## CADEAUX TO RETIRE IN AUSTRALIA

Popular globetrotting gelding **Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), who was retired from racing after fracturing a sesamoid in last week's G1 Melbourne Cup, will be retired Down Under, trainer Ed Dunlop told *Racing Post*. The Newmarket-based conditioner said the 9-year-old, who continues recuperation from surgery, may be destined for Living Legends, a retirement farm near Melbourne. Red Cadeaux raced in eight countries but is perhaps best known for finishing second in the Melbourne Cup three times.

"We have been inundated with offers from all over the world

to rehome him and it's important for all concerned that he's found a decent home after his achievements, in which he won just shy of £5 million," Dunlop told *Racing Post*. "We are in discussions

to transfer him to Living Legends, which is near Melbourne and where hopefully he will prove a popular attraction."

Dunlop added, "I can't stress enough the role the vets at Flemington Racecourse as well as the University of Melbourne Veterinary Centre played, and well done to all. Obviously his rehabilitation is ongoing and it will be some time until he's ready to be moved but he won't be coming home."

Dunlop also told *Racing Post* his G1 Gold Cup winner **Trip To Paris (Ire)** (Champs Elysees {GB}), fourth in the Melbourne Cup, is entered in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 29 and could head straight from Australia to Japan.

bay broke on top from the one hole and was settled into a tracking position along the rail as **Royal Son** (Tiznow) led the way. Royal Son remained in charge through the turn and as four challengers bid for the lead from the outside at the top of the lane, he came off the rail enough for Are You Kidding Me to sneak through on the inside. Are You Kidding Me took command in the final furlong and held off Lukes Alley for the win.

"He's a very genuine horse," said trainer Roger Attfield. "He's had a couple of rough trips, but he trained really well to the race and I knew if he got a fair run he would be very tough. I was a little concerned about the speed orientated racetrack as it is, and we had the one hole, so I knew we had to run out of there fairly well. When I saw the half in :49 and change, I thought we were sitting in a great spot and if he gets any kind of trip we were probably going to win." **Cont. p3**

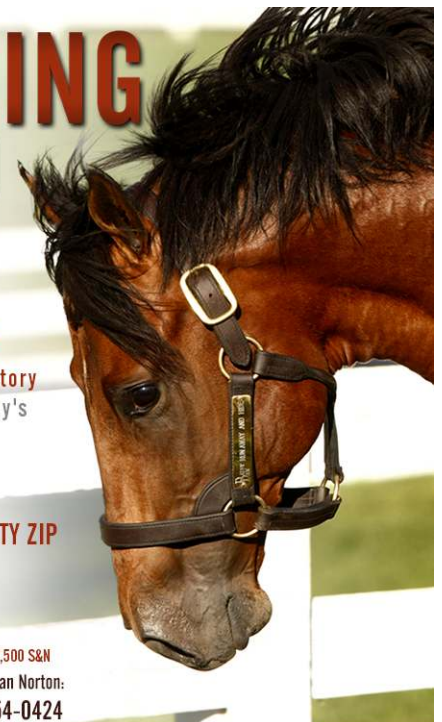

Are You Kidding Me, who was sixth in this race last year, won the GII Eclipse S. June 7 on the synthetic and the turf GII Nijinsky S. July 19 before a narrow third in the GII Sky Classic S. He completed the Presque Isle Mile superfecta Aug. 16 on the synthetic and was most recently third in the GII Durham Cup Oct. 3.

**KEENELAND NUMBERS REMAIN STEADY**

Numbers remained fairly steady during the seventh session of the Keeneland November Sale. Out of the 414 catalogued hips, 256 sold for an average of \$28,932, which was down 10.73% from the 2014 figure. The RNA rate of 24.7% was slightly higher than last year's rate of 22.5%. Calument Farm was session seven's leading buyer, having purchased three head for a total of \$245,000, while Taylor Made was the leading consignor, having sold seven for a total of \$689,000. A colt by Lane's End's The Factor, who sold as [hip 2516](#), led the way Sunday during the opening session of Book Four. The weanling was bred and consigned by Mr. and Mrs. Mike Freeny. George Bolton and Stonestreet Stables purchased the colt for \$155,000. The colt is out of Unbridled mare Winning Country, who is out of MGSW Shawnee Country. Flashy Ride ([hip 2236](#)) was the highest-priced mare on the day. The Candy Ride (Arg) mare, who is in foal to Uncle Mo, was purchased by TNIP Stables for 110,000.

The cumulative figures so far through the seven sessions remain nicely ahead of the corresponding 2014 figures, with 1,462 horses sold for an average of \$135,386, up 14.7% from last year. The median of \$65,000 is up 8.3% from the 2014 median of \$60,000. The RNA rate is also slightly up to 27.15% from 22% in 2014. The Keeneland November sale continues through Friday with session beginning daily at 10 a.m.

Owner Felice Villa was a happy man at the 200 meters pole of the G1 Premio Roma GBI Racing when his Dylan Mouth and Circus Couture battled well in front of the rest of the field. Dylan Mouth, the supposed Scuderia Effeve's first choice, held on by a short head his stablemate under a rough ride by jockey Fabio Branca. The stewards did not call an inquiry since the first two home have the same owner and trainer, but fined they Fabio Branca €1,000 for interfering with the stablemate. "I knew how good is Circus Couture is but in the end I decided to stay loyal with Dylan Mouth, who won the G2 Derby Italiano and the G1 Gran Premio Del Jockey Club and Gran Premio Di Milano for

me," said Branca. French raider Beautiful Heroine was the best of the rest, 4 1/2 lengths behind, while German raider Guiliani (Ire) (Tertullian) snatched fourth over favorite Prince Gibraltar (Fr) (Rock Of Gibraltar {Ire}). Stefano Botti, who since Saturday trains in partnership with his father, Alduino, added, "Dylan Mouth is a true 2400-meter horse and for that reason we decided to run him in front and set a strong pace. Circus Couture ran very well too; the 2000 meter trip over a fast ground is tailor-made for him." Villa was adamant about the future plans for Dylan Mouth. "I had an offer but the price is shorter than I wanted," he revealed. "If they will pay more I could sell him, if they don't Dylan Mouth will move in 10 days, with my good filly Sound Of Freedom, to Marco Botti's yard at Newmarket. Circus Couture will be a good backup next season in the races over 2000 meters."

Dylan Mouth, bred like Circus Couture by Azienda Agricola Mariano, is the first foal out of Cottonmouth (Ire) (Noverre), who won the G3 Premio Verziere for Villa's Scuderia Effeve. The 11-year-old broodmare has a yearling filly by Lawman and a colt foal by Henrythenavigator.

"It is amazing how Parthenius has improved since August," said trainer Mario Hofer. "He is not quite as precocious as his brother [Pastorius] was and, beforehand, we would have been pleased to be placed. Next year's [G3] Dr Busch-Memorial here at Krefeld and, of course, the [G1] German Derby [at Hamburg] are his main targets."

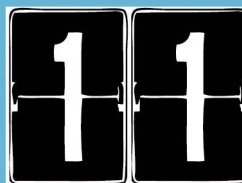

Runner-up in a pair of restricted stakes and sixth in the GI Clement Hirsch S. during the summer months, the dark bay recently tracked the pace and leveled off to be fourth in the wake of Beholder in the 1 1/16-mile GI Zenyatta S. in Arcadia Sept. 26. Sent postward as the slight favorite in this return to Cal-bred company, My Monet was prominent along the inside through a quarter-mile in :22.93 and drove through an opening along the rail to seize control turning for home. Kept to her task in the final furlong, she held off a late rush from Kiss At Midnight to earn the victory. "I was pointing for this race all along after the Hirsch," commented winning trainer Ricky Agarie. "I wanted to just give her some time and wait. But Santa Anita asked me if I was going to run her in the (Grade I) Zenyatta and she put in a bullet work that told me she was ready. You run against Beholder and My Sweet Addiction, those are some tough fillies. This is my first stakes win anywhere. A year ago today I ran my first starter on my own here at Del Mar. 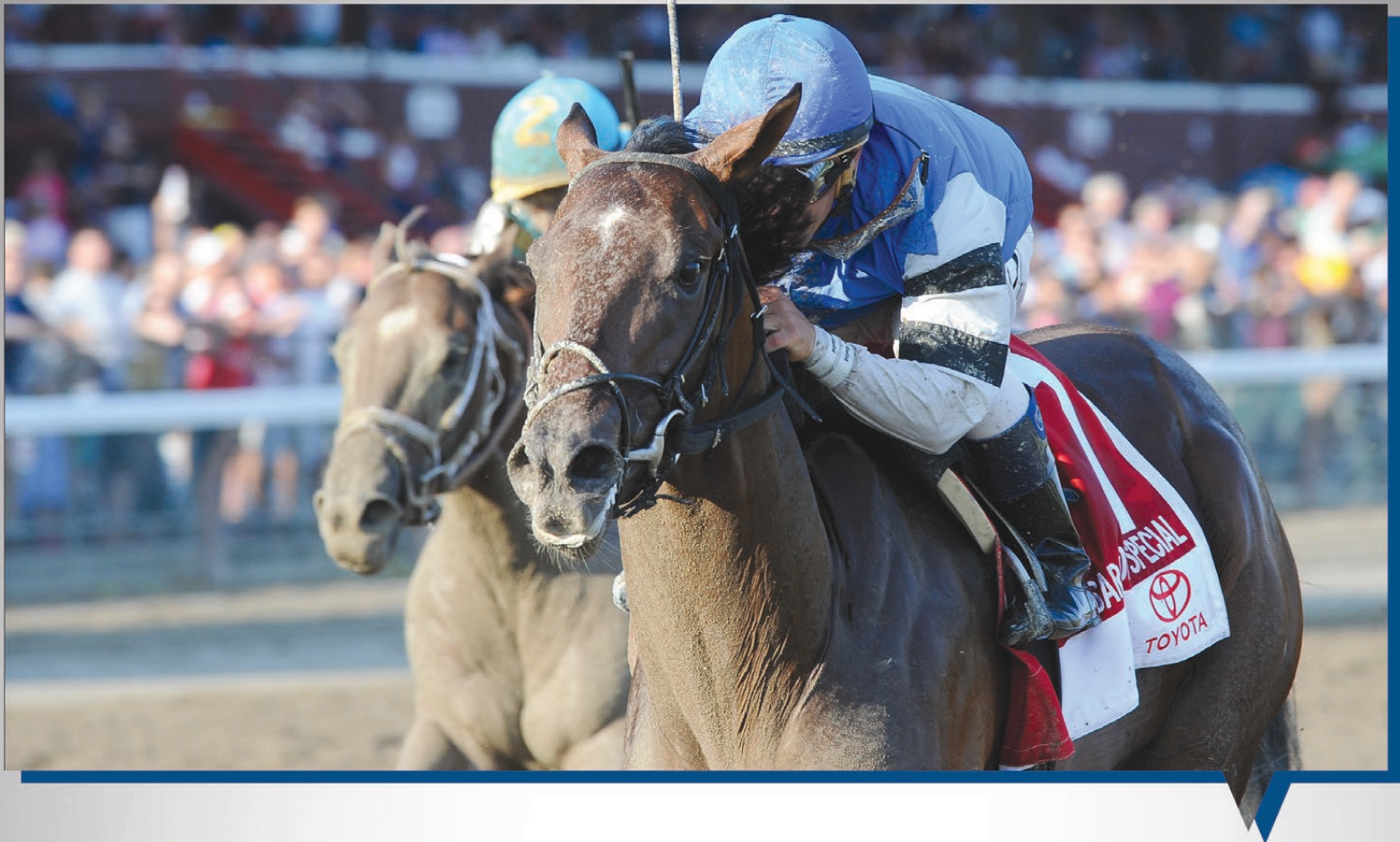

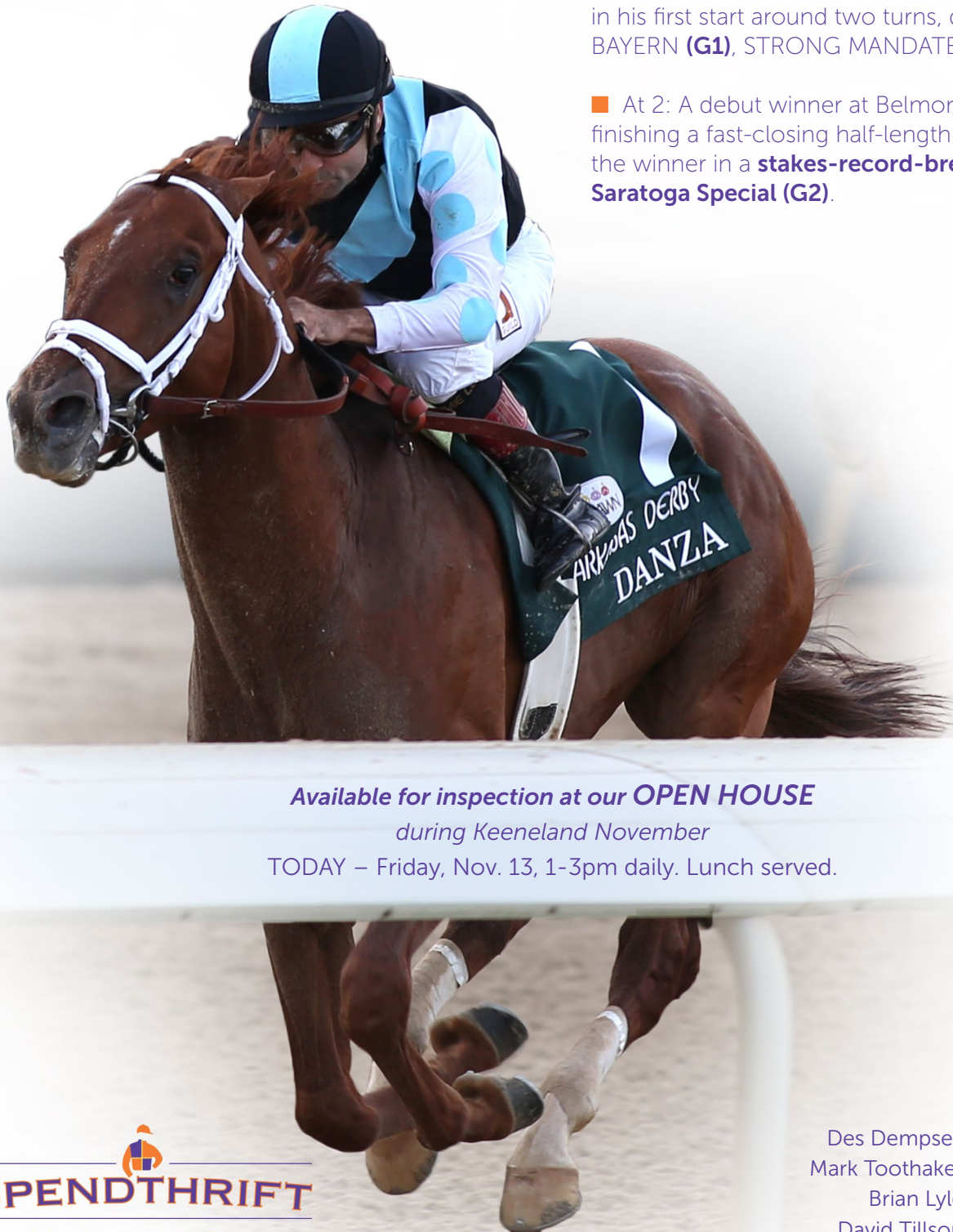

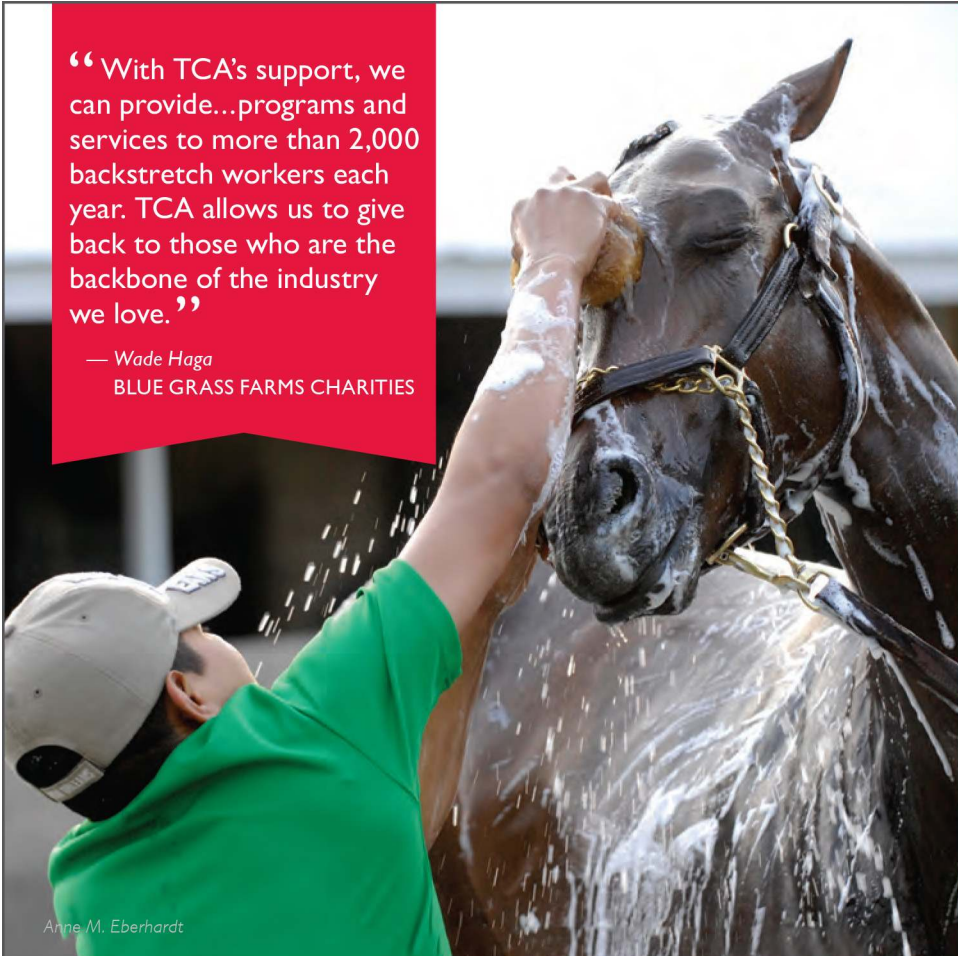
