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INVASOR TURNS IN A DONN-DY PERFORMANCE

Turning for home in yesterday's GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park, jockey Fernando Jara was going to need a shoehorn, a crowbar, some WD-40 to extricate himself from a near hopeless position aboard Horse of the Year **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes). Stopped cold

with nowhere to go at the quarter pole, the duo still had a gap to bridge inside the final furlong. But, as champions do, Invasor overcame the trouble and overwhelmed the opposition, winning by two lengths. "I thought he was stopped [checked at quarter pole]," commented winning trainer Kiaran McLaughlin.

"He showed what a superior

horse he is. He finds a way to win every time."

Nobiz Like Shobiz (Albert the Great) made his much-anticipated sophomore debut in the GIII Holy Bull S., contested this year over a one-turn mile. The imposing bay colt, sent off the 7-10 chalk, disappointed no one in attendance, scoring by 1 1/2 lengths.

Adore the Gold (Formal Gold) also made a promising return to the races, taking the 6 1/2-furlong GII Swale S. in front-running fashion. A homebred for John Murphy Sr., the dark bay, already a stakes winner around two turns, is likely to get added distance for his yet-to-be named next trip to the races. **Cont. p3**

ARSON SQUAD BLAZES A TRAIL IN STRUB

Jay Em Ess Stable's **Arson Squad** (Brahms) fires in nearly all of his races and that proved true again yesterday, rallying beneath Garrett Gomez to take the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita. Winner of last year's GII Swaps BC S., the dark bay had posted three of his four previous wins at this track, including an Oct. 14 allowance. Eighth in the seven-furlong GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, he came into this off a rallying fourth to **Awesome Gem** (Awesome Again) in the GII San Fernando BC S. Jan. 13. Arson Squad was away nicely from the gate and was allowed to settle in fourth as longshot **Objective** (El Corredor) set the pace from Malibu runner-up **Spring At Last** (Silver Deputy). **Brother Derek** (Benchmark) chased three wide throughout and joined the top pair to their outside turning for home. But Gomez had Arson Squad in full flight by that time, steered him around the tiring Objective at midstretch and finished gamely at the rail for the victory. Winning trainer Bruce Headley reports that the winner is likely to face Lava Man and company in the \$1 million GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 3. Perfect in five Uruguyan starts and a Horse of the Year in that country, **Invasor** was fourth to Discreet Cat in the G2 UAE Derby, the lone blemish on his record to date. From there, he rattled off victories in the G1 Pimlico Special, the G1 Suburban H., the G1 Whitney H. and clinched his year-end honors with his mild upset of Bernardini in the G1 Breeders' Cup Classic at Churchill Downs Nov. 4. Allowed to drop back second last as Longshots **Barcola** (Old Trieste) and **Halos Sailing Sain** (Halo's Image) set a cracking pace up front, Invasor still found himself out the back of the camera frame at the half-mile pole, but commenced a rail rally on the turn. Full of run as it came down to crunch time, he checked hard and clipped heels with Barcola at the quarter pole. He was able to rally underneath that tiring pacesetter inside the final furlong and was going away late. "I was worried when Fernando [Jara] came up the inside, because when you're 1-5, everybody knows who you are, and nobody wants to open the door for you," McLaughlin continued. "Even though it was my brother-in-law's horse [Barcola, Mark Hennig], but it all worked out. It was scary, but he showed why he was Horse of the Year. I thought he would be off the pace today because on this speed-favoring track, the outside horses would gun for the front." And now it's on to a rematch with Discreet Cat in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup. "We'll leave for Dubai on March 15. It's going to be exciting."

Nobiz Like Shobiz got his career off to a rousing start, graduating by 10 3/4 lengths at first asking going a mile at Belmont Sept. 9. Troubled at the start of the GI Champagne S., the homebred rallied nicely up into the race and had his head in front at the stretch call, but was outfinished by Scat Daddy by 3/4 of a length. In his juvenile finale, he made a mockery of the GII Remsen S., winning that Nov. 25 event by 6 1/2 superior lengths. Sent up to attend a moderate pace in this comebacker, Nobiz Like Shobiz raced alongside his Champagne conqueror into the far turn, but put that one away leaving the three-eighths pole. He opened a daylight advantage at the furlong marker and held sway while never being asked for his very best. "It was exactly what I wanted. I wanted to get a good race in him without undue stress to win the race," explained winning trainer Barclay Tagg. "We'll see how he comes out of this race. After graduating by 10 3/4 lengths in a \$50,000 maiden claimer at Delaware Sept. 11, Adore the Gold transitioned to two turns and stakes company to take the Oct. 21 Dover S. by 2 1/2 lengths at that track. Returned on just two weeks' rest, the dark bay tired to fifth in the GIII Nashua S. over Aqueduct's one-turn mile Nov. 3, but atoned for that defeat with a popular four-length score in the seven-furlong H. Steward Mitchell S. at Laurel Dec. 2. Heads apart with Forefathers through a half in :44.69, Adore the Gold began to edge away from that one and was fully extended to prevail. "The trip was good," explained winning jockey Cornelio Velasquez. "The plan was to stay in behind, but he [Adore the Gold] wanted the lead today. He was going easily." While not specifying a race, trainer Michael Gorham indicated the winner's next start will come around two turns.

Giant Wrecker captured a pair of optional claimers over the summer, getting the job done by a half-length at Monmouth June 30 and driving home a three-length winner at Delaware Park a month later. The chestnut was sidelined after that effort, returning to be third in the Nov. 4 GIII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct. Tough to handle when restrained off the pace in the Jan. 6 Fort Lauderdale S. over this track, he ended up ninth, and his connections opted to change tactics and riders yesterday. Giant Wrecker and jockey Javier Castellano went right to the front, fought off a challenge from Jambalaya as they raced around the final turn and held on gamely as Host closed late to get the nod. Eclipse champion Miesque's Approval (Miesque's Son), making his first appearance since his GI Breeders' Cup Mile victory, was at the back of the pack early and was fanned wide into the stretch. He failed to make an impact down the lane, finishing fifth. "We had a decent enough pace to run at and he tried to finish, but he didn't have his usual kick," jockey Eddie Castro said.

Keyed Entry showed an affinity for the Gulfstream strip last year, posting a five-length allowance score and taking the GII Hutcheson S. in front-running fashion. Second by a neck in the GIII Gotham S. and third in the GI Wood Memorial, he found himself in the starting gate at Churchill Downs on the first Saturday in May, but his GI Kentucky Derby experience was far from enjoyable, as he stopped badly and finished last. The dark bay trailed the field home once again in the July 4 GII Dwyer S. and was given the rest

of the year off. Making his return here, Keyed Entry went right to the lead and was pressed through a half in :44.53, but opened up down the lane to win handily. "I would think that, as long as we don't screw it up, this horse has a future as a very good sprinter," co-owner Jack Wolf said.

The winner of the June 3 GII Nassau S. at Woodbine last spring, Naissance Royale returned to Canada to run third in the Oct. 22 GI E.P. Taylor S. The chestnut

ended 2006 with a second-place effort as the odds-on choice in the Dec. 18 GII Dahlia H. at Hollywood Park and opened 2007 with a runner-up finish at 3-5 in the Jan. 13 Marshua's River S. at Gulfstream. She shed the role of bridesmaid here to give her sire Giant's Causeway his second graded-stakes winner on the card. Breaking from the rail, the

five-year-old mare saved ground around the first turn. Jockey Edgar Prado settled her off solid early fractions and eased her off the rail to get her out of traffic on the final bend. J'ray closed to take the lead in the stretch, but Naissance Royale powered past her in the final strides to claim victory on the wire. "She's a beautiful filly," jockey Edgar Prado said. "You saw what she can do today. I think the post position helped her a lot. Last time she drew the outside and was fanned wide. She can run down any horse in the stretch. Ravel kicked off his career at Keeneland, running second in a seven-furlong maiden special weight test Oct. 22. The dark bay colt shipped west after that effort and stretched out to two turns for his second start at Hollywood Park Dec. 3. Even-money to get the mile and a sixteenth that afternoon, he sat close to the pace and went on to score by 3 1/2 lengths. The Tabor and Smith colorbearer was the 5-2 second choice to handle graded-stakes foes here. Allowed to settle just off the pace as favored Liquidity and outsider Song of Navarone took turns leading them around the track, Ravel was asked for his best when they straightened for home. The three-year-old had to fight his way past Liquidity, but gained control in the waning yards and edged clear. "I was actually kind of pleased he was able to sit behind horses--he got a good education today," said trainer Mike McCarthy. "Into the first turn I thought he might have been a little aggressive. I saw [jockey Garrett Gomez] pull back into the saddle once. I got a little worried that he might get a little headstrong. Up the back side he was great, tucked in behind horses, sitting very comfortable, always full of run. He was able to swing out. It was good." Gomez added, "From the first time I sat on him and rode him in his maiden win, I had high hopes for him." AQUEDUCT CANCELS AFTER SPILL Officials at Aqueduct Race Track canceled Saturday's live racing program following a spill in the fifth race involving jockeys Eddie Martin Jr. and Norberto Arroyo Jr. It was the second spill in the last three days at the New York oval. The incident occurred when Arroyo's mount, Cadillac Cruiser, took a bad step coming off the clubhouse turn and fractured his right fore before stumbling and falling. Arroyo was taken to Jamaica Hospital to be treated for a bruised eye and injured left shoulder. Martin, who was also involved in the Thursday incident which has sidelined fellow jockeys Jose Santos and Ramon Dominguez, escaped uninjured. Santos will remain out of action indefinitely. "He broke his breastbone, which is why he had so much trouble breathing," said his wife, Rita. "He broke the T-7 and T-8 vertebrae and pieces of the T-7 are pressing against the spinal cord. He is being fitted for a brace and there is no way to tell how long he will be in it." Dominguez is resting at his home in Maryland and will be out at least two weeks. NYRA also cancelled Sunday's card.

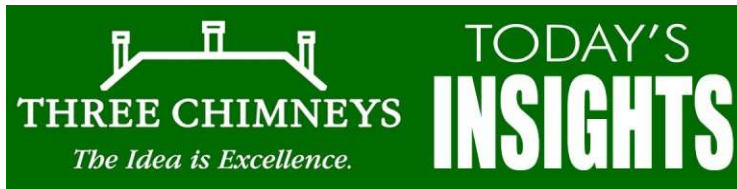

Two Winners in an Hour for Sweet Sixteen:

The eight-year-old broodmare **Sweet Sixteen** (Montbrook--Miss Insync, by Miswaki), owned by Miller Thoroughbred Farm LLC, had two winners in just 64 minutes Friday night.
