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BIG A BACK IN BUSINESS

The marquee match-up may have changed at the last minute, but that hasn't made today's GI Wood Memorial

S. at Aqueduct any less appealing. Elizabeth Valando's homebred **Nobiz Like Shobiz** (Albert the Great) had the Belmont grandstand buzzing following a 10 3/4-length maiden victory last September and followed with a second-place finish behind Scat Daddy as the 7-5 favorite in the Oct. 14 GI Champagne S. His two-turn debut was nothing

short of spectacular in the GII Remsen S. over this track Nov. 25, which he won by 6 1/2 lengths, but things haven't gone as smoothly for the Barclay Tagg-trained colt this term. He gutted out a 1 1/2-length victory in the GIII Holy Bull S. in his sophomore debut Feb. 3, then placed third in the GII Fountain of Youth S. Mar. 3. The bay has raced greenly at times throughout his career and Tagg has added blinkers for this contest. "He's got plenty of talent, but he's still a little immature," Tagg said. "Hopefully, the blinkers will help. He's never done anything wrong in the mornings, so it's hard to say what impact the blinkers have had on him in his training."

Any Given Saturday (Distorted Humor) takes the place of GII Louisiana Derby winner Circular Quay for trainer Todd Pletcher. The \$1.1-million

KEESEP graduate began his career with two straight wins, including an eye-catching Keeneland allowance around two turns last October. The dark bay closed out the year with a bang-up second-place finish behind highly regarded Tiz Wonderful in the GII Kentucky Jockey Club S. Nov. 25. The WinStar/Padua colorbearer handled his business in his sophomore bow at Tampa, posting a 2 3/4-length tally in the Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 17 and was most recently a nose behind two-year-old champion Street Sense in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby Mar. 17. "Both his races at Tampa were very strong," said jockey John Velazquez. "He's really come around the right way. If I rode him better in the Tampa Bay Derby, I think he could have won. If he can run back to his Tampa races Saturday, he will be very tough. I'm very excited to ride him."

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PLETCHER'S KIND OF TOWN

Trainer Todd Pletcher took the 2001 renewal of the GII Illinois Derby with Distilled and struck again three years later with Pollard's Vision. Simple mathematics suggest the champion conditioner is in line for another this year in the form of WinStar Farm and Gulf Coast Farms' **Cowtown Cat** (Distorted Humor). The \$1.5-million Barretts two-year-old purchase was a popular winner of a Gulfstream allowance Jan. 14, but faltered as the favorite in the GII Swale S. Feb. 3 and finished

third to Adore the Gold. He proved he could negotiate two turns in his most recent outing, parlaying a rail trip into victory in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct. Dubai World Cup-winning jockey Fernando Jara has the call. **Cobalt Blue** (Golden Missile) could punch Merv Griffin's ticket to the Derby. The television personality was thwarted when Stevie Wonderboy was forced to miss last year's Triple Crown series, but the chestnut colt, coming off a front-running victory in the GII San Felipe S. Mar. 17, could make 2006 a distant memory.

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PLETCHER VS. O'NEILL IN SAX DERBY

Trainers Todd Pletcher and Doug O'Neill are loaded with talented sophomores this season and the two conditioners figure to clash in today's GI Santa Anita Derby. Team Valor purchased **King of the Roxy** (Littleexpectations) privately following a Hollywood maiden win last July and he finished second in the GII Saratoga Special Breeders' Cup S. Aug. 17 when making his first start for Barry Irwin's operation and Pletcher. King of the Roxy notched Belmont's GII Futurity S. Sept. 23, then finished a disappointing eighth in his two-turn debut in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 4. He kicked off his three-year-old campaign with a victory in Gulfstream's GII Hutcheson S. Mar. 3, and stretches out in distance again for today's contest. Team Pletcher will also be represented by **Sam P.** (Cat Thief), who enters off a second-place finish behind Great Hunter in the GII Bob Lewis S. Mar. 3. O'Neill sends J. Paul Reddam's **Liquid-ity** (Tiznow). The bay won his debut over this course last September, then finished ninth behind Scat Daddy and Nobiz Like Shobiz in the GI Champagne S. Oct. 14. He closed out the year with a pair of strong efforts at Hollywood--a third-place finish in the Nov. 4 Real Quiet S. and a second-place finish in the GI Hollywood Futurity S. Dec. 16. The \$240,000 Barretts March graduate completed the exacta in the GIII Sham S. Feb. 3, but failed to repeat that effort in the Mar. 10 GII Louisiana Derby, finishing sixth behind Circular Quay.

Take Two

Recent Aqueduct allowance winner Reptilian Smarts will be a decided longshot against Nobiz Like Shobiz and Any Given Saturday when the gates are sprung for today's Grade I Wood Memorial S. at the Big A. But risk-taking of the equine and business variety are the forte of owner Christopher J. Hall.

Hall, 48, began his professional career as a bond trader on Wall Street, eventually transitioning into the practice of purchasing distressed debt. He is the majority shareholder in the financial company Call Now, which counts among its holdings Retama Park near San Antonio, Texas. Thus was born Chris Hall, the horse owner and lover.

"It's a game that really grows on you," Hall commented. "I really enjoy the cerebral aspect of it. It's not like you sit there and pull a handle and hope for the best."

Hall has amassed a stable of between 25 and 30 horses and is represented at the sales by agent Thomas Sollitto. Along with trainer Tim Ritvo, the team went searching for horses with "hidden value" at the 2006 OBS March Sale.

"Even though it was the first crop for Include, we liked him and thought he was going to have some potential as a sire," Hall explained. "We consider it a challenge to find attributes in horses that others might not discover. We tend to focus either on horses by sires which are out of favor or ones that are unknown. Those are the ones that are of interest to us." He added, "We are definitely happiest with the two-year-old market. We do our homework, listen to one another and go with the consensus."

Sollitto signed the ticket for just \$30,000 on the Include colt and Hall revealed how he came to name the bay.

"You know, a long time ago, a guy told me that I wasn't smart, but that I had reptilian smarts, i.e. that I was something of a snake," he said with a chuckle.

While Reptilian Smarts represents Hall's best horse to date, he had a half-interest in a filly named Reforest, who broke her maiden by over 11 lengths before being sold for \$750,000.

The Wood will mark something of a homecoming for Hall, who was born and raised in Buffalo, New York, but spent 13 years in New York City and maintains a residence in Manhattan. Expect that joint to be jumping this weekend.

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Hollendorfer Tries to Grab the Derby By Its Horns...

Northern California-based trainer Jerry Hollendorfer tests **Bwana Bull** (Holy Bull) for class here. The chestnut enters the Santa Anita Derby riding a three-race winning streak, including the California Derby at Golden Gate Jan. 28 and the GIII El Camino Real Derby at Bay Meadows last out Mar. 10. "We always thought he'd run better when he stretched out," Hollendorfer told *Daily Racing Form*. "I would guess he would like more distance." Jockey Russell Baze has the call on the \$140,000 Keeneland September graduate.

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Which Summer Doldrums Will Show Up?...

Summer Doldrums concluded his juvenile campaign with a well-beaten seventh behind Nobiz Like Shobiz in the Remsen, but has turned things around this term. The dark bay rolled by 8 1/2 lengths in a \$100,000 optional claimer over the inner track Jan. 12, then dominated five rivals by 5 1/4 lengths in the Feb. 10 Whirlaway S. He failed to repeat that effort as the even-money favorite in the Mar. 10 GIII Gotham S., finishing third, beaten 2 1/2 lengths by

Cowtown Cat, but has trained well since that defeat. The Klaravich colorbearer fired a five-furlong bullet in :59 4/5 over the inner surface Mar. 30. "He obviously regressed in the Gotham, but still only got beat 2 1/2 lengths by a nice horse," said trainer Rick Violette said. "If he can move back to the level he showed in the Whirlaway, he's a serious horse."

Shug Shows Up After All...

Trainer Shug McGaughey won the 1989 Wood with Easy Goer and the 1998 edition with Coronado's Quest and will saddle **Sightseeing** in today's running. The Phipps colorbearer was second best behind Day Pass in the Nov. 3 GIII Nashua S., but failed to make an impact in the Remsen, finishing a well-beaten fifth. Sightseeing has made two starts against Gulfstream allowance company this season--a second-place finish Feb. 11 and a third-place finish behind subsequent GI Florida Derby third-place finisher Chelokee Mar. 3. "He had a bad post in his last race and was wide the whole way," McGaughey said. "Getting off a track where you have to go to keep in the race should help him. Aqueduct is a better track to let him get away from there and relax." McGaughey had originally planned on skipping the Wood, but had a change of heart following the defection of Circular Quay.

GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up **Octave** will have to break her streak of second-place finishes to add this to her victory in the 2006 GII Adirondack BC S. Off for four months after the Breeders' Cup, the gray opened her sophomore campaign in the Mar. 10 GII Fair Grounds Oaks and, after veering at the break, put in her third straight place performance. "Ideally we would have liked to have gotten three races into her before the [May 4 GI Kentucky Oaks], but she missed a week or 10 days early in the year with a fever, so here we are," co-owner Jack Wolf told *Daily Racing Form*.

Mistical Plan wired the field in the 1 1/16-mile FG Oaks, but came from out of the clouds to take the six-furlong Sunshine Millions Oaks at Santa Anita Jan. 27. "Our filly ran out of this world at the Fair Grounds," trainer Doug O'Neill told *DRF*. "But she's got to do it again [today], and I'm a little worried about whether or not her speed will hold. The big thing is she's coming up to this in great shape, so we're going in with confidence." The Cal-bred bay has raced over six different tracks in her eight-race career, including an eighth-place finish over Cushion Track in the Dec. 17 GI Hollywood Starlet, but tries Keeneland's Polytrack for the first time.

Silver Knockers followed a four-length allowance score at Gulfstream Feb. 8 with a second in the GII Forward Gal S. at that track Mar. 10. She tries two turns for the first time. **High Again** comes into this off a 1 1/2-length victory over GII Davona Dale S. victress **Christmas Kid** in the Mar. 10 GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream.

board in her next two, but finished up 2006 with a pair of victories, including the GII Falls City H. in her seasonal finale Nov. 23 at Churchill. The Florida-bred began 2007 in California with a pair of runner-up efforts, the GI Santa Maria H. Feb. 10 and the GI Santa Margarita H. a month later. She certainly has her work cut out for her here, especially if

Round Pond resumes her love affair with Oaklawn. The bay has five wins in six starts over this strip, including the 2005 GII Fantasy S. and last year's GIII Azeri Breeders' Cup H. While she finished up 2006 with a surprise victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, this season didn't start as well, when she ran fourth at 2-5 in the GII Rampart H. Mar. 11 at Gulfstream. Trainer Michael Matz said that the five-year-old tied up in the days before that opener. "We thought about scratching her up to race time," Matz said, "but we took a chance and ran her. It proved to be a mistake. She is doing fine now, and we're looking for a big race from her. We all know she certainly loves Oaklawn Park." Also entered are the swift pair of **Take D'Tour** and **India**, who could set it up for their rivals if neither refuses to relinquish the early lead.

Only six will be in the starting gate with the defection of **Kazoo**--who finished a game third in an optional claimer at the Big A Thursday--but you can't ask for a much better field.

Juddmonte Farms' **Latent Heat** closed out his sophomore campaign with an impressive victory in Santa Anita's GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, then resurfaced with a hard-fought neck victory over Proud Tower Too in a thrilling renewal of the GII San Carlos H. last time Feb. 17. **Keyed Entry**, third as the 4-5 favorite in last year's GI Wood Memorial S., started his four-year-old season with a razor-sharp tally in Gulfstream's GIII Deputy Minister H. Feb. 3. He lost his two previous starts by a combined margin of 75 1/2 lengths, including a 20th-place finish in the GI Kentucky Derby. "I thought his comeback race was excellent," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "We tried him over in the Wood Memorial last year and he ran well. I thought the distance was just a little too far for him. Now, we're going to concentrate on a sprint and middle-distance campaign. I think he's found his niche." Another one who has found his calling going one turn on the main track is **Diabolical**. A distant eighth in last year's GI Preakness S., Diabolical posted a 111 Beyer Speed Figure when turned back in distance for Philly Park's Oct. 7 Gallant Bob H. and followed that victory with a game second behind subsequent sprint champ Thor's Echo in the Nov. 25 GI De Francis Memorial Dash Nov. 25. The chestnut finished third last time in the GII Richter Scale Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 3.

Lawyer Ron returns to Oaklawn, where he swept last spring's series, the Southwest S., GIII Rebel S. and GII Arkansas Derby, for three-year-olds while under the care of Bob Holthus. Things didn't go as smoothly for the flashy chestnut in the year's biggest races—he was far behind in both the GI Kentucky Derby and the GI Breeders' Cup Classic—but he began 2007 with a sharp allowance tally for trainer Todd Pletcher at Gulfstream Feb. 11, and doesn't meet any worldbeaters here. Ten years ago, trainer Richard Mandella brought a versatile Wertheimer homebred, Atticus, to take the Oaklawn H. when it was still a Grade I event. This year, the Hall of Famer will saddle the lightly raced **Boboman**, a six-year-old with just 12 lifetime starts. Winner of the GI Hollywood Turf Cup Dec. 9, the bay apparently entrapped when eighth in the GII San Marcos Jan. 21, but returned to make his dirt debut in the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 3. He rallied to claim third to Lava Man in that \$1-million contest. "We always thought of Boboman as a grass horse," Mandella said, "but he showed in the Santa Anita H. that he could handle dirt as well."

Reporting for Duty is an interesting longshot from the barn of Steve Asmussen. He came flying late to finish second to Ketchikan in a Feb. 16 allowance at the Fair Grounds and the form of that race was franked when the winner returned to be runner-up in the GII Louisiana Derby.

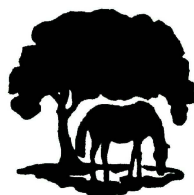

NTRA REPORT FROM *Capitol Hill*

Congress Moves Toward Immigration Reform

The Security Through Regularized Immigration and a Vibrant Economy Act of 2007 (STRIVE Act), introduced in the House on March 22 by Reps. Luis Gutierrez (D-IL) and Jeff Flake (R-AZ), creates

- A system for employers to electronically verify workers' employment authorization;
- A legal channel for future immigrant workers by establishing the H-2C visa, which is valid for three years and renewable for another three; and
- A program providing conditional nonimmigrant status for undocumented immigrants in the U.S. that is valid for six years.

STRIVE also gives qualified conditional non-immigrants an opportunity to apply for lawful permanent resident status (green card) and eventual citizenship, but requires undocumented immigrants seeking citizenship to exit the U.S. and re-enter legally in order to file for permanent residency.

The so-called "touchback" provision is unpopular with some large-scale labor groups. The Senate is expected to debate immigration in May.

Louisiana HBPA Says No to TVG Exclusive Deal:

The Louisiana Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association has decided not to consent to the sending of the signal from Evangeline Downs Racetrack & Casino to TVG under the current exclusive arrangement between the track and racing network. The decision, announced Apr. 5, was made on the belief the exclusion of the other competing account wagering companies is not in the best interest of Louisiana horsemen or the racing industry, the Louisiana HBPA said. Other companies would have access to the Evangeline Downs signal under a sub-licensing agreement, but horsemen said the deal isn't favorable. Evangeline Downs launched its 2007 Thoroughbred meet Apr. 4. The Louisiana HBPA board of directors unanimously authorized President Sean Alfortish, an attorney, to take all necessary action to withhold consent from any Louisiana track entering into exclusive agreements with TVG. The Louisiana HBPA said it's willing to consent to giving TVG the Evangeline Downs signal under "acceptable terms" of a non-exclusive agreement.
