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FORCING THE ISSUE

Joe Allen's homebred **Political Force** (Unbridled's Song) completed a banner day for his sire at Belmont Park yesterday by outslugging **Fairbanks** (Giant's Causeway) in yesterday's GI Suburban H. A half hour earlier, **Octave** (Unbridled's Song) bested three rivals in the GI Mother Goose S. (see p4). **Political Force** had been within a length of the winner in three straight graded-stakes races, including a 3/4-length runner-up effort to **Corinthian** (Pulpit) last out in the GI Met Mile May 28. With that colt backpedaling to finish sixth this time, **Political Force** threw his hat in the ring for handicap division honors. The grey could make his next public appearance in the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga Sept. 1. "That's probably what we'll do; give him a little rest now and point for that," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "If you want to think big, we'll probably look for two more races and then the Breeders' Cup. You've gotta think big." SCALING THE HEIGHTS

Eagle Mountain (GB) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who has come up the hard way to earn his place at the top of the pecking order at Ballydoyle, has a golden opportunity to justify that lofty position in today's G1 Budweiser Irish Derby at The Curragh. Like his industrious sire, Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's charge has been hard at work, but continues to thrive and comes here off a career-best second in the June 2 G1 Epsom Derby. Kieren Fallon seeks to become the only rider to win three consecutive Irish Derbies following his exploits on Hurricane Run (Ire) and Dylan Thomas (Ire). "His run in the Derby was great and he was beaten by one of the best Derby winners we've seen for a while," Fallon told *PA Sport*. "After Authorized went on he was ridden for second, and that run will have stood him in good stead." Cont. p2-3

BEAU PEEP

Michael Tabor and Susan Magnier's **Peeping Fawn** (Danehill) broke through with a comfortable score in yesterday's G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh. Sent off the 7-4 crowd's choice, the bay went one better than her gallant second in the June 1 Oaks at Epsom. Inhaling the game **Speciosa (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) inside the final furlong, she recorded a two-length success. "She ran home strong in the Oaks and she's won against a strong field on ground she wouldn't have been in love with," jockey Kieren Fallon said. Cont. p4

Second to Bluegrass Cat in the GIII Nashua S. in his juvenile finale, Political Force didn't have his picture taken in four 2006 outings, and underwent surgery to have an ankle chip removed following a second in a Saratoga allowance Sept. 2. He resurfaced with two straight one-mile allowance scores at Gulfstream Feb. 7 and Feb. 28, respectively, then ran third by a length in the GIII Skip Away H. Mar. 31. The grey crossed the line second in the GIII Westchester H. May 2, but lugged in and was disqualified to third.



Turning for Home Adam Coglianese

Dismissed at 24-1 in the May 28 Met Mile, the four-year-old put in a solid rally before coming up 3/4 of a length short to Corinthian. Breaking from the rail here, Cornelio Velasquez allowed his mount to come away smoothly and secured an inside trip as Fairbanks laid down splits of :24.29 and :47.53 while tracked by Corinthian and Hesanoldsalt (Broad Brush). Political Force drew closer on the sweeping turn, angled outside of Fairbanks and looked to be home free, but began to meander to the outside and allowed the pacesetter back into the race. Velasquez straightened him out and the pair crossed the wire safely in front. "He was getting late," commented Allen Jerkens. "He always lugs in, so I hope nothing's wrong with him. At least he got his Grade I." It was the fourth Suburban victory for Hall of Famer Jerkens, whose first one came back in 1962, when Beau Purple got the better of five-time Horse of the Year Kelso. Political Force is out of millionaire Glitter Woman, a half to 2001 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Unbridled Elaine (Unbridled's Song). The 3-2 chalk Corinthian was undone by his Met Mile exertions, according to jockey Kent Desormeaux. "He laid his life down last time, but today he just wasn't up to it," he said. "I can't even exaggerate. He didn't just slow down; his head came up in the air and said, 'Not today.'"

Eagle Mountain forms a four-strong challenge from the Ballydoyle barn, which has been successful with Desert King (Ire), Galileo (Ire), High Chaparral (Ire) and Dylan Thomas. **Soldier of Fortune (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) adds muscle to the Aidan O'Brien squad and was a respectable fifth in the Epsom Classic. Previously, he had equaled Longchamp's track record in the G2 Prix Noailles Apr. 8 and defied a penalty when following up in the May 10 G3 Chester Vase. Mick Kinane, who finally ended his hoodoo in this race with Galileo before recording an instant double on High Chaparral, takes the mount on the May 27 G3 Gallinule S. winner **Alexander of Hales** (Danehill). He may have found the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club coming too soon when down the field a week later. "Eagle Mountain came out of Epsom well and is in good form and Soldier of Fortune is also," O'Brien said. Alexander of Hales has considerable ground to make up on His Highness the Aga Khan's **Shamdan (Fr)** (Dr Fong), who steps up in trip after his third in that Chantilly Classic. **Cont. p3**

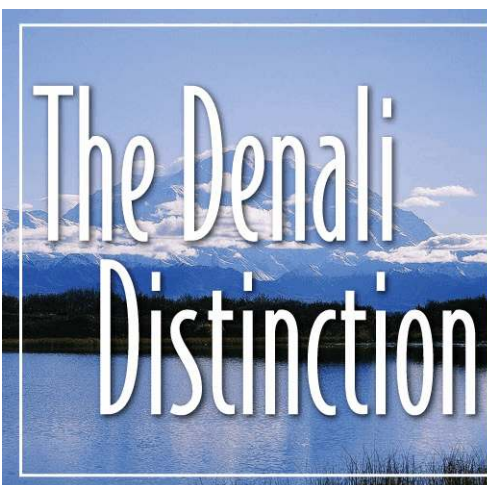
Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum has supplemented **Boscobel (GB)** (Halling) following a victory in Royal Ascot's G2 King Edward VII S. nine days ago. "He's in fantastic form," trainer Mark Johnston said. "He didn't lose a lot of weight at Royal Ascot and has put it all back on again. He has moved up several grades and he is now a Classic horse." Conditioner Kevin Prendergast is happy it's been raining for Iona Equine Syndicate's **Mores Wells (GB)** (Sadler's Wells). He battled to a victory in the G3 Ballysax S. at Leopardstown Apr. 22, but failed to build on that effort when fourth in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. last time May 13. Prendergast blamed the fast ground for that flop and is expecting better this time.

"I was disappointed, but the ground was quite firm and the winner [Archipenko] may have been feeling the effects [when last] at Epsom," Prendergast said. "I'm hoping to make the first four." Dermot Weld saddled 20-1 shot Zagreb to win this Classic in 1996 and followed up with Grey Swallow (Ire) three years ago. He is represented this time by Dr. Ronan Lambe's **Prince Erik (GB)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), who needs to step up off his Leopardstown maiden success May 13. "He's a nice horse and although he's an outsider, I think the Irish Derby is an open race this year," Weld commented. "He's a progressive sort and a big fine horse who stays well--Definite Article was beaten a short head for me in this, and he was by Indian Ridge--we have nothing to lose."

Unraced at two, Peeping Fawn graduated in a one-mile Naas maiden mile May 16. Third to Finsceal Beo (Ire) 10 days later over this course in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, she bounced back in time for a tilt at the Oaks five days later. The regally bred filly put in a strong stretch run that put her within a half length of Light Shift, and she had been giving Aidan O'Brien all the right signals since. Settled in mid-pack early as Speciosa assumed her customary front-running role, Peeping Fawn allowed that foe plenty of rope in the straight, but Kieren Fallon didn't panic and cajoled her closer inside the final quarter. Once in top gear, she produced an irresistible challenge to roll by the long-time leader with 150 yards remaining and was comfortably on top at the line. "She's a big, strong filly and is what a racehorse should look like," O'Brien commented. "She thrives on racing and is very tough. She bends her knee, so [she] handles that soft ground well, but Kieren said she should be as effective on faster. The plan is to come back for the [July 15] G1 Irish Oaks." Octave hadn't visited the winner's circle since last year's GII Adirondack Breeders' Cup S. victory at Saratoga, but had completed some noteworthy exactas in the interim. Runner-up in both the GI Matron S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies to complete 2006, the grey was second-best as the favorite in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks Mar. 10 and GI Ashland S. at Keeneland Apr. 7, then chased home stablemate Rags to Riches in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4 at Churchill in her most recent start. Octave broke from the rail here, but was eased three wide as Bold Assurance (Stormy Atlantic) led up front. The crowd's choice ranged up alongside as they straightened into the lane and resisted a persistent Lady Joanne in the final furlong for her first Grade I success. "That was a big race and she's a deserving winner," said winning trainer Todd Pletcher. He added, "She's had a Grade I coming for a while, so it was great for her to do it."

Lava Man took his bankroll past the \$5-million mark as he followed in the hoofprints of the venerable Native Diver, who swept three editions of this race in 1965-67. He had thrived in the Golden State, taking nine consecutive races on dirt and turf, but his out-of-state ventures were a letdown. The Cal-bred's hometown streak included the GI Santa Anita H., this race and the GI Pacific Classic in 2006. Seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, he came home to land the Sunshine Millions Turf Jan. 27 and successfully defended his title in the Big 'Cap Mar. 3. Trainer Doug O'Neill opted to ship his star for the G1 Dubai Duty Free Mar. 31, but the six-year-old tired badly after setting the pace and wound up last of 16. Upon Lava Man's return home, his California winning streak ended as well as After Market surged past him to win the June 9 GI Charles Whittingham H. He was favored to get back on track in his first attempt over the all-weather. A.P. Excellent bounded along on the front end, with Lava Man sitting chilly in second. He edged closer to the pacesetter on the far turn and drew even with that rival in the lane. A.P. Excellent dug in gamely, but Lava Man responded to Corey Nakatani's vigorous hand ride and found the wire first. Trainer Doug O'Neill was out of town, having travelled to Ireland to celebrate his mother's 70th birthday. He listened to the call of the race whilst in an Irish pub. "It was really old school," O'Neill told espn2. "[Announcer] Vic Stauffer really made it come alive."

The Tin Man gave it his all to make it two straight in this contest, but was outgamed to the wire by the lightly raced Out of Control, who was receiving 10 pounds from the gritty nine-year-old. Out of Control closed out his Brazilian campaign with a second-place finish in the G1 GP Presidente da Republica last August and placed second in his U.S. debut going down the hill at Santa Anita Jan. 20. He posted an allowance win in an off-the-turfer in Arcadia Feb. 23, then finished third behind C'Mon Tiger in a second-level allowance Mar. 30. Freshened up following that effort, the dark bay returned to the grass with a sharp allowance victory at Hollywood May 27 and was backed as the third choice on this step up in class here. Kept close to the lead in third as Willow O Wisp (Misnomer) showed the early way, the TNT Stud colorbearer moved in tandem with The Tin Man on the turn for home. Last year's GI Arlington Million hero took a narrow lead into the stretch, but couldn't hold off Out of Control, who took it by a head. "He was a little rank the first few jumps and then I was just trying to get him to follow The Tin Man the whole way," jockey Michael Baze said. "At the quarter pole both horses were digging in hard and I was trying to keep him there because I know how much heart The Tin Man has."

With the current desperate conditions prevalent in Hamburg, more than the normal amount of courage will be required to win the 138th renewal of this Classic. Certainly a love of deep ground is essential and the Monsun colts **Persian Storm** and **Axxos** may have a genetic advantage in that respect. With the current volatile weather hitting Europe at present, the former would be an aptly-named winner and he booked his ticket with a three-length defeat of **Davidoff**, with **First Stream** back in third, in Munich's G3 Bavarian Classic last time May 28. Persian Storm is the choice of Terry Hellier from the trio of runners representing Jens Hirschberger's barn. Axxos, runner-up to the subsequent G1 Derby Italiano second-place finisher **Shrek** in the G3 Stadtrat Albert von Metzler-Rennen at Frankfurt May 1, bested Norwegian raider **Appel au Maitre** in the premier trial, the June 10 G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen at Cologne. He is the pick of Andrasch Starke from the Peter Schiergen stable successful with **Boreal** (Ger) in 2001 and **Schiaparelli** (Ger) 12 months ago. **Anton Chekhov** is still listed as a Ballydoyle runner, but the May 8 G2 Prix Hocquart scorer is due to be sold to Austrian operation Stall Christ-Lacke and join the Uwe Ostmann stable. The homebred, handled by Pete Anderson, is the only Hobeau Farm horse not trained by Allen Jerkens. "As a personal favor, because they have been best friends for 50-odd years, [Allen] requested that I send Pete a horse," explained Hobeau manager Craig Wheeler. "A couple of years ago, we sent [Pete] some older horses and he did great with them. Allen needed another horse [to send to Pete], because those horses were gone. I told him I didn't have any older horses. Delightful Kiss was a very young two-year-old when we sent him. He was an untried commodity. Pete's brought him along one step at a time and done a great job." Anderson was the leading apprentice jockey in New York in 1948 and won the 1958 Belmont S. aboard Cavan. The 75-year-old also rode Forego to a fourth-place finish behind Secretariat in the 1973 Kentucky Derby. "I had a terrible weight problem [as a jockey], but I have been very lucky in my life," the trainer said. He added that Delightful Kiss would likely be pointed for the Aug. 4 GIII West Virginia Derby.
