This year's 3-year-old filly division has been mostly a revolving door, with Lovely Maria (Majesticperfection) tossing her hat into the ring early in the season with scores in the GI Ashland S. and GI Kentucky Oaks back to back. Curalina (Curlin) announced herself as a

possible title contender courtesy of her victories in the GI Acorn S. and GI CCA Oaks (via DQ), but Embellish the Lace (Super Saver) doused those flames, at least somewhat, with a coast-to-coast tally in the GI Alabama S. All the while, I'm A Chatterbox (Munnings) has been

lying in wait, a Grade III and a Grade II to her credit over the winter before placings in the Kentucky Oaks, the CCA Oaks and the Alabama. The homebred's comprehensive success in Saturday's Cotillion S., the final age-restricted Grade I on dirt, keeps her in the discussion for year-end honors. **Cont. p4**

FROSTED OUTCLASSES PA DERBY RIVALS

Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin's day started out at Belmont, where he saddled the \$2.2-million 2014 co-Keeneland September sale-topper Mohaymen (Tapit--Justwhistledixie) to a determined debut victory at Belmont Park for Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Stable. His day ended in suburban Philadelphia at Parx Racing, where **Frosted** (Tapit), a homebred raced by Sheikh Hamdan's brother Sheikh Mohammed, sat a midfield trip and proved two lengths too tough for eight other rivals in the \$1-million GII Pennsylvania Derby. **Cont. p3**

KEESEP NUMBERS UP AFTER BOOK 2

Trade at the marathon Keeneland September sale remained strong at the conclusion of Book 2 Saturday, with session-to-session, book and cumulative statistics all up from 2014. Top price of the day was the \$485,000 paid by Steve Castagnola's Kempton Bloodstock on behalf of the Albaugh Family Stable for a son of Mineshaft consigned to the sale by Betz Thoroughbreds, Inc. as [hip 1356](#).

A total of 267 horses sold Saturday for combined receipts of \$32,095,000. Yearlings brought an average of \$120,206, up 5.7% from last year's final Book 2 session, which took place one day later in the sale due to Book 1 being held over four days as opposed to three this year. The session median rose 11.11% to \$100,000. The RNA rate rose this year from 27.45% to 31.51%.

For Book 2 overall, 525 head brought \$70,557,000 for an average of \$134,394 and median price of \$105,000. The Book 2 average represented a 14.12% increase in last year's tally of \$117,766, while the median rose by 16.67% to \$105,000. The Book 2 buy-back rate in 2015 was 27%. **Cont. p13**

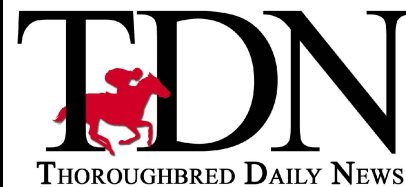

Frosted Back in the Win Column...

Unlucky not to close 2014 as the winner of the GII Remsen S., Frosted entered his sophomore season with high expectations, and if a runner-up effort to **Upstart** (Flatter) in the GII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Jan. 24 was not a cause for panic, a fourth after looking every bit a winner in the GII Fountain of Youth S. Feb. 21 was, so it was back to the drawing board. McLaughlin admitted to starting with a clean slate sending Frosted off to a minor throat procedure to address a breathing issue--and instead of remaining in South Florida for the GI Florida Derby at the end of March, opted for an extra week of prep. The decision reaped dividends when Frosted ran out a two-length winner of the GI TwinSpires.com Wood Memorial S. Apr. 4 with Joel Rosario at the controls for the first time, stamping himself as one of the top Derby threats on this side of the Mississippi.

Sent off the 10-1 fifth choice for the GI Kentucky Derby May 2, Frosted raced well back in the field and, despite having to cover ground on the turn, ran on gamely to be fourth, beaten a little over three lengths. Connections elected to skip the Preakness, in favor of the GI Belmont S. June 6, and though he was asked to

race closer to the pace, stayed on gamely for second, some 5 1/2 lengths adrift of American Pharoah. Ridden forward in a four-horse renewal of the GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga Aug. 1, Frosted plugged away late to drop a half-length to

Texas Red (Afleet Alex) while giving that one four pounds and was exiting a third in the GI Travers S. Aug. 29 where, somewhat surprisingly, he was the one to push the Triple Crown winner along through swifter-than-par fractions. **Cont. p4**

Off as the even-money favorite to return to his winning ways, Frosted was away without incident and was outsprinted in the early going as Ohio Derby hero **Mr. Z** (Malibu Moon) was able to cross and clear his rivals from his widest berth and was chased along by Iron Fist, GIII Matt Winn S. hero **Island Town** (Hard Spun) three wide and Upstart four deep on the track. Joel Rosario was therefore allowed to draft in behind and save all the ground while driven along into a midfield position rounding the clubhouse turn. Though the fractions were not overly taxing by any definition, Mr. Z was pushed along by Iron Fist through a half-mile in :48.50, and Rosario hit the gas ever so slightly at the 4 1/2-furlong marker, allowing Frosted to slide up into a joint third just to the inside of Island Town. As they banked into the second turn, Joel Rosario's body language said that Frosted was going almost too well as he sat hard against the gray colt, who was waiting for his cue. Pulled out to deliver his challenge three wide at the five-sixteenths, Frosted came after Iron Fist and Mike Smith at the quarter pole, went to him in hand a furlong and a half from home and kicked on nicely under hands and heels for a tidy success. Tommy Macho, three wide outside of stablemate **Madefromlucky** (Lookin at Lucky) on the backstretch, was neatly steered to the inside of Upstart to save ground and finished the best of the rest for third.

Frosted's dam, a half-sister to champion Midshipman (Unbridled's Song), posted her career high-water mark at Philly Park, taking the 2003 GII Cotillion H. for Stonerside Stable and Bill Mott. Fast Cookie, among the mares acquired by Sheikh Mohammed through his purchase of the Stonerside stock, is represented by the 2-year-old Bernardini filly Indulgent and, according to The Jockey Club, was bred this season to Tapit and Street Sense.

A maiden winner in three outings for the Ken McPeck barn in 2014, I'm A Chatterbox exploded onto the scene with a change to the Larry Jones stable at the Fair Grounds, annexing the Jan. 17 Silverbulletday S. by eight lengths Jan. 17 before besting stablemate Lovely Maria in the GIII Rachel Alexandra S. Feb. 21. The chestnut easily added the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar 28 and was far from disgraced when a running-on third to Lovely Maria and the New Orleans-based Shook Up (Tapit) beneath the Twin Spires May 1. I'm A Chatterbox crossed the line a nose better than Curalina in the CCA Oaks July 26, but was subsequently demoted to second and could not quite reel in loose-on-the-lead Embellish the Lace when last spotted in the Alabama four Saturdays prior.

In the capable hands of the hot-riding Florent Geroux, I'm A Chatterbox had the eight hole to deal with, but was able to get down all the way onto the rail as GII Delaware Oaks victress Calamity Kate was intent on the lead and set the pace from Embellish the Lace as

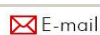

champion Take Charge Brandi (Giant's Causeway) landed in an apparently ideal spot in third. Calamity Kate retained the advantage, but Javier Castellano asked just enough from

Embellish the Lace to prevent that one from dropping down to the inside, and Geroux had a fistful of horse scraping paint atop the race favorite. Asked to improve three-eighths from the money, I'm A Chatterbox was steered out three wide going supremely well as Peace and War (War Front) caught the eye with an inside run on the turn. Calamity Kate carried a precarious advantage into the final furlong and a half, but that was short-lived, as I'm A Chatterbox drove to the front at the eighth pole and proved a much-the-best winner, while Calamity Kate clung on well for second ahead of Peace and War in third.

I'm A Chatterbox is the first Grade I winner for her sire, who has also been represented this season by GII Del Mar Derby winner Om. Her multiple stakes-placed dam is represented by 2-year-old Say It Slow (Haynesfield) and a yearling colt by The Factor, who was bought back by the Grays when bidding stalled out at \$285,000 Saturday afternoon at the Keeneland September sale. Chit Chatter is the dam of a weanling filly by Flat Out and returned to Munnings this past breeding season.

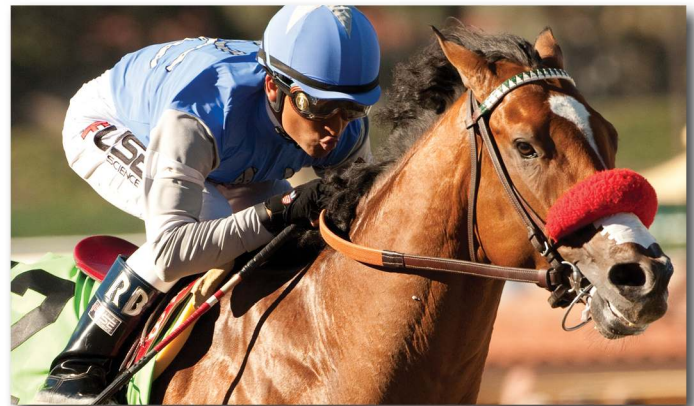

The second-longest shot on the board in this relocated running of the Virginia Derby, One Go All Go led them on a merry chase to spring a \$72 surprise.

Third, beaten a neck in last year's Gill Arlington-Washington Lassie when conditioned by Mike Stidham for Feel the Thunder Stable, the bay was the 6-5 favorite for a two-turn main-track allowance at Keeneland Oct. 22 under new trainer Bill Mott, but ran himself out of the race and finished fifth. Fourth to Dortmund (Big Brown) in a one-mile Churchill allowance last Nov. 29, One Go All Go had one run for this new outfit since, an apparent front-running victory at Indiana Grand Aug. 21 from which he was disqualified from first to second.

Perhaps aided by the early-morning scratch of Vision Perfect (Pollard's Vision), One Go All Go was bounced away from gate five by jockey Ronald Hisby and had things largely his own way up front, as Gallery (Munnings), Go Around and heavily favored Force the Pass gave chase. Still comfortably in front after six furlongs in a pedestrian 1:13.52, One Go All Go refused to kick over to his correct lead in deep stretch, but was able to find the wire first, as Fundamental made up some late ground.

"I couldn't believe 49-and-change. He was right there on the loose. It worked out perfect," winning trainer Pavel Matejka said. "We talked with Ronald before the race and said, 'If they let you go, go. If you get in trouble, take him back and sit and wait.' But nobody wanted the lead."

Cutting back a furlong off that effort, Mr Speaker made the most of his low draw to box-seat the Commonwealth Cup from third as Cut to Order (Ready's Image) set a modest pace in advance of Legendary. Positions remained largely unchanged until the field was approaching the stretch, when Jose Ortiz popped Mr Speaker off the fence and three wide into the lane to set their sights on Legendary, who hit the front going well leaving the quarter pole. From there it was a question of how far, as Mr Speaker asserted his class en route to an ultimately comfortable victory.

"Going into the first turn, I could see he was in a perfect spot," said Robbie Medina, assistant to Hall of Fame trainer Shug McGaughey. "He had plenty of horse going down the backside. When he eased him out at the top of the lane, he gave him a big run. He's been training well. We expected a good effort today."

The winner's dam, a daughter of undefeated champion Personal Ensign, was runner-up in the 2004 GII Demoiselle S. and third in that year's GIII Tempted S. Linda Rice trained Tenski and Things Change to Grade I victories in 1998, and in 2000 came City Zip, a four-time graded stakes winner that season, including the GI Hopeful S. That Lane's End sire's New York-bred son Palace snapped an eight-year dearth of graded stakes success when winning the 2013 GIII Fall Highweight H. and the stallion is now responsible for Saturday's Charles Town Oaks heroine Hot City Girl.

Stakes-placed in restricted company at two, Hot City Girl was second in the Feb. 16 Wide Country S. going this distance against open rivals at Laurel, but could not see out that track's one-turn mile when fourth in the Caesar's Wish S. Mar. 21. An even fourth in the Bouwerie S. for Empire-breds at Belmont May 25, she was adding blinkers off a dead heat for fifth in the GI Mother Goose S. June 27.

Given the bulk of the summer off, Hot City Girl was the second-longest shot in the field of six and hit the ground running, cutting out fractions of :22.96 and :46.74 while hounded along by Toutsie Rules. But try as she might Toutsie Rules could never bridge the gap, and Hot City Gal stayed on to score by a widening margin. Favored Sarah Sis (Sharp Humor) chased the pace from the inside, but had run her race by the time they turned for home and finished a distant last.

She failed to attract enough pari-mutuel support to go off at odds-on for the fourth time in as many starts, but 'TDN Rising Star' Super Majesty took her show on the road for the first time and made it a successful trip to the Bluegrass with a front-running victory.

A \$100,000 Keeneland September graduate two years ago, Super Majesty grew up nicely and was

hammered down to the Solis/Litt team for \$400,000 at the 2014 Fasig-Tipton Florida sale. Though she did not make the races at two, the bay made up for lost time, earning her Rising Star with a 6 1/4-length success on her May 24 debut going six furlongs at Santa Anita. She

overwhelmed a field of first-level allowance opponents during the summer meeting at Los Alamitos by better than 15 lengths July 5 and just failed when trying a route of ground for the first time at Del Mar Aug. 23.

Cutting back to one turn here in what was rumored to be an audition for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly/Mare Sprint Oct. 30, Super Majesty worked her way to the front in the opening three-sixteenths of a mile and had the competition stacked out five abreast through an opening quarter-mile in :22.78. The Hollendorfer trainee was still going well enough on the turn after a half in :45.58, and though she had to be asked to do it by Alex Solis, managed to stretch away in upper stretch, began to look for the wire in the final half-furlong and held sway late. Chide had only one rival beaten down the backstretch, but accelerated leaving the turn, came out and rallied stoutly down the center of the track to be a good second.

"To have our first graded stakes win come at Churchill Downs is just amazing. It's just incredible," commented winning part-owner Larry Roth. "We have a great team in [bloodstock agents] Alex [Solis II], Jason [Litt] and our daughter [Jaime] who is not here, but is an integral part of the team with my wife [Nanci] and myself. It's just incredible."

Gins Majesty has an unraced 2-year-old filly named Flynn Bug (Sidney's Candy), a yearling colt by Bluegrass Cat and a weanling colt by Overanalyze. She was bred back to Pioneer of the Nile.

POW WINNER BACK ON SYNTH IN DERBY

Breaking Lucky (Lookin at Lucky), who took down the colors of Queen's Plate winner Shaman Ghost (Ghostzapper) by the narrowest of margins in the July 28 Prince of Wales S. on the dirt at Fort Erie, returns to the Woodbine Polytrack for Sunday's GIII Ontario Derby.

The chestnut colt, a \$100,000 Keeneland November weanling purchase by Gunpowder Farms--they of Divisidero (Kitten's Joy) fame--was just a maiden winner entering the July 5 Queen's Plate and made a

huge middle move to work his way into contention, only to flatten out a bit late and finish fifth, four lengths astern of Shaman Ghost. He launched a similarly ambitious bid in the Prince of Wales, and managed to rally to deny Shaman Ghost

the second leg of the Triple Crown, but he failed to handle either the turf or the 12 furlongs of the Aug. 16 Breeders' S. and checked in last of nine behind Danish Dynaformer (Dynaformer).

Billy's Star (Perfect Soul {Ire}) raced further towards the back of the pack in the Queen's Plate, but came with an even bigger run than Breaking Lucky to lead into the final stages. Not surprisingly he weakened from that effort to finish fourth, beaten 2 3/4 lengths and 1 1/4 lengths ahead of Breaking Lucky. The homebred could not overcome a slow start and finished third in a first-level allowance over the turf Aug. 2 and exits a 1 1/4-length defeat of **Firespike** (Flower Alley) in the Aug. 23 Victoria Park S. The latter took the OBS Championship S. in January and was third in the GIII Spiral S. over the Turfway Poly in March, but is winless in his last five trips to the post.

Horses don't get more intriguing than **Beat Goes On (GB)** (Piccolo {GB}), who sports a record of two wins from three appearances over the all-weather track at Wolverhampton. A maiden winner at second asking this past February, the 30,000gns Tattersalls December weanling and €70,000 Goffs Orby yearling exits a very comfortable handicap success July 23. He'll drop nine pounds off that effort and is almost certain to remain in North America following the effort.

While the Midwest Thoroughbreds homebred earned his way into the GI Breeders' Cup Turf with his Arlington success, connections are not ruling out a

start in the shorter turf race, also a Breeders' Cup Challenge race.

"We'll just have to see how he runs in the [Shadwell] Mile," he said. "We could have a couple of options. It's kind of a stretch but anything can happen."

Should all go well in the Breeders' Cup, The Pizza Man has been invited to and is under serious consideration for the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 29.

"Book 2 was very good--exactly where we thought it should be," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "It picked up from the momentum created by Book 1, and continued on very well all the way through the last horses of the session. Money carried all the way."

A total of 968 horses have sold thus far at Keeneland September for \$204,918,000. The cumulative average is \$211,692, up 4.4% from the first six sessions in 2014, while the cumulative median is unchanged at \$150,000. The RNA rate has increased so far in 2015 from 27.15% to 29.29%.

With the altered format leading to later book horses arriving on the sales grounds earlier, Russell expects demand to continue to be strong as the two-day Book 3 begins Sunday.

"With the new set-up, a lot of people have had an opportunity to look at the Book 3 horses, which they probably hadn't had in the past," Russell explained. "People that we normally see leave before Book 3 starts were here [Saturday], so we hope they have the opportunity to look at these horses. There are still a lot of people who say they haven't bought yet and have found it difficult to buy, so we hope the momentum carries on from two to three."

Book 3 selling begins Sunday at 10 a.m.

Team Albaugh Shows Confidence in 'Outlaw'

The Albaugh Family Stable team showed just how highly they think of their GIII Iroquois S. third Unbridled Outlaw (Unbridled's Song) Saturday, as Kempton Bloodstock's Steve Castagnola went all the way to \$485,000 to acquire that runner's Mineshaft half-brother ([hip 1356](#)) on behalf of the operation. The bay was consigned by co-breeder Betz Thoroughbreds.

"That was a little more, obviously, than we had hoped to spend, but we came up against some steep competition--Steve Young, I believe, was the underbidder," offered a pumped-up Castagnola. "We own his half-brother Unbridled Outlaw, who was extremely unlucky in the Iroquois. He's with Dale Romans. We think the world of him and we're hoping to be able to run here in the Breeders' Cup if he gets in. He's a very special horse. This horse reminded us a lot of his older brother--a tremendous walk, a huge shoulder, great balance, a terrific mind. He was hard to pass up for us."

A debut third sprinting at Churchill June 27, Unbridled

Outlaw--a \$330,000 purchase here a year ago--broke his maiden over a next-out winner at Ellis July 25. Given a 3-1 chance under the Twin Spires in last Saturday's Iroquois, the dark bay was shuffled from midpack back to nearly last before re-rallying valiantly to round out the trifecta ([video](#)).

"I wish Steve Young hadn't had been quite as strong on him, but when Steve Young is your underbidder, you feel like maybe you're in the right spot," Castagnola continued. "With us owning the half-brother and having big aspirations for him, he was a horse that we really wanted. Sometimes you have to stretch for horses that you really want. I thought we were done about three bids before that. Barry Berkelhammer, Lisa McGreevy and myself all select horses for the Albaughs--we've got a great team. They wanted him, and thankfully we were able to get him."

Albaugh Family Stables is the nom de course of Iowa-based Dennis Albaugh and Jason Loutsch. Albaugh sold his pesticide company, Albaugh Inc., for \$1.3 billion in 2010. The stable has campaigned the likes of GSW Miss Macy Sue (Trippi), and bred recent GI Woodward S. winner and 'TDN Rising Star' Liam's Map (Unbridled's Song) out of her. Liam's Map was an \$800,000 Keeneland September yearling in 2012.

Hip 1356's dam Letgomyecho (Menifee) annexed the 2005 GII Forward Gal S. She sold for \$135,000 at the 2011 Keeneland November sale in foal to Congrats. The resulting filly was a \$100,000 September yearling and \$300,000 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic juvenile.

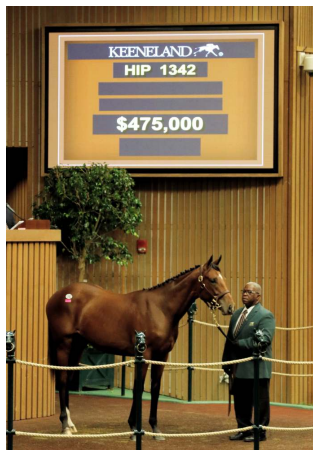

Something Divine for LNJ Foxwoods...

A filly by Divine Park will be joining the burgeoning LNJ Foxwoods stable after bloodstock agent Alex Solis, II signed the ticket on [hip 1342](#) at \$475,000. The yearling, bred by Brereton Jones and consigned by his Airdrie Stud, is out of Kittery Point (Include) and is a half-sister to GI La Brea S. winner Sam's Sister (Brother Derek). The yearling's half-sister Heart of Midway (Stephen Got Even), racing for Jones, currently has a two-race win streak after victories at Delaware and Monmouth Park this summer. The filly is expected to start in the GII Commonwealth Oaks at Laurel next weekend.

"From the first time we saw that filly, she's been a star," Solis commented. "We've been waiting for one more for LNJ and that was the one. If you look at the family, the mare threw a Grade I winner by Brother Derek, she's that good. It sounds like the other filly, who is going in the stakes, is pretty good. I think it's just a family you want to be in. She's gorgeous."

The filly's price tag wasn't a surprise for Solis.

"When I walked back there and I saw the players who were back there, I said, 'This is real money,'" he said. "But that filly is worth it."

Of the competition in Book 2, Solis said, "It's spotty. The really good ones are bringing a lot of money, as always. You just have to vet everything and be there because there are spots where you are finding good value. You have to do your homework and be there."

The 11-year-old Kittery Point, out of the Jones-bred Lucy Sims (Northjet {Ire}), is a half-sister to the dams of Grade I winners Sweet Talker (Stormin Fever), Include Me Out (Include) and Check the Label (Stormin Fever).

"It's a thrill to be able to breed and raise a top-notch filly," Jones said. "Yes [Solis] paid a lot of money for her, but if you put her right back through the ring again next week, I bet she would bring more than she brought this week because a lot of people didn't realize how good that filly was. If you look at that page, at all the Grade Is, it goes all the way down from top to bottom with Grade I winners. And that is what people are really looking for. Plus the conformation went with it. So I'm very proud of the filly and I think very good people got her and will give her every opportunity. She's a great filly." [@JessMartiniTDN](#)

West's Get Their Flatter...

Ben Glass failed to land the Flatter colt he was aiming for late in Friday's session when Bob Baffert scooped up [hip 1094](#) for \$550,000, but Gary and Mary West's longtime advisor found another son of the Claiborne resident Saturday in [hip 1206](#). Glass went to \$425,000 for the bay, who was consigned to the sale by Hermitage Farm.

"I got outbid on a Flatter last night for \$550,000, so I was happy to get this one," Glass revealed. "I thought he'd bring a lot of money."

Flatter also had a filly who brought \$425,000 from Steve Young during the first Book 2 session.

He has been represented this year by the likes of MGISP GII Holy Bull S. romper Upstart and GIII Commonwealth S. winner Kobe's Back.

"Flatter just got popular all of a sudden and everybody's been trying to buy them," Glass said. "This one has a good family, and the one that Baffert outbid me on obviously had a good family. Everybody wants a Flatter--Mr. West wants a Flatter."

Hip 1206 is a son of 2000 champion juvenile filly Caressing (Honour and Glory), and was bred by Carl Pollard, who also campaigned his dam. Caressing's previous produce includes GSP Gold Hawk (Empire Maker)--a \$450,000 KEESEP yearling of 2012--and Juan and Bina (Indian Charlie), a \$145,000 buy here two years ago who was third in the GIII Carry Back S. at Gulfstream in July.

"He's an excellent colt," offered Hermitage General Manager Bill Landes. "He really came along well for us after Keeneland inspected him in the first part of June. There are two ways he could have gone--he could have regressed or flourished, and he came that way. He's a nice colt. The mare's a champion--maybe this will be the next one."

Carl Pollard became principal owner of Hermitage in 1994. The former Churchill Downs Inc. chairman sold his interest in the historic Goshen, KY, nursery to Laura Lee Brown and Steve Wilson in 2010, but remains its primary boarding client. -[BDiDonatoTDN](#)

Sugar Rush for Bell...

Gatewood Bell doesn't remember ever buying anything by Candy Ride (Arg) before, but within the space of some 10 minutes at Saturday's session of the Keeneland September sale, the bloodstock agent doubly rectified that, first going to \$425,000 for a colt by the Lane's End stallion and then acquiring a filly by the sire for \$210,000. Both yearlings were consigned by Arthur Hancock's Stone Farm and both were bought to race on behalf of separate unidentified clients.

The colt ([hip 1493](#)), bred by Stone Farm, is a half-brother to stakes winner Clear Sailing (Empire Maker), while the colt's winning dam Steady Course (Old Trieste) is closely related to GSW & GISP Jump Start (A.P. Indy).

Asked what he liked about the dark bay colt, Bell said, "Mostly the people who raised him." Then he added, "He was an athlete. He was one of the best movers that I saw all day. He had everything I want in a horse."

Hancock, whose Stone Farm sold two-time Group 1 winning juvenile Air Force Blue (War Front) for \$490,000 at this sale a year ago, knew he was leading a special colt into the Keeneland sales ring Saturday evening.

"I just knew he was a really nice colt with a great attitude and so good looking," Hancock, who purchased Steady Course for \$20,000 at the 2009 Keeneland November sale, said. "He looked like he could be any kind of horse. We had six scopes and a heart scan or two and some really good people looking at him. We just hoped he would sell well. The way I look at this, the world is here and they're a lot smarter than me. So I was hoping he might bring between \$200,000 and \$300,000 because he's a really nice colt. Gatewood Bell bought him and that's special to me because the Hancocks and the Bells go way back. It was a good sale and a good horse."

The Candy Ride filly, [hip 1498](#), is out of Strawberry Sense (A.P. Indy) and is a half-sister to stakes placed Distillery (Dixie Union). Strawberry Sense is a half to juvenile champion Vindication (Seattle Slew) and a full to graded stakes winner Scipion. The yearling was bred by Payson Stud.

"I honestly don't think I've ever bought a Candy Ride before," Bell said. "I just loved both of these. And I love Arthur."

Bell admitted the Candy Ride colt was the first horse he had to stretch to buy.

"With the colt, that was the first time that I bid one more time than I had planned on," Bell said. "The ones I've gotten have been for less [than expected], but that's the way an auction works. At the end of the day at an auction, when you buy a horse, you're the only one in the world who thinks it's worth that much money. You've overvalued them compared to every other person here until time tells differently."

As a measure of the winner's persistent progress, the Gimcrack third Raucous--who had been two lengths behind him last time--was again in that spot but much further behind this time. "There is pressure when you put your faith in a horse like this and he's on the way to being a nice horse," trainer Richard Fahey commented. "You can imagine how shocked I was when he got beaten [in his maiden] at Doncaster and it was a brave shout to run in the Gimcrack next time, but he verified where we thought he was there. He's a big baby with a big frame and is not a horse that will have a lot more racing this year, but I'll speak to John [Ferguson] and all the lads and see where we go. He's a quality horse that will get better with time and anything he is doing this year is a bonus--if I have a 2000 Guineas horse, it's him."

Considered an upwardly mobile character when winning the 10-furlong Listed Festival S. at Goodwood May 23 and finishing an eye-catching fourth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. over the same trip at Royal Ascot June 17, the bay had met a deflating defeat at the hands of the Qatari star Dubday (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the G3 Glorious S. over a mile and a half back at the former venue at the end of July. Settled second early as Eagle Top was committed on the lead by Frankie Dettori, he tackled that rival as Sky Hunter did on the other side as soon as it was clear that the

favorite was unable to extend with a quarter mile left. GOSDEN ON ARC WEATHER WATCH

Trainer John Gosden has admitted he would not be eager for his sophomore stars **Golden Horn (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) and **Jack Hobbs (GB)** (Halling) to take on two-time defending champion Treve (Fr) (Motivator {GB}) on soft ground in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in two weeks' time, and the conditioner said weather will help dictate where the Derby winners--Golden Horn, the Epsom Derby and Jack Hobbs the Irish

version--show up next.

"I've never seen a horse skip through ground that soft like Treve did," Gosden said. "To that extent, I would be wary if it's soft ground [for the Arc]. Both hold entries in the [G1] Champion S. 13 days later and the way I look at it is they could run in the Arc and Breeders' Cup, or the Champion S. We will just have to be on weather watch. If it does turn up heavy at Longchamp, it can mess up the race."

"Both could go for the Arc, but if it turns up soft you won't see Golden Horn there, while I would not be surprised if Jack Hobbs winds up in the Champion S.," Gosden added. "There are many permutations. I will have a better idea this time next week when I have a more accurate long-range forecast, as it is hard to predict what the weather will be this far out."

Both Golden Horn and Jack Hobbs won their intended Arc lead-up races, with Golden Horn victorious in the G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 12 and Jack Hobbs taking the G3 September S. over the Kempton all-weather Sept. 5.

Last years G1 Doncaster Mile winner Kermadec added another Group 1 score to his young 11-race career when taking Saturday's George Main at third asking. Kermadec signaled he had a top-level effort in him when finishing fourth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths, in his Group 1 debut in the Mar. 7 G1 Australian Guineas, and he went one placing better against elders next out in the G1 George Ryder S. two weeks later. Let go at 7-1 for the prestigious Doncaster at The Championships Apr. 6, Kermadec scored by nearly two lengths, and was subsequently shelved for the winter. Brought back over 1400 meters for the G2 Warwick S. over this strip Aug. 22, the now 4-year-old finished fifth behind stablemate Royal Descent and Pornichet, and had Royal Descent behind him in third--and Pornichet in sixth--when he was second in the G2 Chelmsford S. over this track and trip Sept. 5. Struggling to find cover while racing midpack and wide early, Kermadec eventually settled in behind the Godolphin runner Sweynesse while Pornichet set the early tempo and Royal Descent sat just off his heels in third.

George Main S. cont.

Kermadec looked full of fuel under Glyn Schofield--who was subbing for suspended regular rider Glen Boss--as the field swung into the straight, and he swept down the center of the track under mostly hand urging to overtake Royal Descent--who once again had to settle for second in a top-flight contest--and Pornichet in the dying strides. Trainer Chris Waller told *Racing and Sports* Kermadec would have some big-race targets in Melbourne.

"He's a very good horse," Waller said. "He's lightly raced--there [were] genuine excuses last start in a good race. More things went his way today but he didn't have it perfect; he got caught wide in the early stages, but he was strong that last 200 meters so that was good heading towards I guess the [Oct. 10 G1] Caulfield

S. and the [Oct. 24 G1] Cox Plate."

"I think he's done it now in terms of the mile," Waller added. "We need to get a big win at weight-for-age next to his name. He's a colt, he's a Doncaster winner; if we can get one of those big ones in Melbourne he is a very valuable horse."

KERMADEC AN EMERGING STAR

Australia's search for a weight-for-age star took a great leap forward when impressive 4-year-old **Kermadec (NZ)** (Teofilo {Ire}) landed the G1 George Main S. over the Randwick mile in Sydney Saturday.

The George Main S. was inaugurated in 1945 on the retirement of long-standing Australian Jockey Club

Chairman George Main. It was soon established as one of the weight-for-age highlights of the spring in Sydney, with the great Shannon (who subsequently won the 1948 Hollywood Gold Cup) scoring in 1946 and '47. Since then it has been won by a host of champions including Kingston

Town, winner in both 1981 and '82. Recent years, though, have seen star quality spread more thinly among the ranks of the country's older gallopers.

Australian racegoers were lucky in that the downside of the boom in the stallion business--ie. the fact that good horses' racing careers nowadays are generally short--took longer to hit home in the antipodes than it did in the U.S. and Europe. However, it is now the norm for the best Australasian colts to have finished racing by the age of four. A glance at Darley Australia's roster sums this up perfectly because it contains last season's best 3-year-old sprinter Brazen Beau (Aus) (I Am Invincible {Aus}) as well as top young milers Hallowed Crown (Aus) (Street Sense) and Shooting To Win (Aus) (Sebring {Aus}). A generation ago all three would most likely, assuming that they remained sound, have still been in training at four.

The upshot of the early retirements of the best locally-bred horses has been that Australia's top weight-for-age races are now often at the mercy of imports such as the past two G1 Australian Cup winners Spillway (GB) (Rail Link {GB}) and Fiorente (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}), and of overseas raiders such as last season's Irish-trained G1 Cox Plate winner Adelaide (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). It now looks, though, as if the home defense contains a proper Australasian-bred star, with Kermadec vying for Cox Plate favoritism.

Conceived in Australia and born in New Zealand, Kermadec went through the 2013 NZ Bloodstock Premier Yearling Sale, bought for NZ\$260,000 by agent Guy Mulcaster on behalf of owner Neville Morgan, who placed him with Sydney's champion trainer Chris Waller. Kermadec was not among Australia's leading juveniles of the 2013/'14 season, but made gradual progress last term as a 3-year-old. He showed his first stakes form towards the end of the spring when taking the Group 3 Carbine Club S. on Victoria Derby Day at Flemington before graduating to Group 1 company in the autumn. He was not ready to win the big 3-year-olds feature races at that stage, but his close fourth to Wandjina (Aus) (Snitzel {Aus}) in the G1 Australian Guineas at Flemington in March showed that he was going the right way.

That Kermadec couldn't quite match the likes of Wandjina (who now stands at Newgate Farm), Hallowed Crown and Shooting To Win as a 3-year-old ensured that he was not snapped up for stud duties, which is now proving to have been a blessing. He ended his second season by landing the G1 Doncaster Mile H. at Randwick under the featherweight of 51kg (112 pounds), and now at the age of four he is blossoming. Kermadec lined up in the George Main as the winner of three of his 10 starts, and after his defeat of 2013 G1 Australian Oaks winner Royal Descent (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) and 2015 G1 Doomben Cup winner Pornichet (Fr) (Vespone {Ire}), he now holds pole position among Australia's weight-for-age performers, and will head down to Melbourne to contest the G1 Caulfield S. Oct. 10 and the G1 Cox Plate two weeks later. He should have a great chance in both races, as Chris Waller observed on Saturday when quizzed about his charge's Cox Plate prospects, "If he's trained right, he'll win it."

Kermadec is the latest Australian-conceived star for Darley's Galileo stallion Teofilo (Ire), previously represented by the Darley-bred 2014 G1 Queensland Derby winner Sonntag (Aus). The Sadler's Wells line continues to make a big contribution to Australasian racing, even if Teofilo no longer shuttles and High Chaparral (Ire), who did best of all the Sadler's Wells horses who have stood in the antipodes, died last year.

Kermadec is the best horse to have emerged in recent years from his family. His first three dams are all stakes winners; his dam, Hy Fuji (an Australian-bred daughter of the Sunday Silence stallion Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}), won the Tattersalls Plate at Randwick in 2003; his second dam, Hysterical (an NZ-bred daughter of the Irish import Wolverton {Ire}), landed the Emancipation S. at Randwick in 1993; and his third dam, Formal Invitation (an Irish-conceived but Australian-bred daughter of Be My Guest), took the Blue Diamond Preview at Caulfield in 1982. Kermadec was one of three stakes winners for Teofilo on Saturday, alongside Amralah (Ire) and Scottish (Ire), successful respectively in the SAJC Tokyo City Cup at Morphettville in South Australia and the Doonside Cup at Ayr in Scotland.

SHEIKH RASHID DIES AT 34

Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed al Maktoum, the eldest son of Dubai ruler and UAE Vice President and Prime Minister Sheikh Mohammed, has died at age 34 of a heart attack. Sheikh Rashid was an avid racing enthusiast, racing horses under the Zabeel Racing International banner. Many of Sheikh Rashid's best

horses were U.S.-breds, many of which were imported to Dubai to race, including G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen winner Reynaldothewizard (Speightstown); triple Grade I winner Richard's Kid (Lemon Drop Kid) and dual Grade III winner

Conveyance (Indian Charlie). Sheikh Rashid's yellow and red colors were also carried by Grade I winners Henny Hughes (Hennessy) and Game Face (Menifee) in the U.S., and more recently his Surfer (Distorted Humor) won the G2 Al Maktoum Challenge Round 1 at Meydan in January.

Sheikh Rashid was a graduate of England's Sandhurst Military Academy in 2002, and was chairman of the UAE Olympic Committee from 2008 to 2012. Like his father, he was an accomplished endurance rider. The Dubai ruler's court has declared three days of mourning.
