



## **RED CADEAUX EUTHANIZED**

**Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}--Artisia {Ire}, by Peintre Celebre), who gained legions of fans the world over with a remarkable three runner-up efforts in the G1 Melbourne Cup, has succumbed to complications from his injuries suffered in this year's running of the race that stops a nation. After first announcing that they would attempt to allow the injury to his near-side fetlock to heal on its own, a decision was made soon after to repair the damage surgically. Reports over the next two weeks were nearly all positive as the 9-year-old recovered, but, according to a release from Racing Victoria, 'irreversible complications' arose with the loss of blood flow in the affected leg.

"This is my saddest day in racing," said trainer Ed Dunlop. "Red Cadeaux was a much-loved member of our family and my thoughts are with his owner Mr. [Ronald] Arculli and my staff, particularly Robin Trevor-Jones and Steve Nicholson, who spent every day caring for this horse. Unfortunately the complication was irreversible and the decision to euthanise the horse, whilst terribly hard, was made in his best interests. Red Cadeaux has given us and the racing public so much joy competing with great distinction across the world. He was an incredibly tough competitor with a wonderful nature and he will be dearly missed by all. I want to thank all the vets in Australia, particularly at the University of Melbourne Equine Clinic, that have worked tirelessly on the horse since the race and given him the very best of care. On behalf of Mr. Arculli and my staff, I also want to thank the Australian public and his racing fans from around the world for their wonderful support and well wishes during what has been an incredibly tough time for us all." cont. p7

They say that death and taxes are the only two certainties in life. To expand that expression for the bloodstock industry, there's also Dubawi (Ire) and Galileo (Ire).

Sales-ring appearances by Dubawi's young stock are becoming ever more infrequent, but when one does take a turn, John Ferguson is never far away. The Darley maestro's appearance at the Goffs complex this morning will have been a welcome sight for Henry Beeby and his team, and indeed Ferguson's principal aim was to ensure that the regally bred colt (lot 1129) out of Galileo's first-ever Group 1 and Classic winner Nightime (Ire) was added to Sheikh Mohammed's team of nascent racehorses. That mission was accomplished after €1.1 million was exchanged and a determined attempt by Ibrahim Araci and his bloodstock advisor Rob Speers was dispatched, their battle ensuring that the prized colt became the most expensive weanling of his sex ever to be sold at auction in Ireland. **cont. p2**

Heading a strong final day of trade for the foal section of the Goffs November Sale, the colt was one of 155 foals sold on



Friday, representing a clearance rate of 84% at an average of €80,894, which fell by 8% compared to the final day of the 2014 auction, and median of €55,000, which was up by 6%. The session's turnover contributed €12,538,500 to the sale's total of €25,847,500, which

was down by 6% on last year's aggregate of €27,492,700 for 67 fewer foals sold in 2014.

Average and median figures for the sale as a whole both declined, as expected under the increased numbers, at  $\leq$ 31,950 (down 14%) and  $\leq$ 18,000 (down 18%), while the clearance rate fell from 85% last year to 77%.

"We are of course delighted to have smashed a foal record for the second year in succession," said Goffs' Chief Executive Henry Beeby. "The Dubawi was the highlight of another superb Goffs Foal sale that enjoyed a trade of depth, consistency and real fireworks. Whist we have not quite kept pace with the records set last year [turnover up 52%, average up 41% and median up 29%], the statistics are the second-best on record, which is the cause for some celebration although it must be noted that the clearance rate is less than 2014, which mirrors the trends seen throughout the autumn at the yearling sales to an extent." **cont. p3**

#### Ferguson Heads Buyers' List...

Commenting after buying the record-breaking Dubawi colt, John Ferguson said, "I don't really need to say anything about the sire, and Nightime was an exceptional mare. Fingers crossed we have a racehorse on our hands. Dick O'Gorman and the team had seen the colt on the farm over the summer and we liked how he's progressed."

Dermot Weld, whose late mother Marguerite bred G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Nightime and her listed-winning daughter Zhukova (Ire) (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), was the first to congratulate Ferguson on his purchase. In fact, it was the second of Nightime's offspring bought by Darley this year, as Ferguson also signed for her yearling daughter by Raven's Pass for 450,000gns at the Tattersalls October Sale.

It wasn't just the Dubawi colt that sparked Ferguson's interest on the final day of foal trade. Also among the Darley list of nine purchases was Springfort Park Stud's colt by Dark Angel (Ire) (lot <u>1201</u>) out of a winning half-sister to top sprinter Kingsgate Native (Ire) (Mujadil) at €300,000. Oghill House Stud's Invincible Spirit (Ire) half-brother to listed winner Dusky Queen (Ire) (Shamardal) (lot <u>1162</u>) was bought for €280,000, and he was joined by another Invincible Spirit colt (<u>lot 1023</u>), the first foal of listed winner Boastful (Ire) (Clodovil {Ire}), acquired for €190,000 from the Irish National Stud. A colt by Kodiac (Ire) (<u>lot</u> <u>1055</u>) out of Foxland Stud's homebred listed winner Duchess Of Foxland (Ire) (Medecis) also made the cut at €170,000. **cont. p4**

#### €475,000 For Sole Galileo Foal...

Des Leadon and Mariann Klay of Swordlestown Little Stud bought nine-furlong winner Sogno Verde (Ire) (Green Desert) from Lady Clague for 60,000gns back in 2005, and the grand-daughter of champion stayer Dark Lomond (GB) (Lomond) has proved to be an inspired purchase. Her second foal was G2 Railway S. winner and young sire Lilbourne Lad (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) and four of the mare's offspring to have passed through the ring since then have all returned six-figure sums. The latest, her colt foal by Galileo (Ire) (<u>lot 1182</u>) and the only one by that sire in the sale, is the most expensive to date and sold for 475,000gns to pinhooker Eugene Daly as the extended five-day auction drew to a close Friday evening.

Jim Bolger's champion juvenile and Classic winner New Approach (Ire), now a stud-mate of Dubawi at Dalham Hall Stud, provided the most expensive filly of the sale (<u>lot 1165</u>), and it was Bolger's Redmondstown Stud that offered the daughter of the proven black-type producer Scribonia (Ire) (Danehill). The 14-year-old's offspring include G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Cuis Ghaire (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and her full-sister Scintillula (Ire), winner of the G3 Jockey Club of Turkey Meld S. Dermot Farrington signed the ticket at €450,000 for an undisclosed client and said, "She's just a lovely filly with a great page. She has everything really. She's been bought as a long-term racing and breeding prospect."

Twelve months ago, Farrington played his part in a new record price for an Irish foal when the Frankel (GB) filly out of dual Classic winner Finsceal Beo (Ire) (Mr Greeley) was sold by Al Eile Stud for €1.8 million. The agent was able to issue an update on the filly, whose racecourse debut will be eagerly awaited.

"She left Ireland about a week ago and she's now in the north of England, under tack and being broken in," he said. "She will stay in England to be trained but it has not been decided who will train her."

#### Herald the Dawn...

Joining his father New Approach among the stallions in the top 10 Friday was freshman Dawn Approach (Ire), who had a number of high-profile weanlings go under the hammer at Goffs. The overall leader at €300,000 was Esker Lodge Stud's colt out of the listed-placed Simonetta (Ire) (Lil's Boy) (<u>lot 1178</u>) and from a Jim Bolger family that includes the stallions Intense Focus (Ire), Sholokhov (Ire), Soldier Of Fortune (Ire) and Heliostatic (Ire). The April-born colt was another to be bought by the Darley team, while Shadwell also got involved when buying <u>lot 1070</u>, a half-brother to stakes winners Forthefirstime (GB) (Dr Fong) and Pyman's Theories (Ire) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) for €180,000. We Bloodstock and Phillip Stauffenberg also opted for colts by Dawn Approach, going to €160,000 (<u>lot 1021</u>) and €125,000 (<u>lot 1013</u>), respectively.

#### Araci Digs Deep For Dark Angel Colt...

Though Ibrahim Araci and Rob Speers were denied on the top lot, they had earlier outlasted Ferguson in their attempt to buy a Dark Angel (Ire) colt (<u>lot 1115</u>) whose family has special resonance for the Turkish owner-breeder. The hammer fell at €370,000gns for the grey son of G1 Moyglare Stud S. winner Miss Beatrix (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), affording the Balintougher Stud offering his own record as the most expensive weanling by his sire, whose popularity in the sales ring has gone though the roof this season.

Prices at this level usually mean that even the boldest pinhookers aren't involved, and Speers explained that Araci had taken the decision to buy a handful of select foals owing to the strength of the yearling market at the top end. He said, "It's hard to compete at the top level in Book 1 so we're delighted to have bought such nice prospects. We'll take home this colt and the Camelot colt we bought earlier and look forward to putting them into training in a year's time."

Speers added, "We had a Galileo out of Miss Beatrix in training with Henry Cecil but he sadly got injured, and her son Tamga (Ire) is a Group 1 horse in Turkey so it's a family we know well."

Araci and Speers also selected one of the members of the first crop of Camelot (Ire), which have been well received this week. Their selection was <u>lot 1039</u>, a half-brother to G1 Metropolitan H. winner Magic Hurricane (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}), who was sold another good sale for the Killourney Mor Farm draft when knocked down at €180,000. <u>Click here</u> for an audio interview by Dave Keena with Rob Speers.

#### A Kodiac For Corduff...

James and David Egan's Corduff Stud enjoyed a terrific autumn at the yearling sales with their mixture of homebreds and pinhooks, and the father-and-son team reinvested some of their profits in <u>lot 1068</u>, a colt by Kodiac (Ire) bought for €260,000 through Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock. The second foal of Four Eleven (Arch), a half-sister to G1 Prix Saint-Alary winner Summertime Legacy (GB) (Darshaan {GB}), was bred by Nelius Hayes of Knockainey Stud, whose graduates include this season's G3 Prix du Calvados winner Great Page (Ire) (Roderic O'Connor {Ire}). Brown said, "Nelius is a top-class breeder and this was a smashing individual with a wonderful back family. David, James and I all saw him and he hit us straight between the eyes. His sire goes from strength to strength."

This year's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 Prix de la Foret victor **Make Believe (GB)** (Makfi {GB}--Rosie's Posy {Ire},



by Suave Dancer) will stand at Ballylinch Stud next year for €20,000. The winner of four of his seven starts for owner Prince Faisal and trainer Andre Fabre, Make Believe was unbeaten at two and bested other

standout 3-year-olds New Bay (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) and Limato (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) in his two Group 1 wins. Make Believe wrapped up his career with a fifth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Oct. 31.

"Make Believe has a lot to live up to as the last three stallions to retire to Ballylinch--Intense Focus, Lope De Vega and Dream Ahead--have all been in the top two in the first-season sires' table," said Ballylinch Managing Director John O'Connor. "Interestingly he broke Dream Ahead's record when winning the Prix de la Foret."

"He's a miler with an awful lot of speed--Andre Fabre was considering him for the top sprints next year if he hadn't been retired to stud," O'Connor continued. "Prince Faisal retains shares in him but Ballylinch Stud has bought the rest and we plan to syndicate him, as we do with most of our stallions. Prince Faisal is going to support him with his very strong broodmare band and we're delighted that he has chosen to work with us in developing his stud career."

O'Connor also pointed to the fact that Make Believe is a half-brother to Grade I winner Dubawi Heights (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}).

"I like strong female lines and his dam has already produced two Group 1 winners while his grand-dam was a stakes winner who has bred a Group 1 winner," he said.

Arculli added, "For a race that stops a nation we were lucky to have a horse that touched a nation. We will miss Red Cadeaux dearly."

Racing Victoria Head of Equine Welfare and Veterinary Services, Dr. Brian Stewart, said, "The loss of any racehorse is a terribly sad time for the connections given the love and care they are afforded. The loss of a crowd favourite such as Red Cadeaux is felt by all within the industry. Our thoughts go out at this time to Red Cadeaux's owner Ronnie Arculli, trainer Ed Dunlop and his staff led by Robin Trevor-Jones and Stephen Nicholson, along with his jockey Gerald Mosse, who all loved this horse dearly and will be shattered by his passing."

#### A True Rags-to-Riches Story...

Bred by Foursome Thoroughbreds, Red Cadeaux was bought back on a bid of 40,000gns as a Tattersalls December weanling in late 2006 and was purchased by Charlie Gordon-Watson



Bloodstock on behalf of Arculli for 55,000gns at that auction house's October sale the following fall. A maiden winner over the Wolverhampton allweather at fourth asking, Red Cadeaux acquitted himself well in handicap company in England before

announcing himself as a potentially top-class stayer with a ninelength demolition of his rivals in the 2011 G3 Curragh Cup.

His first trip to Melbourne later that year was arguably his most memorable, as settled in the latter quarter of the field and was pulled out widest for the drive. He led narrowly into the final 200 meters, but French raider Dunaden (Fr) (Nicobar {GB}) went with him to his inside and scraped home by a nose (video).

Third to Dunaden in the G1 Hong Kong Vase in his next run, he was eighth to Green Moon (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the 2012 Cup, but bounced back two starts later to post an emotional win for his Hong Kong-based owner in the Vase (video). It would be the final victory of his career. **cont. p8** 

#### **Red Cadeaux Euthanized cont.**

The legend of Red Cadeaux grew further in his first start at age seven, as he ran GI Kentucky Derby hero Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) to two lengths in the G1 Dubai World Cup (video) and returned to Australia for the third straight season and charged home to fill second spot in the 2013 Melbourne Cup, 3/4 of a length behind Fiorente (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}) (video). Fourth in defense of his title in Hong Kong in late 2013, he saved his top two final performances for Australia, finishing four lengths adrift of Protectionist (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) in the 2014 Cup and a good second to Criterion (NZ) (Sebring {Aus}) in this year's G1 Queen Elizabeth S. So revered was Red Cadeaux in Australia that the quarantine barn at the Werribee facility near Melbourne was named in his honor in 2014.

Though he had his picture taken just seven times over the course of 54 career appearances, he banked a remarkable \$7,850,451 and logged 250,000 air miles, in the estimation of his trainer. He also competed in Japan and Singapore in his distinguished career.

At the request of his owner, Red Cadeaux will be laid to rest at Flemington Racecourse.

#### **NSW RACING TO GET FINANCIAL BOOST**

Wagering tax parity legislation passed in the New South Wales parliament this week will see an additional A\$235 million funneled into racing in the state over five years as the government progressively changes its share of TAB gross wagering revenue. The industry will receive an additional A\$90 million annually thereafter.

The change in legislation secures the future of The Championships, Sydney's end-of-season carnival introduced two

years ago at Royal Randwick over two Saturdays in April.

"With parity commencing in the present financial year, The Championships are assured in terms of longevity and can now be driven forward off the excellent platform established

over the past two years," said

Racing NSW Chairman John Messara. "Our ambition has been to develop a destination Thoroughbred racing event of international stature, with landmark races that are attractive to the best horses within Australasia and further abroad."

Following the recent announcements of purse hikes for the G1 Sydney Cup (next year worth A\$2 million) and the country and provincial championship finals, next year's edition of The Championships will be worth A\$20 million, with A\$10 million offered each day.

The now 7-year-old Danon Shark has had just three runs since last year's score and while he was fourth in the G2 Mainchi Okan last out Oct. 11, that was not a poor effort considering he was coming off a fourmonth layoff and had to carry 128 pounds. After last year's agonizing defeat, Fiero still seeks his first group-race win, but despite knocking on the door for so long, he shouldn't be discounted. He finished fast to be second over a furlong shorter than this to the 3-year-old filly **Albiano** (Harlan's Holiday) in the G2 Swan S. here Oct. 31.

Unlike many of his fancied rivals who are looking to bounce back from defeat, **Maurice (Jpn)** (Screen Hero {Jpn}) is seeking to extend his winning streak to five Sunday. The 4-year-old colt is unbeaten thus far in 2015 and earned a breakthrough score in the June 7 G1 Yasuda Kinen. He has not been seen since that score, however, so will have to defy a near six-month layoff. **cont. p8**




