FRENCH GROUP 1 FINALE

France will stage its final Group 1 event of 2003 with today's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, but trainer Aidan O'Brien will not have the chance to win his third straight. O'Brien, who took the race with Ballingarry (Ire) and Alberto Giacometti (Ire) in 2001 and 2002, had entered Susan Magnier's **Magritte (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) this year, but the colt was scratched because connections were unhappy with the results of scope examination. That could leave the race to **Simplex (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest), who finished runner-up to subsequent group winner Apsis (GB) in a Longchamp conditions event on his debut Sept. 20 before returning to that track to take a similar contest Oct. 9. He hails from the stable of Carlos Laffon-Parias, successful with Spadoun (Fr) and Goldamix (Ire) in 1998 and 1999. **Top Seed (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) was possibly flattered by his runner-up placing behind Bago (Fr) in last Saturday's G1 Criterium International at this track, but **Happy Crusader (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) got closer to Bago when third in the G3 Prix des Chenes Sept. 20 and holds the fourth-placed **Voix du Nord (Fr)** (Valanour {Ire}) on that form.

SOMETHING TO SHOUT ABOUT

A troubled third in the GI Kentucky Oaks over this surface in May, **Yell (A.P. Indy)** will try to improve on that effort in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. this afternoon. The three-year-old was second best in the GI Mother Goose S. in June before finishing a distant fourth in the 12-furlong GI CCA Oaks July 19. "The CCA Oaks was a big disappointment," assistant Buzz Tenney said. "She was an ordinary kind of fourth with no finish to her race at all. [Trainer Shug McGaughey] wanted to shorten up and see what happened." The regally bred filly regrouped following a close fourth in the GI Ballerina H. Aug. 24 and posted a sharp return victory in the GIII Raven Run S. at Keeneland Oct. 10, both over seven furlongs. "Hopefully, the one-turn mile will be perfect for her," Tenney added. **Churchill Downs Distaff H. field, p4**

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GONE WEST MARE TOPS KEENELAND FRIDAY

West Is West (Gone West), in foal to Maria's Mon, brought a final bid of \$400,000 to top Friday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. Consigned by Robert E. Courtney/Crestfield Farm LLC, agent, the five-year-old was purchased by Copperhead Stable. Ben Walden signed the ticket for Copperhead, a new venture started by Walden and Brad Kelley, who is in the tobacco business. There is an additional one-third partner in this mare, Patrick Madden, son of Preston Madden. "She was as fine a mare as I've seen all week," Walden said. "She is a serious physical. She's from a wonderful Grade I-winning daughter of Storm Cat that Mrs. Abercrombie is very committed to. I thought that she would cost \$500,000...I was thrilled to get her for \$400,000. I've actually had an offer for her for a significant profit within 30 minutes [of the purchase], but Mr. Kelley and I have elected to turn it down." As for the goals of Copperhead, Walden said, "We're developing a long-term strategy to acquire a group of mares over the next five to 10 years that can be competitive at the highest commercial level. We will buy a couple of fillies in training at the two-year-old sales with an eye on the breeding program." Offered on behalf of Josephine Abercrombie, West Is West is out of the Pin Oak homebred Missed the Storm (Storm Cat), who defeated Miss Indy Anna and Educated Risk to win the 1993 GI Test S. Missed the Storm is also a half to Green Means Go (Green Dancer), who won a pair of graded events on the turf in 1995. This is also the female family of Chief's Crown and Winning Colors.

A filly by Pleasant Tap out of Fitzzy (A.P. Indy) attracted a bid of \$240,000 to top Friday's weanlings. Consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent for the complete dispersal of Warner L. Jones Farm, Inc., the chestnut was purchased by Edward J. Kelly, Jr. A 3/4 sister to GISW Tap to Music (Pleasant Tap), she is also from the family of MGSW Northern Afleet, GISW Cuddles and Canadian champion Kamar. "I just loved her," said Three Chimneys' Dan Rosenberg. "She was outstanding for all of the obvious reasons. She comes from a great family, she was wonderful looking and she had excellent vet work. She was the whole package. She went to very good hands. There was a lot of interest in her and we knew that she'd sell well, but you can never predict blow-out prices like that. But we knew that a lot of people liked her."

Top Colt for Swain (Ire)...

Bloodstock advisor John Moynihan, bidding on behalf of Bob and Beverly Lewis, went to \$225,000 for the top-selling weanling colt yesterday. Sold in utero for just \$11,000 from the Shadwell consignment at the 2003 January Sale, the Apr. 16 foal is by Swain (Ire) out of Taanis (Dayjur). He was consigned to Keeneland November by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent. "He's a really great physical, one of the best physicals I've seen come through here this week," Moynihan said, adding, "It's been a very, very strong market for weanlings. The good horses are bringing a whole lot of money." Earlier in the week, the Lewises were the immediate underbidder on the weanling full brother to Point Given, which made \$800,000.
