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HARD SPUN TAKES ON EIGHT IN SOUTHWEST

Heading down the Kentucky Derby path taken by Smarty Jones three years ago, Fox Hill Farm's **Hard Spun** (Danzig) will try to keep his record unblemished when he goes off favored in today's \$250,000 Southwest S. at Oaklawn Park. A Pennsylvania-bred like 'Smarty,' Hard Spun has yet to be tested in four career wins, including his latest in the GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds Jan. 13, his first effort around two turns. The Larry Jones trainee aired by 6 1/2 lengths that day in a facile wire-to-wire victory. While Hard Spun has been up on the pace in all four of his starts, Jones said he has been teaching the son of Danzig to relax behind horses

in his recent works. "He's ready to do whatever," Jones told *Daily Racing Form*. "We're set to go to the front. If they don't want it, we'll take it. And if somebody else wants it, we're set to, hopefully, just do whatever we need to do. I think he's a professional racehorse now, and we're ready to step it up." Two horses making their stakes debuts could factor into the equation. **Our Sacred Honor** (Honour and Glory), who is trained by Todd Pletcher, is two-for-three and comes off a Jan. 13 Gulfstream allowance victory. **Forty Grams** (Distorted Humor) also exits an allowance win, having earned a 90 Beyer in a smart 13-length winning effort at Fair Grounds Jan. 29.

TONY DUTROW A 'SILVER' SUBSTITUTE

Trainer Anthony Dutrow saddled his brother Richard's Oprah Winney to victory in Saturday's GII Barbara Fritchie Breeders' Cup H. Today, he goes for the week-end graded-stakes double at Laurel with **Silver Wagon** (Wagon Limit) in the GII General George Breeders' Cup H. Anthony Dutrow has been named the trainer of record for both horses as Richard Dutrow Jr. serves a 14-day suspension. Silver Wagon, a Grade I winner, boasts a distinct class edge in the \$300,000, seven-furlong General George. The gray

earned an 111 Beyer winning the GIII Sport Page Breeders' Cup H. last November and, in his most recent, was a good third when stretched out to nine furlongs in the \$1-million Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Jan. 27. He scales back to seven furlongs here, the same distance as the Sport Page. Holding the home-field advantage is **Ah Day** (Malibu Moon), a winner of seven of 12 over this strip. The bay earned triple-figure Beyer in a pair of minor stakes victories at Laurel last October and received a 110 Beyer when rallying to win the Fire Plug S. Jan. 20. **Will He Shine** (Silver Deputy), a lightly raced five-year-old brother to the swift Cuvee, could figure if he makes an uncontested lead.

Sunrise Bacchus, a five-time winner in 2005, was unable to reach the finish line first in five tries last season, but got back on track in this prestigious event. The dark bay ended his 2006 campaign with a fifth-place finish in the Nov. 25 Japan Cup Dirt, and opened the new year with a second in the Jan. 21 Heian S. at Kyoto. Allowed to settle near the back of the back over the sloppy strip here, he angled outside for the stretch drive and finished well, taking over inside the eighth pole and edging clear. Seeking the Dia (Storm Cat), the 7-2 favorite, couldn't mount a late rally and finished a lackluster ninth.

The British-bred **Attima** took an immediate liking to America's firm turf courses last year, winning her first two U.S. efforts, including the GII Honeymoon Breeders' Cup H. last June, before later adding the GII San Clemente H. Trained by Julio Canani, the now-four-year-old won her seasonal debut, annexing the Wishing Well H. over this course Jan. 28. The bay used to be a confirmed front-runner, but has learned to relax with

experience. Victor Espinoza will ride Attima for the seventh time on Monday's holiday program. "She was a little difficult to ride in the beginning," he admitted. "But each race, she's adjusted and become more professional. Now, she's easy to ride. One mile should be no problem for her." Attima goes in search of her third graded win against a tough, experienced field that includes **Mea Domina**, the six-year-old mare who has won all four of her starts on the Santa Anita sod. The heroine of the 2005 GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. and a wire-to-wire winner of last year's GII Palomar Breeders' Cup H., Mea Domina was beaten just 3/4 lengths by Price Tag (GB) in Hollywood's GI Matriarch S. last November. Freshened off that one, she should be sufficiently tightened for the Buena Vista with five six-furlong works over the past month. She'll need an honest pace to run at, but if she gets one the four-year-old **Grand Melody** rates a strong chance. She just got up to win the 1 1/16-mile GII Dahlia H. at Hollywood Dec. 18, but could do no better than fourth in the GII San Gorgonio H. at Santa Anita Jan. 7. Her regular jockey Julien Leparoux will be in the irons. Gary and Wendy Broad's **Barbatim** was scratched from the race.

INVASOR, STREET SENSE ON WORKTAB The reigning Horse of the Year **Invasor (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) worked an easy four furlongs at Palm Meadows yesterday, while the champion two-year-old colt **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) put up a more serious five-furlong drill at the track as he prepares for his sophomore debut.

Shadwell's Invasor, who overcame trouble to capture the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Feb. 3, stopped the clock in :51 4/5 and is scheduled to make his next start in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup. Street Sense breezed a strong five panels in 1:00 4/5 (2/18). Trainer Carl Nafzger continues to mull over his options for the colt's return, with the Mar. 3 GII Hutcheson S. still a possibility. Working at Gulfstream was **Einstein (Brz)** (Spend a Buck). The turf specialist breezed a bullet five panels in 1:00 (1/25) on the main track in advance of an expected tilt in next Saturday's GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Turf.

"I had a phone call from Australia at the weekend to congratulate me on selling Cambridge Stud to an Australian operation and I knew that it was time to put the record straight," Hogan concluded. Cambridge Stud was the leading vendor, by aggregate, for the 26th consecutive time at the Bloodstock Yearling Sales at Karaka two weeks ago. It is home to champion sire Zabeel (NZ), as well as the stallions Stravinsky (Ire), Keeper (Aus), Viking Ruler (NZ) and One Cool Cat.
