"SKY" HIGH FOR HOLLYWOOD GOLD CUP

"He should be raring to go." That was trainer Doug O'Neill's reaction after watching six-year-old **Sky Jack** (Jakling Klugman) zip through a five-furlong workout in :58 3/5 Monday. Four-for-four at Hollywood Park, the Cal-bred will try to keep his perfect record at the track intact in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup this afternoon. The gray ended his four-year-old campaign with a seven-length romp in the GIII Native Diver H., but missed the entire 2001 season. A nose runner-up in a Santa Anita allowance test Feb. 9 after the 14-month layoff, he put in a dismal 14th-place showing in his second start back, the Mar. 2 GI Santa Anita H., and went back on the shelf for two months. Sky Jack looked to be back on top of his game in his most recent start, however, posting a 5 1/2-length score in the May 12 GII Mervyn LeRoy H. at Hollywood. O'Neill's biggest concern is the 1 1/4-mile distance of the Gold Cup. The gelding's lone try at the route came in the Big 'Cap, but the trainer blames himself for the lackluster effort, saying he asked too much of his charge in his second start after such a long absence. "If he doesn't have to work overtime early, I think he'll get the distance," O'Neill said. **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again) proved he could handle 10 furlongs with his Big 'Cap victory and added a win in the June 15 GII Californian S. last time out. GOLD MOVER BEATS THE HEAT

Gold Mover (Gold Fever) yesterday became the first filly to beat **Xtra Heat** (Dixieland Heat) at six furlongs, driving past the Eclipse Award winner in the final strides to take the GII Princess Rooney H. at Calder by a half-length. The two had finished just a neck apart in the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont Park last time out June 9. But Xtra Heat had to duel with 24-1 outsider **Vague Memory** (Ward Off Trouble) at Calder and was actually a head back in second as they clipped off the opening quarter in :21.48. Xtra Heat put the longshot away and had 1 1/2 lengths on Gold Mover as they dashed through a half in :44.54. She opened up by two at midstretch, but the winner wore her down in the shadow of the wire for the victory. "It couldn't have developed any better for her with the fast first quarter, but I lost a little confidence when Xtra Heat spurted away from her at the head of the stretch," trainer Mark Hennig said. But, as winning jockey Jerry Bailey observed, "He [jockey Harry Vega, aboard Xtra Heat] might have had his plan to steal away turning for home, but I have to give my mare credit because she dug in at the eighth pole. When I thought she might get beat, she came with another run." Reporting on the runner-up, trainer John Salzman Sr. said, "She ran good and she seems all right. That filly that beat her is a real nice filly. If they had been at equal weights, we might have seen a different turn out, but that's a nice filly that beat her." Gold Mover adds the Princess Rooney to her wins in the GII Schuylerville S., GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup S., GIII Debutante S. and GIII Forward Gal S. Fourth behind Xtra Heat in the GII Barbara Fritchie H. in February, the chestnut filly came back to win the Mar. 17 Hurricane Bertie S. at Gulfstream. Last time out, she was in front by a head at the finish of the GI Humana Distaff H. at Churchill May 4, but was disqualified and placed second for bumping Celtic Melody in the final furlong. A FIRST FOR BALLYDOYLE?

There are not many European Classics that have alluded trainer Aidan O'Brien, but the G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh is one of them, but he looks to have the right filly this year in **Quarter Moon (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), runner-up in both the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas over this course May 26 and in the G1 Epsom Oaks June 7. While she was beaten by Gossamer (GB) in the former, it was her imposing performance when stepped up to this trip last time that marked her as an above-average middle-distance filly. Run on extremely testing ground, the Epsom Classic witnessed two remarkable efforts as Kazzia (Ger) and Quarter Moon pulled 14 lengths clear of Shadow Dancing (GB), who has subsequently upheld the form at Royal Ascot. O'Brien is convinced she is better on a faster surface, but although The Curragh has received a similar soaking to Epsom so far this month, she handles easier conditions where others falter. Although Oaks runners-up have a poor tally in this, with none having gone one better here in the last 30 years, placed horses and winners of the Epsom Classic have a respectable overall record. If Quarter Moon justifies market leadership here, she will become only the fourth Irish-trained filly to take this since 1984. She will be helped by stablemate **Starbourne (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who was fourth at Epsom in front of **Red Rioja (Ire)** (King's Theatre {Ire}) in fifth and sixth-placed **Mellow Park (Ire)** (In The Wings {GB}). Starbourne will ensure an even pace for the free-running favourite and could easily bring off another one-two for Ballydoyle. Connections of Mellow Park, who subsequently beat **Lady's Secret (Ire)** (Alzao) by 1 1/2 lengths in last Saturday's G3 Lancashire Oaks at Haydock, will be hoping that this fairer track will benefit their contender, but her trainer is concerned that this softer ground will compromise her chances. Red Rioja will appreciate give underfoot and her performance when subsequently third behind **Irresistible Jewel (Ire)** (Danehill) in the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot June 21 appears all the more meritorious as it was run on good to firm ground. Third in the GIII Lexington S. over this turf course last July, Whitmore's Conn was third in the 12-furlong GIII Lawrence Realization H. in his penultimate start of the season and went to the shelf following an eighth against state-bred competition at Aqueduct Nov. 1. He was victorious in his first two starts of the year, at Gulfstream Mar. 31 and back at Aqueduct Apr. 19, but was a disappointing sixth in the May 26 Kingston H. for Empire-breds. Despite an improved runner-up finish behind Eltawaasul (Nureyev) in a June 21 allowance, the Randy Schulhofer pupil was dismissed as the second-longest shot in the field. Settled towards the back of the pack as GII King Edward Breeders' Cup winner Moon Solitaire cut out reasonable fractions, and still sixth with three furlongs to come, Whitmore's Conn rallied four wide into the stretch and closed with a flourish to win going away. "It was a big set-up today," the winning conditioner commented. "Last year he ran real well in some stakes, so we had to give him a chance this year. He's matured mentally, as a lot of Kris S.'s will do when they get older." The trainer is hopeful for an invitation to the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga Aug. 10. Century City beat Common World by a narrow margin in yesterday's International S., but that does not tell the true tale as the winner had a fair amount in hand at the line. Century City is known to be notoriously lazy in front, so jockey Michael Kinane was keen to wait as long as he dared in third this time as Temple of Artemis (Spinning World) set the pace. As Wrong Key eased up the rail to pass the rabbit, Kinane covered the move and Century City was in front travelling strongly with a furlong remaining. Pushed out from there to contain the threat of the game filly, he gave as much effort as required to hold off the late thrust of Common World. Century City is due to continue his career in the United States now, having progressed markedly throughout his time with Aidan O'Brien. Last year, he took a Newmarket conditions event in October before returning to finish second to Barring Order (Ire) in the Listed Loughbrown S. at this oval Mar. 24. He returned to winning ways in the Listed Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial S. Apr. 14 before taking the G3 Tetrarch S. here May 6. Beaten 1 1/2 lengths in second by the incredibly easy winner Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) in the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas over this course May 25, he ran with credit when fifth, beaten just four lengths by No Excuse Needed (GB) in the G2 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 18.

Beaten only once this season and a perfect two-for-two going six furlongs, Bold World added a graded-stakes win to her resume with a dominant score. The bay started the year with wins in the Feb. 18 Dame Mystérieuse S. at Gulfstream and the Mar. 18 Ocala Breeders' Sales Sprint S., then came back just four days after that effort to capture the Charon S. at Gulfstream, taking the three races by a combined 25 1/4 lengths. Sent off the 13-10 favorite in the GII Beaumont S. at Keeneland Apr. 26, Bold World pressed the pace, but stopped badly to be sixth. "She ended up pressing a :44 half and it took its toll--she bled," trainer Ron Taylor said. The filly bounced right back, however, taking a pair of stakes at Monmouth May 18 and June 8. The second choice after a return to Florida, she played the role of stalker to the stretch, angled outside for the final drive, took command at the top of the lane and left her rivals in the dust. "I had so much she felt like a bomb under me," jockey Calvin Borel said. As for what's next, Taylor said, "We'll consider the Test [GI, Saratoga, July 27]," he said. Campaigned exclusively on the turf in his brief career, Portcullis broke his maiden at the Fair Grounds at second asking Jan. 19, but came to hand for trainer Mark Frostad during the Keeneland spring meet. Second in an Apr. 7 allowance, the homebred was promoted to first through disqualification and followed up with a 1 1/2-length win 14 days hence. Fifth, placed fourth through the subsequent disqualification of Flying Dash (Ger) in the GIII Hawthorne Derby May 11, he was most recently a two-length victor of the Charlie Barley S. over this grass course June 23. Portcullis could see them all as he trailed for the opening six furlongs, but began to gain momentum approaching the long Woodbine stretch. Secret River had been first or second in six of her seven previous turf starts, but her only stakes attempt had resulted in a sixth-place finish at 31-1 in the restricted George Rosenberger Memorial S. at Delaware Park last September. She came back to win back-to-back optional-claiming events before ending the season with a runner-up finish at that level at Laurel Nov. 24. The bay mare returned after a six-month layoff to be second in a Monmouth turf allowance May 26, but tired badly going a mile and a quarter in an off-the-turf allowance test in the Belmont slop June 14 and finished fourth and last. Overlooked with a return to her preferred surface, Secret River shadowed Quidnaskra (Halo) for six furlongs, stuck a head in front at the top of the lane and held off the late surge of odds-on Golden Corona to take the photo. Puck was booked on a van heading south today, but after powering his way to victory here, it looks like he'll be sticking around for the GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Aug. 4. "We had a van lined up to leave tomorrow for Florida, but I think we'll cancel it after the way he ran today," trainer Bill White said. The Long Branch was Puck's third win from his last four starts. The gray colt bounced back after an inexplicably bad effort in the GI Florida Derby to win a Gulfstream allowance by 12 lengths, then followed a second-place finish in the Primal S. at Calder with a front-running score in the Unbridled S. at that track June 22. Shuffled back after the break, Puck dropped back to fifth as Shah Jehan set the pace. Essayons (Deputy Minister) went after the front-runner after six furlongs and those two raced into the lane as a team, but the winner was coming at them from the middle of the track. He drove to the front in the final sixteenth and pulled away to win handily. Runner-up to subsequent Irish Derby fourth Nysaeen (Ire) in a Windsor maiden Apr. 29 and to Izdiham (Ire) in a similar event at Newbury May 17, he reversed form with the latter next time in the competitive Listed Hampton Court S. at Royal Ascot June 20 in decisive fashion. How he handles this softer ground remains to be seen, but he is progressive and may have the call over the temperamental **Aramram**. That colt is talented, having finished third in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 18, but he is also unpredictable, as he proved when unseating jockey Steve Drowne in the Chantilly straight in the G1 Prix Jean Prat June 2. He will be suited by the step up in trip, but needs fast ground and a fast pace and will get neither this time. **Louveteau** may be the best of the home team, but he needs to show more than he did when eighth in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) at Chantilly June 2. Trainer Andre Fabre has a fine record in this event and saddles the unexposed and beautifully bred **Gulf News**, who needs to step up considerably on his conditions score over course and distance last time June 18.

HAL'S HOPE DIES Millionaire and multiple Grade I winner **Hal's Hope** (Jolie's Halo--Mia's Hope, by Rexson's Hope) died Friday afternoon at the Palm Beach (Florida) Equine Hospital due to complications from intestinal surgery. "He was sick for about a month," said trainer Harold Rose, who also owned and bred the dark bay. "He had intestinal problems and was operated on three times. He had complications during his last surgery...they weren't able to save him. He was one in a million, a part of the family." The winner of the GI Florida Derby in 2000, the five-year-old added five additional added-money successes, all in the Sunshine State, including this year's GI Gulfstream Park H. In what would be his final start, the Florida-bred was third in the May 27 Memorial Day H. at Calder. Hal's Hope amassed a record of 33-9-5-3, with career earnings of \$1,098,422.

BREEDERS' CUP 2004 TO LONE STAR During its annual board meeting Friday in Lexington, Breeders' Cup Limited confirmed the selection of Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas as the site for the 2004 running of the World Thoroughbred Championships. "This is a significant development in our pursuit to host horse racing's year-end championship event," said Corey Johnsen, Lone Star president and general manager. "We've had numerous conversations with the Breeders' Cup staff and have spent thousands of hours in preparation for this event. I am confident that we meet all of their requirements, so I expect an agreement to be reached in the near future."

CALDER SETS RECORDS AT SUMMIT OF SPEED The total handle on Calder Race Course's Summit of Speed program, held yesterday, was a track record \$8,883,212, beating the old mark, set on the 2001 Festival of the Sun card, of \$8,878,346. The attendance of 9,974, the on-track handle of \$1,140,780 and the interstate handle, \$7,176,027, were records for Summit of Speed day. "We're extremely pleased with today's results," Calder President Ken Dunn said. "The build-up for this day has been just incredible. The quality of the horses competing in these races speaks volumes about the Summit of Speed concept. The word is definitely out among the racing community and the fans as well."

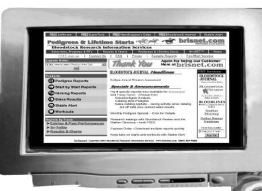
