Next week is a busy week in the European sales calendar; in addition to the Goffs November Foal Sale kicking off, Monday also sees Argana's November Sale commence for a three-day stint. Taking place in the Elie de Brignac sales complex in Deauville, the sale consists of a mix of horses in training, flat yearlings and national hunt store horses. Last year, 421 horses sold from 521 offered, an 80% clearance rate which included the sales-topping Silverwave (Fr) (Sliver Frost {Ire}) who was knocked down to trainer Alan Couetil for €420,000. The 3-year-old colt subsequently won the G3 Prix La Force at Longchamp in April and was also runner up to New Bay (Fr) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the G2 Qatar Prix Niel. Tourny (Fr) (Country Reel), a high class 2-year-old this year for trainer Pascal Bary, was also unearthed in last year's yearling section by Silvain Vidal for just €32,000. Tourny won the G3 Prix De Cabourg at Deauville in August and also finished third to Shalaa (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the G1 Darley Prix Morny, also at Deauville, before being sold at Argana's Arc Sale for €400,000 to Francoise Dupuis. Last year, the sale posted the highest-ever aggregate of €7,631,500 and there are a number of lots catalogued next week that should help match or better that tally. cont. p2

In the horses-in-training section, which opens the sale, the Aga Khan Studs offer 12 racing prospects which include, among others, lot 192, the 3-year-old colt, Zourkhan (Ire) (Shamardal). This Alain De Royer-Dupre-trained half-brother to champion filly Zarkava (Ire) (Zamindar) has progressed nicely in three runs to date, culminating in a maiden win at Saint-Cloud Oct. 14. Lot 194, Cherek (Fr) (Paco Boy {Ire}), also from the Aga Khan draft and trained by Jean-Claude Rouget, is a smart and consistent type. The 3-year-old colt has a race record of 7-1-4-1, which includes a third in the G3 Prix Des Chenes at Longchamp last year and a fourth place in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. English trainer Harry Dunlop offers lot 190, Red Tornado (Fr) (Dr Fong). This 92 rated 3-year-old gelding won twice as a juvenile and his form this year includes a third placing in the listed Glasgow S. at Hamilton in July. The retiring Jonathan Pease offers lot 120, Make Merry (GB) (Teofilo {Ire}), on behalf of owner/breeder George Strawbridge. The 3-year-old filly is a winner this year and the fact that she is a half-sister to G1 winner Montare (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) also makes her a valuable future breeding prospect.

A total of 385 yearlings are catalogued over the second and third days and although many are bred for national hunt racing, there are also a number of attractively bred flat horses on offer. Siyouni (Fr) (Pivotal {GB}) has quickly established himself as a leading young stallion and he has two yearlings catalogued, lot 320, a colt from Haras de la Pommeraye and lot 399, a filly offered by Jean-Marie Callier. Stock by first-crop yearling sire Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) have been well received at the yearling sales this autumn and the Newsells Park stallion is represented by lot 627, a colt offered by Haras de la Croix Sonnet from the family of Group 1 winner Fragrant Mix (Ire) (Linamix {Fr}). Spanish stud Dehesa De Milagro offer the only Footstepsinthesand (GB) (Giant's Causeway)-sired yearling, a colt, lot 548 hailing from the family of G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}). Among those with a pedigree which could translate well to the flat or jumps is lot 418 from Haras des Brousses, a filly from top steeplechase sire Saint des Saints (Fr) (Cadoudal {Fr}) out of a the listed-winning and multiple group and graded stakes placed mare Playact (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}), a top performer in both Europe and the U.S. This filly is a half-sister to the dual champion steeplechaser Pierrot Lunaire (War Chant), the Eclipse Award-winning steeplechase horse in the U.S. and a champion in Britain.

FULL FIELD FOR SINGAPORE GOLD CUP

A field of 16, with four emergencies, was drawn Wednesday for Sunday's S\$1.35-million (*US\$951,335*) Longines Singapore Gold Cup, the richest and most prestigious event on the local racing calendar.

Trainer Laurie Laxon had easily the best luck at the draw, as he selected gate one for **Stepitup (Aus)** (Hussonet) and the next stall for the long-winded **Valbuena (NZ)** (Darci Brahma {NZ}).



The former will get to take the shortest way around as he looks to complete the older horse Triple Crown, having defeated last year's Gold Cup hero **Quechua (Arg)** (Pure Prize) in the Kranji Mile Oct. 4 prior to a last-gasp defeat of **Fastnet Dragon (Aus)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) last

time out in the Raffles Cup over 1800 meters Oct. 25.

"This is perfect for Stepitup and Valbuena," said trainer Laurie Laxon, a two-time winner of the Gold Cup (2004, 2007). "They will drop behind the leaders and enjoy an economical run on the fence." Laxon will also send out **Martin (NZ)** (Colombia {NZ}) and the last of the emergencies, **Mr Spielberg (NZ)** (Pentire {GB}).

Trainer Patrick Shaw, who orchestrated the career of the great sprinter Rocket Man (Aus) (Viscount {Aus}), was winning his second Gold Cup courtesy of Quechua last fall and he, too, saddles a total of four runners. **Emperor's Banquet (Aus)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) completed a stable one-two in last year's Gold Cup, while former Dubai galloper **Cooptado (Arg)** (Equal Stripes {Arg}) and **Perfect P (Aus)** (Perfectperformance) also represent the barn.

"Quechua was drawn wide last [year] [15] and he won. So I'm not too worried about that," said the conditioner. "He will be on the speed with [jockey] Corey [Brown] and won't be too far back, following **Order Of The Sun (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}). Emperor's Banquet and Perfect P have drawn well. They can see what's happening on their inside and make a decision from there. Cooptado is well drawn and that suits him, as he is a horse that likes to follow handy."

Paul Pompa's TOMMY MACHO (Macho Uno), a latest third to Frosted (Tapit) in the GII Pennsylvania Derby at Parx Sept. 19, was able to sit a soft trip just off flank of favored Ocean Knight (Curlin), for the opening seven furlongs of Wednesday's GIII Discovery H. at Aqueduct, took it to the Stonestreet runner at the head of the lane and finished with good energy to give trainer Todd Pletcher his sixth victory in the event and second in succession following the exploits of Protonico (Giant's Causeway) last year. Madefromlucky (Lookin at Lucky) earned second ahead of a weakening Ocean Knight in third.

A debut third at odds of 81-1 for All American Horses at Gulfstream ParkFeb. 21, the \$25,000 Fasig-Tipton October graduate graduated at Belmont May 2, with Pompa as part of the ownership. The bay defeated subsequent GII Indiana Derby winner Tiz Shea D (Tiznow) and future Curlin S. hero Smart Transition (Smart Strike) in a Belmont S. Day allowance June 6, but could do no better than third to 'TDN Rising Star' Speightster (Speightstown) and Texas Red (Afleet Alex) in the July 4 GIII Dwyer S. Never a factor when seventh behind stablemate Madefromlucky in the GII West Virginia Derby Aug. 1, he bounced back with a solid third in the Pennsylvania Derby, albeit 10 lengths adrift of the winner. Keeneland sold 242 horses for \$3,963,600 during the session, good for an average of \$16,379 (+44.8%) and a median of \$10,000 (+48.1%). To date, 2,200 horses have changed hands for \$215,985,500. The cumulative average of \$98,175 is 12.6% above last year's figure of \$87,162, while the





G1SW Lord Shanakill (Speightstown--Green Room, by Theatrical {Ire}) and MGSW Last Gunfighter (First Samurai--Saratoga Cat, by Sir Cat) will stand the 2016 breeding season at Dr. William J. Solomon's Pin Oak Lane Farm in Pennsylvania, it was announced Wednesday.

Lord Shanakill, winner of the G1 Prix Jean Prat in 2009, ranked second by winners among first-crop sires in Europe in 2014. His leading runners include My Dream Boat, winner of the G3 Prix Perth in France. Lord Shanakill will stand for \$5,000 as the property of the Irish National Stud, with a discounted fee of \$3,500 available for two or more mares.

"He's a Speightstown Group 1 winner," commented Solomon. "And he was a very fast horse. Plus he has an outstanding pedigree for both the grass and the dirt. I think he'll be a great fit."

Last Gunfighter won seven stakes races and nine overall races, including four graded stakes triumphs at the age of four. An earner of \$1.2 million from 21 starts, Last Gunfighter will stand his first season for \$4,000, or \$2,500 for two or more mares.

"He's a very attractive horse who beat a lot of good horses," noted Solomon.
