SHARP CAT CRUISES IN RETURN Unseen since taking the GI Bayakoa H. in a walkover at Hollywood Park last December 7, MGISW **Sharp Cat** (Storm Cat) came back after the 7 1/2-month absence as the 4-5 favorite under highweight of 123 pounds in yesterday's \$69,500 Bayakoa H. at Del Mar. Reunited with jockey Corey Nakatani in her first start for trainer Wally Dollase, the four-year-old filly dueled GSW **A.P. Assay** (A.P. Indy), in with 118, through six furlongs in 1:09 1/5, then took command and strode away to a 5 1/2-length victory. Final time for the one-mile test was 1:35. "She ran a tremendous race," said Nakatani. "I've been working her in the mornings without blinkers and she has been relaxing great, but in a three-horse race you don't want to take a horse away from their natural running style, which with her is speed. A.P. Assay pressed her the whole way. She was carrying a lot of weight and she was getting tired, but she is an exceptional filly." Nakatani, who also worked Sharp Cat for the walkover but missed the race due to a prior riding engagement out of town, was aboard the Kentucky-bred for four straight wins, including the GI Hollywood Starlet, GI Las Virgenes and GI Santa Anita Oaks, but had not ridden her in a race since the pair finished third in last year's GI Kentucky Oaks. He will be back in the saddle for her next start, the GI Chula Vista H. going a mile and a sixteenth at Del Mar August 30. *(Chart, p4)*

GOODWOOD OPENS TODAY Britain's longest race meeting, the five-day festival at Goodwood known as "Glorious Goodwood," opens today with two Group 3 events--the King George Grosvenor Casinos S. and the Peugeot Gordon S. Highlights of the meeting are Wednesday's \$254,934 G1 Sussex S., one of Europe's premier mile races, and Thursday's \$115,132 G2 Goodwood Cup for stayers and \$69,901 G2 Richmond S. over six furlongs for juvenile colts and geldings, a major pointer to next year's classic races. In all, 12 stakes races will be run over the five days. One of the most interesting runners at the meeting will be the Henry Cecil-trained former South African Champion Three-Year-Old Filly **Igreja** (Arg) (Southern Halo), who makes her British stakes debut in Thursday's listed Oak Tree S. over seven furlongs.

The 1998 season at Great Barrington Race Course in Massachusetts will begin Friday, August 7 and run for 20 racing days, eight more than last year. The track will be open Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays from August 7-24 and from September 11-21. Post time is 3 p.m. weekdays and 1:30 p.m. weekends. Racing returned to Great Barrington in 1997 after a six-year hiatus.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a + will denote winners who are first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.
