JAMBALAYA PROVES MORE THAN CAPABLE

In two previous tries at the top level, Kingfield Racing Stable Ltd.'s **Jambalaya** (Langfuhr) found the sledding a bit too tough, finishing seventh and ninth, respectively, in last two renewals of the Canadian International S. at his Woodbine base. That all changed yesterday, as the

Ontario-bred rallied five wide into the Gulfstream stretch and outfinished an unlucky **Honey Ryder** (Lasting Approval) for a neck victory in the G1 Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Turf S. "He's won some tight finishes and lost some," commented winning trainer Catherine Day Phillips. "He won at

Saratoga by a nose [the GIII Saranac S. in 2005] and that was a thrill, but this is probably the biggest for me. We'll taking him back to Ocala, but bring him back for the [GII] Pan American [H.] Mar. 31]." Cont. p2

DISCREET CAT RETURNS THURSDAY

Godolphin's unbeaten **Discreet Cat** (Forestry) will

return Thursday at Nad al Sheba in the one-mile G3 Burj Nahaar S., according to *Daily Racing Form*. "Discreet Cat has been training well and will go in the World Cup after his mile prep on Thursday," Godolphin Racing Manager Simon Crisford told *DRF*. The four-year-old has not raced since capturing the G1 Cigar Mile at Aqueduct Nov. 25. He won twice at Nad al Sheba last winter, including the G2 UAE Derby over Invasor (Arg), who subsequently became the U.S. Horse of the Year. They are on track to face one another in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 31.

HAYES QUINELLAS THE BLUE DIAMOND

Trainer David Hayes saddled five runners in Saturday's G1 Blue Diamond S. at Caulfield Racecourse and it was the talented homebred **Sleek Chassis (Aus)** (Flying Spur {Aus}) who came from just off the speed to take Melbourne's plum two-year-old prize from stable-

mate **Zizou (Aus)** (Fusaichi Pegasus). It was the second straight year that the conditioner saddled the first two home, having been represented by Nadeem (Aus) and Miss Finland (Aus) in 2006. Hayes said the winner and runner-up would both progress toward the G1 Golden Slipper S. at Rosehill Mar. 31. "I think Sleek Chassis is absolutely the real deal, she has all the tricks," Hayes said of his fourth Blue Diamond winner. "She is just terrific.

They ran a very fast time and she was powerful at the end. I love the way she was dominating the race coming into the straight. Both Sleek Chassis and Zizou are ideal Slipper horses, they are very strong at the end of their races." Sleek Chassis was a last-out winner of the Listed Talindert S. at Moonee Valley Feb. 3, a race won last season by subsequent Golden Slipper victor Miss Finland (Aus). **Blue Diamond chart p3**

Winner of the 2005 Breeders' S. in Canada, **Jambalaya** followed with a nose success in the GIII Saranac S. at Saratoga before his Canadian International performance. Victorious in the Singpiel S. at Woodbine last June 25, he was third in both the GII Northern Dancer S. July 23 and the GII Nijinsky S. Aug. 27. Runner-up to Better Talk Now in the GII Sky Classic S. Sept. 24, he was ninth in the Canadian International Oct. 22. The \$2,500 KEESEP yearling returned to be a good third in the GIII Canadian Turf H. Feb. 3 and was getting the requisite added ground yesterday. Glued to the rail throughout, Jambalaya was patiently handled and was steered out five deep for the stretch run.

Honey Ryder followed the eventual winner most of the journey. Crying out for room as they raced into the lane, she punched through two off the rail, but was outfinished for the win.

J'ray finally landed her first graded stakes after near misses in her three previous trips to the post. Third in the Apr. 23 Appalachian S. at Keeneland, the New York-bred got a six-month break and came back to finish a wide sixth in the GIII Valley View S. rained off the Keeneland turf Oct. 20. She regrouped to be second by a neck in the Nov. 18 GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs and followed that with a runner-up effort in the Dec. 30 Frances A. Genter S. at Calder, where she missed by a head. The chestnut made her most recent appearance in the GIII Suwannee River H. at Gulfstream Feb. 3 and took the lead past the eighth pole, only to be caught late. Three wide around the first turn, J'ray settled in centerfield for the run up the backstretch. Asked to take closer order at the top of the turn, she took command at will and drew off with complete authority.

A stakes winner and third to champion Sweet Catomine at two, Hello Lucky was purchased privately by current connections and won her first start for them, the Lakeway S. at Retama Park in August 2005. The runner-up in allowance events sprinting on the turf at Hollywood Park July 3 and on the main track at Del Mar July 20 and Aug. 16, the bay was a good third in the CERF H. at the Seaside Sept. 6. A non-threatening seventh in the GIII Sen. Ken Maddy H. on the hillside turf course Sept. 27, she'd made just one start since, a seventh-place effort in the grassy Jan. 28 Wishing Well H. Returning to the main track off that tightener, Hello Lucky was among a crush of horses vying for the early lead before dropping back a bit on the turn. She came four wide into the stretch, took aim on favored Selvatica passing the eighth pole and wore that one down for the victory.

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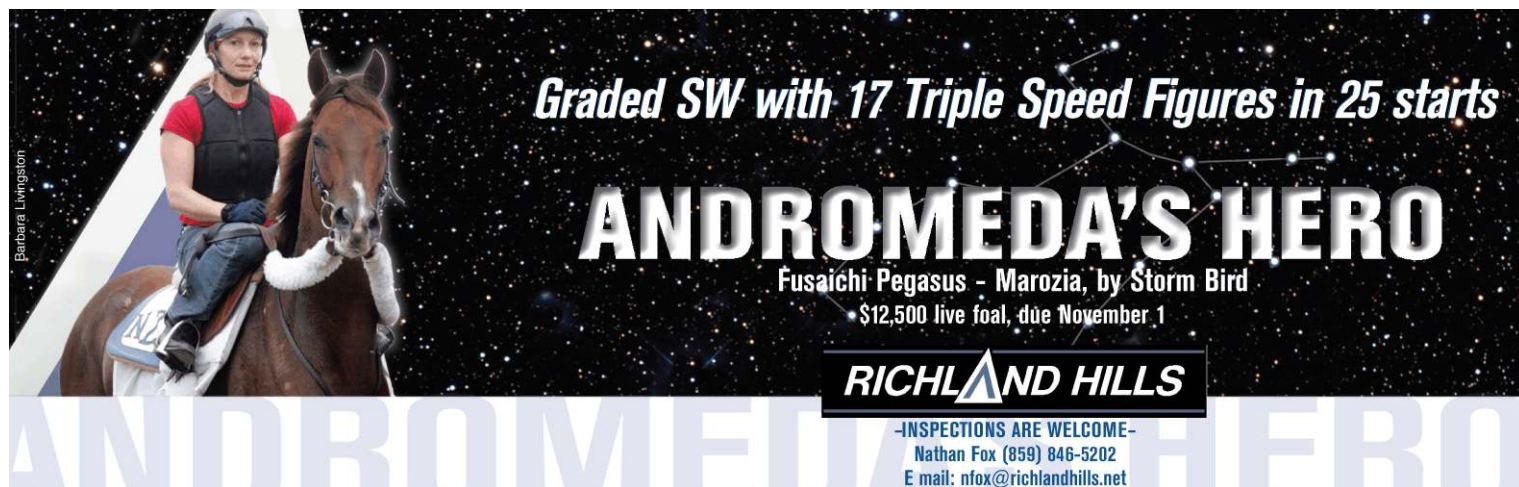

Darwin trainer Shane Clarke was somewhat stunned when Undue came from third last into the straight and sprinted impressively to notch a narrow win from Poet's Voice with favored Magnus in third. Making his first appearance since finishing second to Magnus in the G2 Age Classic last November at Flemington, the consistent gelding added a second Group 1 to his resume. "We drew very wide--right out on Dandenong Road--and I was a bit worried about the horse, but Daniel assured me everything was fine," Clarke said. Undue will press on toward the A\$1-million G1 Newmarket H. over 1200 meters Mar. 10, a race he finished 10th in last term. Jockey Steven Arnold said, "He is a great little horse. I rode him a few months ago at Flemington and thought he was a good little horse and he proved that today winning a Group 1 as topweight. I followed Shadowways (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) from the 600-meter mark, and he gave me a good drag into the race. I knew if I held him up he had a powerful sprint."

SOARING BY HEADED TO LOUISIANA DERBY

Dogwood Stable's promising three-year-old **Soaring By** (Deputy Minister) is likely to make his next start in the Mar. 10 GII Louisiana Derby. A \$200,000 KEESEP

yearling, the dark bay debuted a five-length maiden winner at Belmont in July. He was sidelined after the victory, returning with a second behind the promising Spinmaster in a Gulfstream allowance test Feb. 3. "Right now, we are planning to come," Dogwood President Cot Campbell

said. Campbell added that GIII Schuylerville S. winner **Cotton Blossom** (Broken Vow) could make her seasonal bow in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks on the Louisiana Derby undercard. "That filly has not had a race yet this year, so we're not sure about her. If she works to our satisfaction and comes for the Fair Grounds Oaks, we hope to have [John] Velazquez ride her." Velazquez was aboard the filly in four of five starts last year, including a second-place finish in the GI Spinaway S. and a third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. He will not, however, be available to pilot Soaring By, as he is committed to **Circular Quay** (Thunder Gulch) for the Louisiana Derby. "We are trying to get Garrett Gomez or Edgar Prado," Campbell said.

WAITING TO EXHALE The promising three-year-old **Exhale** (Millennium Wind) has been sidelined with a bone spur in his left knee, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The injury was discovered after the \$800,000 FTFEB juvenile breezed last Sunday at Santa Anita. He is expected to have surgery and will be out of training for 90 days. "He's not the sort that needs to be pushed for the Derby," trainer John Sadler told *DRF*. "I think he'll be a nice older horse." The CRK Stable colorbearer broke his maiden impressively in his second start Jan. 15 at Santa Anita ([video](#)).

HORSE GREELEY BACK ON THE SCENE Graded-stakes winner **Horse Greeley** (Mr. Greeley) has returned to trainer Richard Mandella's barn at Hollywood Park, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The chestnut was a sharp winner of the GII Del Mar Futurity, but ran seventh as the favorite in the GII Norfolk Breeders' Cup S. Oct. 8 at Oak Tree. A chip in his ankle was detected afterwards, and the colt underwent surgery to remove the chip. "He won't run for six to eight weeks," Mandella told *DRF*.

MORE BAD NEWS FOR INJURED SANTOS; DOMINGUEZ RETURNING

Eclipse Award-winning jockey Jose Santos, injured in a racing accident at Aqueduct Feb. 1, has been diagnosed with further fractures to the spine than initially detected by physicians. According to Kelly Wietsma, the jockey's public relations manager, Santos received compression fractures to the T-5, T-6, T-7, T-8, and T-9 vertebrae in addition to his fractured sternum, with the fractures to T-7 vertebrae being the worst. Initial swelling prevented doctors from detecting the injuries, which will keep Santos sidelined for an undetermined amount of time. "He's going to take it month by month, go back and see the doctor every couple weeks, and see how it goes," Wietsma said. "He's in Florida with his family, resting comfortably." Jockey Ramon Dominguez, who has not ridden since being involved in the same spill more than three weeks ago, received medical clearance to return to racing after doctors reviewed an MRI

of his injured right knee Friday morning. According to the jockey's agent, Steve Rushing, Dominguez suffered bruising to the bone which has healed in the past three weeks. He will begin exercising horses Saturday and is expected to be accepting mounts at Aqueduct by Wednesday. At the time of the spill, Dominguez had a 13-win lead over Eibar Coa as the leading rider for the current Aqueduct meet. Coa has since passed Dominguez, with 40 wins to Dominguez's 36 as of Friday.
