not been established and you have not been charged with administration, but a cobalt positive brings a certain amount of discredit to the industry."

Moses has trained since January 2002 and had not previously been charged with any other offences.

The full-sister to this year's miling sensation Gleneagles (Ire) and last year's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas heroine Marvellous (Ire) faces eight rivals in the race in which her barnmate Found (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) was successfully introduced 12 months ago en route to Group 1 glory.

CHINESE INVESTMENT STRONG AT INGLIS

The Inglis August Thoroughbred Sale enjoyed a successful renewal Friday, with figures improved across the board and a large crowd of diverse buyers. A total of 205 horses changed hands for A\$2,440,700, up from 228 sold for A\$1,954,750 12 months ago. The buyback rate dropped to 7.7% from 10.9%, and the average was up 23.6% to A\$11,906. The median climbed 80% to A\$4,500.

"We couldn't be more pleased with the day," said Inglis's Victorian Manager Simon Vivian. "Significant increases in aggregate and average from the 2014 sale were very satisfying and the exceptional clearance rate is evidence that buyers really appreciated the quality of product on offer."

Yu Long Investments was the sale's leading buyers, purchasing 11 lots for A\$602,900, including the three top-priced offerings. The leading lots of the day was [lot 118](#), the 5-year-old Group 3-winning mare Mamwaazel (Aus) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), who was sold for A\$200,000 from the Chris Waller stable. She will now be trained by Mick Price.


"Jin Tian, Inglis's China Representative, assisted with the sale to Yu Long Investments, which has been a supporter of our stable for the past three years," said Luke Wilkinson, Bloodstock Manager for Mick Price. "We are delighted to have the horse in the stable. She will spend the next fortnight at Rockmount and then we will see where we're at with her. We are aiming to race her over the summer, but we'll know more once we get her in our system and get a feel for her."

Yu Long also picked up the 7-year-old gelding Our Voodoo Prince (GB) (Kingmambo), best known as the first foal out of champion racemare Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}), also the dam of dual Derby winner Australia (GB) (Galileo {Ire}).

Catalogued as [lot 163](#), Our Voodoo Prince--who is a Group 3 winner Down Under and won a Caulfield handicap last week--sold for A\$140,000 and will be trained by Darren Weir along with another stakes-winning gelding, the 6-year-old Rugged Cross (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) ([lot 166](#)), who was picked up by Yu Long for A\$100,000.
