Town and Country Farms' **Stopchargingmaria** (Tale of the Cat) overcame a very wide trip and a stewards' inquiry to defeat California raider **Stellar Wind** (Curlin) in the \$2-million

GI Longines Breeders' Cup Distaff, the main event on Ladies' Day Friday at Keeneland. **Curalina** (Curlin) made a middle move into contention on the backstretch and stayed on well in the final half-furlong to complete a 1-3 finish for the Todd Pletcher barn,

successful earlier in the day with **'TDN Rising Star' Liam's Map** (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Dirt Mile. The first two across the line appeared to bump two or three times in the latter stages of the race, but after a lengthy debate, stewards ruled there was insufficient evidence to make a change. "You always get scared when this happens because it's such a big race and you don't want to get taken down, but I did nothing wrong," Javier Castellano explained. "My horse ran a great race and I kept a straight path and was keeping the horse straight." **Cont. p4**

CHARTING A COURSE TO VICTORY

Entering Friday's GI Las Vegas Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, racing luck--or, specifically, bad racing luck--probably had a better chance of beating **'TDN Rising Star' Liam's Map** (Unbridled's

Song) than any of the 10 other rivals that signed up to take on the fleet gray. As it turned out, fate nearly intervened, as the \$800,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase missed the break and was snookered away as some of the opposition tried to capitalize on the early misfortune. But the

good ones always seem to find a way to win when the chips are down, and Liam's Map finally found running room as they cornered and powered away from **Lea** (First Samurai) for an ultimately comfortable 2 1/2-length victory. **Red Vine** (Candy Ride {Arg}) sat a ground-saving trip, but made no late impact and finished a distant third. **Cont. p6**

CLASS, TALENT TRUMP ADVERSITY AT BC

This year's two-day lineup of Breeders' Cup races projected to be strong in terms of equine talent and deep in engaging storylines. But Friday's card, traditionally pegged as the appetizer to Saturday's main course, served up its own satisfying spread of intrigue.

Overcoming on-track adversity with meticulous race-riding tactics seemed to be the overall theme. But a lights-out display of raw power from trip-troubled **Liam's Map** (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Dirt Mile posed a tantalizing question that won't be answered until after Saturday's GI Classic: Did we already see the most formidable racehorse in the nation?

Jockey Javier Castellano said he thought so after the win. He piloted the 4-year-old to a 2 1/2-length score in the Dirt Mile with what looked like devastating ease after a nightmare journey that included a poor start, being locked in a box all the way down the Keeneland backstretch, and having to hit the brakes several times before finally guiding Liam's Map to clear sailing off the far turn. **Cont. p3**

“I had to find the best seam for the horse, and I didn’t want to squeeze the lemon early,” Castellano said. “I tried to ride with a lot of patience...He’s an amazing horse. He showed he’s got great skill today...When you ride the best horse in the country--I think he paid off.”

Trainer Todd Pletcher would have none of the “Did you choose the right race?” line of questioning after Liam’s Map’s victory, deflecting the first of what are sure to be many queries about what it might have been like to instead have thrown down against Triple Crown hero American Pharoah (Pioneer of the Nile) in the Classic.

Then, going about their business as the continent’s highest-earning individual trainer and jockey have done all year, Pletcher and Castellano came back two races later to capture the featured GI Distaff with **Stopchargingmaria** (Tale of the Cat).

The Distaff unfolded as a mad cavalry dash from the quarter pole to the wire, with at least nine fillies and mares in contention to win it at the head of the lane and six of them lining up across the track approaching the final furlong.

The two who opted for the widest paths off the turn were left to fight it out in deep stretch, and although Stopchargingmaria and **Stellar Wind** (Curlin) exchanged bumps and engaged in drifting out-induced roughhousing caused by the eventual winner, the stewards saw no hard evidence to compel them to reverse Stopchargingmaria’s battle-weary neck decision.

The two grass races for juveniles lived up their annual billings as wide-open shootouts among full fields of 14, and there was little doubt that the best 2-year-olds of their respective sexes won each division, despite mid-priced horses topping the exacta over the actual betting favorites in each affair.

In the GI Juvenile Turf, **Hit It a Bomb** (War Front) scored a convincing last-to-first neck victory in a three-way photo thanks to a ground-saving go followed by deft maneuvering through the pack by jockey Ryan Moore. The win erased substantial pre-race chatter about whether the Aidan O’Brien-trained colt could overcome the far outside post and yielding course, which Moore characterized as “loose” turf that would be called “good/soft” in Europe.

The pace-pressing win by **Catch a Glimpse** (City Zip) in the GI Juvenile Fillies Turf can also be chalked up to impeccable horsebacking by jockey Florent Geroux. Not wanting to get pinned down inside fully committed long-shot frontrunner Ruby Notion (Great Notion) as the tandem sprinted solo into the first turn, Geroux repositioned the Mark Casse trainee to the outside of the primary pacemaker, then settled down the tempo. Catch a Glimpse gamely had enough left late to repel a barrage of off-the-back challengers, with the top five fillies separated by barely three lengths.

Originally a \$220,000 purchase by Mike Repole out of the 2013 OBS March Sale, having fetched \$47,000 as a Keeneland September yearling the previous fall, Stopchargingmaria was a dual graded winner and twice Grade I-placed at two and really took flight during the middle of 2014, grinding out a win in the GI Black-Eyed Susan S. ahead of a five-length tally in the GI CCA Oaks. She entered the discussion for an Eclipse Award with a hard-fought victory in the GI Alabama S. and closed the season with a runner-up effort in the GI Beldame S.

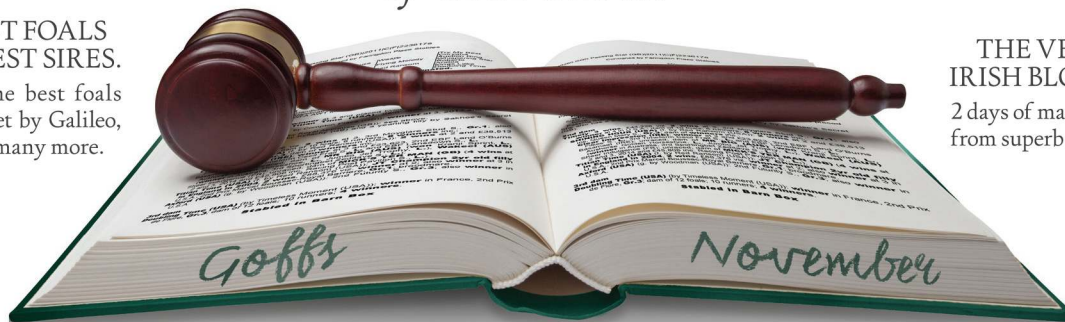

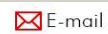
Sent through the ring at last year Fasig-Tipton November sale, the dark bay was led out unsold on a bid of \$3.15 million, but a private transaction was concluded and she made her 4-year-old debut in this track's seven-furlong GI Madison S. for Louise and Kiki Courtelis's Town and Country Farms. A rallying second in that Apr. 4 test, Stopchargingmaria easily defeated Yahilwa (Medaglia d'Oro) by four lengths in the GII DuPont Distaff S. at Pimlico May 15, then took down the colors of Untapable (Tapit) in Saratoga's GIII Shuvee H. Aug. 2. She most recently set a pressured pace in the GI Personal Ensign S. Aug. 29, but gave way late to finish fourth behind Sheer Drama (Burning Roma). There would be no interim start in the Beldame--or any other Breeders' Cup prep for that matter--and that decision reaped benefits Friday.

One of three in the race for trainer Todd Pletcher, Stopchargingmaria was ridden for speed by Javier Castellano, but was not as quick as some of her other rivals and settled in fifth around the clubhouse turn as My Sweet Addiction (Tiznow) led from GII Delaware Oaks upsetter Calamity Kate (Yes It's True) at the fence, favored Wedding Toast (Street Sense) three wide and Yahilwa on the wide outside. When Jose Lezcano took a hold of Wedding Toast to ease her back off the pace and into the three or four path, Castellano allowed his mount to amble up alongside, but was committed to a deep run as they reached the end of the backstretch.

Asked to kick on at the three-eighths pole, Stopchargingmaria pulled her way into a contending position, but Stellar Wind was coming with an even wider run, and the stage was set. The two appeared to brush a furlong and a half from the wire and again just inside the eighth pole, and although Stellar Wind looked to have all the momentum, Stopchargingmaria refused to let her by, then was allowed to keep the victory.

"The real key was when we made the decision not to run back after the Personal Ensign and train her up to this," said Pletcher, who tied Aidan O'Brien and Bill Mott for fourth among trainers with nine Breeders' Cup wins. "Being able to train her in her 2- and 3-year-old years, [it's clear] that she runs her best races sometimes when she's fresh. I think that was the key, and how she trained here. I thought her work here on Saturday was exceptional. She's the kind of filly who when she breezes like, that she tips herself. I thought that's what she did in her breeze the other day."

The winner's dam was purchased in by Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings for \$500,000 at the 2013 Fasig-Tipton November sale. She is represented by a colt of this year from the first crop of Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) and was bred this year to Tapit.

Accorded 'TDN Rising Star' status off a 9 1/2-length maiden win at Belmont last September, Liam's Map thrashed first-level allowance foes by 11 1/2 lengths going Aqueduct's one-turn mile in November and turned back Valid (Medaglia d'Oro) by a hard-fought half-length in the Harlan's Holiday S. at Gulfstream

Park the following month. Given the next six months off, the gray hit the ground running, annexing a June 19 allowance in Elmont, then, trying nine furlongs for the first time, set a searching pace in the GI Whitney S. at Saratoga Aug. 8 and looked as if he'd find the wire first,

but was tagged on the wire by fellow Rising Star Honor Code (A.P. Indy). He proved that effort took little toll on him, as he was able to control things from the front end in the GI Woodward S. at the Spa Sept. 5 and proved easily best over his stablemate Coach Inge (Big Brown), with Wicked Strong (Hard Spun) a non-threatening third. Connections were forced to choose between the known commodity of the Dirt Mile and the

unknown of the Classic and had the last laugh Friday afternoon.

Liam's Map hesitated noticeably at the break and was consigned to about fourth position entering the clubhouse turn, as Bradester (Lion Heart) and Mr. Z (Malibu Moon) argued things up front and Lea took up a prominent spot while three wide from third. Javier Castellano had a fistful of horse as they moved inside the final three-quarters of a mile and the colt tugged for his head while still short of room. A gap appeared for a split second between the dueling pacesetters at the five-furlong marker, but it soon closed up and Liam's Map was forced to check back as Lea rolled up to make it a line of three nearing the third corner. For the next eighth of a mile or so, Joel Rosario aboard Lea looked around in an attempt to locate the favorite and the Claiborne/Dilschneider product surged to the front and cut the corner into the stretch traveling ominously well. But not long after, Castellano and Liam's Map found the running room they'd been looking for, spun four wide into the lane, grabbed Lea with 100 yards to run and pulled clear.

"I was very concerned," winning trainer Todd Pletcher admitted. "The one thing Javier [Castellano] talked about is that he's a horse with a lot of speed, but he's not always quick away from there on the first step. We were hoping he'd get a clean break, but he didn't and was behind horses. I was very concerned at that point. **Dirt Mile cont. p7**

In the space of about 10 days in 2014, jockey Ryan Moore won the GI Canadian International S. in Canada, the G1 Cox Plate in Melbourne, jetted into Los Angeles for the Breeders' Cup meeting and returned to Melbourne to register an upset in the G1 Melbourne Cup.

Though Moore, who was named the first winner of the Longines World's Best Jockey award at the end of the year, was shut out at Santa Anita 12 months back, he wasted little time in getting on the board in 2015, masterfully

navigating his way through stretch traffic atop 7-1 chance **Hit It a Bomb** (War Front) for a narrow victory over favored **Airoforce** (Colonel John). Fellow European raider **Birchwood (Ire)** (Dark Angel {Ire}) was a close third. It was the third win in five years for Moore and trainer Aidan O'Brien. It was the first Breeders' Cup victory for Mrs. Evelyn Stockwell, the mother of Coolmore principle John Magnier.

Moore was at the controls when Hit It a Bomb made his debut over seven furlongs at The Curragh Sept. 27, and, sent off the 2-1 favorite in a field of 22 juveniles, the homebred sat off the pace from a high draw, bid a quarter mile out and took over inside the final furlong en route to a neck success. As connections are wont to do with horses they are contemplating sending overseas, Hit It a Bomb was sent to Dundalk for the Listed Star Appeal S. Oct. 9. Dispatched the 2-5 chalk, Hit It a Bomb, partnered this time by Joseph O'Brien, raced in a covered-up third, was pulled out full of run at the head of the stretch and powered home to score by 4 1/2 emphatic lengths. With that effort behind him, many thought the colt would have a date in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile on the main track, but it was back to the turf and another shining moment for Moore.

The 9-2 third choice on the morning line, Hit It a Bomb was allowed to drift out to better than 7-1 owing mostly to the awkward 'visitor's' draw in gate 14. Hit It a Bomb broke slightly outward at the break and settled in a joint last outside

Joy) got a good spot in third for William Buick, just ahead of the ground-saving Azar (Scat Daddy), who raced just in advance of favored Airoforce. Manhattan Dan was still going easily up front and the half-was posted in :48.22, as positions were largely unchanged on the turn, and Moore was biding his time with just one behind as the quarter-pole loomed. Hit It a Bomb rallied in tandem with Conquest Daddyo from the tail and may have bumped lightly with Hollywood Don (Tapit) just inside the three-sixteenths. **Cont. p9**

Manhattan Dan took them into the final furlong and looked for a few strides like he was going to pull a 45-1 upset, but Moore steered Hit It a Bomb off the heels of Airoforce and got his ultimate quarter in a sensational :24.10 to be up in the shadow of the post.

"I'm absolutely delighted," commented winning trainer Aidan O'Brien, unsaddling his ninth Breeders' Cup winner. "We were always looking forward to Keeneland. When we got the outside draw, we were worried and when the ground changed, we were also worried. Ryan said he would let him really relax, because he knew what he could do. This was always the plan--he's a real classy miler."

The winner's dam was the first foal from MSW & GSP Lahinch, purchased by Mrs. Stockwell at the Goffs October Yearling sale in 2000. Liscanna is also a half-sister to GSW The Bogberry (Hawk Wing) and Lahinch Classics (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who is trained for Stockwell by Chad Brown. Liscanna produced a full-sister to Hit It a Bomb in 2014, a full-brother to the winner this year and was bred back to War Front.

Indy) is the 5-1 third selection as he tries to emulate his sire, who landed this event at Gulfstream Park in 1992. The striking dark bay will be the eighth Classic runner for Hall of Fame trainer Shug McGaughey, who, though winless, sent out back-to-back runners-up in the form of Seeking the Gold and Easy Goer in 1988 and 1989, respectively. **Gleneagles (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), whose dam is a full-sister to 2000 Classic runner-up Giant's Causeway, is gamely pitched in by the Coolmore connections and although many will discount his chances, brings additional color to an already-colorful renewal.

Speaking of farewells, G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero **Golden Horn (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) makes his final career appearance before retiring to Darley's Dalham Hall Stud as the 4-5 chalk in the GI Longines Breeders' Cup Turf, while **Legatissimo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) looms the one to beat in the GI Filly & Mare Turf. The GI Mile also looks be at the mercy of the Euros, with top horses like **Make Believe (GB)** (Makfi {GB}) and **Esoterique (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) set to lock horns with defending champion **Karakontie (Jpn)** (Bernstein).

Brody's Cause (Giant's Causeway) and **Greepointcrusader** (Bernardini) go toe-to-toe in a wide-open looking renewal of the GI Juvenile, while **'TDN Rising Star' Songbird** (Medaglia d'Oro) looks one of the day's standouts in the GI Juvenile Fillies. It'll be pedal to the metal in the Sprint, with fireballers like **Runhappy** (Super Saver) and **Private Zone** (Macho Uno) expected to burn up the main track, and **Bobby's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) is back to defend his title in the GI Turf Sprint.

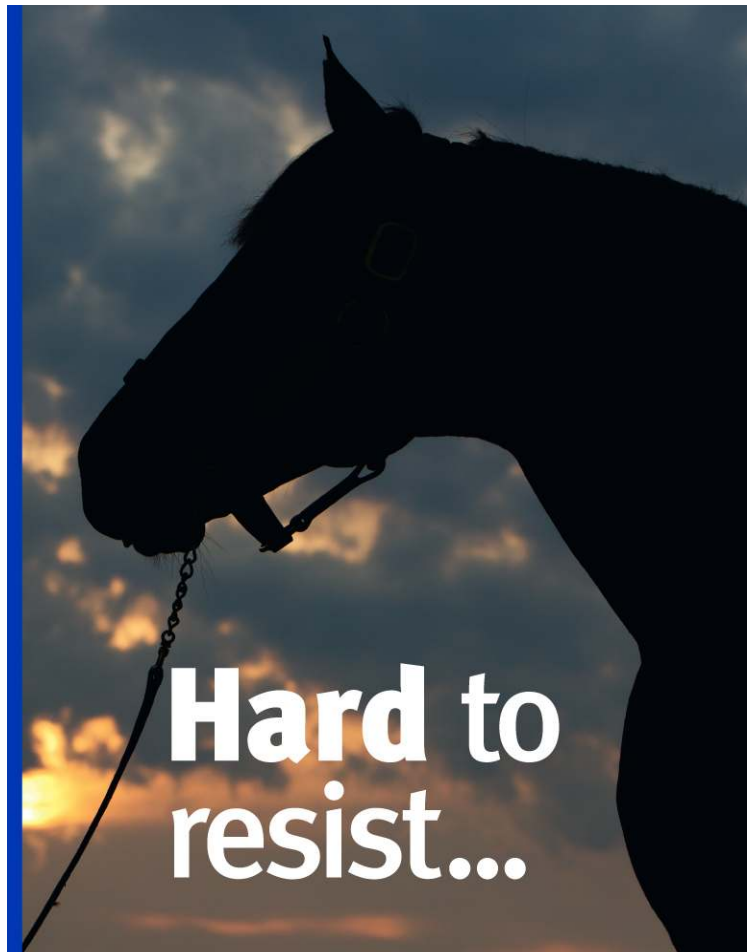

Race Day sat just off pacesetting Encryption while racing on the rail through a quarter in :23.55 and a half in :47.15. Forced to check slightly leaving the backstretch, he lacked racing room turning for home and was tipped out three wide into the stretch. He surged to the lead with a furlong to run and powered clear before just lasting over the late-closing Hoppertunity.

“He came running,” jockey John Velazquez said of the winner.

“I grabbed him a little on the backstretch and sat [in behind] on the turn and then pulled out at the quarter pole and he responded the right way. We can’t even imagine why he ran those two bad races because he’s done so well [other than that]. This [race is] what

America went from gate-to-wire to provide owner/breeder Bobby Flay with his second consecutive renewal of the Turnback the Alarm H. following last year's victory by GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint contender Dame Dorothy (Bernardini). Away well from the outside post in this eight-horse affair, the crowd's second choice seized the early advantage and maintained an unpressured lead through comfortable early splits of :23.81 and :47.32. La Madrina (Tapit) made a threatening move when drawing alongside the leader turning for home and looked like she would go on with it, but she lost momentum after shifting out several paths and impeding heavy favorite Delightful Joy. With those two out of the way, America had no other challengers and coasted home an easy winner. Delightful Joy did her best to run down the leader after overcoming that trouble in the stretch and finished a very game second.

Dancing many of the major dances for sophomore fillies last year, including a third-place effort in the GI Mother Goose S., America's only wins last season came in a pair of Aqueduct allowances over the winter. Kicking off this term with a victory in that venue's Affectionately S. Jan. 1, the 4-year-old was a non-factor seventh in the GI La Troienne S. at Churchill May 1 and was fifth in that venue's GII Fleur de Lis H. June 13. Third to Sheer Drama (Burning Roma) in the GI Delaware H. July 18, the bay was fifth behind that rival next out in the Spa's GI Personal Ensign H. Aug. 29 and failed to fire after stumbling at the break of the turf GI Flower Bowl Invitational S. here Oct. 3.

America hails from the female family of GSW & GISP Better Than Honour (Deputy Minister), who is the dam of a pair of GI Belmont S. winners in Jazil (Seeking the Gold) and champion Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy). The winner's dam produced the unraced 2-year-old filly Street Strut (Street Cry {Ire}), a yearling colt by Tiznow and a weanling filly by Malibu Moon. She was bred back to Bernardini. 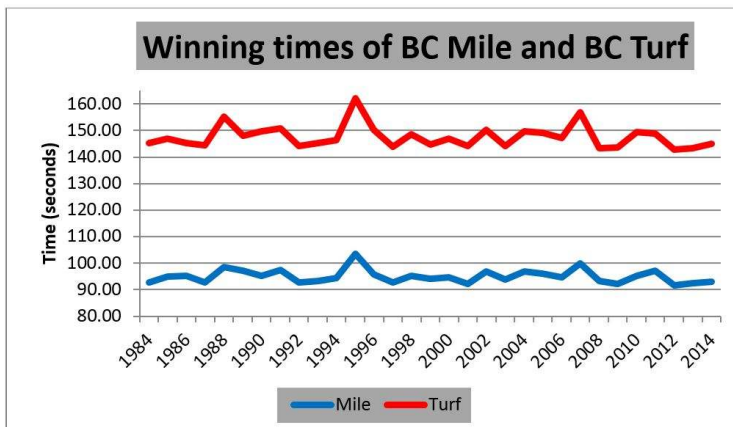
SOFT CAN SUIT AMERICANS

The prospect of a soft Keeneland turf course this weekend is thought by many U.S. experts to hand an advantage to European-trained runners at the Breeders' Cup. The thinking is that the raiders are more accustomed to such conditions

through their exploits back home.

But is this really the case? And, should we ever apply general rules to racehorses when specific evidence is available? Let's see what the history of the Breeders' Cup offers from first perspective, then consider the likely impact on key runners on a case-by-case basis.

It's fair to say that three renewals of the Breeders' Cup have taken place on a soft surface, as verified by the times of the Mile and Turf events ever-present since the 1984 inception (the softer the ground, the greater the time taken to complete the course). Shown in bold in Table 1--and by significant peaks on the two parallel line graphs--these were 1995 at Belmont, 2007 at Monmouth and 1988 at Churchill. Table 1 also contains in light type the renewals that can be counted as good ground and seen as minor perturbations to lines on the graph.

Belmont 1995 (officially soft):

The Turf went to ex-French Northern Spur (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {Ire}) with fellow sons of the great stallion finishing third (Carnegie) and fourth (Tamure); European-trained horses finished second to fourth. Ridgewood Pearl (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), a top-class Irish mare with form on heavy ground, won the Mile by two lengths, with seven lengths back to third; few really handled conditions behind.

Monmouth 2007 (officially soft):

Kip Deville (Kipling), who had never raced outside North America, beat the Aidan O'Brien-trained Excellent Art (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and another U.S.-trained runner, Cosmonaut (Lemon Drop Kid). The winner had one piece of soft-ground form, but had put up his best performances on a firm surface. English Channel (Smart Strike) won the Turf, another victory for America. The Todd Pletcher-trained horse had some form on a yielding turf track and clearly relished conditions.

Churchill 1988 (officially good):

The track was patently slower than given following recent rain, and French-trained super filly Miesque (Nureyev) relished it on the way to her second Mile. Steinlen (Habitat), who went one better the following year at Gulfstream, was trained by Wayne Lukas and highly effective on firm. The first four were miles clear of a bunch of horses who arguably struggled with conditions. The Turf went to U.S.-trained Great Communicator (Key To The Kingdom), a real warhorse effective on a firm surface but with a markedly round action.

While this sample doesn't constitute proof or otherwise of any particular conjecture, it at least provides a reminder that plenty of U.S.-trained grass runners have a latent capacity to act on a softer surface than normally encountered. Along the same lines, there are lots of European runners who may not want it soft.

This year's GI Turf favorite **Golden Horn (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) is a perfect illustration of the fallacy. His best form is on firm, and conditions most commonly encountered in the U.S. would have suited him better than those that are likely to prevail. It was on the soft side when he won the G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown in September, but also when he suffered his only defeat in the G1 Juddmonte International at York before that. Trainer John Gosden is adamant that his charge wants to bounce off a fast surface, so track conditions are a worry.

O'Brien's 3-year-old filly **Found (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) is by a sire who was a brilliant mover himself and often passes the same trait to his stock. This filly may be an exception, however. Second to Golden Horn in the Irish Champion, she also ran second on a soft surface in the G1 Qipco Champion S. at Ascot most recently.

Yielding conditions are no problem for the GI

Arlington Million one-two **The Pizza Man** (English Channel) and **Big Blue Kitten** (Kitten's Joy). It's an interesting angle that the former is by the aforementioned Monmouth winner on soft. Both will require the top two to underperform, it is true, but it has happened before.

The six European-trained runners in the Mile have contrasting ground preferences. An easy surface is ideal for **Make Believe (GB)** (Makfi {GB}), **Esoterique (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and **Impassable (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}); certainly tolerable for **Mondialiste (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and last year's winner **Karakontie (Jpn)** (Bernstein); but isn't helpful for **Time Test (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), who has a ton of speed and was highly impressive on a firm surface at Royal Ascot this year.

But, **Tepin** (Bernstein) gained a big win over this strip on soft

shine. Her Beyer Speed Figure of 108 for that romp is notable.

Table 2 (see page 24) provides an executive summary of Breeders' Cup runners on Saturday with notable performances on a soft turf surface. Conditions on the dirt track are more in flux than on the grass, these surfaces designed to dry out quickly. If the track is sloppy, horses with speed to clear the kickback hold an advantage, as do those habituated to a wet track or with a particular type of action. None of these attributes are held by O'Brien's Classic hope **Gleneagles (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}).

A 'SHO' IN TOKYO

Group 1 action in Japan moves to Tokyo this weekend for one of the country's fall showpieces, the \$2.4 million G1 Tenno Sho Autumn, and Sunday's edition offers an intriguing rematch of the top three finishers in the G2 Mainichi Okan over this course Oct. 11. **A Shin Hikari (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) was victorious that day, and makes his Group 1 debut here having lost just once in his nine-race career. The 4-year-old grey has won over this trip before, and likes to race on the lead. Trainer Masanori

Sakaguchi was realistic about the task ahead of his charge, saying, "the field gets a lot stronger at the Group 1 level and the distance will stretch to 2,000 meters. Plus he's never run under [128 pounds]. The conditions won't be easy for him but

we're just going to stick to our style. He's hard to control if there are horses in front of him but if he can grab the lead he will settle. He can be a bit rowdy when he makes his way to the actual course from the paddock but he is 3-for-3 at Tokyo. The track itself won't take anything away from him."

Second in the Mainichi Okan, despite being hit in the face with a rival's whip, was the late-blooming 6-year-old **Decipher (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}), who had previously taken the G2 Sapporo Kinen over this trip Aug. 23. Last year's G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas) winner **Isla Bonita (Jpn)** (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}) rounded out the trifecta in the Mainichi Okan, and that 4-year-old is making up for lost time, having run just twice this year. He has not won since taking last year's G2 St. Lite Kinen in September, but finished third in this 12 months ago behind the formidable pair of Spielberg (Jpn) and Gentildonna (Jpn) and could be coming back to his top form.

Another who could start favorite is **Lovely Day (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), who enter this off three straight wins including the G1 Takarazuka Kinen in June. The 5-year-old returned from a summer holiday to score in the G2 Kyoto Daishoten two weeks ago. "Physically, he's filled out and has added a lot more power," said trainer Yasutoshi Ikee.

PA GETS ONE WEEK REPRIEVE TO AVERT SHUTDOWN *By T.D. Thornton*

Stakeholders in the Pennsylvania racing industry have been granted an extra week to come up with a plan that shifts a significant portion of the operating costs of the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission to horsemen and the state's six Thoroughbred and Standardbred track operators.

On Oct. 22, Gov. Tom Wolf's administration had threatened to pull the plug on racing because the State Racing Fund, which has an annual budget of \$20 million to pay for PHRC administrative costs and drug tests, has run dry.

A four-month governor-vs.-legislature budget standoff is preventing a transfer of money from other sources to make up the \$6.2 million shortfall.

The State Racing Fund gets its money from a portion of pari-mutuel bets, uncashed tickets, breakage, licensing fees and a mix of other racing-related revenue. But declining handles in Pennsylvania have caused the fund to fail to keep up with the amount budgeted for it in recent years.

Salvatore DeBunda, president of the Pennsylvania Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, said a conference call between his organization and state officials ran late into Thursday evening before both sides agreed to speak again Friday at noon.

In the interim, DeBunda said that on Friday morning, horsemen and track operators retooled their plans for contributing to the PHRC budget with the goal of presenting to the state a long-term solution instead of just a quick fix to get through this year.

"When we got in at 12:00 [Friday], we felt that we were far enough along in the discussions that we requested additional time to work on the issues," DeBunda said. "It was granted to us [by the Department of Agriculture under the auspices of the governor's office], so what we understand is that we've been given an extra week, until Nov. 6, at which time we will reconvene and hope to have things worked out by then."

DeBunda said horsemen and the tracks will pick up talks again Tuesday.

Separately, at the legislative level, the non-profit public government integrity website www.watchdog.org is reporting that a bill has been filed to draw an estimated \$11.3 million from the gaming-revenue-generated Race Horse Development Fund to pay for drug testing.

The bill, which has passed the state Senate and is pending in the House, would also restructure how racing is regulated in the state. Its sponsor, Sen. Elder Vogel, projects that the changes would create a surplus of more than \$27 million for the State Racing Fund by 2019-20.

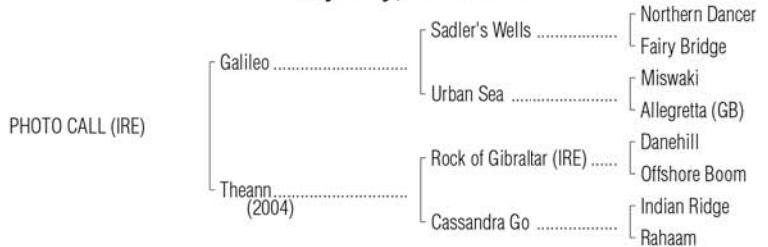
