## A COMEDY IN SEVERAL ACTS

Two days after **Taris** (Flatter) goes postward in the Oct. 31 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint, her dam **Comedy** (Theatrical {Ire}) will go through the sales ring at Keeneland during the first session of the November Breeding Stock Sale. Rooting for both will be West Virginia breeder Mike Di Cola. Di Cola purchased Comedy, carrying a full-sister to the future graded stakes winner, for \$24,000 at the 2012 Keeneland

November sale. "I liked her because she was in foal to Flatter," Di Cola recalled. "I love Flatter as a stallion--at the time he was a \$5,000 stallion, which was a bargain. And I knew she had already produced a Flatter, Taris, who was in training with Todd Beattie and they saw a lot of potential." **Cont. p3**

## PRIVATE ZONE WORKS FOR SPRINT

**Private Zone** (Macho Uno), a leading contender for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, worked a half mile in :48.60 under Carlos Marquez Jr. at Keeneland Saturday just before the track closed for morning renovation at 8 a.m. Going from the three-eighths pole to the seven-eighths in a light drizzle, the GI Forego S. winner produced fractions of :12.80, :35.80, :48.60 and galloped out five-eighths in

1:03.60 over a track labeled as fast. "Before a big race, I want better than that," trainer Jorge Navarro revealed. "I wanted a little more. We were going to go at 8:30, but they were sealing the track and I didn't want to work on a sealed track." He continued, "This is the first time he has worked for me when it was this dark. He came back OK and that's the main thing. Carlos is an old-time rider who takes care of the horse. He said not to worry [about the work], that he is still doing good."

## WINX WONDERFUL IN COX PLATE

Trainer Chris Waller described his 4-year-old filly **Winx** (Aus) (Street Cry {Ire}) as a potential superstar leading into Saturday's G1 Cox Plate, and the dark bay more than delivered on that promise, annihilating the males to win by nearly five lengths--a remarkable margin down the short Moonee Valley straight--while smashing the track record in the process. Dispatched as the favorite from the rail, Winx and jockey Hugh Bowman were content to take back passing the stands the first time as **The Cleaner** (Aus)

(Savoire Vivre {GB}) was hustled to the lead directly to their outside. British raider **Arod** (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) raced up to join The Cleaner heading into the first turn while **Highland Reel** (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) settled in an ideal position behind them with Winx on his heels on the rail. Winx kept the front-running The Cleaner no more than five lengths away down the backstretch, and began to inch ominously closer under a motionless Hugh Bowman rounding the second bend as **Criterion** (NZ) (Sebring {Aus}) followed in her slipstream. **Cont. p16**

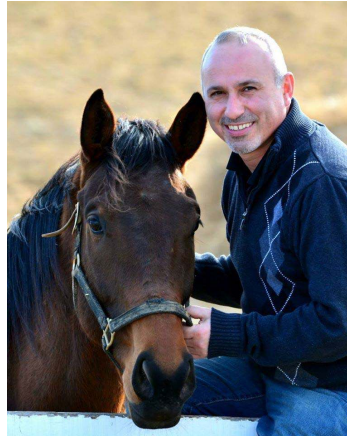

**A Comedy in Several Acts cont.**

Comedy already had a dependable record in the sales ring, with a juvenile by Arch bringing \$150,000 at the 2011 OBS March sale and subsequent stakes winner Theatre Star (War Front) bringing \$95,000 at the 2012 OBS June sale. At her initial auction, Taris brought \$90,000 at the 2012 Keeneland September sale.

“All three of her foals had sold well when I had made the decision to buy Comedy,” Di Cola said. “We bought her as a long-term member of our broodmare band, but then obviously we know what happened after that.”

The “after that” was all Taris. The filly, tabbed a **“TDN Rising Star”** after her debut win at Aqueduct in 2013, confirmed her quality with a nine-length romp in the GII Raven Run S. the following year. She attracted a final bid of \$2.35 million from trainer Simon Callaghan at last year’s Fasig-Tipton November sale. Now racing for Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and John Magnier, Taris was second in last year’s GI La Brea S. This term, she won the GIII Rancho Bernardo H. and enters the Breeders’ Cup off a third-place effort in the GIII L.A. Woman S.

The first decision Di Cola and partners Antonio Scotto Di Carlo and Michele Fascelli had to make was what to do with Taris’s young full-sister.

“When the Flatter filly was born, we had to make the decision to keep the filly or keep the mare, so we decided to sell the filly,” Di Cola explained. “We sold the filly at the Saratoga sale as a yearling. She was a little bit on the small side and we sold her so we could keep the mare. But once Taris won the Raven Run, we had so many offers and the last offer we decided to sell. We got many calls and I turned down many different offers, but the last one was too good to say no.”

The partners sold Comedy to SF Bloodstock, which sells the 11-year-old mare Monday through Select Sales as [hip 29](#). She is in foal to Tapit.

Di Cola still has a yearling colt by Stay Thirsty out of Comedy and the mare continues to pay dividends for the partners.

“As of right now, we are shooting for the 2-year-old in training sale in Florida for the Stay Thirsty colt,” he said.

Taris’s full-sister Stoweshoe, a West Virginia-bred, is now two for three, a stakes winner and stakes-placed at Charles Town.

“We sold her to a local owner and she is in West Virginia and so we are making money through the breeding program with her,” Di Cola said.

The trickle down from the private sale of Comedy continues.

“With the money we got from Comedy, we invested in buying other weanlings, mares and racehorses,” Di Cola said.

One of those investments was as part of a pinhooking venture with Machmer Hall, which purchased a colt by Harlan’s Holiday for \$190,000 at last year’s Keeneland November sale. The

youngster returned to bring \$425,000 at this year’s Fasig-Tipton Saratoga sale. A transplant from Monte di Procida, Italy, Di Cola is a restaurateur in Martinsburg, West Virginia. He has been involved in racing for some 15 years now, starting out in the claiming ranks with his brother, trainer Raimondo Di Cola, before graduating to breeding.

“We have 10 broodmares,” Di Cola said. “Some of them are in Kentucky and we keep some at the farm in West Virginia.”

He continued, “We both breed to race and sell. But we are not in a position to keep high-priced foals. If the foal looks likely to bring a lot of money, then we’ll sell. Whenever we have a big horse, you’ve got to pay the bills. We sell the good ones. Maybe one day, we will be able to keep the good ones, too.”

Selling horses like Comedy is a building block that Di Cola hopes leads to bigger and better things ahead. “It was a tough decision to sell Comedy, but the offer was too good to say no,” he said. “It was a business call. Like everybody else, we are aiming to win a graded race some day. We’ve won stakes races, but never graded races. So our goal is to win a Grade I or II one day. And I believe we’re going to do it one day. We have some young mares who look like they have a good future.”

The Keeneland November sale begins Monday, Nov. 2 at 11 a.m.

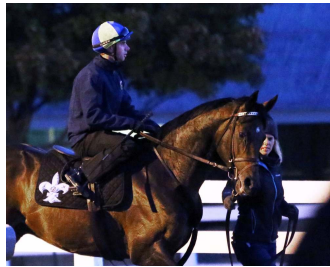

## EXAGGERATOR PREPS FOR JUVENILE

Not since D. Wayne Lukas sent out the winners of the

GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile in three straight seasons (Capote, 1986; Success Express, 1987; and Is It True, 1988) has any trainer gone back-to-back, but--somewhat improbably--trainer Keith Desormeaux has not one, but two chances, to accomplish the feat Saturday.

"We're going to see if we can get lightning to strike twice," said Desormeaux, who won last year's Juvenile at Santa Anita with Texas Red (Afleet Alex).

The more accomplished of the duo, Big Chief Racing's Exaggerator (Curlin), tuned up for the Juvenile with a sharp five-furlong drill over the Keeneland main track Saturday morning

that went in :59.60, fastest of 10 moves at the distance. With jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. in the irons, the dark bay broke off five lengths behind his company and clicked off fractions of :12.20, :24.20 and :36 before galloping out six panels in 1:13.60 while finishing 10 lengths clear of the workmate.

"The track was perfect, and I thought it was going to be sloppy," Desormeaux continued. "We were under pressure to get this in with the rain in the forecast and it rained more last night than I thought it would. The work was very nice. He was very smooth, finished strong and galloped out strong. He did all the things that you would want to say."

A maiden winner at second asking at Del Mar July 25, Exaggerator shipped east and came with a rail rally to take the GI Saratoga Special S. by 3/4 of a length Aug. 16. The \$110,000 Keeneland September purchase led in the final furlong of Keeneland's GI Claiborne Breeders' Futurity Oct. 3, but was overhauled late and dropped a one-length decision to **Brody's Cause** (Giant's Causeway).

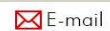

years to take down the GI Breeders’ Cup Distaff Friday, turned up for the race with a solid five-furlong workout. With jockey Florent Geroux up, the last-out winner of the GI Cotillion S. was timed in 1:00.40 for trainer Larry Jones through fractions of :11.80, :23.60, :36.20. She galloped out six furlongs in 1:14.60. It was her third work over the local strip.

“We called a little audible and went early because they

were going to seal the track [at the break],” Jones said. “The track was OK [at 7:15 a.m.] so we said, ‘Let’s go.’ Things couldn’t have gone better for her since she has been here and the only question now is do we have enough horse.”

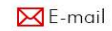

## CLEMENT DUO BREEZE AT BELMONT

Robert S. Evans's GI Breeders' Cup Classic contender **Tonalist** (Tapit), a two-time winner of the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, breezed six furlongs in 1:13.81 at Belmont Park Saturday morning. Regular rider John Velazquez was aboard the **'TDN Rising Star.'** "Some people had him in 1:13 and change, I had him in 1:13 4/5," Clement said. "It was a nice work. He worked in company, was in a good position and finished nicely. He went very willingly, not very aggressive, just nice. He came back in good shape. He looks very fit to me. Everything is good." Clement added, "Johnny thinks he was very comfortable without blinkers. I don't think we want to change too much, he just won a Grade I without the blinkers. Unless Johnny or the owner comes to me with a great idea, I think we'll pass on them."

**Hard Not to Like** (Hard Spun) turned in her final breeze for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Belmont Saturday. With Velazquez in the irons, the GI Diana S. heroine worked a dogs-up half-mile on the inner turf in :49.55 seconds in company. "The important thing was to settle her, because the Breeders' Cup is 1 3/16 miles," Clement said. "She looked well. Johnny said he had no problem keeping her settled. She was strong, but manageable. They finished very well. The last quarter was very nice. She came back well."

Clement will also be represented in the Breeders' Cup by **Red Vine** (Candy Ride {Arg}) (Dirt Mile) and **Pure Sensation** (Zensational) (Turf Sprint).

## FINAL WORKS FOR BROWN'S BC CONTINGENT

Chad Brown, who has the most Breeders' Cup entries of any trainer this year with 14, supervised 10 of those contenders during their final works for the Championships Saturday morning at Belmont.

Leading the calvary were GI Breeders' Cup Turf contenders **Big Blue Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) and **Slumber (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}), who most recently finished first and second, respectively, in Belmont's GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic S. Sept. 26. The duo worked together going a half-mile on the main track, with Big Blue Kitten stopping the clock in :50.33 (30/47) and Slumber going just the slightest bit slower in :50.34 (31/47).

"They've been working on the dirt since the Hirsch, just maintenance works," Brown said. "Big Blue Kitten always works on the dirt. Slumber's had a long year and the horse is doing fantastic, so it's just some maintenance. I think they make a good team. It was more of the same from them, just an easy half and both horses cooled out real happy."

Brown's third BC Turf contender **Shining Copper** (Aragorn {Ire}) also breezed a half-mile on the main track, covering the distance in :50.54 (39/47).

The New York-based conditioner also has a trio of runners for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, all of whom also worked Saturday. Last term's F/M Turf runner-up **Stephanie's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy), winner of the GI Flower Bowl Invitational S. here last time Oct. 3, drilled five furlongs on the turf in company with **Dacita (Chi)** (Scat Daddy). Atzeni to provide that rider with a third consecutive renewal and also trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam with a career trio of successes in this significant Classic precursor. Last early, the imposing dark bay was angled wide for his run as the 10-11 favorite **Foundation (Ire)** (Zoffany {Ire}) was locked up in behind approaching the final quarter mile. Surging past **Johannes Vermeer (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, he quickly had that rival's measure and was kept up to his work to comfortably score by 1 1/2 lengths, with Foundation 2 1/2 lengths behind in third having only been

granted a clear run just before the furlong pole.

"We weren't filled with confidence, but Peter had always said he was a good horse and it was just a question of how good," his winning owner said. Held up with all rivals in his sights as Ballydoyle's G2 Beresford S. winner Port Douglas (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) took up expected pace-setting duties, Marcel moved up with menace and was the only one able to produce the kind of acceleration required to make a difference from just before the two-furlong marker. As he stayed on strongly with Johannes Vermeer keeping respectable distance on the run to the line, Frankie Dettori was freeing up the favorite, who hardly had a race and can be considered desperately unlucky. "I've always thought he was a nice horse and his work had been very good, but I think Paul [Hancock] thought I was mad coming here," Chapple-Hyam commented. "Coming here I thought he'd be placed, because he's always worked like a good horse, but he's been weak. Even though I don't have many good horses, you know when a good one comes along." His trainer was looking ahead to next year's Classics, with Epsom's blue riband not high on the agenda. "He obviously goes on any ground and will be better next year when he's stronger," he added. "I see him as a French Derby type; I'd be worried about him staying further. If I get my way, he'll be in my favorite race, the Dante, but if he shows enough speed before then he could go for the Guineas." Atzeni added, "I rode him to run well, but I was traveling so well. He likes the ground, quickened up well and won going away." Foundation's trainer John Gosden said of the unfortunate beaten market leader, "The horse is delighted. He thinks the boss has brought him all this way for a piece of work. Frankie said they all just died in front of him and he had nowhere to go. The winner came around and had a free one. That's racing. He's a gorgeous horse, he handled the ground and I'll look to run him in a trial in the spring now. We'll probably look at the Greenham and then aim him at some nice races at Deauville."

Being successful in this game is down to three things: You need good horses, patient owners and great staff. When you have good people the job is easy, as then only the trainer and jockey can mess it up. Thankfully, this year we've only done that on the odd occasion."

Gosden offered an update on his GI Breeders' Cup Turf contender Golden Horn (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}): "Golden Horn is currently 38,000 feet above us flying to America," he said. "When he left he weighed more than before the Arc, which is what I wanted as he'll lose weight on the flight, you'd have thought. He's well, though, and I'm looking forward to it."

**IT'S HIM AGAIN**

Staged at Saint-Cloud today, the G1 Prix Royal-Oak, or French St Leger, offers a chance for **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {GB}) to restore fortunes that seem to be in sharp decline and bid for an eighth triumph at the highest level. While Corine Barande-Barbe has not lost any faith, it is hard to escape the feeling that the 9-year-old is understandably over the peak and on the way down, especially after a tame fifth in the Oct. 3 G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp that he had traditionally dominated. Previously last in both the May 24 G1 Prix d'Ispahan also at Longchamp and Sept. 12 G1 Irish Champion S. at

Leopardstown, he at least has the testing conditions here in which he thrives and on which he captured the latest of his top-level successes in the G1 Prix Ganay again at his favored Longchamp May 3. As well as his form is the question of the trip, as he has never been asked to tackle anything like this near two-mile trip throughout his eight seasons of racing. "It will be a little bit of a surprise for him going the longer distance, but he is a very intelligent horse and I am sure he will adapt," Barande-Barbe said of the veteran, who will be partnered by Frankie Dettori for the first time. "Four years ago he won over 2500 meters, further than a mile and a half, in very deep ground in the Grand Prix de Deauville. This will be a new experience for him, but new experiences keep people young. For the first year since he has been racing, September and October have not been so wet, so running him over 2000 meters, the going has been too quick. That is why we are trying him over longer and having Frankie Dettori on his back is another nice surprise for him." Retirement is never far from the discussions surrounding Cirrus des Aigles, but his trainer is keeping that talk at bay at present. "I don't think this could be his last race," she added. "If he is enjoying it, we would love to go back to Dubai with him." Youth is certainly on the side of His Highness The Aga Khan's **Vazirabad (Fr)** (Manduro {Ger}), who was an impressive winner of the 15-furlong G2 Prix Chaudenay at Longchamp last time Oct. 3. That bloodless win was his fourth in succession and followed another stress-free outing in the G3 Prix de Lutece over the same course and distance Sept. 6 and he is a serious player with weight-for-age on his side. Old rivals **Fly With Me (Fr)** (Beat Hollow {GB}) and **Alex My Boy (Ire)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) meet again, with the former having won the G3 Prix Gladiateur over this trip at Longchamp last time Sept. 13 and Alex My Boy arriving fresh, having been rested since annexing Deauville's G2 Prix Kergorlay

over 15 furlongs Aug. 23. Another with major claims is **Siljan's Saga (Fr)** (Sagamix {Fr}), who was a slightly unlucky fifth in this last year and who went from success in the Aug. 30 G2 Grand Prix de Deauville to finishing just over four lengths eighth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 4.

**ROMANET WINNER TO BE TESTED IN ITALY**

The G1 Premio Longines Lydia Tesio is the last chance for fillies and mares to grab a Group 1 in Italy this season, and the favorite, **Odeliz (Ire)** (Falco), is the only one in the field of eight to have already landed one, thanks to the upset she posted in the Prix Romanet at Deauville Aug. 23. The 5-year-old mare, trained by Karl Burke, has enjoyed her best season this year. She collected a first group win in the G3 Franz Gunther Von Gaertner

Gedachtnisrennen in July over 1600 meters at Hamburg, and was not disgraced when fourth in the G1 Prix Rothschild over the same trip. Odeliz has a couple questions to answer over 2000 meters on good ground at

Capannelle. The first is about the ground: her win at Deauville came over a very soft surface when she was allowed to set a leisurely pace. The second is the form: she ran dead-last in the G1 Prix de l'Opera, even though she had some tactical excuses.

The 3-year-old **Sound Of Freedom (Ire)** (Duke Of Marmalade {Ire}) is by far the best of the three Italian fillies, all trained by Stefano Botti. The easy winner of the G3 Premio Regina Elena

(the Italian 1000 Guineas) tried to become the first filly to win the G2 Derby Italiano since Archidamia in 1936, but found her stablemate Goldstream (Ity) (Martino Alonso {Ire}) just too good. Sound Of Freedom ran a decent race when sixth in the G1 Prix De Diane, but was very disappointing when third in her come back in the G3 Premio Verziere, two weeks ago at San Siro. "She needed the run, and the heavy ground bothered her," said Stefano Botti. "Sound Of Freedom has improved a lot from that, I think she is ready to run at the top of her form."

**Victoria Regina (Ire)** (Mastercraftsman {Ire}) snatched her first group win in her first start for up-and-coming French trainer Henri-Francois Devin when taking the G3 Premio Elena & Sergio Cumani Sept. 27. The other French 3-year-old filly, **Via Pisa (Fr)** (Pivotal {GB}), grabbed her black-type win in the Listed Prix Coronation at Saint Cloud, holding the challenge of the German raider **Nymeria (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow), also a live contender today.

Winx put her raw talent on display for all to see right from the start, winning Randwick's G2 Furious S. in her third start a little over a year ago before finishing second in the prestigious G2 Tea Rose S. and G1 Flight S. Off the board in her first two autumn outings in February at shorter-than-ideal distances, Winx bounced back to take Rosehill's G2 Phar Lap S. over 1500 meters in March and was fifth--beaten two lengths--in the G1 Vinery Stud S. over 2000 meters two weeks later. She notched her second Group 1 placing when second in the G1 Australian Oaks at The Championships Apr. 4, after which she embarked on a five-race win streak that still stands. Dominant in the G3 Sunshine Coast Guineas May 16, Winx was even more impressive when winning the G1 Queensland Oaks by 3 1/2 lengths two weeks later. Given a winter holiday thereafter, Winx took the G2 Theo Marks S. over 1300 meters at Rosehill Sept. 12 and recorded an eye-popping first Group 1 win in Randwick's prestigious G1 Epsom H. going a flat mile Oct. 3, setting the

stage for Saturday's career high. It was also a high for her trainer, who--while being one of the most recognizable and successful conditioners in the country--was recording his first win in what are described as the country's 'major' Group 1s: The Caulfield and Melbourne Cups, Cox Plate and Golden Slipper.

"It is a big moment," Waller said. "It was shades of [dual Cox Plate-winning mare] Sunline."

"She is fast and she is a superior athlete," Waller added. "You never go on and think these horses can be Cox Plate winners and I don't even dream about these things."

It was an emotional score for Bowman, who said, "All I ever wanted to be, since I was a little boy, was a jockey. To be here riding on this stage is one thing, but to win a race like this, I can't tell you how much it means. I am so thankful to Chris Waller and to the owners of the horse, also to my family and friends who are here--I cannot believe it to be honest."

The aftermath of the race was not entirely celebratory for Bowman, who had to defend alleged interference from Criterion's jockey Michael Walker after Walker was forced to check Criterion at the 500-meter mark. It was deemed The Cleaner was also involved in the movement that saw all three horses shuffle towards the fence, and Bowman was not charged.

Winx was bred by John and Debbie Camilleri's Fairway Thoroughbreds, which has enjoyed a banner year having also bred the G1 Golden Slipper hero Vancouver (Aus) (Medaglia d'Oro). She is out of the stakes-winning and Group-placed Vegas Showgirl, who the Camilleri's bought for A\$455,000 out of the 2008 Magic Millions National Broodmare Sale. Winx is Vegas Showgirl's second foal; she also has an unraced 3-year-old gelding named Win Win Leader (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) and 2-year-old and yearling colts by Snitzel (Aus). Like her dam, Winx was also offered for sale at Magic Millions, fetching A\$230,000 from agent Peter Tighe from the Coolmore Stud draft. Tighe is now part of the ownership group that also includes Debbie Kepitis, a member of the Ingham family, one of Australia's first families of racing. The Ingham family has campaigned great Group 1 winners like Octagonal (NZ) and his son Lonhro (Aus), and more recently Kepitis has also enjoyed success with last year's G1 Thousand Guineas winner Amicus (Aus) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}).

Winx is the fourth Group 1 winner for former Darley shuttler Street Cry (Ire), who died in Australia last September. Street Cry currently has five sire sons standing in Australia and New Zealand, including Carlton House and G1 Melbourne Cup winner Shocking (Aus), and his Group 1-winning grandson Hallowed Crown (Aus) (Street Sense) is currently standing his first season at Street Cry's former home, Darley's Kelvinside Stud in the Hunter Valley alongside Carlton House.

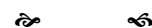

## HOPES CHANGE COBALT PLEA TO GUILTY

The father-son training team of Lee and Shannon Hope, who are currently embroiled in a hearing for charges related to cobalt positives returned by three horses under their care, have changed their plea to guilty, according to *Racing.com*. Racing Victoria stewards still must prove the cobalt was administered for performance-enhancing purposes, and the Hopes say they didn't purposely deliver a performance-enhancement substance to their horses, saying the positives came about as part of their regular feed, supplement and medication practices, *Racing.com* reported.

The plea change to guilty means the Hopes will face at least a suspension or fine. The first part of the Hopes' cobalt hearing ran Oct. 15 to 20, and has been adjourned until Nov. 4.

## ABLE FRIEND WORTH THE WEIGHT?

When last seen on a racecourse, **Able Friend (Aus)** (Shamardal) was a shadow of himself as he finished a well-beaten sixth behind Solow (Ire) (Singspiel {Ire}) in what became an all-smoke-no-fire matchup in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot in mid-June. The massive chestnut gets back to work Sunday in the Premier Bowl H., but with a title defense in the G1 Longines Hong Kong Mile Dec. 13 the major near-term objective, the question becomes just what to expect from the world's current top-rated turf miler.

The 6-year-old, who will be partnered by Mauritian Karis Teetan, raced first-up in last year's Premier Bowl and looked a

winner in the stretch, but his rally stalled and he finished a close fourth to **Aerovelocitv (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}), whom he spotted 11 pounds. For the next six months and six starts, he was untouchable, with four imperious Group 1 wins,

bookended by the Hong Kong Mile in December and Champions Mile in May. He'll give Aerovelocitv nine pounds this time around, but trainer John Moore isn't willing to concede defeat.

"Able Friend was well underdone when he ran fourth last season and I can assure everyone that we have a lot fitter horse this season," said Moore. "As I've already said, sprinters beware! Champions can sprint well fresh, we know that. If he won it wouldn't be a surprise."

Aerovelocitv runs for the first time since his decisive victory in the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint in Singapore in May, but his

trainer is approaching this comeback with some trepidation.

"He might just be older and complacent, I don't know," Paul O'Sullivan suggested, "but I expect him to take a lot of benefit from the run. I don't think he's as far forward as he was last year. He hasn't taken off and thrived yet."

**Not Listenin'tome (Aus)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}), stablemate of Able Friend and in receipt of 15 pounds from Hong Kong's Horse of the Year, is the now horse. A Group 3 winner and twice Group 1 placed in Australia, the 5-year-old could not have been more impressive in landing the National Day Cup H. up the 1000-meter straight Oct. 1.

Leading rider Joao Moreira will be atop Able Friend for the rest of the year, but he has the call for trainer Tony Cruz on **Peniaphobia (Ire)** (Dandy Man {Ire}) Sunday. The 4-year-old, runner-up in last year's Hong Kong Sprint and in the Al Quoz Sprint, exits a seventh in the National Day Cup. **Click for the HKJC.com form.**

## MOREIRA LOOKING FOR CONTENTMENT

While such names as **Blazing Speed (GB)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}), **Military Attack (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}) and **Helene Super Star** (War Front) are recognizable to a broader audience as international Group 1 winners, **Contentment (Aus)** (Hussonet) is not nearly as familiar, but the 5-year-old will seek to continue a meteoric ascent in Sunday's Sha Tin Trophy H.

Ninth, beaten 5 1/2 lengths in the Hong Kong Derby in March, Contentment twice won over this 1600-meter trip to close out the 2014/2015 season and was impressive in handing **Giant Treasure** (Giant's Causeway) a half-length defeat in the Celebration Cup H. Oct. 1.

“I thought Contentment was a little bit under-done last time, which is a good sign because he won the race and that shows his ability,” commented jockey Joao Moreira. “I think he’s going to be 100% fit this time, which will make it very tough for the others. I respect every other horse in the race, they are very good horses, but I have faith in this horse and I think he can win.”

Helene Super Star, the former G2 UAE Derby hero Lines of Battle, makes his first start since besting **Dominant (Ire)** (Cacique {Ire}) by a short head in the G1 Champions and Chater Cup over the metric 12 furlongs May 31, as Blazing Speed was fourth as the 3-2 favorite. This 1600-meter distance figures short for each of those, who will aim for the G1 Longines Hong Kong Cup and Hong Kong Vase in December.

**Dan Excel (Ire)** (Shamardal), the two-time defending champion of the now-discontinued G1 SAI Cup in Singapore going 10 furlongs, is also a proficient miler and should improve off his sixth-place effort behind Contentment in the Celebration Cup.
