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FACING FINSCEAL

Today's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches revolves around whether Michael Ryan's **Finsceal Beo (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley) can repeat her G1 1000 Guineas heroics of a week ago, but the Queen of Coolcullen has failed to frighten potential challengers to her crown. Jeremy Nosedá was forced to pull Sir Robert Ogden's **Sander Camillo** (Dixie Union) from Sunday's Newmarket Classic because she was in season, but last year's G2 Cherry Hinton S. winner gets a shot at the title this afternoon. "Sander Camillo's preparations from the Nell Gwyn onwards have not been ideal, but her owner Sir Robert Ogden and I have decided to take our chance before we head on to the [June 22] G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot," her conditioner explained. **Cont. p3**

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ALL TO PLAY FOR IN THE POULAINS

Newmarket staged an open renewal of the G1 2000 Guineas last Saturday, and there is the same feel to Longchamp's equivalent today as 14 colts head to post for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains. Andre Fabre, who has plundered this Classic four times, has a sole representative in His Highness the Aga Khan's **Visionario (Fr)** (Spinning World), Bidding to go one better than his sire in 1996, he shaped with promise when third behind Chichi Creasy (Fr) and Cheveley Park Stud and Joseph Allen's **Battle Paint** (Tale of the Cat) in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over course and distance Apr. 15. That form received a boost when fourth-placed Lawman (Fr) ran out an impressive winner of Wednesday's G3 Prix de Guiche. The Aga Khan's Racing Manager Georges Rimaud is expecting Visionario to step up off that effort. "Everything is in good order. The horse has worked well and should have progressed substantially from his last run," he told *PA Sport*. **Cont. p2**

TIZZY AN EMERGING STAR

Slew's Tizzy (Tiznow) has been through peaks and valleys this season, falling in the GIII Risen Star S. in February before going on to win the GII Coolmore Lexington S. in his last start Apr. 21. Favored to remain on that high in yesterday's GIII Lone Star Derby, the Lacombe homebred raced in third in the sloppy conditions and came calling for the lead nearing the quarter pole. He dueled with pacesetter **Mr. Nightlinger** (Indian Charlie) in upper stretch, edged past that one and on to a 1 3/4-length victory. **Moyer's Pond** (Monarchos) flew home late to land second money.

The two favorites face a formidable overseas challenge, that includes Godolphin's **Dijeerr** (Danzig), who bids to provide the operation with a fourth renewal on his seasonal debut. "Dijeerr has been working well," commented Saeed bin Suroor of last year's G3 Horris Hill S. hero. "There are some good horses in this race and it will be tough. This is the horse's chance to prove himself and we will see whether he is capable at the Group 1 level."

Another foreign raider who commands respect is Jim Bolger's **Creachadoir (Ire)** (King's Best), who took the Apr. 7 G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial and May 7 G3 Tetrarch S. at The Curragh either side of a fine fourth under a penalty in the G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 22. He adds strength to a six-strong Irish challenge, made up of a quartet from Ballydoyle, responsible for last year's winner Aussie Rules. Heading the squad is **Excellent Art (GB)** (Pivotal {GB}), third in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville in August before taking the G2 Mill Reef S. at Newbury the next month.

Sander Camillo, second on her return under a penalty in the G3 Nell Gwyn S. at Newmarket Apr. 18, is joined by stable companion **Rahiyah** (Rahy), who signed off in 2006 with a three-length second to Finsceal Beo (Ire) in the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket in October. Jeremy Nosedo is hoping that his two-pronged challenge will make its mark. "Rahiyah has been trained specifically for the race and appears to be in good order," Nosedo said. "There is a slight question mark as to the trip, but the race will tell us more. The ground is on the fast side of good and we would need it to stay that way."

Rookie trainer Marco Botti is looking to Scuderia Rancati's G3 Prestige S. winner **Sesmen (GB)** (Inchinor {GB}) to provide a Classic thrill, but she needs to improve off her sixth in the G3 Fred Darling S. at Newbury Apr. 21. "She has come on a lot for that race and we are happy with her preparation," Botti told *PA Sport*. "She looks in good shape, so we will take a chance there. We're hoping there will be a good pace and she will run a good race, but it is a very competitive race and a tough task."

Corey Nakatani aboard Prospect Park tried to walk the dog and nearly succeeded, but it was the superior acceleration of On the Acorn which got the job done. Claimed for \$40,000 out of a fifth-place effort over this lawn last November, the dark bay was ninth for a \$50,000 tag Dec. 16 before things began to change. With blinkers off, he won optional claiming events--while entered for the claiming price--for \$40,000 at Santa Anita Jan. 13 and for \$62,500 Feb. 8, then finished third, but was placed second in the Feb. 25 GII San Luis Obispo H. in Arcadia. The gelding was given a bit of a breather thereafter, but did not miss a beat last time out, taking the GII San Juan Capistrano H. over 14 furlongs Apr. 22. Taken back second last as Prospect Park crawled along through six furlongs in 1:17.14, On the Acorn was full of run, but still fifth as the field rounded into the stretch. Sailors Sunset but proved his mettle over this track and distance last December, leading every step of the way to post a 13-1 upset in the GIII V.O. Underwood S. in a spritely 1:07 3/5. His front-running tactics served him less well in Santa Anita's GI Malibu S. Dec. 26, fading to a midpack sixth after leading through the opening half-mile. Returned to the Grand Canyon State for his 2007 debut, he stumbled at the break and could not recover, finishing second in the Feb. 24 Phoenix Gold Cup H. In his most recent appearance, he cut out the early fractions in the GII Portrero Grande Breeders' Cup H. Apr. 7, but gave way through the lane to be third to Smokey Stover. Sailors Sunset outfooted favored Peace Chant to the front and set the pace along the inside. He relinquished the advantage briefly at the furlong grounds, but fought back gamely for the win.

Valbenny ran her stateside record to three wins from four tries, stamping herself a leading domestic candidate for the GI American Oaks July 7. A maiden winner at the third time of asking July 25 at Ayr for trainer Alan Swinbank, the bargain-basement purchase got four months off and made her U.S. debut a winning one, taking this track's Nov. 25 GIII Miesque S. at odds of 9-1. She closed out her two-year-old campaign on an equally positive note, adding a one-length success in the Dec. 31 Blue Norther S. over the Santa Anita turf before getting a rest. The bay resurfaced in the Apr. 7 GIII Providencia S. in Arcadia, but things went amiss that day, as she was off slowly and failed to produce her textbook late rally to finish sixth to Super Freaky. Taken in hand for the run around the clubhouse turn, Valbenny commenced a middle move to draw within five lengths of the pacesetting Passified (GB) (Compton Place {GB}) and Seaside Affair (Sea of Secrets). Super Freaky got first run into the stretch and took a short-lived advantage, but Valbenny closed stoutly outside that one to win comfortably. Given a bit of a breather off that effort, the striking black colt was upset by Court Folly at 15 cents on the dollar in the GII Amsterdam S. at Saratoga July 31 and was put away off a fifth to Henny Hughes in the GI King's Bishop S. at the Spa Aug. 26. Donning Godolphin blue for the first time in this

seasonal debut, Songster won the break, then was joined to his outside by Anew (Awesome Again) and the duo scampered through an opening quarter in :21.77. The Florida-bred put the second choice away after a half in :44.19, opened up an unassailable advantage past the eighth pole and held sway late while being shown the whip. "It looks like he's come back in old form," said winning rider Edgar Prado, who has ridden Songster in each of his eight career starts. "I think he is coming back to the races great. He's just more mature. He used to be really crazy in the post parade; today he was very relaxed. Mentally he grew up a lot." Rick Mettee, assistant to trainer Saeed bin Suroor, indicated that the winner could make his next appearance in either the GII True North Breeders' Cup S. June 9 or the July 4 GII Tom Fool Breeders' Cup H.

Still a maiden entering this Derby prep, Aqaleem stamped his authority on the contest to emerge as a leading contender for the June 2 Epsom Classic. The bay colt, third on debut at Newbury in August, returned to that venue to post a second in a conditions event the following month, but his re-introduction was delayed by a virus that went around the Tregoning stable. Off at 12-1 in his belated return, he was forced to race wide without cover throughout the first half of this contest. The homebred was playing catch-up at the top of the straight, but, under tender handling made up the ground on the errant Kid Mambo to lead before the eighth pole. He asserted from there and stretched clear with distance as **Hearthstead Maison** chased in vain.

"We hadn't had a runner for two months until yesterday, but this horse has always shown tremendous potential and has always been nice," Tregoning commented. "He should have gone and picked up a maiden, but I voted for this, and Sheikh Hamdan is very sporting. [Aqaleem] carries very little condition, so it didn't take us long to get him ready and he won very well." The trainer added, "We'll wait before making a decision and I'll chat to [Racing Manager] Angus Gold and Sheikh Hamdan, as our job is to just point him in the right direction. He's got very good action and I don't think quicker ground will be any problem to him."

Aqaleem is a grandson of **Irish Valley**, who, after selling for \$300,000 at the 1988 Keeneland November Sale to Curragh Bloodstock Agency, made her way to Ireland. Her second foal for Shadwell was **Alhaarth (Ire)** (Unfuwain), a champion at two in 1995. Aqaleem is the fourth foal from his unraced dam, who sold for 87,000gns to Murayama Bloodstock at the 2005 Tattersalls December Sale.

The Jim Tafel runner is expected to work either Monday or Tuesday before boarding a plane bound for Baltimore Wednesday. **Curlin** (Smart Strike), who suffered his first career defeat when third in the Derby, galloped 1 1/2 miles for trainer Steve

Asmussen. The chestnut colt will breeze Monday morning at approximately 6:30 a.m. at Churchill Downs. He will also fly to Baltimore Wednesday.

Flying First Class Confirmed for Preakness...

Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas informed officials at Pimlico yesterday that **Flying First Class** (Perfect Mandate), impressive winner in his last start of the Derby Trial S. at Churchill Downs, will make his next appearance in Saturday's GI Preakness S. Mark Guidry, who was aboard for the Derby Trial score, will retain the mount. "We think he is coming up to the race in good order and he's been doing what we asked of him," said Lukas, who will be saddling his 32nd Preakness runner. He has hoisted the Woodlawn Vase five times. "I think he merits the chance. He's earned it." The conditioner also confirmed that **Starbase** (Tale of the Cat) has been removed from Preakness consideration. The GII Coolmore Lexington S. runner-up could make an appearance on the undercard in the Barbaro S.

Sanders Rules Out Teuflesberg...

Trainer and co-owner Jamie Sanders announced yesterday that **Teuflesberg** (Johannesburg) will not start in next Saturday's Preakness. "We need to do what is right for the horse," said Sanders. "He has given us everything leading up to this spot, including the Derby. It was a tough decision, but it is a long campaign and we have a lot of races in store for him." Teuflesberg, who upset **Hard Spun** (Danzig) in the Feb. 19 Southwest S., was a brief forward factor in the GI Kentucky Derby, but dropped out to be 17th, beaten 35 3/4 lengths.

Dominguez to Ride, Mount Yet to Be Determined...

Jockey Ramon Dominguez will have his sixth Preakness ride on Saturday, but just which horse he will pilot remains unknown. His agent Steve Rushing has informed Pimlico media relations staff that the 30-year-old has accepted the call to ride **Chelokee** (Cherokee Run), if trainer Michael Matz decides to enter the colt, most recently a troubled third in the GI Florida Derby. The decision hinges on a workout this morning at Matz's Fair Hill base. Dominguez will make the trip to the training facility for the move. Chelokee could also be entered for the Barbaro, and Dominguez has the call in that race. The rider has given a second call to trainer Mark Shuman, who will saddle **Xchanger** (Exchange Rate) in the Preakness. Last year's GIII Sapling S. winner, who comes off a victory in the Apr. 21 Federico Tesio S., breezed five-eighths of a mile in :59 2/5 at Fair Hill yesterday. "He did it as easy as a horse could do it," Shuman offered. "He cooled out great, scoped good. We are 100 percent ready for next week."

King of the Roxy Works at Belmont...

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out Team Valor's **King of the Roxy** (Littleexpectations) for his final Preakness prep yesterday morning and the colt, working in company with last year's GII Peter Pan S. winner Sunriver, stopped the timer in 1:14.92. "Both horses worked well," Pletcher commented. "King of the Roxy has to work in company." Winner of this year's GII Hutcheson S., the Ohio-bred was last seen finishing runner-up to Tiago in the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 7. "We're hoping he's going to run the race of his life on Saturday," the conditioner continued, adding, "He needs to."

THOR'S ECHO RETURNING TO U.S. Thor's Echo (Swiss Yodeler), the reigning GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner and the division's Eclipse Award winner, will return to the barn of trainer Doug O'Neill at Hollywood Park, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Campaigned last season by Pablo Suarez and Royce Jaime, Thor's Echo clinched his championship with a victory in the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash, and the duo sold the five-year-old gelding to Sheikh Rashid bin Mohammed al Maktoum in early 2007. However, the chestnut disappointed in two starts in Dubai this winter, finishing sixth in the G3 Mahab al Shimaal Mar. 1 and filling the same spot behind countrymate Kelly's Landing in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 31. Thor's Echo is scheduled to complete his quarantine on the East Coast and is expected to arrive in California Wednesday.
