**GOLDEN BOY**

With **Treve (Fr)** (Motivator {GB}) unable to fire as she has on the last two occasions, Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe belonged to Anthony Oppenheimer's **Golden Horn (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), as he benefitted from an inspired Longchamp ride from Frankie Dettori, who was joining six other jockeys in steering a record fourth winner of the great race. Keen to keep the poorly drawn G1 Epsom Derby, G1 Eclipse S. and G1 Irish Champion S.

winner away from the others to avoid over-racing for the first two furlongs, he was able to track across and use Treve's pacemaker as a perfect target in second.

Committed at the head of affairs with over two furlongs remaining as Thierry Jarnet struggled to keep Treve on an even keel out wide, the 5-1 shot dug in bravely to hold last year's runner-up **Flintshire (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) at safe distance and win by two lengths, with **New Bay (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) a neck away in third, a nose ahead of the 9-10 favorite, who was unable to provide the dream scenario.

"He's a fabulous horse with a gorgeous constitution and I've nothing but praise for him," trainer John Gosden said after greeting his first Arc winner. "He's taken a lot of training all year and he does stay a mile and a half--we are sure of that now. I was very happy with the ground and probably on soft, Treve would have blown us all away." Gosden said Golden Horn is still in the frame for Keeneland at the end of the month. "The owner is keen on the Breeders' Cup, which gives us a month and if he's in good order next week there is no reason why he can't go there."

Criquette Head-Maarek said of the vanquished triple-seeker, "I think she gave a good performance and there is no excuse--she was just beaten by better horses on the day. The ground is good, it's not hard. She had two of the best 3-year-olds in Europe in front of her and this is the first time she has met members of that crop. She was very brave and will always have a special place in my heart." **Cont. p13**

**GOT LUCKY IN KENTUCKY**

Philip Steinberg and Hill 'n' Dale Equine's **Got Lucky** (A.P. Indy) proved she was both lucky and talented with her first win at the highest level in Sunday's

GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland, earning a spot in the starting gate for the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff in less than a month. Got Lucky was away well and settled well off the pace as GI Kentucky Oaks winner **Lovely Maria** (Majesticperfe

ction) set the pace with **Yahilwa** (Medaglia d'Oro) pressing in second as favored **Untapable** (Tapit) tracked those two early. Yahilwa led by a narrow margin entering the turn as Untapable swung to the tree path to challenge. Got Lucky, who was in last as the field hit the final bend, began to zip up the rail to sit in fourth at the top of the lane. Untapable and Yahilwa continued to battle in upperstretch as Lovely Maria dropped back and Got Lucky continued her sustained rally to catch the leading duo in the shadow of the wire for a narrow victory. "Where I was in the Grandstand--I was right at the eighth pole--I thought she had a lot to do at that point, but I could tell she was coming," winning trainer Todd Pletcher said. "I was just hoping she got there in time. She's got as good of a pedigree as any filly in the world, and to get that first Grade I is huge for her."

Last year's champion filly Untapable has tallied only one win so far this season in the GI Apple Blossom H.

"She ran well, but that is not her best," trainer Steve Asmussen confessed. "It hasn't fallen together. We brought her here so she could get a feel for the track. This is the first time she has stepped on it that it isn't muddy. Hopefully things will go smoothly with her from here. She has had an extremely disappointing year [yet] she has run out [\$800,000]. It's frustrating."

Got Lucky was bred by her owners, who campaigned her dam Malka--who was bred by Steinberg and Ben Walden. Got Lucky is the third foal out of Malka, who also produced a yet unraced 2-year-old filly named Lucky Number (Smart Strike). This is the deep female family of Grade I winners Rhythm (Not For Love), Super Saver (Maria's Mon), Imagining (Giant's Causeway), Girolamo (A.P. Indy), Callback (Street Sense) and Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat).

Hill 'n' Dale's John Sikura said, "It's a huge win. She's by A.P. Indy and just getting better and better with each race as she's gotten older. To win a Grade I with that pedigree is amazing."

Got Lucky collected a string of runner-up efforts during her juvenile and sophomore seasons, including the GII Demoiselle S., GIII Rachel Alexandra S. and GII Gazelle S. She wrapped up her 3-year-old year with fifths in the GI Alabama S. and GI Spinster S. and kicked off 2015 with an optional claiming win cutting back to a mile at Gulfstream Jan. 15. Fifth in the GIII Rampart S. in February, Got Lucky took a three-month break and returned to finish second in the Monmouth Beach S. May 23. She returned to the winner's circle in a 5 1/2-length romp in the GIII Molly Pitcher S. at

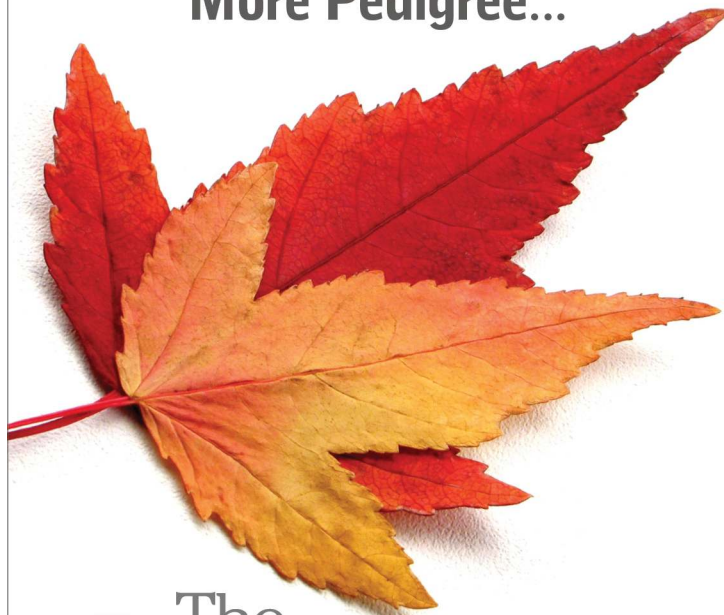

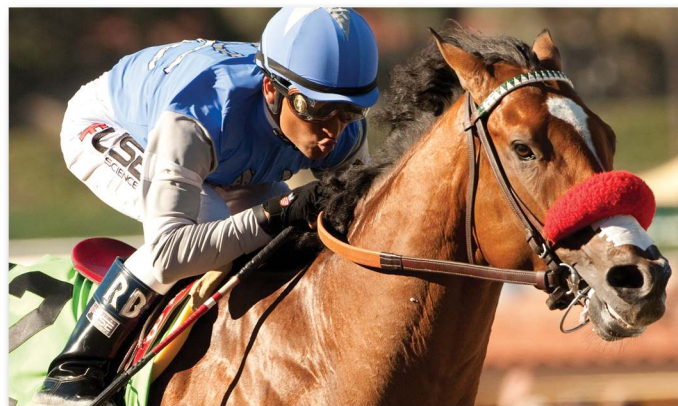

John Oxley's Airoforce got the best of a full field of 14 in Keeneland's GIII Bourbon S. The gray was purchased for \$350,000 at the OBS April Sale after breezing a quarter in :21.0 and boasted a solid worktab at Churchill downs during the month of August.

He rallied to win his career debut by 3 1/4 lengths at Kentucky Downs Sept. 5, earning an 8 3/4 *Thorograph* number. Supported at odds of 5-1, Airoforce was away well from gate 13 and tracked the dueling leaders from three wide through the first quarter. Moving to the front in tandem with stablemate Siding Spring on the turn, he gained the lead by midstretch and kicked hope to finish well clear of the rallying Camelot Kitten.

"I was a little nervous going into the first turn," winning trainer Mark Casse said. "Actually both of our horses had pretty wide trips. Going in [the race] we thought [Airoforce] was a good horse, and I think he proved today he is."

Casse noted that the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf would likely be the next step for Airoforce.

"Not every horse likes this turf course," the conditioner noted. "He proved that's not a problem. Hopefully he stays happy and healthy and we'll give it a try."

Pilot Julien Leparoux was also pleased with Airoforce's effort.

"It was a good race," the rider offered. [It was a] big step up from the maiden he won at Kentucky Downs.

He's still a little green. When I got to the lead down the straight, he started looking around a bit. He's a nice horse. I think he should get better. I rode the horse when he broke his maiden. But [today's race] was such a big jump. We had a wide post--we got the 13. He broke sharp so I was pretty good in the first turn. He's very professional even though he's only raced twice."

Airoforce is the first foal out of the multiple stakes placed Chocolate Pop (Cuvee). Chocolate Pop has a yearling filly by Colonel John and delivered a filly by First Samurai this year. She was bred to Sidney's Candy.

Ben's Duchess, let go at double her 4-1 morning line quote, certainly would not have gone off at that price had the public known what tactics the riders aboard her competition would employ. Just five runners lined up in the gate, but four of them battled across the track from the bell, with odds-on Taris the widest of all as Ben's Duchess watched the scene unfold in front of her while well off the inside.

Inching closer after impossible splits of :21.29 and :43.45, she circled the field and played out what already seemed like a formality to earn a first graded win as she pleased.

"I was smiling when I saw the race play out in front of me," said winning jockey Joe Talamo, back from a Saturday trip to Belmont where he stole the GII Kelso H. aboard Appealing Tale (Tale of the Cat). "We really had a good trip. I kept her back and to the outside because the kick-back was a little heavy. I came into the turn and I had so much horse." He continued, "She runs her race every time, she's hit the board every time she's run. Even when she doesn't win, she's such a hard-trying filly, so I had all the confidence in the world in her today."

Third to eventual Grade I winner Callback (Street Sense) on debut at Los Alamitos Race Course last December, she broke through later that month before hitting the bench. The chestnut returned to fill out the trifecta in local listed stakes in both April and May, and crushed optional claiming foes by 5 1/4 lengths June 14. Third trying the turf at Del Mar July 17, she bested Unforgettable U (Tale of the Cat) by a nose while earning a career-best 100 Beyer Speed Figure on the main track back "where the turf meets the surf" Aug. 9. Ben's Duchess was soundly beaten by Uzziel in the restricted CERF S. last out Sept. 6.

"She always tries, she always brings her 'A' game, and today, Joe didn't do what [the other jockeys] did," said John Sadler's assistant trainer Larry Benavidez. "At the half-mile pole, I was kind of smiling when they went 43 and change. We kind of wanted to sit third.

We thought [Unforgettable U and Taris] would go head and head. We didn't think there would be four across the track, but when that materialized, I was smiling."

**Tonalist Looks Towards Breeders' Cup**

Tonalist (Tapit) exited his second GI Jockey Club Gold Cup victory well and will look towards the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 31. "Tonalist seems to have come back from his race in good order," trainer Christophe Clement offered Sunday morning. "He looks okay to me. If you believe in speed figures, this horse has been running very good races all year long. He went 111 when he won the [GIII] Westchester [S. May 2], 105 in the [GI Metropolitan H. June 6], 107 in the [GII] Suburban [July 4], 110 in the [GI] Whitney [S. Aug. 8] and 111 for yesterday's performance. He's been running similar [figures] all year long, very consistent. I've never been disappointed with him."

Clement also said that Tonalist will prepare for the Breeders' Cup from their homebase at Belmont Park and will most likely run again with out blinkers, which he has shed since his runner-up effort in the Met Mile.

"He trains really well at Belmont, so I'd like to keep him here as long as I can," Clement explained. "He's got to be there Wednesday, so we can either fly him on Monday or we can van him Tuesday. I'd have to think about it. We'll check the weather and everything and decide. If he trains as willingly as he has been, I don't think I'll make any changes [in terms of equipment]. But if I think he's being a touch lazy or needs to wake up a little bit, we might."

Red Vine (Candy Ride {Arg}), who was second in Saturday's GII Kelso S., is a possible for the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, but might opt for the GI Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 28 or Belmont's GIII Bold Ruler S. Oct. 31.

"I think we need to keep him eligible for the Breeders' Cup [Dirt] Mile and we'll speak to [owner] Mr. Kelly over the next 10 days and see how he is, how he came out of the race," said Clement.

## LET'S HEAR IT FOR THE OLD GUYS



We've all seen the statistics. We've studied them, debated them, and have our theories on them. Thoroughbreds make fewer starts today than in decades past.

They make far fewer starts; noticeably fewer starts; alarmingly fewer starts.

All of which makes it well worth noting the results of North America's graded stakes on Oct. 3, a huge day of prep races for the Oct. 30-31 Breeders' Cup.

Hail the geldings; hail the "old" mares. There were 10 graded stakes that day for 3-year-olds an up, three restricted to fillies and mares.

Of the seven open to both sexes, two of the winners are age six, three are 5 and two are four.

In the races restricted to fillies and mares, the winners were a 6-year-old mare, 5-year-old mare and 4-year-old filly.

Three of the races were Grade I affairs; their winners ages six, six and five.

Maybe not old by Wise Dan's standard, but a breath of fresh air in a sport where so many fans bemoan the fact the best runners are usually shuffled off to the breeding shed at age three or four.

This year, in fact, will not be remembered for any of the victories that happened Oct. 3. This is the year of American Pharoah...and rightfully so.

But Triple Crown winner American Pharoah is too valuable to continue racing next year. The stud farm that bought his breeding rights has every right to begin recouping its return on investment, and that is done in the breeding shed and in sale pavilions.

It is this dynamic that spurs another debate: Is Thoroughbred racing a business or a sport?

In fact it is both, and often at the same time.

It is a business for farms, breeders, agents, consignors and all those that work for them, with them, or on behalf of them.

It is a sport for the backbone of the industry, those whose dollars make up the pari-mutuel pools.

It is a sport and a business--though often more of one than the other--for the racetracks, those toiling on the backside and all those connected to a track in one way or another.

We all know we need fewer racetracks and fewer race dates, but those are tough subjects to crack with so many vested interests.

Many of our claiming races are filled with geldings, but not so often in Grade I races, contests trying to be won by those with stallion aspirations.

And filly and mare races are, of course, won by fillies and mares, though not many of the graded variety by five and 6-year-old mares that have usually visited a breeding shed, or two or three, by that age.


A quick recap of those grade I winners:

- Wild Dude (Wildcat Heir--Courtly Choice, by Doneraile Court), 5, horse, won the Santa Anita Sprint Championship, his 18th start.
- Stephanie's Kitten (Kitten's Joy--Unfold the Rose, by Catienus), 6, mare, took the Flower Bowl for the second straight year. She has made 24 starts and won nine graded stakes and nearly \$3.2 million.
- Grand Arch (Arch--Bacinella, by El Gran Senor), 6, gelding, was head best in the Shadwell Turf Mile, his 23rd start.

Also on the day: 5-year-old Appealing Tale (Tale of the Cat--Appealing Bride, by Unbridled's Song) won the Kelso H. in his 25th start; 5-year-old Fioretta (Bernardini--Move Clickly, by Cherokee Run), in her 22nd start, took the GII Thoroughbred Club of America S.; 5-year-old Golden Sabre (Medaglia d'Oro--Strike Softly, by Smart Strike) was best in the GIII Durham Cup in his 12th outing; and 6-year-old No Silent (Silent Name--Two Names, by War Chant) won the GIII Eddie D S. in his 23rd start.

Applaud the owners and trainers. Celebrate the decisions to geld when necessary and to forego a season (or more) in the breeding shed when the racetrack still beckons.

These results will not, by themselves, magically correct the problem the industry faces of its participants making fewer starts. But it warms the heart by giving hope that breeders, owners and trainers will take note of these graded stakes winners and what they mean.

Charting Golden Horn's progress up to his surprise defeat in the G1 Juddmonte International was straightforward, with decisive wins in the championship events at Epsom June 6 and at Sandown July 4 lending him an air of invulnerability and encouraging

comparison with the best of the recent blue riband winners. Where the benchmark figure Sea the Stars (Ire) had succeeded in diverting from the King George to York's premier contest six years earlier, the Oppenheimer homebred stalled as the unlikely heroine Arabian Queen (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) dealt him an inexplicable blow there Aug. 19.

Sent to Leopardstown with a point to prove for the first time, he put his previous debacle firmly behind him when playing with Free Eagle (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) and Found (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) under more positive tactics in the showpiece of the Irish Champions weekend Sept. 12. As the ground dried sufficiently from the testing surface that prevailed at the warm-up meeting here three weeks ago, connections took the plunge and forewent Champions Day and were met with a potentially disastrous berth in 14.

With the need to spare as much energy as possible early on, a plan was hatched between Gosden and Dettori based on a precedent, as another past Gosden trainee, Duncan (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}), had been kept separate from the field in the 2010 G2 Prix Foy. Easing over gradually into the slipstream of Treve's rabbit, Shahah (GB) (Motivator {GB}), to enjoy an uncomplicated stalking trip on a day when the winners were all racing prominently, Golden Horn tanked along with the Juddmonte duo Flintshire and New Bay in close attendance. Full of run turning for home, he was asked to grind there and responded generously to open a gap on the recent Sword Dancer scorer as Treve hung down to her right instead of surging forward. Out of reach as Dettori put down his whip with just over 100 meters remaining, he freewheeled to the line with the 2013 and 2014 heroine unable to engage her customary turbo.

For the winning jockey, it was a performance in the saddle on a par with his similarly positive ride on Lammtarra 20 years ago, and he was able to join Jacques Doyasbere, Freddy Head, Yves Saint-Martin, Pat Eddery, Olivier Peslier and Thierry Jarnet and tie for the coveted record.

thought it was impossible for another horse to pass me. I've been scratching my head all week.

Everyone was determined to make me sit behind and I said 'Why? We've got the best horse. Let me get him up there and show the world how good he is'. The only blip he had was at York, but his record is

unbelievable. He's probably the best horse I've ridden."

Gosden was unable to hide his delight at reaching another landmark in his career. "To win the Arc is a great achievement and I rank that personally as high as winning the Breeders' Cup Classic and the Epsom Derby," he commented. "Frankie was able to float down the outside and watch where he wanted to slot in and the pacemaker set an even gallop for him to switch off. I knew he was going to kick relatively early, as he had said earlier that the problem with the Arc is they come at your back with arrows."

Anthony Oppenheimer added, "What a fantastic day. John Gosden is truly a remarkable trainer with a great feeling for horses. Maybe the Breeders' Cup is a possibility, but the horse will tell us. What is for certain is he will not race next year. He will stand with Darley and Sheikh Mohammed will have a half share and I will retain the other."

Sam Bullard, Darley's director of stallions, later said in a statement, "It is wonderful that Darley has bought into this great champion and we are thrilled that Mr. Oppenheimer has decided that Dalham Hall Stud is where Golden Horn will get the best opportunity of becoming the great stallion we believe he can be."

Darley stands Golden Horn's sire, Cape Cross, at its Kildangan Stud in Ireland, and also stood his broodmare sire, Dubai Destination, at Dalham Hall from 2004 to 2009.

Juddmonte were left content with confirmation that they have a pair of high-class horses on their hands, and racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe said of the second and third, "The two horses ran great races and had good positions and quickened well in the straight. We have no complaints and we were beaten by a true champion on the day. We will talk with Andre Fabre and the Breeders' Cup is a possibility for Flintshire, while we have to decide what happens next with New Bay."

Golden Horn's elder half-sister, the 4-year-old filly Eastern Belle (GB) (Champs Elysees {GB}), won a listed race at Newbury last year for the Oppenheimers before being sent Stateside to trainer Graham Motion. She has been second in her last four starts, including Belmont's GII New York S. and the GIII Wya S. and GIII Glens Falls S. at Saratoga Aug. 8 and Sept. 5, respectively.

Ballydoyle showed her mettle when narrowly defeated in Royal Ascot's June 20 Listed Chesham S., which followed a May 23 debut fourth at The Curragh, and shed maiden status at Newmarket July 11 before embarking on her present black-type sequence. Emulating full-sister Misty For Me (Ire)'s 2010 success here, she provided conditioner Aidan O'Brien with a record-equaling fifth renewal of the contest.

Regarding future plans, O'Brien revealed, "She's a classy filly and we'll target the [G1 1000] Guineas [at Newmarket] next year. The [GI] Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies could still be an option this season, but the lads will sit down and discuss that in the next week or so."

Jim Bolger was far from downbeat following Turret Rock's defeat and the breeder-trainer said of the runner-up, "I'm delighted with that effort and she could be an Oaks filly next year. [Jockey] Kevin [Manning] said the ground is on the fast side [of good] and, if it remains so, I could be tempted to bring her back to France for the [Nov. 1 G1] Criterium de Saint-Cloud."

Jean-Claude Rouget was also content with Qemah's display and added, "I'm happy with that performance and she'll have a great season next year." Pascal Bary was almost at a loss to explain the eclipse of 'TDN Rising Star' Antonoe (First Defence), but offered, "She was never traveling well [trapped three wide] on the outside. She was never comfortable and her run was too bad to be true."

Already successful in the G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 16, Goldream was able to pull off a rare sprint double as this prize went outside of France as it had on all but three occasions since 1997. Maturing into a top handicapper in this sphere last term, the bay beat the subsequent Abbaye hero Move In Time (GB) (Monsieur Bond {Ire}) in Ascot's Shergar Cup Dash over this trip in last August before finishing fourth to Muthmir in Doncaster's Portland H. and second at Haydock in September. Returning with a signal of intent

when annexing Newmarket's G3 Palace House S. May 2, he was only seventh in Haydock's G2 Temple S. staged on dead ground three weeks later prior to his significant career-high on the opening day of the Royal meeting. Given a break before a satisfactory re-introduction when fifth in the

G1 Nunthorpe S. at York Aug. 21, Goldream built on that effort to benefit from the absence of Mecca's Angel (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}).

Held up in mid-division early by Martin Harley, he was temporarily swamped by Rangali as the pair made their moves

either side of Muthmir approaching the furlong pole, but he managed to reel in that rival in the final strides.

"It's not easy to win two Group 1 sprints in the same year, as they depend very much on tactics, but today he had the fast pace he needs and the jockey sensibly held him back and waited. He also got fast ground, which is a great help."

Henri-Alex Pantall, who was the sole French stable represented with just two home-trained runners, was ruing getting so close to victory with Rangali. "He has a lot of quality, but is a little bit tricky and the type who when he hits the front too early stops," he explained. "That's what happened today, but we'll keep going."

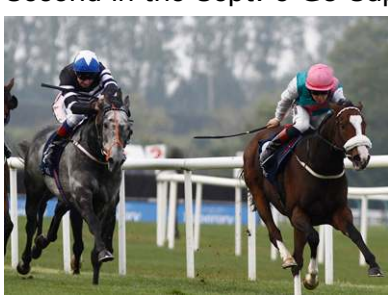

Last year's G1 Victoria Derby hero Preferment appeared to go by the wayside for a short while after that career high, but the 4-year-old seems to now be firmly back in the frame for the country's top contests after a win in Sunday's G1 Turnbull S. Preferment was winning his first race of any kind when causing a mild upset in the 2400-meter Victoria Derby last November, after which he was put away for the Australian summer. He could be excused for off-the-board finishes in the G2 Hobartville S. and G1 Randwick Guineas at

distances far short of his best, and he put up an encouraging effort to be a narrowly beaten second in the G1 Rosehill Guineas over 2000 meters Mar. 21. He could manage only eighth in the G1 Australian Derby back over 2400 meters Apr. 6,

however, and was once again sent to the paddocks. After finishing 12th of 16 in the G2 Chelmsford S. over 1600 meters on seasonal debut Sept. 5, Preferment took the G2 Hill S. at 2000 meters two weeks later, but was nonetheless let go at 10-1 over the same trip here and over the track on which he'd won the Victoria Derby. Traveling worse than midpack early, Preferment charged through the straight to nail his once again unlucky stablemate Royal Descent on the line.

While Preferment will now be among the favorites for the Caulfield and Melbourne Cups, Waller told [Breednet.com.au](#) he is also considering a tilt at the A\$3 million G1 Cox Plate Oct. 24.

"He's a very exciting horse and it's just good to see him showing speed over 2000 meters, not only second-up last start in Sydney but again today against some of the better horses around," Waller told the site. "We know he'll get the distance of, say, 2400 meters and beyond, so he's a pretty special horse. He's certainly matured this year; he was a maiden when he won the Derby, but untapped and not pushed to be there. I think that's a big, important thing; we just let

him get there himself. Usually the Derby is not a good guide to the Melbourne Cup, but I think this horse might be different. Obviously a Cox Plate comes into the equation now; I guess it's a good problem to have."

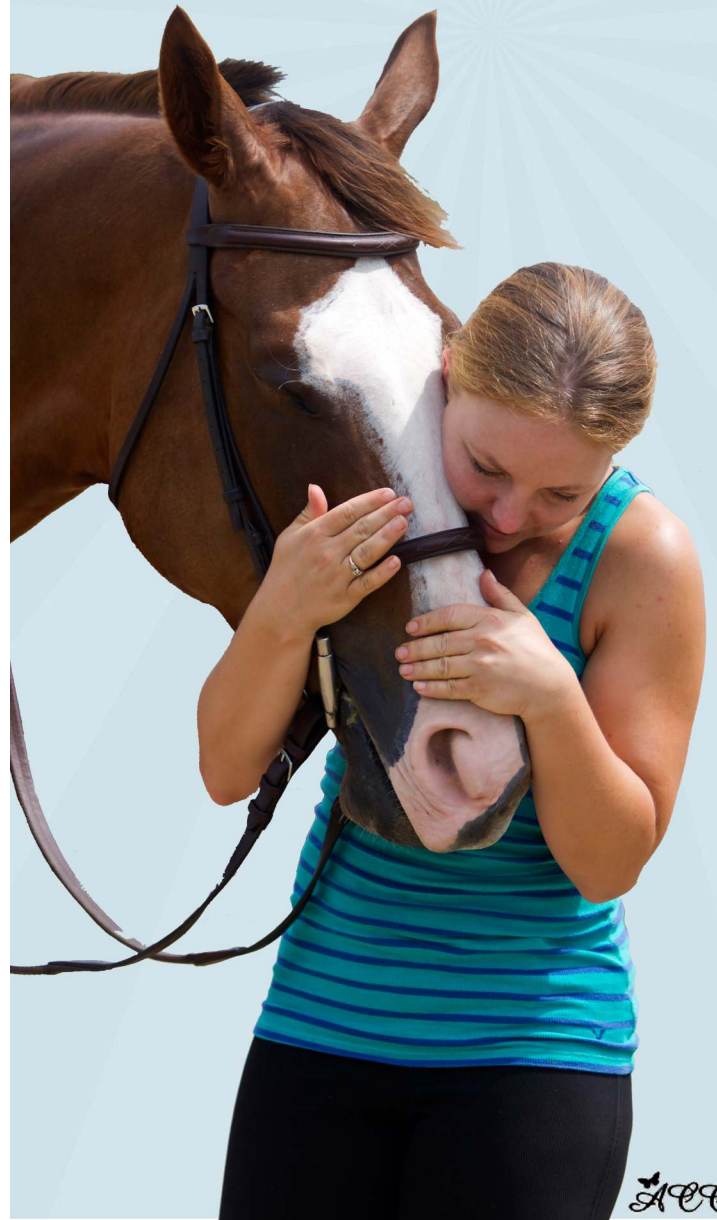
