has been retired from racing after fracturing the top of a sesamoid during his final work ahead of the GI Suburban H. next Saturday. He reportedly suffered a similar injury to the ankle area as a young horse. The bay was sent out for a five-furlong breeze yesterday morning in the company of

stablemate Like Now, winner of the 2006 GIII Gotham S., and the tandem covered the distance in :59.47, the best of 29 moves at the distance. The injury was not readily apparent until the horse was back at the barn, cooling out after the work. Although surgery does not appear to be indicated, the decision was made to stop on the horse at this point. "He's done everything we've ever asked of him. Soldier's Tale's career had been confined to just seven prior starts, but he had always shown talent and captured Newcastle's G3 Chipchase S. on only his fourth outing in June 2005. Injured when fourth in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket that season, the chestnut showed he retained all his ability on his belated return when an eye-catching third behind Amadeus Wolf in the May 16 G2 Duke of York S. He was sent off the 4-6 favorite to build on that at Haydock last time, but failed to fire, prompting connections to resort to the headgear. The equipment change sharpened him up sufficiently to race handily throughout the first half of the contest as he tracked Takeover Target. Driven as that rival hit the front at the quarter pole, Soldier's Tale responded gamely to reel him in and win it on the bobber. "He's had countless fractures, colic surgery and pieces of his stomach removed--he has to have a special diet as he finds it hard to digest," Jeremy Nosedo said. "We live in fear all the time of him getting colic again, but he's just a special horse and a fighter. He's twice been at the point of having to be put down, but he's fought hard and, despite all the problems, he's always been honest and tried." Joe Janiak was delighted with the run of the gallant second. "It was absolutely fantastic and he deserves a bit of a spell off now, as he's had a hard campaign and done a lot of traveling," he said. "I don't want to push him to the limit and I think we'll just pack up and go home and concentrate on the local races. I'd give Japan and Hong Kong a miss and I love the conditions in England, so I hope we'll be back next year if he's up to it." Tuesday's G2 King's Stand S. heroine Miss Andretti (Ihtiram {Ire}), sent off the 2-1 favorite, was restrained behind the early pace and, when asked for her effort, failed to pick up and trailed in 15th. "I'm dazed and dumbfounded," jockey Craig Newitt told the *Racing Post*. "She was struggling 600 metres out, which is not like her at all. It may be that the two races came a bit close together, and also the soft ground might be to blame; soft here is totally different to the soft we get back home." Last year's winner Maraahel returned to deny Scorpion in a pulsating finish, recording back-to-back renewals here. With six group successes already on his resume, the only thing missing from the list is a Group 1, which was painfully wrested from him by Notnowcato (GB) in the final stride of York's Juddmonte International S. last August. This term, the blinkered bay had defied penalties when winning the G3 John Porter S. at Newbury Apr. 21 and G3 Huxley S. at Chester May 10 before finishing third to Scorpion in Epsom's G1 Coronation Cup on his latest start June 1. It was the latter who carried the burden of a five-pound penalty yesterday, and that proved decisive as Maraahel wrought his revenge on the Ballydoyle favorite. Keen as usual out wide early, the homebred stalked the moderate early pace before being asked to close before the final turn. Getting first run on Scorpion when hitting the front at the quarter pole, he quickened to inflict the damage there and drew on reserves as that rival loomed large in the final furlong. "He's been a favorite for a long while," jockey Richard Hills commented. "I've found if he can get to the front, he's a hard horse to get by, and over four years he's pretty much taken on the best and been thereabouts. He keeps coming up with the goods and you can't ask for more." Trainer Sir Michael Stoute, who was recording his fifth renewal and his second dual scorer, after Rock Hopper (GB) in 1991 and 1992, is considering either a return to this track for a tilt at the July 28 G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. or a trip to Sandown for the July 7 G1 Eclipse S. "I think he's slightly better than ever at six--I put blinkers on instead of the visor this year and he's a little keener, but has won three out of four in them," Stoute commented. "We'll see how he comes out of this, but Sheikh Hamdan has his ideas and asked me to leave him in the Eclipse, so it's either that or the King George. It would be nice to win a Group 1 with him one day." Aidan O'Brien said of the runner-up, "He ran a stormer and it was a very good race. He was coming home well and was getting there and getting there. He is well entered, including back here in the King George, and we'll go home and discuss plans."

Makderah was third to the smart Red Evie (Ire) in last year's Listed Sandringham H. at the Royal meeting last June and in the G2 Oak Tree S. at Goodwood in August before earning black type when victorious in the October S. at Ascot in September. Last but one in the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket in October, she was transferred to this country and had two starts to her credit this term--a runner-up effort over the Keeneland turf Apr. 27 and a 5 3/4-length success going nine panels of this sod May 31. The second wagering choice in her U.S. stakes bow, the Sheikh Hamdan runner was content to trail as For Always (War Chant) and favored Jade Queen (Giant's Causeway) loped along on the front end. She advanced one position as the field hit the quarter pole, but, switched out deepest of all for the drive, blew the doors off the field with an exceptional final quarter mile of :22 1/5. "When you step up from a 'two-other-than' to a Grade 2, you don't think you are going to see the same result. But it was exactly the same," said winning trainer Kieran McLaughlin. "She was pretty impressive. I have to look ahead now. I haven't planned anything for her beyond this."

Worldly, second in his debut over the Salisbury turf Aug. 17, won his maiden at Wolverhampton Aug. 30, setting a Polytrack record in the process. Last of nine in a Newmarket handicap back on the grass Sept. 19, he has been a different sort of animal since his arrival in this country. The gray gelding made a positive and winning impression in his stateside debut going nine panels at Santa Anita Apr. 6 and shortened up to a mile in his latest to annex this track's GIII Will Rogers S. May 19. Aiming to become the first horse to add this to the Will Rogers since 1996, Worldly rated in midpack before tugging Victor Espinoza up into third approaching the far turn. Angled wide for the drive, he closed with powerful strides and proved too good for La Puente S. winner Golden Balls in the final sixteenth of a mile. The winner could make his next start in the \$1-million GII Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs July 21.

Pleasant Strike was twice second from three tries over the main track at two--including to Summer Dol-drums at Belmont in October--but has flourished with a switch to the turf this season. An eight-length maiden winner at Gulfstream Jan. 31, the Evans homebred was sixth to Queen's Plate hopeful Twilight Meteor in the Feb. 24 Hallandale Beach S. Third in what has become a key allowance over the Keeneland turf Apr. 27, the dark bay most recently took a local first-level allowance test rained onto the Polytrack May 26. Always traveling beneath top turf rider Rene Douglas, Pleasant Strike was tucked in neatly in fourth as Starbase (Tale of the Cat) and Beta Capo (Capote) exchanged blows on the front end. Tipped out as the field exited the far turn, the Virginia-bred was urged to the front leaving the eighth pole and sprinted away to win nicely. "In the stretch this horse really took off," said Douglas, who won four straight riding titles at Arlington from 2001-2004. "[Trainer] Todd [Pletcher] did a good job with this horse. Gottcha Gold only knows one way to run--he hits the gas when the starting gate opens and hopes no one can catch him. After a six-race losing streak, those tactics finally paid off yesterday. The longshot led every step of the way, holding on gamely to beat 1-10 Lawyer Ron by a neck. "I didn't have to do anything but hang on," winning jockey Chuck Lopez admitted. The front-running winner of the Choice S. at Monmouth last August and runner-up in the Majestic Prince S. in September, Gottcha Gold ran out of steam in his next four starts and finished off the board. He came to life in his latest, however. Hustled away from his outside post position in the May 28 Frisk Me Now S., the bay reeled off a suicidal opening half mile in :44. He tired in the stretch, but still managed to finish second. Lopez had better luck harnessing that speed this time. Gottcha Gold was five lengths in front after a half in :45.43 and still had daylight on the field as they dashed past the eighth pole. Lawyer Ron, coming off a third-place finish in the GI Met Mile at Belmont Park May 28, cut into that advantage late, but he ran out of real estate and Gottcha Gold was back in the winner's circle. "I didn't hit him at all, because he doesn't like to get tagged," Lopez said. "I didn't see Lawyer Ron coming and I wasn't looking--I was just riding my horse all the way to the wire." There were no excuses for the beaten favorite. "Things just didn't work our way today," said jockey John Velazquez. "That horse got loose on the front end and we couldn't get to him. We tried to make a big run in the lane, but we didn't have enough ground."

König Turf, who took the G3 Grosser Preis der Freien Hansestadt Bremen in October of 2005, was injured last year, but returned to finish third behind Apollo Star (Ger) in the Listed Frühjahrs-Meile at Cologne Apr. 1. Dead-heating for second behind that foe in the Listed Excelsior Hotel Ernst-Meile back at that track three weeks later, he was fourth in the G3 Badener Meile at Baden-Baden last time May 13. Held up behind the early pace before making a sweeping move widest of all at the top of the stretch, the bay took command with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and was pushed out to assert for a comfortable success.

Maze got off the mark first time going six furlongs at Newcastle, where he needed every yard of the trip after a slow start and trouble in running. Breaking sharper here, the chestnut was rank in the slipstream of the leading duo early before settling into a steady rhythm for Royston ffrench. Quickening to lead with 1½ furlongs remaining, he wandered around in front, which allowed newcomer Pegasus Again a chance up the far rail, but had enough in hand to eke out the victory. "On pedigree, these are the best two-year-olds I've ever had and this is a smashing horse," commented trainer Bryan Smart, following up on Royal wins with juveniles Titus Alone (Ire) in the Listed Windsor Castle S. in 2005 and Hellvelyn (GB) in the G2 Coventry S. last year. "He's hit the front too soon and run green, with the crowds and everything, but he's won on merit and is bred for the Derby, so he's a proper horse to show speed over six and seven furlongs. You probably won't see him now until the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 27], as he's a bit on the leg and is bred for a mile and a half."

Two-thirds of the field for today's opening leg of the C\$1-million Queen's Plate have raced south of the border at this junction of their careers, but the home defense is led by **Jiggs Coz**, who shoots for his fourth consecutive victory this afternoon. The gray, who broke his maiden over the local turf at first asking last October, has proved elusive in his two starts this season, taking the seven-furlong Queenston S. May 5 prior to an easy score from Eugene Melnyk's **Marchfield** in the June 3 Plate Trial S. "He's coming up [to the race] very good," said trainer Sid Attard. "You can do whatever you want with this horse. I don't think there will be any problem getting the distance." The field's best speed figure belongs to **Twilight Meteor**, who achieved it over Keeneland's Polytrack when taking last year's Bourbon S. The Todd Pletcher-trainee comes in off a third to subsequent GIII Colonial Turf Cup one-two Summer Doldrums and Strike a Deal in the Straight Deal S. over the Belmont turf May 23.

Leonnatus Anteus has been scratched from today's Classic after developing an infection in his pastern. "Obviously it is a big blow and horrendous timing, but we've made a decision to be cautious and prudent here," said trainer Kevin Attard.

Invasor Retired cont. from p1

Bred in Argentina by Haras Clausan, Invasor was an Uruguayan sensation as a Southern Hemisphere three-year-old, taking all five of his starts and that country's Triple Crown en route to earning Horse of the Year honors. Purchased privately by Sheikh Hamdan for a reported \$1.5 million, Invasor was sent to Dubai and was prepared for the 2006 G2 UAE Derby, a race in which he would suffer his lone career blemish, finishing fourth to Discreet Cat. It didn't take long for the son of Candy Stripes to showcase his heart in the U.S., when, in the GI Pimlico Special last May, he appeared hopelessly beaten at the quarter pole, only to keep digging in and eventually winning by 1 1/4 lengths. He combined with Bernardini to complete a special Pimlico wager, a foreshadowing of events to come five months down the line. He made his next two appearances in New York and announced his arrival in no uncertain terms when he landed the 2006 GI Suburban H., scoring by 4 1/4 lengths in a canter. From there, it was on to Saratoga for the GI Whitney H., and only raw determination saw Invasor find the line a nose better than Sun King. Championship honors were on the line on the first Saturday in November as dusk fell upon the Twin Spires and a clash of the Maktoum brothers was about to unfold.

A Classic Performance...

Sent off the 6.70-1 second choice behind GI Preakness S., Travers S. and GI Jockey Club Gold Cup hero Bernardini, Invasor was given a patient ride by Fernando Jara and as the cornered into the long Churchill stretch, it was clear that the Classic was headed in the direction of Sheikh Hamdan's blue and white colorbearer. Invasor reported home one length better than his younger rival, clinching year-end

honors as champion older horse and Horse of the Year. Kept in training for 2007 with an eye on the G1 Dubai World Cup, Invasor made his much-anticipated return to action in the GI Donn H. Feb. 3, but found himself looking straight down the barrel of defeat when he was boxed in with nowhere to go into the Gulfstream stretch. Calling upon all his class, Invasor sliced through a narrow opening at the fence and on to a two-length victory, the perfect prep for racing's \$6-million richest jewel.

Horse of the World...

They don't just give away the \$3.6 million first prize for the World Cup and the 10-furlong affair figured something much more than a walkover, given the presence of the up-and-coming Premium Tap. Well-placed in third, Invasor joined the John Kimmel runner at the head of the stretch, but Invasor proved too good and too classy, going on to a 1 3/4-length victory. Given ample time to recover from his efforts, Invasor had gradually been asked to do more over the recent weeks and looked in great form for his defense of the Suburban. Trainer Kiaran McLaughlin reflected on his star performer late last evening on TVG. "He's a superstar, magnificent horse and it's great that he's able to retire undefeated this year," he said. "He's been such a great horse. I feel privileged to be involved with him." Invasor retires with a record of 12-11-0-0 and earnings of \$7,804,070. He retires to stud in 2008 at Shadwell Farm in Lexington.

Perfect Drift (Dynaformer), most recently last in the GII Californian S. over the Cushion Track at Hollywood Park June 2, returned to the worktab yesterday, breezing five-eighths of a mile in 1:04.20. The move was a good bit slower than anticipated, explained trainer Murray Johnson. "He worked fine and did everything good, although he went a little slow," the Aussie said. "We were looking for a little faster move, but [exercise rider] Joe [Deegan] miscalculated a bit. But he finished his last quarter good. It doesn't look like there's a race for him for a little bit, so we'll come back with a little more serious work next week."
