CLASSIC GATE OVERFLOWING

A field of 11, led by GI Hollywood Gold Cup hero **Lava Man** (Bertrando), is slated to go postward for the centerpiece of the summer meeting at Del Mar, the \$1-million GI Pacific Classic. The field was reduced from a full dozen Friday afternoon when trainer Nick Hines decided to scratch 50-1 outsider **Polish Times** (Sea Hero). But all eyes will be on Lava Man this afternoon. Claimed for \$50,000 out of a runner-up finish over the local turf just over a year ago, the dark bay repaid a good portion of that investment with a victory in the Pomona Derby, but then failed to win again in seven starts. Trainer Doug O'Neill equipped his charge with blinkers for a May 14 optional claimer at Hollywood and he has since rattled off three straight, including the July 9 Gold Cup, a race for which he earned a lofty Beyer Speed Figure of 120. "We're just hoping he can mimic his Hollywood Park form," O'Neill commented. "If he does, we'll be OK. The horse is training great and looking great and we think he's going to run well." **Cont. p2**

If at First You Don't Succeed...

Perfect Drift (Dynaformer) grabbed his surfboard and headed to the left coast for last year's Pacific Classic, but had the misfortune of running into Pleasantly Perfect and settled for second, one of five runner-up efforts in a winless campaign. This season, the venerable gelding has fared much better, with a pair of victories, including Arlington's GII Washington Park H. July 30. "He's very, very consistent and really is a remarkable animal," says trainer Murray Johnson. "Most of the credit goes to him for being the incredible animal that he is."

Surf Cat Tries Older...

Trainer Bruce Headley passed on the opportunity to run **Surf Cat** (Sir Cat) against his peers in the GI Haskell H. two weeks ago and will learn today whether that strategy proves sound. The dark bay defeated subsequent GI Bing Crosby hero Greg's Gold in a 6 1/2-furlong allowance at Hollywood May 15 then was second by a neck in his two-turn bow in the GIII Affirmed H. June 18. He put it all together in his latest, winning the GII Swaps BC S. by five lengths July 9 and will try to follow in the footsteps of Best Pal, General Challenge and Came Home, who all defeated their elders in the Classic.

One Foot In Front of the Other....

A May foal, produced by a half sister to Horse of the Year Holy Bull, Sweet Symphony was dismissed at longshot odds for her seven-furlong debut at Belmont Park May 12, but overcame some trouble to post a 3/4-length victory at 17-1. Stretched out to the one-turn mile-and-a-sixteenth distance for her first allowance test, the homebred rated nicely, turned in an impressive three-wide move and scampered home by six lengths June 24. Pounded down to 1-5 for a second-level allowance going nine panels over this surface July 28, the dark bay tracked a very slow pace, accelerated three wide into the stretch and ground out a 2 1/2-length victory, earning her way into this event.

A Harmonic Victory....

Settled in the rear as GI Ashland S. winner **Sis City** (Slew City Slew) and **Spun Sugar** (Awesome Again) tussled on the front end, Sweet Symphony commenced a run along the inside leaving the half-mile pole which saw her draw to within two lengths of the lead approaching the stretch. Spun Sugar held the call as the field straightened away, but Sweet Symphony, angled out three wide for run, overtook that one and pulled away despite drifting in late. **R Lady Joy** (Vicar), winner in her most recent start of the GII Delaware Oaks, held third as Sis City tired in the final furlong. "The question was whether my horse would have enough going long," commented winning jockey Jerry Bailey, posting his first stakes victory of the meet. "She's answered every question climbing up the ladder. Obviously, this was a much bigger test. I really didn't have to get to the bottom of her. I guess the sky is the limit for her." Mott was equally impressed. "I think this puts her on the top of the heap," he said, referring to the sophomore filly division. "The way she won today, I think we would consider the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Distaff]. I would like to get a race between now and then for her at Belmont." The winner of a Doncaster nursery last September, Singhalese was shelved for seven months, returning to finish fourth to Berbatim (Bernstein) in the Apr. 9 Providencia S. at Santa Anita. She had the bad fortune of drawing the 11-hole in her next two outings, but ran with credit when fourth in the GII Honeymoon Breeders' Cup H. June 5 and third in the GI American Oaks July 3 at Hollywood Park. Dropped into entry-level allowance company in her latest, the chestnut rallied to post a 2 1/4-length victory Aug. 1. Patiently handled at the back of the pack, Singhalese raced wide on the far turn and looped around the field at the quarter pole. Over-taking pacesetter Dancing Edie at the eighth pole, she was always holding favored Three Degrees to the wire.

Ballydoyle is already home to the favorite for next year's 2000 Guineas in the shape of George Washington (Ire) and Horatio Nelson's victory here means that Aidan O'Brien also trains the 2006 Epsom Derby favorite. It also continued O'Brien's domination of this race, which he has taken five times in the past seven years with Giant's Causeway, Hawk Wing and Oratorio (Ire), among others. Horatio Nelson won a Curragh maiden in comfortable fashion on debut June 24 and stepped up with success in the G3 Superlative S. at Newmarket last time July 7. Stalking the early leader in second here, he was niggled at three furlongs out, but responded well to reach the lead at the quarter pole. One crack of the persuader was sufficient for him to come clear inside the final furlong for a workmanlike score. "He's got a great attitude," enthused winning rider Kieren Fallon. "He's won there not doing a stroke and could be a Derby horse. He wants a trip, he travels and he's well-balanced." With the attention focused on Ruwi, it was his stable companion Pinson who upstaged him in impressive fashion to make it four straight. Brought along quietly with conditions wins at Maisons-Laffitte May 4 and at Longchamp June 1, he showed he was ready for the big league when annexing the G3 Prix Daphnis at the Paris oval last time June 27. Settled off the early pace in fifth by Stephane Pasquier, he was asked to close at the top of straight and responded to challenge wide approaching the final quarter. Grabbing the advantage soon after, he showed immaturity when wandering out on his own, but quickened clear in the final 100 yards for a commanding score. "He has made enormous progression since his last win," trainer Jean-Claude Rouget said. "I don't know if he'll stay a mile-and-a-half and there are no 10-furlong races left in France this year, so we may have to go abroad." He added of Ruwi, who stayed on from rear to take second late, "He was giving weight and was in need of the run, so his return was most encouraging."

Trainer Bob Baffert, whose Friday began in tragic fashion after the fatal breakdown of his star two-year-old What a Song, gained some consolation by nightfall when Behaving Badly maintained her unbeaten record by winning her stakes debut. The New York-bred had a splashy career opener last August at this meeting, romping by eight lengths, but didn't resurface again until July 24, handling allowance foes by a length. Favored to negotiate this class rise, the bay filly sat off the flank of Dee Dee's Diner through a half in :44.26 before forging to the lead. Victor Espinoza set her down for the drive and she responded with a determined effort. "She's a really nice filly and she's improving every time," Espinoza said. "She's professional. It will be fun to see just how good she really is." After the race, Baffert spoke about What a Song. "It's part of horse racing you never really get used to," he said. "These horses are like our children, so when something happens like that it's pretty devastating for everybody involved. When it's unexpected like that, it makes it worse." 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Current law enables purchasers to write off up to \$100,000 of the cost of horses, provided total purchases of all depreciable property during the year do not exceed \$400,000. The \$100,000 expensing allowance applies to purchases made January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2007.

He's Got Grit made some headlines in his June 26 bow versus \$80,000 maidens at Churchill Downs, winning by 3 1/4 lengths in new track-record time of :50 3/5 for the 4 1/2 furlongs. The attractive dark bay was given a chance to prove his mettle in stakes company in his next and most recent appearance and took advantage of the opportunity, annexing this track's Tyro S. by three-parts of a length July 30. Stepping up to graded competition for this try, He's Got Grit was the second choice in the wagering

behind Diabolical, who earned a 91 Beyer in winning his maiden at first asking at Belmont Park July 7. Sent immediately to the front by jockey Aaron Gryder, the gelding rated kindly while cutting out fractions of :21.41 for the opening quarter and a snappy :44.15 for the half mile. Asked for his best in upper stretch, He's Got Grit responded gamely and drew off to post a much-the-best victory. Diabolical outstayed Confront for second money. "He's got a great stride," the winning rider commented. "I was comfortable the entire race. Confront came up to me, but turning for home my colt just accelerated and at the top of the stretch he drew off. When you have a nice colt like this, you just keep dreaming of bigger and better things."

She angled out five wide turning for home and opened up under a hand ride to outclass her rivals. "That's the way you're supposed to ride those kind of horses," the visiting jockey commented. "You think they're the best and you know what the filly is capable of doing, you want to sit there and you don't want to make any mistakes." Added victorious trainer Juan Garcia, "We came a long way and I'm glad we won the race. In the middle of the turn I was a little worried. I couldn't see her until she started to do the kick and when I saw her make the kick, I knew that we had it." Halory Leigh, making her first start since winning the GII Falls City H. Nov. 25, came along to complete the exacta.

With Ballydoyle already off mark in the first of the European Group 1s for juveniles with George Washington (Ire), this race may provide a showcase for another budding mogul in Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Irving Cowan's **Ivan Denisovich**. Johannesburg was the latest of the three winners saddled by Aidan O'Brien in this contest in 2001, a year which belonged to his cluster of top-class two-year-old colts. Early signs are that he has a formidable set this season and Ivan Denisovich is right at the top after a smooth two-length success in the G2 July S. at Newmarket July 6. That followed a debut reversal behind the smart To Sender (GB) at Newbury May 14 and an emphatic maiden score at Leopardstown June 1. Eoghan O'Neill has leapt to the fore this term, saddling winners left, right and center for his patron John Fretwell. Their new connection bore fruit when **Always Hopeful** routed a decent field in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood last time July 29 and the trainer thinks there is more to come. "He's probably the best horse in the race and is in great order," he commented. "He goes there with a big chance and he'll stay a mile in due course, as we can settle him in behind and let him finish." Robert Collet saddled Whipper to take this in 2003 and relies on the unbeaten **New Girlfriend** this time. Having won the July 7 Listed Prix Yacowlef for debutantes here, she followed the Divine Proportions route with an impressive score in the G2 Prix Robert Papin at Maisons-Laffitte last time July 24. She is one of three talented fillies in the line-up including Aldridge Racing Ltd's impressive Newbury maiden winner **Silca's Sister**.

NO ARC FOR KITTEN'S JOY In a statement released by the New York Racing Association, owner Kenneth Ramsey indicated that reigning Eclipse Award winning turf male **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado {Ire}) will not run in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and will instead accept an invitation to the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational Oct. 1. "I spoke with Jerry Bailey, who rode Kitten's Joy on soft turf, and Edgar Prado, who rode him on firm and yielding turf," Ramsey explained. "It is the opinion of the professionals that he is a better horse on firm turf and if we were to go to Paris, there is an 80-percent chance of the course being good, yielding, soft or even heavy. By staying at Belmont Park, those odds are reversed. Then I started thinking, if we went over there, we would have to get a French jockey, no medication, have him run on an up-and-down course. Then factor in the trip over, quarantine and the trip back and he would be a knocked-out horse for Japan." Ramsey had previously stated that he intends to run Kitten's Joy in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 27. He concluded, "So, when you put it all together, the smart and logical thing to do is to stay and train at Belmont Park. Based on what happened with Roses in May, we felt making this announcement this way was the right thing to do." The winner of the GII Firecracker Breeders' Cup H. at Churchill Downs July 4, the blaze-faced chestnut was most recently second, beaten three lengths, in the GI Arlington Million Aug. 13.

BELLAMY DECISION DUE WEDNESDAY Edward Sexton knows which race GI Wood Memorial S. winner **Bellamy Road** (Concerto) will run in Saturday at Saratoga. He just isn't telling. Sexton, the farm

manager for George Steinbrenner's Kinsman Stable, said a decision has been reached regarding the next start for the Wood Memorial winner, but it won't be revealed until Wednesday. He will run in either the 10-furlong GI Travers S. or the GI King's Bishop S. over seven-eighths of a mile. Sexton said he is not disclosing his decision because the stable wants to

avoid the type of media hype that surrounded Bellamy Road before his failed attempt in the Kentucky Derby. Neither race appears to be a perfect scenario for Bellamy Road, who would have to take on the undefeated **Lost in the Fog** (Lost Soldier) in the King's Bishop or compete in the Travers after a 3 1/2-month layoff. Bellamy Road was scheduled to breeze Saturday in Saratoga, but the workout was delayed a day because of muddy track conditions. "Bellamy Road is back 100 percent," Sexton said. "Whichever race he runs in he will be a tough cookie. He can sprint. He can stay. He's definitely a class act and he is better now than he ever was."

The distance is a question, but the timing into this is very good, and he's clearly the horse to beat.
