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BATTLE FOR THE ATTO CROWN

Today's C\$1-million GI Atto Mile at Woodbine will feature a pair of California-based chestnuts in their first clash this year, and they will break from adjoining stalls. Drawing the rail is **Leroidesanimaux (Brz)** (Candy Stripes), who handled **King of Happiness** (Spinning World) in an optional claimer at Santa Anita in 2004, the second win in his seven-race streak. Since then, the five-year-old has added front-running wins in the GI Citation H. and the GI Frank E. Kilroe Mile, and is coming off a course-record setting performance in the GII Bernard Baruch H. Aug. 27. He'll be running off just

three weeks rest, but assistant trainer Brian Lynch doesn't foresee a problem. "He's very sharp," Lynch said. "He looks in outstanding condition." King of Happiness had a disappointing 2004 campaign, but has rebounded with several sharp efforts this year. After annexing the GIII Inglewood H. Apr. 30, he came up a half-length short in his next two starts at Hollywood, the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile May 30 and the GII American Invitational H. July 30. His trainer **King of Happiness** Benoit Neil Drysdale will be looking for his third victory in this contest. **Thorograph analysis, p17**

Folklore entered the Matron as the most experienced filly in the field. After winding up second to Fifth Avenue (Monarchos) in her May 18 career opener, the bay graduated by four lengths over this surface June 3 and followed with a runner-up finish to Adieu in the Astoria S. July 3. She turned the tables on that rival in the GII Adirondack on Saratoga's opening day card July 27, but had to settle for second best to that filly in the GII Spinaway S. Aug. 26. Folklore had been training smartly at Churchill in recent weeks and was the second choice to India (Hennessy), whose eye-catching Saratoga maiden win saw her go postward at even-money. Along the Sea burst through the gate and delayed the start by several minutes, but Folklore was undeterred. She jumped out to scrimmage for the lead and took charge on the turn. Her rivals were unable to match strides and the Lewis homebred strode home smartly. "I was nervous when she broke on top, but Edgar [Prado] kept his cool and let the others go on and dictate the pace," said assistant trainer Peter Hutton. "She just took over. From Day 1, she's been nothing but class and she showed it today. Wayne [Lukas] will talk things over with Mr. and Mrs. Lewis; they may decide to go straight to the Breeders' Cup [Oct. 29] or maybe get another race in between." Lukas, a Hall of Fame conditioner, had twice saddled three successive Matron winners: 1994-96 with Flanders, Golden Attraction and Sharp Cat; and 1987-89 with Over All, Some Romance and Stella Madrid. He won back-to-back runnings in 1983-84 with Lucky Lucky Lucky and Fiesta Lady. [Video, sponsored by Taylor Made](#). Collier Hill denied home favorite Vinnie Roe a fifth consecutive victory in this famous race. Although Vinnie Roe had the full support of the partisan Curragh crowd, Collier Hill has impressed racegoers in many countries and has come a long way from an incarnation as a winning hurdler. His overseas debut yielded the G3 Stockholm Cup International at Taby in September.

Shipped to Dubai in the new year, he took a valuable 12-furlong handicap at Nad al Sheba in February before running third to Phoenix Reach (Ire) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 26. He wired the G2 Gerling-Preis at Cologne May 1 on his return to European action before a last-out second in the G1 Preis der Freunde & Förderer at Dusseldorf July 24. Racing in mid-division from the outset here, he was pushed along in fourth as Vinnie Roe swept to the front while travelling well into the straight. Responding to Dean McKeown's urgings, Collier Hill wore down the local hero 50 yards out and held on late. Private Vow was forced to go eight wide in his July 3 debut at Churchill, but still managed to get second to Sorcerer's Stone, who will be among the favorites in today's GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity. The bay travelled up to Saratoga to graduate with a wire-to-wire effort July 30 and followed up with a very impressive 5 1/2-length allowance victory Aug. 29 upstate.

Disco's Son (Disco Rico), who stumbled at the start and unseated Javier Castellano, went to the front and had everyone staying cautiously off his flank. Private Vow wound up going three wide on the turn, put away his only threat in Changing Weather, and raced alongside the loose Disco's Son down the lane. "I hated to see Javier come off, but it created a perfect scenario for me," admitted winning rider Jerry Bailey. "There was more speed, more of a 'rabbit,' and it put me in a great spot." Estate Collection had only started twice prior to the the GIII Kentucky Cup Sprint, but it was his opponents who looked light on experience in the stretch. The sophomore was claimed by trainer Chuck Peery for \$40,000 out of his winning debut at Del Mar Aug. 12 and quickly added a \$40,000 starter allowance score over that course Aug. 27. Transferred to Doug O'Neill for this, he jumped

out of the gate first from the seven post with Patrick Valenzuela aboard and cut out :22.18 and :45.69 splits. The dark bay brought a one-length lead into the stretch and was able to hold off a late challenge from the second-longest shot on the board to post his first stakes victory. Going Wild, who had finished off the board in his previous six starts, stayed on for third while 9-5 favorite Vicarage (Vicar) placed a distant fourth. Making his first start since the 2004 GII Sanford S. at Saratoga, GIII Kentucky Breeders' Cup S. winner Lunarpal (Successful Appeal) never got involved and crossed the line a well-beaten seventh.

Black Type Designators for North American Racing

A **Graded Race** is defined as a non-restricted race with added money or guaranteed purse value of \$50,000 or more which has been run at least twice under similar conditions and on the same surface and has been assigned graded stakes status for the year contested by the American Graded Stakes Committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association (TOBA) for the United States, or The Jockey Club of Canada for Canada.

MORE GOOD HUMOR AT KEENELAND Buzz Chace, bidding on behalf of an unnamed client who "is just getting into the game," dug deep during yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland September Yearling Sale in Lexington, as the New Jersey-based agent went to a session-topping \$1.1 million for a colt by Distorted Humor. It was the first seven-figure horse in Book 3 since 2000. Consigned to the sale by Taylor Made as agent for the colt's breeder, Racehorse Management, the dark bay is the second live foal from Weekend in Indy (A.P. Indy), a half sister to the talented handicap horse Second of June and already the dam of last year's GIII Cicada S. winner Bohemian Lady (Carson City). Chace was not surprised he had to work as hard as he did. "He's a very nice individual," he commented. "He had some pedigree, he's an athlete and just being around him, he's a very nice horse." It has been a banner sale for Distorted Humor, who has been represented by a half-dozen horses that brought over \$400,000 off a 2003 stud fee of \$20,000. The 12-year-old stood the 2005 breeding season for an advertised fee of \$60,000. WinStar President Doug Cauthen said that the marriage of sire to dam was one made in heaven. "He's probably the best Distorted Humor--physically--we feel we've bred," he explained. "I know that Weekend in Indy is going to have a lifetime date with Distorted Humor. It's a great cross and obviously we're getting a good physical." WinStar acquired Weekend in Indy for \$290,000 at the 2001 Keeneland November Sale, carrying what turned out to be Bohemian Lady. After producing that filly, Weekend in Indy slipped her 2002 and 2003 foals before catching to Distorted Humor. She did not produce a foal this year. Cauthen indicated that WinStar will breed 25-30 of their best mares to Distorted Humor, a sire he credits with putting the nursery on the map. "He's been a blessing to WinStar," he added. "He's proven that he can get Grade I winning colts and Grade I winning fillies. For the Europeans, he can get a grass horse. He can kind of do anything--he can get you a sprinter, a miler, a Classic horse."

Jackson Four...

After purchasing 14 horses during the first four sessions, Jess Jackson was back at work yesterday, signing tickets on three of the day's five most expensive offerings. The founder of the Kendall-Jackson Winery made the winning bid on hip 1582, a gray or roan colt from the first crop of GI Wood Memorial S. winner Buddha. Peter O'Callaghan's Woods Edge Farm consigned the Apr. 16 foal for Bloodstock Services, which paid \$135,000 for the colt at last year's November sale. He is the second foal produced by the Caller I.D. mare Call Your Beau, a half sister to Grade I winner See How She Runs and GSW Hasten To Add. Ben Walden's Gracefield agency successfully pinhooked a Holy Bull colt, which Jackson purchased for \$450,000. Walden, along with partners Brad Kelly and David Hanley, were able to secure the son of Sister Baby (Lord Avie) for just \$52,000 last November. "We really loved him last year and we're delighted he turned out like he did," Hanley commented. "He had a very good frame, even if he was a little bit leggy and light as a foal. He's put together very well and, I have to say, Gracefield have done a tremendous job to get him looking the way he did." Jackson also landed the session's top filly, outlasting the competition to get hip 1482, an elegant dark bay daughter of Forestry, for \$375,000. The Taylor Made consignee is the first foal from Summerwood (Boston Harbor), who was purchased by Aaron and Marie Jones for \$350,000 as a yearling at the 2000 Keeneland January sale.

Book Five Gets Saturday Bump...

Hip 3403 isn't scheduled to sell until next Thursday, but the page received a tremendous boost yesterday. The dark bay filly, consigned by Paramount Sales, is by Tiznow and is the first foal from Queen's Lady (Storm Cat). The latter is in turn a full sister to Contrive, whose daughter Folklore, also by Tiznow, stormed to a 14-length powerhouse victory in yesterday's GI Matron S.

Book Three Off to Flying Start...

With nine days remaining, the September sale has already pressed through the \$300-million mark in gross receipts, achieved last year following the ninth session. A record 40 horses have achieved pricetags in excess of \$1 million. Yesterday, Keeneland sold 274 horses for gross receipts of \$29,839,000, an average of \$108,901, a whopping 27.4-percent gain over the corresponding 2004 session. The session median of \$85,000 was a 21.4-percent improvement over last year. A total of 20 horses sold for \$250,000 or more, compared to just nine in 2004.

"The emphasis of book three was placed on conformation. We wanted it to be a strong conformation catalog," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "We placed what we thought were very good horses in here and the market has reacted accordingly." Russell admitted that he did not anticipate such a strong performance. "Last year was an \$85,000 average, which I thought was unbelievable," he said. "To break \$100,000 is fantastic. I always said last year that the stars aligned. I said if we were close to last year, I'd be happy. You can imagine my reaction."

Just as last week, we'll be looking at a grass race. But this one will be run under allowance conditions, not weight for age, and with evenly matched grass horses a few pounds can make all the difference.

1 Leroidesanimaux (Brz) Candy Stripes

Has been very good and very solid, but has also benefited from some great trips. In his last five tries at a mile or over, he has been on the rail all 10 turns (1w1w), and saving ground has made those efforts look even better than they were. There are several in here that have run figures just as good, if not as often, and they all get weight from the favorite. With speed and the rail he should save ground again, but this race features only one turn and a long stretch, so that won't help him as much as usual. On top of that, he goes to post today on the shortest rest of his career, for a trainer who does best when he spaces his runner's races. Leroidesanimaux is a contender, but definitely beatable.

2 King of Happiness Spinning World

Is severely underrated. In every one of his last six starts at less than a mile and an eighth, he has run a figure every bit as good as Leroidesanimaux's best race, and since Drysdale is great with fresh horses, there is no reason to think he won't run just as well today. Since he gets five pounds from the favorite (worth almost two lengths at this distance) and should save ground stalking under Valenzuela, this is the horse to beat.

3 Vanderlin (GB) Halling

Showed decent ability in England, but moved way up with the addition of Lasix last time. A repeat of that effort combined with a good trip would put him in the mix here, but a bounce off the new top is more likely.

4 A To The Z

Benchmark

Was a moderate dirt horse that moved way up when switched to turf. On the plus side he has lots of good figures, gets a little weight from the favorite and comes from a strong layoff barn. The negative is that his late running style often gets him wide trips (3w4w at CD), and probably will here. There will be a time to bet this horse, but this is not it, though he certainly could be used in exotics.

5 Royal Regalia

Cozzene

Is an extremely late developer that got better from five to six, and came out with his best race off a layoff for a barn that is 37 percent in that category. With two months to recover, he could run that well again and, while he is not as good as several others, he does get significant weight, which should get him close, like last year.

6 Awesome Action

Awesome Again

Is yet another late developing gelding, and his last dirt effort was tremendous, good enough to win this. But it's not clear how much that took out of him, and while he has run okay on grass before, it's hard to tell if he's as good on it. Tough to figure.

8 Le Cinquieme Essai

Fastness (Ire)

Is a very solid six-year-old that jumped to a totally new level last time out. A repeat of that effort would give him a real shot here, but a bounce is likely.

9 Mobil

Langfuhr

Is, on his best, the best horse in the race. But he's not quite as good as he was last year, may not be quite as good on grass as dirt and goes here on only two weeks rest. He's one of many with occasional efforts good enough to win.

Overview – *The big story is that Leroidesanimaux is extremely vulnerable at a short price, probably odds-on, and if we had head-to-head betting in this country, the play would simply be to bet against him. King of Happiness is definitely the most solid, but there are few that can be tossed out with confidence.*

COMEBACK FOR CORDERO Hall of Fame jockey Angel Cordero Jr., who retired from the saddle after a spill that nearly took his life in 1992, will make a one-day comeback, riding for trainer Todd Pletcher at Philadelphia Park Oct. 1. Cordero, 62, initially tried his hand at training, then briefly returned to race riding in October of 1995, guiding Bandit Bomber to a track-record setting win at El Comandante in his native Puerto Rico. He retired again soon after to become a jockey's agent, and currently handles the book for 2004 Eclipse Award winner John Velazquez. Cordero, who regularly exercises horses for Pletcher, will ride undefeated Indian Vale in the GII Cotillion H. and Yes Yes Yes in the Gallant Bob H. at Philly Park. "I'm doing this for a lot of reasons," Cordero said. "I've been getting on horses in the morning for about two years now, and a good opportunity came up. It just happened that all of the good riders in New York were going to be tied up that day. The owner [Eugene Melnyk] and trainer agreed to let me ride [Indian Vale], and my jockey agreed to let me take a week off." The two-time Eclipse winner is also looking to raise money for the victims of Hurricane Katrina. "I am going to donate 25 percent of my earnings to the people that lost their houses," he said. "I hope this gives more people the incentive to help. I lost my wife, so I know what loss means. There are a lot of people suffering right now...I want to go out of my way to help them." Cordero also expects to add to his career total of 7,057 victories. "If Indian Vale is as good as we think she is and she runs her race, she'll make me look good," he said. "If I make her look bad, then I will apologize to her, but I don't think that's going to happen." He added, "She might be the next Ashado. That's exciting to me, to be a part of a filly who could be the next superstar." Cordero also has faith in Indian Vale's conditioner. "We'll find out how good the leading trainer in America really is--he should be able to get a 62-year-old rider home," he said with a laugh. While the Hall of Famer is looking forward to his abbreviated return, he revealed yesterday that it will be his final comeback. "This is it," he said. "I have a good job, good customers, a great rider. That's good enough for me."

AFLEET ALEX RESUMES TRAINING Dr. Larry Bramlage gave trainer Tim Ritchey the go-ahead Thursday to pick up on the training schedule of GI Preakness S. and GI Belmont S. hero **Afleet Alex** (Northern Afleet), the *Daily Racing Form* reports. Partnered by regular exercise rider Salamon Diego, the bay galloped 1 1/2 miles over the Belmont main track Friday. Afleet Alex, sidelined July 26 with a condylar fracture, resumed jogging two weeks ago. "The X-rays looked fantastic," Ritchey told *DRF*. "We're not going to do anything to hurt him or hinder his career, but it's great that he can start to do more than just jog around the racetrack because he was getting pretty eager to do something." The sophomore colt's connections are still hoping that he will be ready to run in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 29. "The main thing is, I have to see how he is after he has galloped a week or so, then I will know whether I need to start putting some works into him or I need to start giving him longer gallops," explained Ritchey. As to how to get his colt ready for the big day, Ritchey added, "There's a lot of different ways to get to where we want to get to. The main thing is how much fitness he has maintained. I think he has maintained quite a bit, actually, because of the walking he has done. Two-and-a-half hours a day is a lot of walking." To take part in the Classic, Ritchey said he would have to give his charge a prep between Oct. 8-15.
