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### SEXTET AND THE CITY

A select field of six will line up for today's GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont Park, with 2004 Horse of the Year **Ghostzapper** (Awesome Again) returning to the track for the first time since annexing the GI Breeders' Cup Classic last October. The Bobby Frankel trainee will be the favorite and for good reason. Aside from dominating his peers at the Classic distance of a mile and a quarter, the bay has proven himself a brilliant sprinter, winning the 6 1/2-furlong GI Vosburgh S. as a three-year-old and taking last year's seven-furlong GII Tom Fool H. in a blistering 1:20 2/5. "He's probably

better going farther than six furlongs, but he's equally effective from seven furlongs to a mile and a half," said Frankel. The biggest question mark for Ghostzapper is the seven-month layoff. Frankel, however, is not concerned. "If he's 90-percent fit, he should win," he said. "I think I have him fit enough. I'd be surprised and a little disappointed if he didn't win." Rival trainers, however, are far from conceding victory. Todd Pletcher has entered **Forest Danger** (Forestry), who has won five of six starts, including a rallying victory in the Apr. 9 GI Carter H. that earned him a 115 Beyer. "We've been pointing toward this race since the Carter," said Pletcher, adding, "The thing I really liked about his Carter was that he galloped out very strongly afterwards, indicating that a mile is certainly within his scope."

**Ecclesiastic** (Pulpit), a relative newcomer to the Allen Jerkens barn, had never won on the grass and was just two-for-17 lifetime, but put it all together with a come-from-behind score in yesterday's GIII Jaipur H. The four-year-old, transferred from Kiaran McLaughlin this spring, was runner-up for his new trainer in a second-level allowance race over Gulfstream's main track Apr. 6. He ran a solid second to Better Talk Now in the grassy GIII Fort Marcy H. at the Big A Apr. 23, but was an 8-1 outsider Sunday on the basis of a zero-for-eight turf record. Settled off the pace of **Gulch Approval** (Gulch), Ecclesiastic found his best stride down the lane and outfinished **Old Forester** (Forestry) for the win. **Cont. p2**

### WILL THE SHOE FIT?

The 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Mile hero **Singletary** (Sultry Song) was second in the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile S. last year, but trainer Don Chatlos Jr. believes the five-year-old will be the one to beat this time around. The bay disappointed in his return, tiring to be seventh in the Mar. 5 GI F.J. Kilroe Mile H., but got the job done in the Apr. 9 GII Arcadia H., winning by a length. "He knows what he's doing so much more than last year," said Chatlos. "He's got enough speed that [jockey David Flores] can put him wherever he wants." Still, the trainer is not expecting his charge to have an easy time out if today. "The Shoemaker is the toughest race you could find," he said. "It's not just one horse in there you have to beat. There are six." He added, "They're all dangerous, but the one that worries me most is [King of Happiness]. We haven't faced him since the Shoemaker last year, but he's really caught my eye on the track." **Cont. p4**

With a field reduced to just three fillies when the race was taken off the grass, Sea Gull Associates' Toll Taker prevailed in a virtual match race over Pleasant Lyrics. Toll Taker had shown good form at two, winning the GIII Astarita S. in October, and rebounded from a poor showing in the Feb. 5 GIII Old Hat S. to win the Sun Coast S. at Tampa Feb. 26. Second in the Florida Oaks Mar. 19, she again had something to prove after running eighth in the Apr. 16 GII Comely S. Hustled out to set the pace as Pleasant Lyrics stayed glued to her hip, Toll Taker lost the lead in mid-stretch, but battled back gamely to post the win. "When that other filly got by us in the stretch, I was hoping that she was going to reach down and find something extra, and she did," said winning rider Aaron Gryder.

Winning for the first time since taking a NW1X at Belmont in May of 2004, Ecclesiastic gave sire Pulpit the weekend graded double at Belmont. Pulpit's son Oratory set a new stakes record in the GII Peter Pan S. Saturday, taking the nine-furlong race in 1:46 1/5. Of Ecclesiastic, trainer Allen Jerkens said, "He was in good shape when we got him. We just kind of went along with him. He didn't like Florida that much. He's a lot better up here. I had a feeling that he was sharp right now." Of the future, the Hall of Famer added, "I don't have anything special planned for him. We'll just be happy with this for awhile." The six-year-old Le Cinquieme Essai concluded 2004 with a pair of wins over Woodbine's lawn and picked up right where he left off. Canada's champion three-year-old in 2002 off a victory in the Prince of Wales S., Le Cinquieme Essai didn't miss the board in six starts last year, finishing second by a nose to Slew Valley in this race in May and winning the restricted International Turf Cup S. at Fort Erie next out. Second in the With Approval S. at Woodbine in August, he won an allowance race at that track in October before wiring the Labeeb S. Nov. 7. Making his first start since then, he was eager early, but was taken just off the pace under Steven Bahen. Given his head as they straightened for home, the gelding put a nose in front and was under a stiff drive to hold the late challenge of Tusayan, winning his first graded race in the process. "I was trying to get him to stay a little bit off the pace," explained Bahen. "Today, he rated very nicely. He was very relaxed and he was happy doing what he was doing. He punched on when I called on him."

Sweet Wake was handed a could-do-better sophomore report at the end of last season, although he did receive gold stars for wins in the Listed Fruhjahrspreis at Hannover last May and Listed Walther J Jacobs-Rennen at Bremen the following month. He returned this semester with a runner-up finish to Gentle Tiger in the Listed Grosser Preis der Dr Duve Inkasso back at Hannover Apr. 17 and turned the tables on that foe to secure a first group race success here. Stalking the early pace behind Near Honor (Ger) (Highest Honor {Fr}), the eventual winner was shuffled back to third for much of the contest until making headway to join Gentle Tiger approaching the final furlong. The result was soon put to bed as he found plenty from the eighth pole, drawing off late for the victory. Sweet Wake, who marks the first Pattern winner for his Group 1-winning sire, was purchased for his current owner just before last season's G1 Deutsches Derby, where he finished a disappointing 17th. Vengeance of Rain put the wraps on a terrific 2004-2005 season, winning the final Group 1 on the domestic calendar in his first try at 2400 meters. The four-year-old has been unstoppable since finishing third in his seasonal debut back in September, rattling off four straight victories, including the Hong Kong Derby Mar. 13 and a world-class performance in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup Apr. 24. Sent off at odds-on to make it five in a row, Vengeance of Rain was content to linger at the back of the field as Saturn set a slow pace, despite racing keenly. Pulled out four wide and asked to rally leaving the three-furlong marker, the bay responded when asked and methodically made his way to the front as Best Gift outfinished Saturn for second. The winner will now be rested and pointed at the Hong Kong International Races in December. At that point, overseas races will be considered, but a potential run in the G1 Cox Plate, suggested following his QE II success, is "out of the question," trainer David Ferraris indicated.

**Whilly** is another one to watch. A troubled fourth in the GI Hollywood Derby last November, the four-year-old colt followed with a win in the Dec. 26 Sir Beaufort S. going a mile at Santa Anita. He added a victory in the

10-furlong GII San Marcos H. in January, then shipped to the Middle East and was second in the G1 Dubai Duty Free H.

**Miss Terrible** made her U.S. debut in the 2003 Gamely and cut out all the pace before faltering to be fourth. The bay mare started just once more that year, stopping badly to be sixth in a Saratoga allowance test, then disappeared for nearly 19 months. During her extended absence, the six-year-old was handed over to Bradley Ross. She is the only horse that the former blacksmith trains. "She didn't acclimate well in this country," Ross explained. "When I got her last June, we X-rayed her knee, found a little old crack and gave her three months off." The South American import returned to win the Feb. 27 GIII Las Flores H. at Santa Anita and made it two in a row in the GIII Distaff Turf Mile H. at Churchill Downs. Already a seven-time Group 1 winner in her native country, Miss Terrible bids for her first U.S. Grade I. "She is such an incredible horse," her trainer said. "I really would like the world to get to know her. It's been an exciting trip. Everyone has been so nice to me and my one-horse stable." **Nadeszhda**, a handicap winner in France, has been on the board in all four starts since shipping to the States last fall. The five-year-old mare was third while facing the boys in her 2005 opener, an allowance on the Santa Anita turf. She came close to beating Megahertz (GB) in the Apr. 17 GII Santa Barbara H., but was caught in the final strides and finished second by 3/4 of a length. A Listed winner going a mile and a quarter in France, **Flip Flop** made her U.S. bow in a one-mile allowance test on the Hollywood lawn May 13 and closed to win by a head.

"Oratorio, Gypsy King, Grand Central and Almighty will be our Derby horses," he told *PA Sport*. **Oratorio (Ire)** (Danehill), a 6-1 chance with British bookmaker William Hill, was a fast-closing fourth in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket Apr. 30 and returned to finish runner-up in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh May 21. **Gypsy King (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) booked his ticket with a victory in the G3 Dee S. at Chester May 6 and number one jockey Kieren Fallon will likely choose between the pair. **Grand Central (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) will line up off a third in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 8 and the quartet is completed by G3 Chester Vase runner-up **Almighty** (Sadler's Wells). Ballydoyle's G1 Vodafone Oaks challenge will be three-pronged, represented by G1 1000 Guineas victress **Virginia Waters** (Kingmambo), who was supplemented at a cost of £20,000, **Mona Lisa (GB)** (Giant's Causeway) and **Silk And Scarlet (GB)** (Sadler's Wells).

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# Thoro-Graph Race of the Week

Over the years, the Belmont surface has changed considerably--the cushion, which was 2-1/2" deep back when Secretariat and the 70's superstars were running, is now almost 4". To give you an idea of what this means, there was one day in 2003 when the cushion was only 3"--the day Najran ran a mile in 1:32:24. Additionally, the track now has a higher percentage of sand, which dries out faster, but is slower when dry ("fast") than when it had more clay. The result of the changes is a track which, among other things, is much slower, and obscures the fact that the equine athletes that compete over it are much, much faster than their ancestors of a few generations ago. In part this is because a generation for Thoroughbreds takes about one-third as long as it does for humans--Secretariat is to today's top racehorses as Jesse Owens is to today's track stars. Other reasons for improvement include advances in nutrition and sports medicine, including unfortunately some which have prompted the security measures recently implemented at the NYRA tracks. All of which brings us to this year's Met Mile and a short but ridiculously fast field. Where a decade ago only one or two horses a year would run a negative figure on the Thoro-Graph scale, it has now become a commonplace occurrence, and every single member of this field has already gone negative this year.

A very fast horse, and fast horses are hard to keep sound--you will notice that several Met Mile horses have extended gaps in their form. This colt ran a negative number as an April 3yo and soon thereafter went to the sidelines. Since his return, he has been a monster with two huge figures (negative 4-1/2s), and Pletcher has smartly spaced his races to keep him in one piece. He comes into the Met fresh and very fast, and getting a five-pound pull in the weights from Ghostzapper worth one point on the Thoro-Graph scale. All of which makes him very tough, and probably the most likely winner of the race.

**Overview** – Not much of a betting race, but if Forest Danger and Ghostzapper both bring their "A" game, this could be one for the ages. Silver Wagon could be used underneath at a big price in the exotics.

Jerry Brown formed Thoro-Graph in 1982 to service the needs of horsemen and professional handicappers. Thoro-Graph performance figures take into account weight, ground loss, effect of wind on the time of the race, and track speed. The lower the figure, the better the performance. Among Thoro-Graph's innovations are Thoro-Patterns, the figure-based profiles, which enable horsemen and serious handicappers to accurately assess the tendencies of trainers in different situations, and sire's and dam's runners at different distances, over different surfaces, and at different ages. John had been asking me for years to train privately, but I have too many good owners and I just couldn't become a private trainer." Abreu, a Zito assistant since 2002, had previously worked for D. Wayne Lukas, Todd Pletcher and John Ward. "We've always like Reynaldo," said Hendrickson. "He's a terrific horseman and Nick recommended him highly, so we're very happy with the arrangement."
