

BALLYDOYLE LANDS ANOTHER CLASSIC

Landseer (GB) (Danehill), sent off at 9-1, powered away with the G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains (French 2000 Guineas) at Longchamp yesterday to provide Aidan O'Brien and Ballydoyle Stud with their second Classic of 2002. The colt reversed the form of his previous start, when he was third behind **Bowman** (Irish River {Fr}) and **Medecis (GB)** (Machievellian) in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over this course Apr. 14.

Recording his first win at the highest level, he was settled in ninth on the rail early as stable companion **Sahara Desert (GB)** (Green Desert) and **Captain Rio (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}) set furious fractions. As Captain Rio faltered in the straight, jockey Mick Kinane asked Landseer to quicken and, after being switched off the rail, he surged to the front 300 yards remaining, then held Medecis at bay to win by a length, with Bowman a further 3/4 of a length back in third. "This horse has improved a ton since he ran in the Fontainebleau," Kinane said. "He showed his true quality here in a truly run race and won like a nice colt." **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}), sent off the 5-2 favourite, stayed on well and, after finishing fifth, was moved up to fourth. Last year, Landseer was the first two-year-old from Ballydoyle to set foot on a track and that precocity saw him win a strong-looking G3 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot in June. Off the track until second in the Houghton Sales S. at Newmarket at the start of October, he returned to that track to be beaten a short head by stable companion Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 Dewhurst S. 18 days later. His seasonal finale came in Saint-Cloud's G1 Criterium International in early November, where he found only Act One (GB) a half length too strong, ending the campaign on a rating of 115 pounds in the International Classifications. Landseer was described by O'Brien as a "possible" for the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas May 25. (Chart, p2)

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AS GENUINE AS THEY COME

It's a wonder she's ever been beaten. **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat), showing no ill effects after her trip to Dubai, sprinted to the front when the gates opened and was never headed, winning yesterday's GII Genuine Risk H. at Belmont Park by a length to run her record to 20 for 26. The diminutive bay spotted her rivals from nine to 14 pounds, but it wasn't enough to produce an upset. "She was carrying 126 pounds, the track was a little heavy and she'd been off for six weeks--she can handle everything," trainer John Salzman said. Second in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and third in the GI DeFrancis Dash to end her three-year-old season, Xtra Heat beat fillies in her first two starts this year, including the Feb. 16 GII Barbara Fritchie H. Shipped to Nad al Sheba for the Mar. 23 GI Dubai Golden Shaheen, the Kentucky-bred dueled for the lead before tiring to be third. "She didn't switch leads and she had allergies and she still only got beat 3 1/2 lengths," Salzman said. As for what's next, he pointed to the Charles Town Dash July 4 or the GII Princess Rooney S. at Calder July 13, but added, "maybe she'll run in June."

PRISONERS OF ZENDA

Zenda (GB) (Zamindar) made virtually all the running to capture yesterday's G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulaches (French 1000 Guineas) at Longchamp at a massive 44-1. The longshot turned back the challenges of **Firth of Lorne (Ire)** (Danehill) and the 5-2 favourite **Sophisticat** (Storm Cat) to take it by a length and a short neck. John Gosden, who won this with Valentine Waltz (Ire) in 1999, explained how Zenda made the 2002 line-up. "This is a really nice filly who has been working well all spring," he said. "Ten days ago I had lunch with Prince Khaled Abdullah at Saint-Cloud and I asked for his permission to run her here." Introduced in a conditions event at Kempton last September, she found only the subsequent G2 Rockfel S. winner Distant Valley (GB) 2 1/2 lengths too strong, then finished third on heavy ground in a Doncaster maiden at the end of October. Returning to score impressively in a similar event at Windsor Apr. 22 on faster going, she entered this race very much an unknown quantity. She quickly turned that around yesterday. After breaking well and settling in front, the filly was shaded by stable companion **Camaret (GB)** (Danehill) and **Massarra (GB)** (Danehill). She re-established her advantage by halfway before kicking away from the traffic jam in behind at the top of the straight. While Michael Kinane found no room on the rail on Sophisticat, Richard Hughes stole a three-length advantage and was keeping on well under pressure despite drifting left. That allowed Frankie Dettori a run up the rail on Firth of Lorne, but as that filly drew to within half a length, Zenda quickened again to assert and win a shade comfortably in the end. "She was a little keen and fresh, but she broke so well that I thought it better to let her go on," Hughes said. "It's better to do that around here on this ground." Gosden added, "She'll be even better when we can settle her in behind and allow her to deliver her turn of foot. She may go for the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 26] or the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 21] and then we'll give her a break. We'll freshen her up for an autumn campaign and we'll maybe step her up in trip because I think she'll stay further."

Act One assured himself the role of favourite for the G1 Prix du Jockey Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2 with another fluid score. Although it was expected that Ballingarry (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) would provide competition for the grey here, it was not to be. As Act One took over from Temple of Artemis (Spinning World) at the top of the final straight, Ballingarry rapidly dropped from the action, leaving the favourite in the clear. Jonathan Pease confirmed the mile-and-a-half Classic as the natural next step for his unbeaten colt.

"He's a lovely horse with a powerful action," Pease said. "We're always worried when he runs because we have nothing good enough at home to work him with. He has done everything we have asked of him and he definitely goes for the Jockey Club." Act One continues to confirm his status as France's leading three-year-old, having achieved the highest rating amongst his peers at 117 pounds in the 2001 International Classifications.

His two-year-old form is also holding up well, with Landseer (GB), who he beat by a half length in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud last November, taking the G1 Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Poulains earlier in the afternoon. Act One had advertised his wellbeing with a smooth success in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at this course Apr. 14 and confirmed that form with this showing. Jockey Michael Kinane reported that Ballingarry finished distressed; plans for that colt are now on hold.

Falbrav was the darling of the Italians here, taking this contest by storm to win in record time and provide only the third home win since 1990. Trainer Luciano d'Auria may now aim him at the GI Arlington Million. "I was sure he would win and I would like to run in the Arlington Million over the fast ground in Chicago," he said. "Of course, I'll have to speak with the owner about this, but bear in mind Falbrav is a top-class sort and I wouldn't be scared to go for any Group 1 with him on that ground." Settled in last place early as Shibuni's Falcon (GB) (Polar Falcon) was sent into a clear lead, he was always travelling sweetly and, when asked to gain closer order in the straight, he quickened onto the heels of Ekraar, who had taken the initiative under Richard Hills. The winner was switched outside to challenge and tackled that horse when in the clear to pass him at the furlong marker. Pushed out to assert from there as the pair pulled clear of the remainder, he ran out the comfortable winner. Falbrav was the biggest earner from last year's G1 Derby Italiano despite finishing runner-up to Morshdi (GB), thanks to the generous breeders' prizes on offer there for Italian-breds. Successful in valuable conditions races in Rome and Milan, his achilles heel is soft ground--his third placing behind Altieri (Selkirk) in the Listed Premio Mse Giuseppe Ippolito Fassati in Milan last September was attributable to the very testing conditions. For Luciano Salice, the supremo of Scuderia Rencati, it was a huge bonus to see Sunstrach finish late to grab third, bringing home another breeders' premium of over \$500,000.

Portella stayed glued to the fence here as long-time leader Red Liaison veered left in the straight to win the first Classic of the 2002 German season. Having won a national listed event on her debut last September, she finished second to Baselga (Ger) in a similar event at Neuss the following month. Not sighted since, she was generally unconsidered in the betting as the only filly without a prep run and was sent off at 11-1. Racing in third on the fence early as Richard Quinn established a clear lead on Red Liason, she quickened instantly at the top of the straight as the frontrunner drifted off a true path. Seizing the initiative, winning jockey Eduardo Pedroza went to work to maintain the advantage as Red Liaison was straightened for her rally. Keeping up the gallop all the way to the line, Portella was comfortably clear as Tomori made late headway to take second in the final strides. Portella, whose regular rider Paul Johnson was injured last week, is from the first crop of the tough and durable four-time Group winner Protektor (Ger). He is the second son of leading sire Acatenango (Ger) to sire a stakes winner from his first crop, following the exploits of Lando (Ger). Portella was her sire's leading performer last year, securing him the title of leading German-based first season sire. She is also the first foal bred from Polish Affair (Ire), herself a half-sister to the Listed winning Fair Crack (Ire).

Sky Jack ended his 2001 campaign with a win in the Dec. 3 GIII Native Diver H. at Hollywood and started 2002 with a solid second-place finish in a Santa Anita allowance test Feb. 9, but was out of his league in his latest. The gray tried a mile and a quarter and Grade I company for the first time in the Mar. 2 Santa Anita H. and came home 14th and last, 43 lengths behind winner Milwaukee Brew. Sent off the favorite after a two-month freshening, the six-year-old showed his appreciation for the shorter distance here by leading the field from gate to wire en route to a handy victory. "I was hoping the Santa Anita H. didn't hurt him, but it obviously didn't," winning jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. said. "He was really running today, and he just loves this track. I'm looking forward to the Hollywood Gold Cup." Sky Jack will be pointed for the July 14 GI Gold Cup. Bosque Redondo, looking for his third straight after taking the Mar. 9 Tokyo City H. and Apr. 6 GII San Bernardino H., sat second the entire trip, but couldn't match strides with the winner down the lane while clearly best of the rest. It took Van Rouge six starts to break his maiden, finally breaking through with a victory on the Santa Anita lawn Apr. 19, but the gray wasted no time posting win number two. Italian stakes winner Six Hitter (Boundary), the 2-1 favorite after going two-for-four in Europe, was caught in traffic early and tired late to finish fifth in his U.S. debut. "They went a nice respectable pace and he's beautifully balanced--he's a definite possible for Epsom, but that's a long way from here and I wouldn't rule him out of the French Derby [G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly June 2]."

DIFFERING OPINION OVER CHAPARRAL

High Chaparral (Ire) (Sadler's Wells {USA}) followed the script by winning yesterday's G3 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown, but bookmakers were divided over the merit of that performance. Although he was cut to 11-8 as favourite for the G1 Epsom Derby June 8 by Coral Eurobet afterwards, the Tote were unimpressed, lengthening him to 11-4. He may, however, have one less rival to take on if he goes to Epsom, as Andre Fabre's **Shaanmer (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) was virtually ruled out of the Classic after being promoted to fourth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains [French 2000 Guineas] at Longchamp yesterday. Baron Edouard de Rothschild, who owns the colt, favours the French version of the Derby. "It looks like he didn't handle coming down the hill so we would be worried about Epsom," the Baron said. "Therefore, we think it more likely he will go for the G1 Prix du Jockey Club [French Derby at Chantilly June 2]." Shaanmer's absence from that Classic will strengthen the position of the Ballydoyle pair **High Chaparral** and **Hawk Wing (USA)** (Woodman {USA}) at the forefront of the market. Aidan O'Brien yesterday described both colts as "definite possibles" for Epsom, adding that **Sorcerous (GB)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) would contest the G2 Dante S. at York on Wednesday.

BALLINGARRY DOUBTFUL FOR FRENCH DERBY

With **Ballingarry (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells {USA}) finishing distressed in the G1 Prix Lupin at Longchamp yesterday afternoon, Ballydoyle may need to look elsewhere for a challenger to Jonathan Pease's winner **Act One (GB)** (In The Wings {GB}) in the French Derby. Aidan O'Brien refused to rule out that option for High Chaparral yesterday. Saturday's impressive G3 Lingfield Derby Trial winner **Bandari (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}) has still to be supplemented, but Mark Johnston's colt is likely to be in demand if allowed to take his chance. David Hood, spokesman for bookmakers William Hill, said yesterday: "Should Bandari be supplemented to the Derby, Hills consider him as the best possible British challenger for Epsom at 12-1."
