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THE ROAD LESS TRAVELED

And they said it couldn't be done. Jim Tafel's **Street Sense** (Street Cry {Ire}) trampled 23 years of history into the long stretch at Churchill Downs as he charged to a 2 1/4-length victory in the GI Kentucky Derby yesterday afternoon, becoming the first GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero to wear the blanket of roses. Thirteen previous Juvenile winners had traveled the Derby trail, only to be thwarted on the first Saturday in May. But Street Sense, blessed by a near-perfect 10 furlongs, was destined to break the jinx. "We had an awesome trip," said jockey Calvin Borel, celebrating his first Derby score. "I knew I had my horse where I wanted him and he has a tremendous turn of foot. I felt like I was sitting on a bomb." **Cont. p2**

REBEL WITH A CAUSE

As expected, the swollen field for the G1 2000 Guineas split in two, but there were few who could doubt that the best horse came out on top as Phil Cunningham's **Cockney Rebel (Ire)** (Val Royal {Fr}) caused a 25-1 upset in the Newmarket Classic. Off the track since finishing third behind **Vital Equine (Ire)** (Danetime {Ire}) in the G2 Champagne S. at York in September, the bay, named after Steve Harley's 1970s band, produced a sustained burst under Olivier Peslier to inhale the majority of the field inside the final three furlongs. Flying the flag for veteran trainer Geoff Huffer, he came with a sweeping run that carried him past his York conqueror approaching the furlong marker and on to a 1 1/2-length success. "I didn't have a good trip and was last three furlongs out, but the horse was relaxed and when he quickened I thought I'd got there too soon," Peslier said. "He just kept going and won well." **Cont. p3-4**

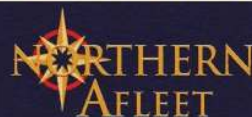
of :22.96, :46.26 and 1:11.13, the pair dropped back until they were nearly last entering the backstretch. They began to pick up horses one by one as the rail remained open in front of them, but, with a quarter mile left to run, their path was finally blocked. Making a split-second decision, Borel shifted Street Sense around **Sedgefield** (Smart Strike), finding the narrowest of openings to his outside, and set sail after Hard Spun. The frontrunner dug in as the champ came at him, but Street Sense was in front at the eighth pole and Borel kept him busy til they hit the wire. "I knew I had the ability [to win the Derby], it was just a matter of finding the right horse," the Louisiana native said. "We left there good and saved ground...once I got over to the rail, it was pretty smooth from there on. We only had the one horse to get around at the quarter pole, and it did get a little tight there, but this horse will do whatever you want him to." Added trainer Carl Nafzger, who captured the 1990 Derby with Unbridled, "When he made it through the gap and had one horse in front of him, I knew it was all up to Calvin. But this horse has taken us so many places, and he took us home again today." Was winning the roses as good the second time around? "Any time you win the Derby, you are having a ball," Nafzger said. Added owner/breeder Jim Tafel, "It's just overwhelming and I'm sure it will prove more so down the road."

Derby Notes...

Of the 13 previous BC Juvenile winners who made it to the gate on the first Saturday in May, only two hit the board--Chief's Crown ('85) and Timber Country ('95) were both third...Street Sense is the fourth consecutive homebred to wear the roses...The winner came out of post 7 for the eighth time in Derby history; posts 1 and 5 have produced the most winners, with an even dozen each...Street Sense was the first horse since Sunny's Halo in 1983 to win the Derby with only two prep races...He becomes the first juvenile champion to win the race since Spectacular Bid in 1979.

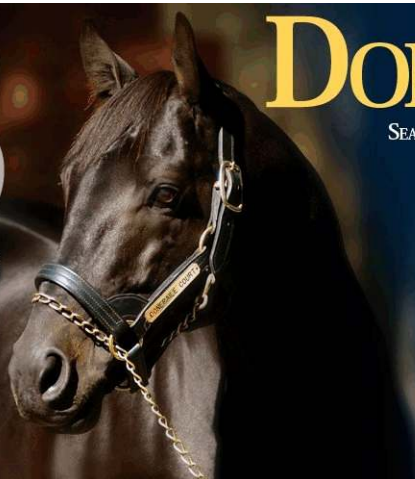

Cockney Rebel (Ire) was sold by Paul and Sara Thorman's Trickledown Stud at Doncaster's St Leger sale; Trickledown also consigned last year's 2000 Guineas hero George Washington (Ire).

Early Portents...

Cockney Rebel showed enough when winning over six furlongs on debut at the July Course to suggest he was above average, and trainer Geoff Huffer upped the ante by proclaiming him the best he had trained. The colt went some way towards validating that statement when he finished runner-up to subsequent G2 Mill Reef S. second Doctor Brown (GB) in the St Leger Yearling S. at York in August, and he was beaten just a half-length by Vital Equine in the Champagne before being wrapped up for the winter. Denied his intended prep in the G3 Craven S. due to a bad scope, he was drawn in no man's land in the middle of the track in this seasonal debut, and Olivier Peslier decided to cross to the stand's side without any cover. Cockney Rebel had most of his rivals still in front passing the halfway point, but he made up ground with impressive elan thereafter, and his momentum took him past his enterprisingly ridden arch rival in the final 300 yards and away up the hill to a convincing success. Dutch Art came out the best of the far-side group, completing the trifecta made up of Tatts foals and Doncaster yearlings. "It's a dream and I can't believe it," owner Phil Cunningham said. He added, "He's in the [June 2] G1 Epsom Derby and he didn't look like he was stopping there, but Geoff's preference is for the [one-mile] G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 19]." **Cont. p8**

Geoff Huffer, who started training in 1978 and was responsible for such talented performers as Persian Heights (GB), was elated. "He was eight pounds behind the best before the winter, but he's a few pounds in front of them now," Huffer commented. "We never did anything with him until January, and then just brought him on steadily and he showed all his old sparkle. I took him to Lingfield about 10 days ago and he worked with a good lead horse--in the last furlong and a half he took 25 lengths out of him without moving." Vital Equine's trainer Eoghan O'Neill was delighted with the runner-up, who will head to The Curragh for compensation in the May 26 G1 Irish 2000 Guineas. "[Jockey] Chris [Catlin] rode him according to plan, but he did say the ground just took the sting out of him a bit," he told *PA Sport*. Dutch Art's conditioner Peter Chapple-Hyam commented, "[Jockey] Jimmy [Fortune] said he would have won if he was drawn on the stands side. He got there, but had nothing to race with. He'll go to the St James's Palace now." Adagio (Grand Lodge) was sent off the 4-1 favorite, but could never get into contention and trailed in 12th. Jockey Kerrin McEvoy said, "He wasn't ideally out of the stalls, which meant I was further back than I wanted. Cockney Rebel is named after veteran pop star Steve Harley's band. Harley was on hand to greet the colt after his victory. "I've lived one life and just lived another one," he said. "This is the best thing to have happened to me. I've owned plenty of horses, but would never had had one bred like this so I was happy for them to use the name. I'm usually away on tour when he runs."

Within five lengths of the winner in his last 12 starts, the consistent Sky Conqueror captured the July 3 GII King Edward BC S. and July 23 GII Northern Dancer S. at his home track in Ontario last summer. He made it three in a row after a short break, taking an allowance test Oct. 8, and got up to be third in his final appearance of the year, the Oct. 22 GI Canadian International S. The Sorokolit homebred made his 2007 debut in the Apr. 13 GII Maker's Mark Mile, running fifth at 16-1, and needed every inch of the extra furlong to get the job done here. "We always have known he's a fantastic racehorse," trainer Darwin Banach said. "We're just very proud of him. He had some bad trips in the past and he pulled it out here. I just like to see him get to the outside and get a straight run for the wire and not have to be checked and steered and turned and everything else. That's what he did, and we got there in time." First under the wire in three of her first five starts while competing in Northern California, she ventured south for the GII Hollywood BC Oaks last June and romped by 7 1/2 lengths. The chestnut was out of the money in her next two, the July 15 GII Delaware Oaks and, after a seven-month layoff, the Feb. 24 GIII Las Flores H., but turned it around

to beat the boys in an optional claimer at Bay Meadows Apr. 5. The bettors were unconvinced she could carry that form into Grade I company, but she proved them wrong. Rated in third as Shaggy Mane (Bertrando) dashed off quick splits, Hystericalady went after the frontrunner as they came out of the bend and galloped away from the field to win impressively. Possessed of a pedigree which screams distance, Dream Rush has proved proficient at one-turn events. She decimated this field en route to a likely appearance in the one-mile June 9 GI Acorn S. on the Belmont S. undercard. The dark bay was a handy winner of her two juvenile outs, graduating at this venue Sept. 24 before taking a Churchill allowance Oct. 29. Put away following that one, she could not overcome a world of trouble in her seasonal debut at Gulfstream Jan. 20 and checked in second. She atoned for that defeat in her latest, leading past every pole for a 3 1/2-length score in the GIII Old Hat S. in Hallandale Feb. 10. Odds-on to continue her winning ways, Dream Rush was sent to the fore by Eibar Coa, got a breather on the turn, and streaked home the easiest of winners. "Eibar said she really relaxed," said trainer Rick Violette Jr. "She had her ears pricked and was really on cruise control. When she did that, we knew everyone behind her was in trouble." Molengao is getting better as he gets older. One-for-six last season, with his lone victory coming in a NW2X allowance at Santa Anita in January, the chestnut showed promise in his last two starts of the campaign, set nearly five months apart. Second in the July 16 GII Sunset BC H. going 1 1/2 miles on the lawn, he returned after the layoff to be third in the Dec. 10 GIII Native Diver H. at nine furlongs on the Hollywood Cushion Track. The Brazilian-bred moved forward off that effort, taking the Feb. 4 GII San Antonio H. on the Santa Anita main track before finishing 3/4 of a length adrift of Lava Man in the Mar. 3 GI Santa Anita H.

Rated in sixth early, Molengao was three wide on the final bend, but motored past the leaders at the top of the lane and galloped clear. "I think my main goal now is the Hollywood Gold Cup [GI, June 30]; he's proven that he runs well fresh," said trainer Paulo Lobo. Second in two prior tries over sloppy tracks, Saint Anddan once again showed his affinity for rain-soaked surfaces as he picked up his first graded score. The bay, unraced at two, broke his maiden over this track and trip during a three-race sophomore campaign and added an entry-level allowance score at Belmont Park in September in six outings last season. Fourth when stretched to two turns for his 2006 finale, an optional claimer at Fair Grounds Dec. 10, he rebounded when dropped back to six panels with a front-running success Jan. 6. His chances were compromised when he lunged at the break in an optional test in New Orleans Feb. 1 and he had to settle for second, but the five-year-old once again wired the field in his stakes debut, the Mar. 24 D. 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"QUEEN" TO UPSTAGE THE BEO SHOW

Today's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket revolves around Michael Ryan's **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley), who will start the hot favorite to bring some silverware back to Jim Bolger's Coolcullen base. While stable confidence remains high in last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and G2 Rockfel S. winner, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Yaqeen (GB)** (Green Desert) is just one of a handful of unexposed fillies ready to square up to the market leader. Despite having just a maiden success to her name, she has vital experience on this track, and looked in need of the extra panel when scoring over seven furlongs at the Craven meeting Apr. 19. "In a perfect world, she would have gone on and won a maiden last year before being tried in a better race, but unfortunately she had persistent trouble with an ankle, so we had to take it easy," Racing Manager Angus Gold explained. "[Trainer] Michael [Jarvis] feels she will definitely stay and that the mile will suit her, and she has a very good turn of foot. She is a filly with a lot of potential, but she has never run in a group race and we are putting her in at the deep end."

The One to Beat?

Few fillies will enter this race with as accomplished record as William Durkan's **Miss Beatrix (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who won the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at The Curragh in August before doubling up in the inaugural Goffs Million the following month. She had last week's G3 Sandown Classic Trial winner Regime (Ire) and Finsceal Beo behind her on that occasion, but needs to prove that her success there was not solely due to a widely perceived track bias. "She has more of a sprinting pedigree than a miler, and you would say, 'how can she get a mile?'," trainer Kevin Prendergast said. "However, she got seven on soft ground at The Curragh last year and did it well, so she has every chance of getting the trip. She's in good shape, and we hope she runs a big race."

All is not lost for those held at inflated odds at the moment, as six of the last seven winners traded at longer than 9-1. As in the colts' contest, Aidan O'Brien saddles a longshot in Evie Stockwell's **Theann (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who was a fast-finishing third behind Pat Garvey's **Arch Swing** (Arch) in the G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial Apr. 7. She needs to find improvement to secure Ballydoyle

a second renewal, following the exploits of Virginia Waters two years ago. "She ran well in her trial and is a filly who likes fast ground," O'Brien commented. "She was trapped in behind horses and came home well there." Mick Channon, who has yet to win a domestic Classic, relies on **Treat (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}) and **Sweet Lilly (GB)** (Tobougg {Ire}). The latter was fourth behind **Simply Perfect (GB)** (Danehill) in the G2 May Hill S. at York in September before beating the boys in the Listed Silver Tankard S. at Pontefract the next month. Owner Jaber Abdullah's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond believes Sweet Lilly has the requisite hardiness for this test. "She was slow to come in her coat this spring, but the recent sunshine has meant she has picked up a lot in her condition," he said. "She has been working quite well and is as tough as they come. She is a spirited filly and we are hoping for a decent performance." Nicholas Jones's homebred **Scarlet Runner (GB)** (Night Shift) will bid to provide John Dunlop with his fourth renewal, and to become the second consecutive winner of the G3 Nell Gwyn S. to complete the double after Speciosa (Ire) 12 months ago. Sheikh Hamdan's **Kaseema** (Storm Cat) was fourth in that Apr. 18 trial, and Angus Gold is hoping that the three-parts sister to Aragorn (Ire) will hold her own here. "She is a filly of enormous potential and it's just a question of whether this will come too quick for her," he said. "She definitely wants a mile and has a lovely long stride on her."

A question mark hangs over the participation of last year's G1 St Leger winner **Sixties Icon**, with connections keen to inspect the track condition before committing the four-year-old. Highly progressive in his first season racing in 2006, he followed a seventh in the G1 Epsom Derby with a third behind **Papal Bull** in the G2 King Edward VII S. at Royal Ascot in June. Looking a different proposition after a short break, he took the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood in August before running out one of the most impressive winners in the history of the oldest Classic at York in September. That colt failed to build on his Royal Ascot exploits when eighth under a penalty in York's G2 Great Voltigeur S. in August and fifth in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp the following month. Andre Fabre took this with Shirocco (Ger) 12 months ago and bids to double his tally with **Linda's Lad**, who has not been seen since finishing third in the G2 Prix Eugene Adam at Maisons-Laffitte last July.
