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CHANNON KEEN ON ZAFEEN

Trainer Mick Channon was in an ebullient mood as he contemplated the chance of **Zafeen (Fr)** (Zafonic) in tomorrow's G1 Entenmann's Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh. "He has always been our big gun and he's very consistent," Channon said. "I'm very sweet on him and he's in great form. We'll see how we get on, but he's in good heart and we are going to keep turning up until we get lucky." Zafeen was denied a clear run until the closing stages of the Newmarket version of the May 3 Classic before closing to within 3/4 of a length of winner Refuse to Bend (Ire) at the line. "We didn't get any luck in running and it wasn't our day," Channon explained. "This racing game is a marathon, not a sprint, and you've got to be in there to fire a few times." As expected, Aidan O'Brien has a numerically strong team headed by **Tomahawk** (Seattle Slew), eighth behind Zafeen, **Tout Seul (Ire)** (Ali-Royal {Ire}) and **Saturn (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) at Newmarket. However, the Ballydoyle conditioner yesterday withdrew both **Catcher in the Rye (Ire)** (Danehill) and **Statue of Liberty** (Storm Cat) due to the soft ground; both colts will head straight to Royal Ascot. Among O'Brien's other five runners are the unraced **Solskjaer (Ire)** (Danehill) and **Great Pyramid (Ire)** (Danehill), full brother to last year's winner Rock of Gibraltar (Ire). Bookmakers Paddy Power have listed Zafeen the 4-1 favourite, with Tout Seul next best at 9-2 and Tomahawk at 5-1. *Field, p3*

Best Minister Joins Belmont Stakes Cast

Best Minister (Deputy Minister), winner of the Sir Barton S. at Pimlico Race Course May 17, has been supplemented to the June 7 G1 Belmont S. The colt's owners, Phillips Racing Partnership, put up \$100,000 to make the earner of \$100,050 eligible. "The timing is super," said trainer Ken McPeck. "The horse is doing good and you only get one chance at the Belmont." Last year's Belmont S. hero Sarava, trained by McPeck, also used a win in the Sir Barton as a stepping stone to a Belmont victory. According to McPeck, the bay will ship to New York Tuesday. AZERI READIES FOR MILADY

Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter), who arrived at Hollywood Park Tuesday afternoon, cantered and galloped about 10 furlongs Wednesday morning as trainer Laura de Seroux prepares the five-year-old mare for Saturday's G1 Milady H. "I like it when you have to ask her to go forward instead of saying 'whoa'" said de Seroux. "I just want to get this race over with. She's been very strong lately." The first reigning Horse of the Year to run at Hollywood since Sunday Silence took the G1 Californian in 1990, the chestnut is undefeated in three starts at Hollywood and seeks to record her ninth straight career victory with a win in the 1 1/16-mile event. Owned by the Allen Paulson Living Trust, the mare has won 11 of 12 starts and earnings of \$2,527,740.

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Twenty-One Eying Oaks

There were no surprises at Thursday's final forfeit stage for the £375,000 G1 Vodafone Oaks at Epsom June 6 as all of the leading contenders are among the 21 remaining fillies. Godolphin, successful last year with Kazzia (Ger), have four fillies entered, including **Hi Dubai (GB)** (Rahy) and **Mezzo Soprano (Darshaan {GB})**. Hi Dubai heads the ante-post wagering along with **Hanami (GB)** (Hernando {Fr}), a troubled fifth in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket. Trainer Aidan O'Brien has two fillies still in the race, **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **L'Ancrese (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}). **Ocean Silk** (Dynaformer) was listed as "unlikely" for the Oaks by owner Robert Sangster following her success in Wednesday's Listed Lupe S. at Goodwood, but remains among the 21. The U.S. Ambassador, William Farish III, has homebred **Casual Look** (Red Ransom) entered for the Classic. The five-day stage is set for May 30; there will be a £20,000 supplemental stage at which Cheshire Oaks heroine **Hammiya (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) will be added to the field.

Domestic Dispute Prepares for Turf Debut

Domestic Dispute (Unbridled's Song), 10th last time out in the G1 Kentucky Derby May 3, breezed a half-mile in an easy :54 over the Matt Winn Turf Course at Churchill Downs Thursday morning as trainer Paddy Gallagher fine tunes the chestnut for a possible next start in the GIII Jefferson Cup at Churchill June 7. The move was the slowest of six at the distance. "He was just looking around out there," said jockey Joe Deegan, who was in the irons. In reference to the slow time, Deegan added, "I stayed on the very outside because there are no divots out there. I just let him scoot down the lane and he went ahead and skipped down there. I'm sure the time wasn't much because I was on the very outside of the course." The David Bienstock and Chuck Winner-owned colt has won two of 11 starts, including the GII Santa Catalina at Santa Anita Jan. 18.

Saratán rattled off three successive scores in competitive handicaps last year, including the Listed Grand Handicap de Deauville in August. He was reportedly past his best when upped in class on his last two outings where he finished sixth and 10th, respectively, in the G3 Prix Quincey at Deauville in August and G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein at this track in October. He ran fourth, beaten less than a length, by Bezrin (Danzig) on his return in the Listed Prix du Montretout over course and distance Apr. 24. Settled in a stalking role early, Saratán quickened to cut down Mount Abu with 50 yards remaining as Meshaheer closed late for third. "It's so nice to win my first Group race with the first horse I received as a trainer," said trainer Mikel Delzangles.

Belmont Jocks to Visit Ronald McDonald House:

A number of top Belmont jockeys are scheduled to visit the Ronald McDonald House in New Hyde Park, New York, on June 5 as part of the Belmont Stakes Festival. The jockeys, who have made several such visits in past years, will sign autographs, speak to the children in English and Spanish, answer questions and offer pony rides. "The families who stay at the Ronald McDonald House of Long Island are in crisis," said Executive Director Silvana La Ferlita Gullo. "They often feel isolated, afraid and anxious about their situation. The jockeys make them feel that there are people who really care about their welfare."

Migliore Wins 2003 Venezia Award:

Jockey Richard Migliore was selected by fans, turf writers and jockeys to be the recipient of the 2003 Mike Venezia Memorial Award. He will be presented with a 13-inch bronze statue during a ceremony on Memorial Day. The New York Racing Association instituted the award for riders who "exemplify extraordinary sportsmanship and citizenship," and first awarded it posthumously to Venezia, who was killed in a tragic spill at Belmont Park Oct. 13, 1988. Migliore, 39, was selected over three other finalists; Patricia Cooksey, Aaron Gryder and John Velazquez. Previous winners of the award include Jerry Bailey, Angel Cordero Jr. and Bill Shoemaker.
