STONESTREET GOES CAVORTING AGAIN

Stonestreet Stable's **Cavorting** (Bernardini) registered another brilliant run at Saratoga in Sunday's GII Prioress S. The filly added to her GII Adirondack S. and recent

GI Test S. victories to boast a perfect three-for-three record at the Spa. The prohibitive favorite was away best of them all, but settled to stalk the pace about two wide as **Ekati's Phaeton** (Tale of Ekati) led the way through fractions of :22.35 and :45.35.

She improved her position and asserted for the lead as she angled out five wide on the bend. Cavorting took over in midstretch and pulled clear to finish three lengths ahead of **Bar of Gold** (Medaglia d'Oro), who was also runner-up to Cavorting in the Test. It was 2 3/4 lengths back to **Fusaichi Red** (Fusaichi Pegasus) in third. The Prioress was the second Saratoga graded stakes win in as many days for Stonestreet Stables, which was represented by 'TDN Rising Star' Rachel's Valentina (Bernardini) in Saturday's GI Spinaway S. HOPEFUL HAS DARTBOARD FEEL

Pick a number, any number, and you could be a winner, as Monday's GI Hopeful S. at Saratoga has a definite wide-open air about it.

Each of the eight runners has posted a Beyer Speed Figure of between 72 and 77 and it isn't hard to envision several horses on the wire together.

Sticksstateladydude (First Dude), one of a surprising seven first-crop winners for his freshman sire (by Stephen Got Even), looks to have as much upside as anyone in this seven-furlong affair. The Virginia-bred outran debut odds of 8-1 to finish a strong second in a highly rated Churchill maiden June 27 for trainer Greg Burchell and was saddled by Kieran McLaughlin in an Aug. 1 heat at this track. Settled off a generous pace that afternoon, he swung up

four wide into contention, but got to playing a bit inside the final furlong. He looked an unlikely winner at the sixteenth pole, but came out and dug in gamely to best subsequent Spa maiden winner Ready Dancer (More Than Ready) by two lengths. Burchell handles the training duties again here. Cont. p6

G2 York S. over 10 furlongs July 25, the chestnut was held up in last early and was brought stand's side as the field fanned out at the top of the stretch. Surging to the front with just over a half furlong left, the 6-4 favorite was given three smacks with the whip to make sure and hit the line with 1 3/4 lengths to spare over the filly **Nightflower (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}). One of France's premier middle-distance Classic hopes last spring, Prince Gibraltar was on a roll entering the G1 Prix du Jockey Club after taking the 2013 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud and G2 Prix Greffulhe also at that venue last May. 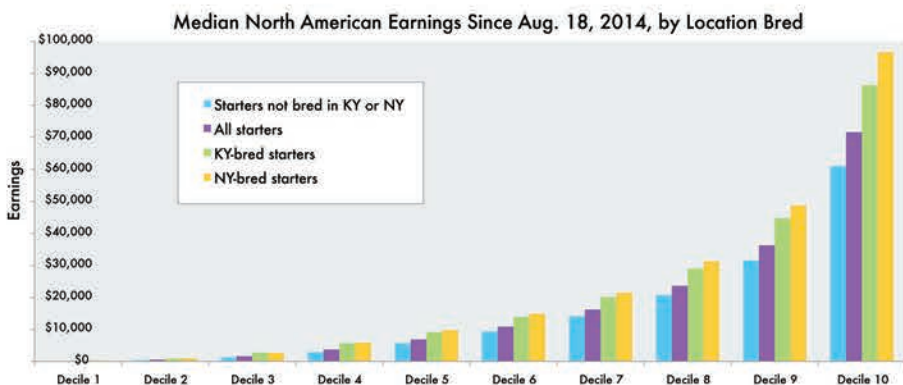

"Great trip," winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said following the victory. "She broke so sharp and [jockey] Irad [Ortiz] rode her great. She loves it up here at Saratoga, as we all do, but she's 3-for-3 up here, so this was great. She was sitting close from the start and there was enough speed up front so it worked out well. We'll train her up to the Breeders' Cup from here because she likes a little more space between races."

Ortiz was equally impressed with Cavorting's performance.

"Last time, she broke a little slow, but we were confident in the filly," Ortiz explained. "Kiaran said, 'Let her break and be wherever she's comfortable.' She broke sharp, so that helped me. I let the speed go and followed the speed. When I asked her, she was there. I give credit to the trainer; she's not an easy horse to train. She's tough in the morning and he really does a great job with her. She's doing unbelievable right now."

Cavorting was tabbed a 'TDN Rising Star' after her 11-length debut romp at Belmont last July before she annexed the Adirondack that August. The Stonestreet colorbearer was bumped at the start of the GI Frizette S. in the Belmont slop and finished a well-beaten seventh trying a mile Oct. 14. The bay returned from an almost four-month hiatus to finish ninth in the GII Davona Dale S. in Hallandale Feb. 21. She was back in top form to take Belmont's Jersey Girl S. when cutting back to six furlongs June 5, earning a career best -0 1/2 *Thoro-Graph* figure, and won the Test with a 2 *Thoro-Graph* figure Aug. 8.

Om garnered his first graded score Sunday in pillar-to-post fashion in the GII Del Mar Derby. The chestnut got off the mark in his second career start, besting subsequent Triple Crown winner American Pharoah (Pioneerof the Nile), over the Del Mar synthetic last August. He returned to the races with a flat fifth in the San Pedro S. at Santa Anita Apr. 12 and took to the turf when he annexed a one-mile optional claimer in Arcadia Apr. 12. Om was put back on the dirt for the 1 1/16-mile stretch out in the GIII Affirmed S. and weakened to third behind Gimme Da Lute (Midnight Lute) June 7. He returned to the grass last time out and was runner-up to Prospect Park (Tapit) in the GIII La Jolla H. here Aug. 9. Sent postward as the third choice while removing blinkers for the first time in his career, Om went straight to the front and coasted along on the lead through fractions of :23.58 and :47.71. Asked for more as Prospect Park challenged for command on the turn, he responded well and kicked home to a decisive victory. Royal Albert Hall finished best of the others to complete the exacta. **cont. p5**

She tallied her third career win in wire-to-wire fashion in a Churchill optional claimer May 30 and was fifth in the rained-off Ellis Park Turf on the 4th of July. She returned to the winner's circle in an optional claimer here Aug. 6.

The bay rated towards the back of the pack about three wide down the backstretch through the opening stages of this one. She was parked widest of them all when she began to take closer account heading into the turn. She's Not Here circled the field on the bend, battled with Prize Exhibit down the lane and edged free late to earn the victory.

"She travels really well and she's one of those fillies that's very versatile, that's why we brought her out here," said winning trainer Victoria Oliver. "The plan was to run in an allowance race and then the Yellow Ribbon and it worked out.

It doesn't always, but this time it did. I didn't think there would be as much pace because there was only one speed horse, but they went pretty quick up front. She had to circle wide, but she likes being on the outside and Mike (Smith) rode her perfect."

She's Not Here is closely related to champion Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}). She's the third foal out of Where's Bailey (Aljabr), a half-sister to Zenyatta. Where's Bailey has a 2-year-old unraced colt by Street Cry named Richmond Street and was bred to Street Sense this year.

Jockey Mike Smith, who was Zenyatta's regular rider, said the filly danced like Zenyatta in the post parade. "They told me that when she ran, she would start dancing in the parade, just like Zenyatta used to do," Smith said. "When I rode her last time, she never danced. But today, as we were coming through the tunnel, she started to dance. I said; 'Oh, oh, here we go.' We had a perfect trip; it couldn't have worked out any better. This was a real good one."

The former set a modest pace and looked to be on his way to success when he ducked out at the furlong grounds, causing a few of his rivals to steady slightly. He came home a 3/4-length winner from Uncle Vinny, but stewards ruled the interference was enough to cost Percolator (Flashy Bull) a spot and demoted Magna Light to third. The Rudy Rodriguez runner outworked five others to earn the five-furlong bullet Aug. 29 and will be under the gun early from the inside stall.

Uncle Vinny validated prohibitively short odds on his May 21 debut, but was a troubled sixth in the June 5 Tremont S. at Belmont ahead of his Sanford effort.

Cheyenne Stable's Everett Dobson has Oklahoma roots and named **Sallisaw** (Exchange Rate) for the town, population 8,650, not far from the Arkansas border. The bay drew the outside stall for his Aug. 15 bow going 5 1/2 furlongs here and tracked a slow tempo before grinding his way to a 3/4-length success in a race where the seven runners were covered by just over three lengths.

"He broke [widest in a field of seven], was out in the clear and ran very well to win," McLaughlin said of Sallisaw. "In this race, he's two of eight, and we'll see how it goes with the inside post. He does everything right. He's very professional."

Bullet Gone Astray (Gone Astray), whose Florida-based sire is also off to a strong start at stud, defeated Gulfsteam maidens in the slop June 28 and made it two straight with a nine-length defeat of much softer in the Aug. 1 Mountaineer Juvenile S.

A \$70,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase, the bay breezed an eighth of a mile in a slick [:10 flat](#) and was knocked down to Richard Templeton's Doubledown Stables for \$320,000 at this year's OBS March Sale.

Nyquist (Uncle Mo) is strictly the one to beat off his 5 1/4-length thrashing of **Swipe** (Birdstone) and **Annie's Candy** (Twirling Candy) in this track's GII Best Pal S. Aug. 8. A \$180,000 Keeneland November weanling and \$230,000 graduate of last year's September sale, Nyquist reached out well to cover a furlong in [:10 2/5](#) over the Gulfstream main track and was purchased by Paul Reddam for \$400,000 out of the Fasig-Tipton Florida sale this past winter.

With a dozen Futurities to his credit, including American Pharoah (Pioneerof the Nile) last year, trainer Bob Baffert saddles two this time around, each of whom have several lengths to find with the top three or four runners. **Mt Veeder** (Ghostzapper) looks the more likely of the duo, having showed good debut speed to break his maiden by a little more than two lengths Aug. 15. Despite the relatively quick turnaround, the chestnut has posted a pair of works, including five furlongs in 1:00 2/5 Sept. 1. **Nightly News** (Misremebered), one of two maidens in the field, has the rail draw to overcome and exits a runner-up effort over a mile Aug. 26. With Martin Garcia sticking with Mt Veeder, Rafael Bejarano takes over on Nightly News.

CONSTITUTION LOOKS LOOSE IN TURF DEBUT

'TDN Rising Star' Constitution (Tapit) is the only Grade I winner signed on for Monday's GII Bernard Baruch H., and--if he takes to the grass, an obvious unknown--looks to be the chief speed in what looms a stepping-stone to bigger days back on the main track over the coming months.

Last year's GI Florida Derby hero, the 4-year-old completed a sophomore trifecta in the GI Clark H. to end 2014 and returned to his favorite track to annex the GI Donn H. in front-running fashion in his lone appearance this season in February. Though there is not a great deal of turf in his female family, the combination of class and what appears to be a significant

tactical advantage could win the day.

"We initially planned to run in an allowance race that didn't fill, we're trying to look for a race to prepare him for the [Oct. 3 GI] Jockey Club [Gold Cup] and we felt like this would be a little bit easier on him than the Woodward," trainer Todd Pletcher explained.

Ironicus (Distorted Humor) can continue on a trajectory towards the GI Breeders' Cup Mile with a good performance here. After rolling to a 7-1 upset in the GII Dixie S. on Preakness Day May 16, it looked like the Janney homebred could go for spots like the GI Manhattan S. and GI Arlington Million, but he has been kept at a mile since. A tidy allowance winner over the trip downstate July 8, he was fanned wide at the top of the stretch in the GII Fourstardave H. Aug. 15 and kept on well to drop a narrow decision to Grand Arch (Arch). Javier Castellano sticks with the proven turf commodity over Constitution.

"He's had a couple breezes since [the Fourstardave] and we're ready to go," trainer Shug McGaughey said. "Hopefully, we'll get more pace in the race. That's going to help, and another sixteenth of mile is going to help as well."

Vyjack (Into Mischief), a half-brother to one of the meet's tough-luck horses in Tepin (Bernstein), has run well in his two turf tries while pace-compromised on both occasions. Runner-up to King Kreesa (King Cugat) when that one was gifted the lead in the GIII Poker S. June 13, he was forced to settle for third to that free-wheeling rival in the July 11 Forbidden Apple S. at Belmont. He may have his day on the grass at some point, but faces a similarly cloudy pace scenario here.

The 4-year-old colt, who was an \$800,000 Keeneland September purchase for Teresa Viola Racing Stables, boasts a career record of 7-5-2-0 with \$808,940 in career earnings so far. The gray ran four times during his sophomore season, which was highlighted by a win in Gulfstream's Harlan's Holiday S. This season he annexed an optional claimer at Belmont in June before finishing a game second in the GI Whitney S. Aug. 8. He will likely make his next start in either the GI Breeders' Cup Classic or GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile.

"We're really excited about being a small part of the ownership with Teresa and Vinnie Viola," West Point's Terry Finley told *Thoroughbred Daily News*. "The opportunity presented itself before the Woodward and it came together very quickly. We've had some good horses together and we've developed a really good relationship, so it was a very straightforward deal. He's shown he's a pretty talented colt and that's certainly a huge understatement. He's been brilliant in every one of his races and we were there when Vinnie bought him as yearling and they've done a great job developing this horse. This is just the right team that you want to get on board with, that's for sure."

Saturday - No shame in Tap to It (-\$200) rallying for a valiant second behind Rachel's Valentina in the GI Spinaway S... **Effinex (-\$75)**, on the other hand, never mounted any kind of rally while posting a disappointing fourth in the GI Woodward S... **Bankroll: \$1,879.**

GI Hopeful S. - Although he didn't run off by a big margin or earn a flashy speed figure, **Sticksstatelydude's** Spa maiden breaker at second asking was visually impressive enough to make him a major player here. A debut second after pressing the winner throughout at Churchill in late June, he displayed different tactics last time. Seventh in the early going, the son of First Dude began to launch while four wide on the far turn. With Joel Rosario aboard, the Va-bred altered course no fewer than three times down the lane while racing greenly and finished up full of run to bring it home by two lengths, including a very strong gallop out. It appears that he's exiting a live race, too. The runner-up Ready Dancer returned to earn his diploma for Pletcher in late August, and the fourth-place finisher Isotherm resurfaced to graduate going long on the lawn three weeks later. While the 12-1 morning-line quote seems impossible, Sticksstatelydude should still go off at a square enough number in this wide-open affair and figures to have no problem handling the extra furlong as well. With Kieran McLaughlin and Greg Burchell alternating training duties, he has worked a nice trio of four-furlong breezes since. **Wager: \$150 Win on #3 Sticksstatelydude (12-1).**

Saturday - Tap to It (-\$200) came with a big run in the GI Spinaway S., but fell just short of Rachel's Valentina. Looking forward to seeing that talented pair square off again in the future. **Protonico (-\$40)** simply never made an impact in the GI Woodward after getting hung wide into the first turn. **Bankroll: \$1801.80.**

GI Hopeful S. - Since I've been following Saratoga, I can't recall a less flashy crop of juvenile males than this one. There isn't a single blowout maiden winner signed on here, and the runners coming out of stakes races have all run well enough so far, but don't really feel like world beaters. I'm going to hope that **Set the Trappe** can earn his diploma the hard way. The \$300,000 Fasig-Tipton Saratoga yearling did all the dirty work in his Aug. 8 unveiling, only to get run down by a perfect-trip winner late. Runners from the first crop of sire Trappe Shot have so far seemed to step forward in their second outings, and conditioner Tony Dutrow--who's having a very good meet--does extremely well with babies who have a start under their belts, especially here. He's won a number of graded stakes for juveniles at Saratoga in recent years, and while those runners had already broken their maidens, they were also all second timers who stepped forward significantly from a speed figure perspective. **Wager: \$180 Win on #4 Set the Trappe (8-1).**

GARY PIMENTEL PASSES AWAY

Gary Pimentel, the longtime Thoroughbred yearling manager at Hermitage Farm, Three Chimneys Farm and Gainsborough Farm, died at his home near Knoxville, Tennessee Sept. 3 following a long illness. He was 66. Pimentel started at Hermitage as a foreman in 1977. He became yearling manager and then assistant farm manager before moving to Three Chimneys in 1984.

When Pimentel joined Three Chimneys, owner Robert Clay and farm manager Dan Rosenberg were just getting into the sales consignment business. By the time he left in 1999, Three Chimneys was perennially one of the top five consignors at Keeneland.

“Gary was a key member of the Three Chimneys team as yearling manager in our formative years,” recalled Clay. “He was a true professional, whose loyalty, dedication, horsemanship and good wit made all of our lives richer for having known him. We have lost a great friend.”

Dan Rosenberg remembered, “Gary was a consummate horseman, but even more importantly, he was a teacher and mentor. The lessons came at the horse barn and the soccer field, and frequently delivered with a laugh, but were life lessons. Anyone who knew Gary will carry a bit of him through the rest of their life, and very likely pass along a bit of Gary to the lives they touch. Gary was that kind of person.”

Pimentel left Three Chimneys to become the yearling manager for Sheikh Maktoum al Maktoum’s Gainsborough Farm. In 2004, he returned to his native Bermuda to operate a landscaping business with his brother. He and wife Caron moved back to the U.S. after the death of his mother about eight years later.

In addition to his wife, Pimentel is survived by two sons, Fred and McClain; a daughter, Patricia; and numerous other loving relatives. The family will receive friends from 6-7 p.m. Sept. 10 at Woodlawn Christian Church in Knoxville, followed by the funeral service at 7 p.m. Interment will be at 11 a.m. Sept. 12 at Bluegrass Memorial Gardens on Harrodsburg Road in Nicholasville, KY. In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to Young Life Knoxville Camp Scholarships.

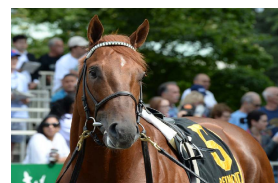

June 20, the bay was second in the G3 Summer S. over this course and distance July 10 before filling third spot in Newmarket's Listed Hopeful S. eight days ago. Anchored behind the speed up the center of the track early, she was delivered widest of all by Jamie Spencer to gain the lead with 100 yards remaining and grind out a belated follow-up black-type score. "She's been unlucky and is showing all the right signs at home," trainer George Margaron said. "We changed from blinkers to a visor and it's worked."
